D-DAY FOR DALAKHANI

Dalakhani (Ire) (Darshaan {GB}) has scared off most of the opposition as he bids to emulate his sire in winning the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club at Chantilly this afternoon. In 1984, Darshaan bested Sadler's Wells and

Rainbow Quest in a race for the ages. While the competition is not quite so illustrious, Dalakhani faces a select field of rivals as he defends his perfect record and seeks to provide his owner and trainer with their fourth renewal of this event, and their first since 1987. The

gray followed a debut score at Deauville in August with a smooth success in the G3 Prix des Chenes in September, then recorded a hard-fought neck verdict over Chevalier (Ire) in the G1 Criterium International at Saint-Cloud in November. Rated the best domestically trained juvenile at 118 pounds in the 2002 International Classifications, he showed he retained his ability when beating Jipapibaquigrafo by a half length on his return in the G2 Prix Greffulhe at Longchamp Apr. 20. His big test came in the G1 Prix Lupin May 11, but he proved its equal, comfortably holding **Super Celebre** (Peintre Celebre) by a length while only briefly out of cruise control. Super Celebre, whose sire was one of the finest winners in this Classic's prestigious history in 1997, has another shot at the champ as he bids to provide Elie Lellouche with his first French Derby. The colt beat **Coroner (Ire)** (Mtoto {GB}) by 2 1/2 lengths in the G2 Prix Noailles Apr. 6, showing a measure of his sire's impressive acceleration. **Papineau (GB)** (Singspiel {Ire}) has made strides since finishing a short-head runner-up to **Touch of Land (Fr)** (Lando {Ger}) on his debut in a conditions event at Saint-Cloud Apr. 2. After taking a similar contest at that track Apr. 28, he won the Listed Prix de l'Avre at Longchamp May 15, the race that connections used as a springboard to this race for Sulamani (Ire) last year. His trainer, Andre Fabre, whose only previous success in this race came with Peintre Celebre, has already scooped the first two domestic Classics this year. **Prix du Jockey-Club field, p5**

THE SKY'S THE LIMIT

The skies opened up yesterday afternoon over Belmont Park, turning the turf course into a near bog, but **Mariensky** (Gulch) relished the conditions as she sprinted away from **Owsley** (Harlan) to record an easy win in the GII Sheepshead Bay H. Favored **Lilac Queen (Ger)** (Law Society) floundered in the heavy going to be fifth. A Listed winner in France, Mariensky was a close third in her U.S. bow in the GIII Lake George S. last July and a nose second in the GIII Valley View S. over a yielding Keeneland turf Oct. 19. Shelved following a seventh in the Nov. 16 GII Mrs. Revere S. at Churchill, the bay resurfaced to score a two-length allowance victory at Aqueduct May 4. Sent off at longshot odds on the return to graded company, Mariensky was patiently handled early, advanced on the final turn, overtook Owsley at the eighth pole and stormed clear. "I told [jockey] Johnny [Velazquez] just to make sure she relaxed," commented winning trainer Christophe Clement. "Obviously she likes it soft and she ran a good race." Following a two-length victory in last year's GIII Elkhorn S. across I-65 in Lexington, Kim Loves Bucky could do no better than seventh (placed sixth) in this event, a result that kicked off a six-race losing streak. Returned to his California base, the gelding was sixth in a June 30 optional claimer at Hollywood Park, a close fourth in the GII Sunset H. in Inglewood the following month and fifth in the GII Del Mar H. in early September. Sent back across the continent, the bay led past the eighth pole of the GI Turf Classic at Belmont Sept. 29 before finishing fourth, but ended his four-year-old campaign with a sixth-place effort in the Sycamore Breeders' Cup S. at Keeneland Oct. 6. Given plenty of time to rest, he made a successful defense of his Elkhorn title Apr. 23, but was coming into this off a fifth to the promising Storming Home (GB) in the Jim Murray Memorial H. at Hollywood May 10. In front in the opening strides, Kim Loves Bucky was eased back to track pacesetting favorite Quest Star (Broad Brush) from second, battled that one into submission turning for home and withstood the late run of Rochester for the victory. "He was supposed to go to the front," explained winning trainer John Glenney, "but Quest Star wanted it, so it played out better for us. We wanted him to be out front to stay out of trouble." The winner is possible for the \$750,000 GI United Nations H. [11 furlongs] at Monmouth Park July 5.

Second going a flat mile May 24, the grey stretches back out to a more comfortable distance for this.

Tashkandi bids to provide connections of Dalakhani (Ire) with the perfect precursor to that colt's bid for Classic glory. Alain de Royer-Dupre is a master of patience as a trainer, so it is a major pointer to the regard in which he is held that this will be the third time the grey has been tested within three weeks. He could not have won any easier on his sophomore debut, a Longchamp conditions event May 11, and barely had to extend to win the Listed Prix de Pontarme over a mile at this track nine days ago. **Marshall**, who will race in the colors carried successfully by Rouvres (Fr) in this 12 months ago, had **Art Moderne** back in third when winning the G3 Prix de Guiche May 15. He was previously beaten a short neck when runner-up to **Vadalix** in the Listed Prix Matchem Apr. 15. Vadalix's trainer Andre Fabre has won this twice since 1989, but he appears held by **Vespone**, who beat him by two lengths in the G3 Prix la Force May 5.

Habitual front-runner **Captain Rio** appeared to go too fast too early when finding Miss Emma (Ire) four lengths too strong in the G3 Greenlands S. at The Curragh May 24. Those tactics had paid handsome dividends last term when winning the Listed Testimonial S. by eight lengths in early October, but they were less effective when being beaten a head by Danehurst (GB) later in the month in the G3 Prix de Seine-et-Oise at Maisons-Laffitte. However, those employing bold tactics have been rewarded in France, as Best Walking (Ger) demonstrated by stealing a healthy lead in the G3 Prix de Saint-Georges at Longchamp May 11. **Ziping**, who missed the kick on that occasion, could fare no better than to close to within 1 1/2 lengths at the line. It may be possible he finds five furlongs too sharp, as his best performance came over the six furlongs of the Deauville straight when winning the G3 Prix de Ris-Orangis in July. He was doing his best work at the finish of the G1 Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp in October, where he finished third, but needs to display more early dash here.

Empire Maker Works Well

Juddmonte Farms' **Empire Maker** (Unbridled) breezed six furlongs yesterday morning over a fast Belmont main track in 1:13 as he continues his preparations for Saturday's GI Belmont S. The son of Toussaud was caught in splits of :38 3/5 for the first three-eighths and five panels in 1:01 1/5 before galloping out in 1:27 for seven furlongs. "I was just looking for him to go well and he did," trainer Bobby Frankel commented. "He finished up very well, but that doesn't mean anything." After finishing second as the 5-2 favorite in the May 3 Kentucky Derby, Frankel decided it was in the colt's best interest to skip the Preakness and point for the 1 1/2-mile conclusion to the Triple Crown. So has Empire Maker progressed since the first Saturday in May? "It's hard to say," Frankel explained. "He's been going good every day since the Derby. Some people have come by his stall and say it looks like he's put on weight, but for me it's hard to tell since I see him every day."

Wild and Wicked to Thistledown

Wild and Wicked (Wild Again), who has shown infinite promise in winning the first two starts of his career, will bypass Saturday's Belmont S. in favor of the GII Ohio Derby at Thistledown June 21. "More than anything we just decided to be more conservative, take a little more time and not throw him into the ring with the lions--although I think he's a lion himself," trainer Ken McPeck said yesterday. "If we wanted to be more aggressive and throw him in there, I wouldn't be scared to. He's a special horse and you're going to hear more about him." A half brother to 1994 champion older horse The Wicked North, the dark bay won his maiden by 9 1/2 lengths at Keeneland Apr. 25 before registering a 2 3/4-length success in his two-turn bow at Churchill last Sunday.

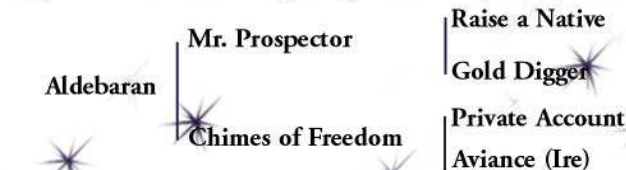
