DALAKHANI STORMS TO DERBY WIN

Dalakhani (Ire) (Darshaan {GB}) turned on the after-burners to beat **Super Celebre** (Peintre Celebre) by two lengths as the 2-5 favourite in yesterday's G1 Prix du Jockey-Club (French Derby) at Chantilly. In doing so, the unbeaten grey provided a fifth Derby win for owner-breeder His Highness the Aga Khan, a fourth for trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre and a second for an emotional jockey Christophe Soumillon. The latter had the privilege of steering the son of 1984 Jockey-Club hero Darshaan to an impressive success, stalking the rabbit **Diyapour (Fr)** (Alhaarth {Ire}) before traveling sweetly to the front at the quarter-mile marker. **Cont. p. 2**

Outta Here Drills

MGSP **Outta Here** (Dehere), seventh in the Kentucky Derby, worked a mile over Hollywood Park's turf course yesterday in 1:43 3/5. The colt remains possible for Saturday's G1 Belmont S. "He went okay," said co-owner and trainer William Currin. "The dogs were way the hell out. I'm sitting on the fence [for the Belmont] now. We'll see how he cools out and make a decision tomorrow."

Also sitting on the Belmont fence is Preakness runner-up **Midway Road** (Jade Hunter). Trainer Neil Howard reported yesterday that a decision on the colt's participation in the 1 1/2-mile Classic would be made today. And Scott Schwartz, trainer of GII Peter Pan S. winner **Go Rockin' Robin** (Distorted Humor) has not ruled out a start in the Belmont. "We're really not leaning towards it, but it's not out of the question," Schwartz commented. "There are some horses that have dropped out of the Belmont, but you still have Funny Cide, Empire Maker and Dynever. The three best horses are still in the race. We'll definitely meet them somewhere down the road."

MAGISTRETTI PLEASES

Magistretti (Diesis {GB}) pleased connections yesterday as he continued his preparation for Saturday's G1 Vodafone Derby at Epsom. After overseeing the G2 Dante S. winner gallop up Newmarket's Rowley Mile racecourse, conditioner Neville Callaghan told *PA Sport*, "He went fine. He went a mile and did exactly what we wanted and did it in the manner which we would have expected. As things stand, we are quite happy and we are entitled to be there. He's a nice horse, but whether he'll stay I don't think anyone really knows. If he does stay, he'll obviously be thereabouts. I don't want rain. Good ground is fine. He's a horse who doesn't need a lot of work. He appears to be in very good form. The hope is that he's improving in which case you never know." **Classic Corner cont. p. 2**

SAEED HIGH ON DUBAI

Trainer Saeed bin Suroor yesterday gave an upbeat bulletin on **Hi Dubai (GB)** (Rahy) ahead of Friday's G1 Vodafone Oaks at Epsom. Godolphin's sister to Fantastic Light has continued to please after her second in the G1 Prix Saint-Alary at Longchamp Apr. 18. "She worked really well four days ago over a mile of Newmarket's Round Gallop," he commented. "I am happy with her. A mile and a half will not be a problem and she is improving. She has a great chance in the race, but I would prefer good ground rather than fast."

Quickening from the quarter-mile, Dalakhani left Super Celebre with the now-familiar sight of his hindquarters before allowing his young jockey the chance to showboat in the closing stages. "I said I would get him to the Derby without touching him with my whip," commented an ebullient Christophe Soumillon. "He just cruised to the front today and took off like the brilliant horse he is." Dalakhani has proved that he can win any which way, scoring with ease in the G3 Prix des Chenes at Longchamp in September and getting down to fight with Chevalier (Ire) when following up in the G1 Criterium International at Saint-Cloud in November. Returning to win the G2 Prix Greffulhe at Longchamp Apr. 20, he showed he was ready for this test by comfortably beating Super Celebre by a length in the G1 Prix Lupin back at that track May 11. "Our aim is always to breed the best possible, and I try to follow my grandfather and father in that respect," explained owner-breeder His Highness the Aga Khan, whose first success in this Classic came 24 years ago. "When he retires, he will be a great opportunity for breeders, as he is free of Northern Dancer blood, with his pedigree all built around Never Bend. He is a great horse who is maturing and we enjoy being around him." Alain de Royer-Dupre added, "Of all the greats I have trained for His Highness, Dalakhani is the most complete racehorse. He has all the qualities--he has speed, he stays and he always relaxes perfectly. He likes the company of people and is a pleasure to train, making it very easy for me. We will wait until after Epsom to see if he goes to The Curragh for the G1 Irish Derby [June 29] and if we miss that we will wait and ready him for the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe [at Longchamp Oct. 5]. Vespone made all to turn this seemingly competitive contest into a procession under Christophe-Patrice Lemaire. Still travelling on the bridle as the field entered the straight, he was the last to be asked a question, but when given the office at the quarter-mile marker, he quickened impressively to settle the result in a matter of strides. Vespone's ride to prominence began with an impressive conditions score at Saint-Cloud Mar. 20 before finishing runner-up to Mister Charm (Fr) in the Listed Prix Djebel at Maisons-Laffitte Apr. 7. Stepped up in trip last time, he comfortably beat Vadalix (Fr) (Linamix {Fr}) by two lengths in the G3 Prix la Force at Saint-Cloud May 5. "He is a lovely horse," trainer Nicolas Clement commented. "He had proved his stamina last time in the Prix la Force, so we didn't want to get caught up in a French-style tactical race at this trip. He took the race by the scruff of the neck, relaxed perfectly in front and quickened well. We will consider the G1 Grand Prix de Paris [at Longchamp June 22], but he would have to be supplemented." Second to Olympic Express (GB) in the 2002 G1-HK Hong Kong Derby, Precision swept onto the world stage with a stunning victory over the likes of Paolini (Ger), Sarafan and Grandera (Ire) in the G1 Hong Kong Cup last December, winning by a short head at odds of 65-1. The grey had found the going a bit tougher at age five, losing each of his four previous starts. The French-bred finished 10th, 5 3/4 lengths behind Eishin Preston and Elegant Fashion, in the G1 Audemars Piguet Queen Elizabeth II Cup Apr. 27 and was more recently an improved second in the G2-HK Queen's Silver Jubilee Cup over an insufficient 1600 meters May 24. Trying this distance for the first time in his career, Precision raced about midpack as the leaders set a dawdling pace up front. Still well in arrears approaching the final turn, the gelding began to pick it up with about 600 meters to race, swept widest of all into the stretch, engaged Elegant Fashion at the furlong marker and outfinished that rival for the win. The latter had a ground saving trip from fifth, struck the front at the three-sixteenths, but could not hold the winner while staying on gamely for second. "I felt very confident once we straightened up," commented winning rider Brett Prebble, who was having his first ride aboard Precision. "He really let down and showed a lot of guts. I always felt we would hold Elegant Fashion." The winner will be put away for the summer with an eye on the International Meeting in December. **Click for free brisnet.com pedigree.**

Strait From Texas, winner of last summer's Ontario Colleen H., had a Tampa Bay allowance victory and a win in that track's Hillsborough S. in March to her 2003 credit and was coming off an 11th-place effort in the GIII Distaff Turf Mile at Churchill Downs May 3. Lightly regarded in her return to the Canadian turf, the dark bay filly moved to challenge for the lead with a four-wide move into the stretch. Asked for run at midstretch, Strait from Texas overtook Chopinina late for the half-length tally. "She's a nice filly," admitted winning trainer Paul Buttigieg. "I bought her at the Fasig-Tipton [October] sale [for \$12,500] and I really liked her from the word go." Winning rider Richard Dos Ramos added, "I know she has a nice little kick to her. I had a little bit of a time settling her, but when I settled her down turning into the lane, I knew I had the two horses in front. Jockey Frankie Dettori had it in mind that he was up against two dubious stayers in Acago and Intercontinental and maximized the stamina of Maiden Tower to record a convincing score. Sent into a clear advantage in the early stages, Maiden Tower piled on the pressure off the final turn and that proved decisive as Olivier Peslier pulled Acago out of the pack too late. Her strong finishing burst was not enough to pull back the significant distance Dettori had poached. Maiden Tower has proved a thoroughly game and genuine performer this term, winning the Listed Prix la Camargo at Saint-Cloud Mar. 25 and G3 Prix de la Grotte at Longchamp Apr. 20 before finishing a length runner-up to Musical Chimes in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches (French 1000 Guineas) back at that track May 11. "Maiden Tower is so tough," conditioner Henri-Alex Pantall commented. "She was badly drawn in the Pouliches last time and so had to race too early without the easy lead she enjoys. She was perfect for Frankie today and they got into a good tempo and won nicely. I will have to discuss things with her owner but maybe she will have a break now and miss the G1 Coronation S. [at Royal Ascot June 20]." Dettori, recording his 300th group win, added, "She's a nice filly and has a lot of speed. She could even run a bit shorter." Intercontinental, who failed to stay the mile at Newmarket in the May 4 1000 Guineas, raced keenly in the early stages without cover and again tired. Teddy Beckett, racing manager to Intercontinental's owner Khalid Abdullah, said of the filly, "She didn't stay. Olivier Peslier waited for the pacesetters to burn themselves up before swooping late on Porlezza to take this prize. In doing so, the filly was winning for the first time since beating Maybe Forever (GB) by a neck in this race 12 months ago. Highly tried after, she struggled to find her feet in better company, finishing a disappointing 12th in the G1 Nunthorpe S. at York in August and seventh in the G1 Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp in October. She offered little hope that there was better to come when last of seven on her return in the G3 Prix de Saint-Georges at Longchamp May 11, but delivered under a fine waiting ride from Peslier here. 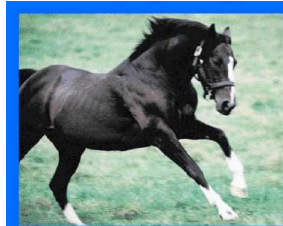
