ATSWHATIMTALKNBOUT OUT OF BELMONT

Atswhatimtalknbout (A.P. Indy), fourth last time out in the GI Kentucky Derby May 3, will bypass the final leg of the Triple Crown, the GI Belmont S. June 7. Following a routine workout May 20, the bay developed an abscess in his right front foot which later turned into a quarter crack. The affected foot was patched and appeared to be healing normally until an uninspiring mile

work in 1:46 4/5 Wednesday left trainer Ron Ellis looking for answers. "He was trying to tell me something [Wednesday], so I think I'll go ahead and listen to him," said Ellis. "There is another one [quarter crack] starting to form in front of the old one," he said. "The foot's just not stable." According to Ellis, the B. Wayne Hughes and Biscuit Stable-owned colt will be on the sidelines for an undetermined period. "I don't have a timetable for him," said Ellis.

"We'll just wait and see how long it takes to grow that foot

out right and make sure that it's going to stay in good shape. I don't want to do it halfway." Second in the GI San Felipe S. at Santa Anita Mar. 16, the son of the Red Ransom mare Lucinda K is a winner of two of six races and \$209,120 in earnings.

BELMONT TOO SOON FOR COLITA

Team Valor's **Colita** (Grindstone), a winner of half of six lifetime starts, including a 8 1/2-furlong allowance event last time out at Belmont Park May 21, has been taken out of consideration for the June 7 GI Belmont S. "It's just running back too quick," said Team Valor President Barry Irwin. "He ran real fast [last time] and he hasn't recovered. This is a tough race. We don't want to bring him back this quick." According to Irwin, the dark bay will be targeted for Saratoga's Midsummer Derby, the GI Travers S. Aug. 23.

LADIES DIN RETIRED

Bernie Schiappa's and Terrence Lanni's multiple Grade I winner **Ladies Din** (Din's Dancer--Ladies Double, by Kris S.), winner of the 2000 GI Eddie Read H. and the 2002 GI Shoemaker Breeders' Cup Mile, has been retired from racing, reports the *Daily Racing Form*. Sixth behind Redattore most recently in this year's edition of the Shoemaker Mile May 26, the gelding retires with 12 wins from 35 lifetime starts and earnings of \$1,906,754. According to Schiappa, the eight-year-old, who was trained by Ron Ellis and Julio Canani earlier in his career, will remain with current trainer Frank Monteone for the next two weeks before heading to Valley Creek Farm in Southern California.

Outsiders Face the Ballot

Officials at Epsom racecourse are facing the possibility of balloting out several of the contenders for next Saturday's G1 Vodafone Derby. Revealing that the reduction of the maximum field from 30 to 20 was necessary to avoid "the risk of an unsafe race," Clerk of the Course Andrew Cooper explained. "The horses with the lowest official rating, according to the BHB handicapper Nigel Grey, will be eliminated," he said. "You have to remember the Derby only once in the last 20 years has had a field in excess of 20 and that was Erhaab's year in '94 where there was a faller." Cooper described the going as currently good, adding that the dry spell would make the surface faster. Trainer John Oxx was relieved to hear that news as he prepares **Alamshar (Ire)** (Key of Luck) for the Classic. "I understand the ground is perfect at Epsom at the moment, not quite as fast as Sandown," he told *PA Sport*. "The faster the ground the better. It would suit Alamshar, and mightn't help the Sadler's Wells colts, but soft ground blunts his turn of foot."

Jockeying for Position

Jockey plans for next Saturday's G1 Vodafone Derby at Epsom are beginning to firm with the news that Pat Eddery will join the team of partners for Aidan O'Brien's selected runners. Despite links to the Terry Mills-trained **Let Me Try Again (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), the three-time Derby winner has switched to **The Great Gatsby (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), runner-up to Alamshar (Ire) in the G2 Derrinstown Stud Derby Trial at Leopardstown May 11. "I am sorry to let Terry Mills down as I'm sure his horse will run well, but this looks like quite a good horse and he's improving," Eddery explained. "The Derby only comes once a year and he's a Sadler's Wells colt on the up. He only just got copped by Alamshar at Leopardstown, so he's got to have a good chance. Let Me Try Again is an improving horse and stays well--I just felt if it was soft ground it would help him a little bit. When you get offered a really nice horse, like Aidan O'Brien's, it's hard to turn it down."

Fallon High on Kris Kin

Jockey Kieren Fallon, who committed to the Sir Michael Stoute-trained **Kris Kin** (Kris S.) on Wednesday, is looking forward to the ride on the winner of the Listed Dee S. at Chester May 8. "He has worked well and has to take his chance in a wide-open race," Fallon told the *Racing Post*. "The way he went round Chester you would think he would act around Epsom."

Godolphin on Hi

Hi Dubai (GB) (Rahy) headed the 21 acceptors for next Friday's £375,000 G1 Vodafone Oaks at Epsom after the May 22 final forfeit stage. Godolphin's main contender, who was runner-up in the G1 Prix Saint-Alary at Longchamp May 18, pleased connections when working over five furlongs on the Limekilns trial grounds on Wednesday morning. She was one of four fillies left in by the Dubai-based operation, including UAE 1000 Guineas winner **Mezzo Soprano** (Darshaan {GB}). **Yesterday (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) and **L'Ancrese (Ire)** (Darshaan {GB}), first and fourth, respectively, in Sunday's G1 Irish 1000 Guineas at The Curragh, represent Aidan O'Brien, while other notables include **Hanami (GB)** (Hernando {Fr}), fifth in the G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket May 4 and the Sir Michael Stoute-trained **Halawanda (Ire)** (Ashkalani {Ire}), runner-up in the Listed Cheshire Oaks at Chester May 7. The winner of that contest, **Hammiya (Ire)** (Darshaan {GB}), is likely to be added to the field by trainer Marcus Tregoney Saturday.

Ocean Silk and Spanish Sun Unlikely for Oaks

Listed Lupe S. winner **Ocean Silk** (Dynaformer) looks increasingly likely to miss next Friday's G1 Vodafone Oaks at Epsom and wait for the G2 Ribblesdale S. at Royal Ascot June 19. Ben Sangster, racing manager and son of owner Robert Sangster, told *PA Sport* yesterday, "I would say it's 95 percent certain she will not be going to Epsom. I think the thought is to go to Ascot for the Ribblesdale, as she might not handle the track at Epsom." Also set to sidestep the fillies' Classic is the Sir Michael Stoute-trained **Spanish Sun** (El Prado {Ire}), who is also likely for the Royal Ascot contest.
