**THE EMPIRE STRIKES BACK**

Eight weeks ago, immediately after winning the GI Wood Memorial with **Empire Maker** (Unbridled), trainer Bobby Frankel must have envisioned a victory in the GI Belmont S. as a Triple Crown coronation for the regally bred colt. The story didn't go exactly to script, instead taking a bit of a Horatio Alger twist, but the Brooklyn-born trainer finally won his first Classic when **Empire Maker** glided over a soupy surface in front of 101,864 fans as Kentucky Derby and Preakness hero **Funny Cide** (Distorted Humor) finished third in his Triple Crown bid.

"I guess [the Triple Crown] wasn't meant to be," Frankel said. "But I've got a little redemption now." It was also the first U.S. Classic win for Juddmonte. "I'm sorry, New York, that there's no Triple Crown for your New York-bred, but I've got a New York-bred trainer," said Juddmonte's Dr. John Chandler.

**The Laughter Stops Here...**

Funny Cide's victories in the first two legs of the Triple Crown propelled his connections into the national spotlight, but his quest to secure the Belmont came up short by five lengths. "We wanted to win the Triple Crown for New York," said jockey Jose Santos, "but he was third best today. He wasn't handling the track that well, switching leads back and forth." Santos was able to slow the pace down aboard a slightly rank Funny Cide on the backstretch after an opening quarter of :23 4/5 and got to the 3/4-pole in 1:13 2/5, but he had to start riding the chestnut approaching the stretch when Empire Maker moved up on even terms. "I was pretty confident, especially when I saw three-quarters in 1:13," said trainer Barclay Tagg. "But I guess you never know what they're going to do in the mud. He looks alright, but I can't talk to him. It's horse racing."

**NO FAULTING FALLON AT EPSOM**

Sir Michael Stoute credited the public support that saw **Kris Kin** (Kris S.) sent off at 6-1 in yesterday's G1 Vodafone Derby to the "Fallon factor," and the jockey justified the people's faith. Kieren Fallon drove Kris Kin past **The Great Gatsby (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) in the final quarter to win the Epsom Classic by a length. "I think he got one of the great rides around Epsom on Derby day from Kieren Fallon," Stoute said of his third Blue Riband hero and first since Shahrastani in 1986. Placed in a perfect stalking position on the inner as The Great Gatsby cut

out a strong pace with the help of **Dutch Gold** (Lahib), he was left behind as the leader struck for home at the top of the straight. Not to be panicked, Fallon switched Kris Kin wide inside the final quarter and gathered in the game front-runner in the final 75 yards. "Everything went his way," said Fallon, who had won the Derby on Oath (Ire) in 1999. "They went a good gallop and he was able to quicken. It got tight at the top of the hill and I was worried there, but I let him find himself and he was okay." **Epsom Derby cont. p2**

**Humble Beginnings for Derby Winner...**

Kris Kin (Kris S.) had just a Doncaster maiden score to his name when starting at odds of 20-1 for the Listed Dee S. at Chester May 8. He was passed over by Kieren Fallon in favour of Big Bad Bob (Ire) that afternoon, but Fergal Lynch delivered the colt with an impressive burst to win by two lengths. That display, and progressive subsequent homework, earned him a berth in the starting gate at Epsom, but he had to be supplemented to the race for £90,000 by owner Saeed Suhail. Making only his fourth career start, Kris Kin once again evidenced the closing kick he'd demonstrated at Chester to justify his owner's faith. "I was quietly confident, but he's quite a lazy horse at home and doesn't show you everything," Fallon said. "It's when he gets on the track we know how good he is." **Kinship...**

Kris Kin was born to succeed at Epsom. John Galbreath's homebred Roberto fought his way home against Rheingold (Ire) in the 1972 Derby and now, 31 years later, is represented as the grandsire of both the Oaks and Derby winners. On Friday, Casual Look, a daughter of the late Paul Mellon's Red Ransom, landed the Oaks for Ambassador W.S. Farish. Now the deceased Kris S., who worked his way up in the stallion ranks with a series of Breeders' Cup winners, has a Derby hero of his own in Kris Kin. Roberto has also been represented by 1997 Derby hero Benny the Dip, a son of Silver Hawk; and is the broodmare sire of 1993 Derby victor Commander in Chief (GB) and 1997 Oaks heroine Reams of Verse.

Kris Kin's victory in the Blue Riband follows the success of Warrsan (Ire) in Friday's G1 Coronation Cup; both runners share the Tanerko (Fr) mare Sweet and Lovely (Fr) as their third dam. For the Niarchos family, Sweetly (Fr) (Lyphard) produced French highweight two-year-old Common Grounds (GB) (Kris {GB}) and Listed winner Lightning Fire (GB) (Kris {GB}) before foaling Angel In My Heart (Fr) in 1992. The Rainbow Quest filly landed the G3 Prix de Psyche prior to her transfer to California. Despite winning just once for Bobby Frankel, she was the runner-up in the G1 Yellow Ribbon, G1 Matriarch S., G1 Santa Ana H. and the GII Santa Barbara H. She has produced three colts and a filly for Flaxman; the colts have all been sold at auction. Her '98 colt by Gone West, Venturer, was a \$400,000 KEEJUL yearling; Kris Kin himself was a \$275,000 KEESEP purchase by Charlie Gordon-Watson; and her current two-year-old, a Cherokee Run colt by the name of Seyalateralligator, sold for \$250,000 at KEESEP. Angel In My Heart is also the dam of the four-year-old Silver Hawk filly Mimalia, who has placed in France.

**Refuse Finally Bends...**

The 11-4 favourite after winning the G1 2000 Guineas, previously undefeated **Refuse to Bend (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) wound up a disappointing 13th. "Down the hill I thought I was in with a shot of winning, but this was probably a bridge too far," said jockey Pat Smullen.

## ☆ BELMONT ☆

### *For Want of an Empire...*

Bobby Frankel had raved about **Empire Maker** well before the colt had ever started and got the Unbridled youngster to the races with a win last October. The dark bay was given some time off following a third in the Gil Rensen S. Nov. 30, returning to run a spotty second to Man Among Men in the Feb. 7 Sham S. at Santa Anita, a race in which **Ten Most Wanted** (Deputy Commander) was fourth. Frankel added blinkers for the colt's next start and Empire Maker turned in a tour-de-force in the GI Florida Derby, winning by 9 3/4 lengths Mar. 15. That set him up for the GI Wood Memorial S. Apr. 12, where he defeated Funny Cide by a deceptive half-length. Frankel and jockey Jerry Bailey had wanted something left in the tank for the Derby and a possible Triple Crown bid, but when Empire Maker sustained a foot bruise several days before the Run for the Roses, he was forced to miss some time. That left him a bit short on the big day and forced Frankel to rethink his strategy. "I was caught by surprise [in the Derby]," he said Tuesday before the Belmont. "I think I was looking too far ahead, to be honest with you. Maybe I should have told Jerry to really let [him] run in the Wood Memorial instead of letting him loaf to the wire. Maybe the time he missed with the bruised foot hurt him. But you don't have the option of going back and doing it over."

In contrast to his Derby preparations, Empire Maker trained strongly ahead of the Belmont, posting four works in the span of 17 days, and had his Hall of Fame trainer brimming with confidence. "I think Empire Maker is a different horse now," he continued. "I'm real anxious, I've been waiting for this race. You could call it his chance for redemption."

### *How the Race was Won...*

Breaking from the rail, Empire Maker came out alertly and was taken out several paths by Jerry Bailey racing through the clubhouse turn, with Funny Cide in his sights from the start. "I rode him like he was the best horse," Bailey explained. "As soon as I saw Funny Cide get a little rank and start pulling Jose [Santos], that is when I eased back and moved outside. When I turned up the backside, Funny Cide was really rank and my horse was relaxed. That is what you want going a mile and a half." Empire Maker began to move closer approaching the far turn, finally drawing even with the favorite at the 3/8 pole.

But with Funny Cide already under a ride, any hopes for a battle quickly faded as Empire Maker hit the front at the top of the stretch. The Juddmonte colorbearer got a bit distracted, but quickly got back to work once Ten Most Wanted loomed up, holding that colt at bay through the stretch. "He pulled up a bit when he made the lead," said Bailey. "There was an unbelievable roar and he threw his ears up and went into second gear." Bailey, who has been aboard the homebred in each of his seven career starts, added, "He's the best three-year-old I've ever been on." Empire Maker follows Commendable as the only Belmont winners in the last 50 years to come into the race off a layoff as long as five weeks.

### *Ten Most Redeemed...*

Ten Most Wanted had been the wiseguy selection for the Kentucky Derby, only to struggle home ninth after getting knocked around at the start. Taken home to Hollywood Park, the handsome colt had sparkled in the morning, prompting trainer Wally Dollase to send him back into the fray. "Wally did an excellent job getting this horse ready for a big effort against Empire Maker and Funny Cide," said jockey Pat Day. "He came into the race looking like a million dollars. I could only be happier if we got our picture taken."

### *Dynever to Try Again...*

Making just his fifth career start, **Dynever** (Dynaformer) wound up fourth in his first attempt at top-flight competition. "The best horse won," said trainer Christophe Clement. "I thought my horse was going great, but at the 3/8 pole, he had nowhere to go. You had a sloppy track today, and I would have liked to have seen this group go on a fast track. But we'll be back and try again."

### *Once Again, a Crown Slips Away...*

For the fifth time in the last seven years, a three-year-old came into the Belmont with a chance for the Triple Crown, only to come up short in the 1 1/2-mile Test of Champions. This year, it was Funny Cide's turn. "His best was third today," said Jose Santos. "I still think I have the best three-year-old. We will back. I can't wait for Funny Cide and Empire Maker to meet again. It has been 25 years since we have seen the last Triple Crown winner. I hope we don't have to wait another 25 years."

## HIGH FIDELITE

Trainer Criquelette Head-Maarek may find another trophy in her cabinet if **Fidelite (Ire)** (In the Wings {GB}) can reproduce the flying finish that carried her to victory in the G1 Prix Saint-Alary at Longchamp May 18. She showed a dramatic turn of acceleration that afternoon to beat Hi Dubai (GB) by a comfortable two lengths, with **Arvada (GB)** (Hernando {Fr}) and **Campsie Fells (UAE)** (Indian Ridge {Ire}) in third and fourth. Only Zainta (Ire) has gone to to Diane glory after winning that trial in the last 10 years, but Fidelite hails from the stable that has produced two winners of this Classic and excels with its top-class fillies.

Campsie Fells had previously had Fidelite back in fourth when winning the slowly run G3 Prix Vanteaux Apr. 27, but may struggle off this likely even tempo. Andre Fabre, who has won this twice, saddles **Musical Chimes** (In Excess {Ire}), who beat the smart Maiden Tower (GB) when winning the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches May 11. But only East of the Moon has completed this Classic double in the last decade, and Musical Chimes has to prove her stamina. Fabre is also responsible for **Nebraska Tornado** (Storm Cat), who was impressive in winning the Listed Prix Melisande May 22. Only one British-trained raider has proved successful since 1990, but **Cassis** (Red Ransom) has every chance of arresting that trend. She showed a fine turn of foot to win the G3 Musidora S. at York May 13 and warrants respect.

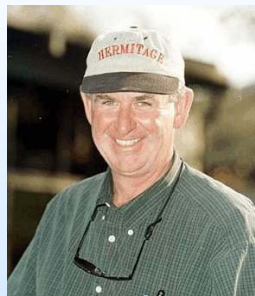

Private Steer, who showed some Group 1 ability when third in the G1 Flight S. last season, came with a bold late move to become the first filly to win this since Dane Ripper (Aus) in 1997. Purchased for A\$20,000 as a weanling, the bay also captured the Listed Reginald Allen H. in 2002, but was looking for his first Group success. Caught behind horses under a feathery 108 pounds early, she found running room between horses late to get the victory. Private Steer, who gave young trainer John O'Shea his second Group 1 victory, will now be rested before being pointed for the G1 Cox Plate in October.

Sixth in the May 3 Queensland Guineas, Half Hennessy erased the memory of that effort with a stunning victory in this Classic. "I thought he would win the race, but I didn't expect him to score like that," trainer Bede Murray told *Australian Associated Press*. Twice a Group 3 winner and runner-up in the G1 Champagne S. last year, the bay was at a disadvantage at the shorter distance of the Guineas, but had a genuine pace to follow here and proved much the best in the straight, drawing off in an impressive effort. So what's next for the winner? "[Owner] Nick Robinson has been talking for a while about going for the Arlington Million and I'd love to go there with him," Johnston said.

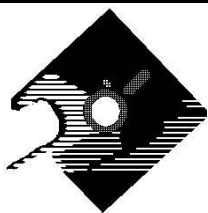
