“QUEEN” STREAKS INTO SHEEPSHEAD BAY

Undefeated since shipping to the U.S., **Lilac Queen (Ger)** (Law Society) will try to keep her streak alive in the GII Sheepshead Bay H. at Belmont Park today. The five-year-old has made the most of her six career starts. Twice a winner in Germany, she missed by a neck when second in the G1 German Oaks in June of 2001, then disappeared for nearly 20 months. “I’ve had her for a while, but she wasn’t right and I didn’t run her for a long time,” trainer Bobby Frankel said. But the dark bay is right now. She kicked off her U.S. career with a win vs. optional-claiming company at Santa Anita Jan. 24, took a short break, then resurfaced to post a 5 3/4-length score in a Keeneland allowance Apr. 6. Last time out, Lilac Queen cruised to victory in the 12-furlong GIII Bewitch S. She makes her Belmont debut. **Owsley (Harlan)** has won three of five tries on the Belmont turf. Beaten just a half length when fourth in last year’s Sheepshead Bay, she came back to take the GII New York H. and also accounted for the GIII Glens Falls H. at Saratoga and the GII WinStar Galaxy S. at Keeneland before ending the season with a 12th-place finish in the GI Breeders’ Cup F/M Turf. She has started once this season, running fourth in the May 3 GIII Beaugay H.

DALAKHANI HEADS ALL-FRENCH AFFAIR

Dalakhani (Ire) (Darshaan {GB}) will face no overseas opposition in tomorrow’s G1 Prix du Jockey-Club (French Derby) at Chantilly. His Highness the Aga Khan’s grey will renew acquaintances with **Super Celebre (Peintre Celebre)**, who was a length back in second in the G1 Prix Lupin May 11. Alain de Royer-Dupre, trainer of Dalakhani, reported that “all is going to plan” with the favourite’s preparation for the Classic, due to be run on ground described as good to firm, or 2.9 on the penetrometer. Despite a risk of showers tomorrow afternoon, clerk of the course Mathieu Vincent applied 10 mm of water to the track yesterday evening. Alberto Giacometti (Ire), who was third in that contest, was yesterday withdrawn from the French Classic by Aidan O’Brien along with stable companion Balestrini (Ire). That duo will take their chance in next Saturday’s Epsom equivalent, leaving a field of seven to face the starter tomorrow, the smallest field since Suave Dancer beat his six rivals in 1991. Frankie Dettori has been booked for the Andre Fabre-trained **Papineau (GB)** (Singpiel {Ire}), who faces a rematch with **Touch of Land (Fr)** (Lando {Ger}). The former was beaten a short-head by that rival on his debut in a conditions event at Saint-Cloud Apr. 2. Touch of Land, who was purchased by Gary Tanaka earlier in the week, has been supplemented by connections at a cost of €60,000.

Ingolf registered a mild upset to earn his first group success, while 17-10 favorite Danehurst (Danehill) struggled home 10th. Reserved off the early pace, the five-year-old rolled up into contention with two furlongs to run, hit the front at the eighth pole and ran on well to easily account for Gold Type, who was up late for second. British shipper Danehurst failed to make an impact after a poor start compromised her chances.

REINSTATED: The American Graded Stakes Committee has decided to reinstate Grade III status for the Jersey Derby, run last Monday at Monmouth Park. Heavy rains forced the race to be run on the main track. The winner **Happy Trails** (Peaks and Valleys), a claimer making his first start in open company, will be credited with a Grade III victory. Second was **Stone Canyon** (Mt. Livermore) and third was **Angelic Aura** (Concerto).

Not so lucky was the Jaipur H. at Belmont Park the same day, which will remain an ungraded stakes race this year. Originally scheduled for the turf, the seven-furlong race was contested on the main track after storms moved through the New York area. The race was won by **Garnered** (HolyBull).

FASIG-TIPTON SET FOR SUMMER Fasig-Tipton has announced that approximately 890 yearlings have been catalogued for its three summer sales this year. The company will kick off the yearling sale season with 460 head in Kentucky July 16 and 17, then will continue with 220 at Saratoga Aug. 5-7 before concluding with roughly 210 New York-breds Aug. 10 and 11. "Our Kentucky sale will be smaller than last year," said Fasig-Tipton President Walt Robertson, "while the total for our two Saratoga sales balances out pretty much the same." The effects of Mare Reproductive Loss Syndrome are being felt at the summer sales. "MRLS hit us harder for our July Sale," Robertson explained. "The largest percentage of losses came early in the year and we find that most of our strong, precocious types for July are early foals. We knew going in that our July numbers would be light, but we were determined not to relax our criteria in the selection process. As a result, we'll have a smaller catalogue here in Kentucky, but we are excited by the overall physical qualities of our 2003 summer yearlings." Catalogues for the July Sale will be available June 16, for the Saratoga Sale June 23 and for the New York-Bred Preferred Sale July 11. For more information, log on to www.fasigtipton.com.

Peace Rules Works:

Working out for the first time since his distant fourth behind Funny Cide in the Preakness S., **Peace Rules** (Jules) breezed a half mile in :48 and galloped out five furlongs in 1:00 4/5 over Belmont's main track Friday morning with jockey Edgar Prado up. "He felt good," Prado said. "He went nice and easy [and had] plenty left. His Derby was great. I just don't think he cared for the track at Pimlico." Trainer Bobby Frankel said that the Virginia Derby, run on the turf July 12 at Colonial Downs, is the colt's next potential start.

Promising juvenile **El Sysco Kid** (Sea of Secrets) was euthanized Tuesday after suffering from severe complications from colitis. The flashy chestnut had finished second in his only career start in the GIII Three Chimneys Juvenile S. on the Kentucky Derby undercard May 3. "This cuts the heart right out of you," Ernie Retamoza, who bred, trained and owned 70 percent of the colt, told *Daily Racing Form*. "I thought this colt was going to take me to the show." El Sysco Kid was insured for \$500,000.
