FALBRAV LOVES PARIS IN THE RAIN

Rainfall in Paris was not what trainer Luca Cumani wanted to see, but it failed to stop **Falbrav (Ire)** (Fairy King) from powering to victory in yesterday's G1 Prix d'Ispahan at Longchamp. Falbrav, who was winning his fourth Group 1 event, proved he relishes a sound surface with wins in last year's G1 Japan Cup, G1 Premio Presidente della Repubblica and G1 Gran Premio di Milano. This year, he encountered testing ground when

third behind Fair Mix (Fr) in the G1 Prix Ganay, but the rain that preceded yesterday's race failed to deaden the ground and his inherent speed. With **Bright Sky (Ire)** (Wolfhound)'s rabbit **Poussin (Ire)** (Alzao) providing the necessary early pace, jockey Kieren Fallon was content to stalk before asking Falbrav

to use his turn of acceleration at the top of the straight. Seizing the advantage on the inner with 300 yards remaining, Falbrav kicked clear of the chasing Bright Sky before comfortably holding off her challenge in the drive to the line. "He's improved since he came here two weeks ago," Fallon said of the winner. "We were a bit worried about the ground, but he's overcome that. He's travelled well and really picked up--he's going to be a good horse to follow this year." Cumani added, "[Falbrav] is just as effective over a mile as a mile and a quarter, but I'm not really sure he is a mile and a half horse as he has such speed. Now we will take a look at the G1 Prince of Wales's S. [at Royal Ascot June 18]." That could also be the target for Bright Sky, whose trainer Elie Lellouche said, "She ran a great race and showed her performance in Japan was not true. She looked like she would win, but just blew up and will come on for this. The ground will decide whether she runs at Ascot as it has to be soft." *Race chart p. 2*

FIDELITE TAKES SAINT-ALARY

Fidelite (Ire) (In the Wings {GB}) swooped late under jockey Olivier Peslier to take yesterday's G1 Prix Saint-Alary at Longchamp. Having taken a conditions event over course and distance Mar. 20, she was fourth behind the **Campsie Fells (UAE)** (Indian Ridge {Ire}) in the G3 Prix Vanteaux Apr. 27 before coming into this trial for the G1 Prix de Diane Hermes (French Oaks) at Chantilly June 8. Held up in rear early as **Summitville (GB)** (Grand Lodge) proved a reluctant leader, she quickened impressively in the straight and within a few strides had joined **Hi Dubai (GB)** (Rahy) at the furlong marker. Swamping that rival for speed, she was coaxed to a comfortable success as **Arvada (GB)** (Hernando {Fr}) closed late to fill the frame. Conditioner Criquelette Head-Maarek, enjoying her sixth renewal of this contest, commented, "Last time in the Vanteaux, she could not run her race as they went too slow, but today she showed how good she really is. I knew she could quicken off a good tempo and she has booked her place in the Diane." She will be joined by Aravada there, while the Epsom version June 6 is the next stop for Hi Dubai. Meridiana, completing an afternoon stakes double for jockey Andreas Suborics, provided conditioner Hans Blume with his second renewal of this Classic after the exploits of Nagoya (Ger) in 1999. On a day when the San Siro belonged to Germany, the talented filly flew the flag by cutting down Godolphin's Lady Catherine in the closing stages. In doing so, she was avenging her defeat by that rival when a disappointing seventh in the G3 Premio Dormello at this track in October, having previously taken the Listed Kronimus-Rennen at Baden-Baden in August. She had warmed up for this contest by winning the Listed Kolner Fruhjahrens-Stuten-Preis at Cologne Apr. 21, underlining her toughness and durability. She used those qualities to outbattle the game Lady Catherine, who attempted to make all under an enterprising Jamie Spencer ride, stalking her throughout before getting on top with 100 yards remaining. Vale Mantovani ran on strongly to reverse the form of the G2 Premio Regina Elena (Italian 1000 Guineas) with the winner Golden Nepi (Ire) (Revoque {Ire}), who appeared to find the trip beyond her. "She loves top of the ground and in the Dormello she was over the top and gone in her coat," Blume explained. "She is a good filly, but I'm not sure where she will go now."

Funny Cide Back Home

Just a few hours after taking a step closer to racing immortality, Kentucky Derby and Preakness winner **Funny Cide** (Distorted Humor) was on a van back to his home base at Belmont Park. The chestnut gelding left Pimlico shortly after 9 p.m. and arrived at Belmont just after 1 a.m. Sunday. "The trip back was fine," said Robin Smullen, assistant to trainer Barclay Tagg. "What's pretty remarkable is that he got his [feed] tub put in at 1:45 a.m., and when I got here at five o'clock this morning, it had absolutely been polished. To me, that's amazing; to ship and run and ship in the middle of the night back. You'd think he'd be exhausted, but he licked his tub--again." Looking ahead to the June 7 GI Belmont S., Tagg commented, "As long as he handles everything like he did the last few weeks, I can't see any problem with it. But you always have to wonder with a horse. Sometimes you think they're doing well and they fall apart on you. They are athletes and we put them under a lot of stress." Tagg said Funny Cide would likely have two workouts prior to the Belmont. Standing between Funny Cide and the Triple Crown are would-be spoilers **Empire Maker** (Unbridled), **Dynever** (Dynaformer) and **Atswhatimtalknabout** (A.P. Indy), but Tagg isn't concerned about the competition. "To tell you the truth, I'm not worried about any of them," the trainer said. "I think they have to beat this horse now. I don't think he has to beat them."

Preakness Also Rans Consider Belmont

Midway Road (Jade Hunter), second in Saturday's Preakness, could start in the Belmont. "We'll watch him and wait before making any future plans for him right now," said trainer Neil Howard. "The Belmont S. remains a possibility, but it's too early to make that call. I'll talk to [owner] Mr. [Will] Farish and we will make that decision when the time is right."

Also contemplating the Belmont is trainer D. Wayne Lukas, whose **Scrimshaw** (Gulch) ran third and **Ten Cents a Shine** (Devil His Due) ran ninth. "Scrimshaw is probable for the Belmont," Lukas said yesterday. "And Ten Cents a Shine is still possible." Lukas added that Ten Cents a Shine may be gelded before his next start.

Cut Quartz looked a natural at the stayers' game when beating Clety (Fr) (Sillery) and Morozov (Sadler's Wells) on his first attempt at an extended trip in the G2 Prix Kergolay at Deauville in August. He again had Clety behind when finishing fourth, before being promoted to third, behind Give Notice (GB) in the G1 Prix du Cadran at this track in October. He disappointed back here later in the month when only seventh in the G1 Royal-Oak behind Mr Dinos (Ire), but showed promise when fifth on his return over an inadequate mile and a half in the G3 Prix d'Hedouville at this track Apr. 17. Held up off the even pace set by Orchestra Stall (GB) (Old Vic {GB}) in this contest, he quickened in pursuit of Morozov when the sprint began in the straight. Collaring that rival with 50 yards remaining, he was the strongest in the finish and gained the upper hand to score comfortably. "He has come on a lot for his first run," conditioner Richard Gibson said. "The rain came just in time as he needs give, but he's a marvellous horse who has never let us down. He is in the G1 Ascot Gold Cup [at Royal Ascot June 19] and may go there if the ground is soft."
