### JUDDMONTE JUGGERNAUT ROLLS ON

Saturday, Juddmonte homebred Empire Maker charged to a 3/4-length score in the GI Belmont S. Not to be outdone, undefeated **Nebraska Tornado** (Storm Cat) added her name to the list of Juddmonte Classic winners with a 3/4-length success over **Time Ahead (GB)** (Spectrum {Ire}) in the G1 Prix De Diane Hermes (French Oaks) at Chantilly yesterday. The dark bay was reluctant to load, but had no issues once the gates opened, stalking the tepid early pace before being unleashed at the top of the straight by Richard Hughes. After displaying a turn of speed in keeping with her name, she was always holding the valiant closing effort of Time Ahead in the drive to the line. "We had a little bit of a problem getting her in the gate, but once she was in it was easy from there," jockey Richard Hughes commented. "She was a little bit green and I chased her out of the gate, so she ran a bit free for the first 200 metres, but I was full of horse at the top of the straight. I could hear [the runner-up] coming, but I still had a few gears left." ### EMPIRE MAKER AOK AFTER CLASSIC SCORE

GI Belmont S. winner **Empire Maker** (Unbridled) came out of the race in good order, but trainer Bobby Frankel said yesterday that the colt can't rest on his laurels if he is to get the Eclipse Award this season. "He's got to keep on winning now," Frankel said, adding he expects improvement from the big dark bay. "I don't think he's nearly reached his peak," he said. "He's a light, tall, gangly horse. He's growing fast and he hasn't had time to muscle up and put his weight on yet. If he stays sound, I'll guarantee a great horse." The Juddmonte Farms homebred is scheduled to make his next start in the Aug. 3 GII Jim Dandy S. at Saratoga, and could meet Derby and Preakness hero **Funny Cide** again in the Aug. 23 GI Travers. "I usually don't like to run against competition," Frankel said. "I would usually like [a race] to be as easy as possible. But I'm looking forward to running against [Funny Cide again]."

### TAKING THE SHINE OFF THE VAGRANCY

The field for yesterday's GII Vagrancy H. at Belmont Park was scratched down to three, but 7-10 favorite **Shine Again** (Wild Again) still found herself in traffic trouble and never could catch **Shawklit Mint** (Air Forbes Won). The winner of three straight, including the GII Genuine Risk H. at Belmont May 11, Shine Again was tucked behind front-running Shawklit Mint early, and had **Gold Mover** (Gold Fever) to her outside as they raced out of the final turn. While the favorite was forced to wait for racing room, the pacesetter sprinted clear and had enough left to hold Shine Again at bay, winning by 1 3/4 lengths. Still, winning jockey Richie Migliore felt he was on the best horse yesterday. "The way she ran today, nobody was going to beat her," he said. Shawklit Mint rode her own winning streak into the Vagrancy, returning after a two-month break to take an open allowance over a sloppy Belmont strip May 22 and making it four in a row yesterday. "She is so good right now, and she just topped it all off," trainer Pat Reynolds said. **Vagrancy chart, p2**

**A Gathering Storm...**

Nebraska Tornado only started her career May 5, breaking her maiden by a length and a half at Saint-Cloud. She was difficult to get into the starting stalls before the Listed Prix Melisande at Longchamp May 22, but showed acceleration to die for in beating La Sabana (Fr) by 1 1/2 lengths on that occasion and earned her chance at Classic competition. Showing good speed at Chantilly, the Juddmonte colorbearer was second through the early going. She took control with two furlongs to race and had enough left in reserve to safely hold Time Ahead. The victory gave trainer Andre Fabre his third domestic Classic of 2003. Teddy Beckett, racing manager to Khalid Abdullah, commented, "This is a marvellous weekend for Juddmonte. To win two Classics in two days is just exceptional. She had the perfect trip under a great ride from Richard and quickened brilliantly before staying on well. She's done a lot in a short period of time and we'll see how she comes out of it. The thing is, on breeding, she's unlikely to stay a mile and a half, so one of the targets under consideration is the G1 Nassau S. [at Goodwood Aug. 2]." Favourite **Fidelite (Ire)** (In The Wings {GB}), winner of the G1 Prix Saint-Alary at Longchamp in her latest outing May 18, struggled to get on terms before the straight and ran on at the one pace thereafter to finish eighth.

**Funny Cide Connections Looking for a Rematch**

The connections of **Funny Cide** (Distorted Humor), who tired after dragging jockey Jose Santos through the opening fractions of the Belmont and finished third, are looking forward to a rematch with Empire Maker in the Travers. The chestnut gelding will be pointed for that 10-furlong event, with an appearance in the \$1 million G1 Haskell Invitational H. also a possibility. "We're going to freshen him up now," trainer Barclay Tagg said. "He needs it. Then we will look at races like the Haskell and Travers. I'm not letting anything get in the way of the Travers. That's the race I want to make." As for a chance at a championship, Tagg said, "I'm not worried about Eclipse Awards or anything like that. If this turns out to be Empire Maker's year, believe me, Funny Cide will get his Eclipse later on. We hope to have Funny Cide around for a few more years."

**Ten Most Wanted Also Travers Bound**

Belmont runner-up **Ten Most Wanted** (Deputy Commander) was doing well yesterday morning. "I'm a happy camper," trainer Wally Dollase said. "The horse came out of the race great. He ate up well last night. He's a hearty rascal--his dad was the same way." He added, "The Belmont was a real reprieve for me because of how poorly he ran in the Derby [finishing ninth]. He did have an excuse in the Derby, but this makes me feel I was right about this horse." As for future plans, the California-based horseman said, "I don't know about his first race back, but my ultimate goal would be the Travers."

**Big Ratings for Belmont**

The NBC telecast of the third jewel in the Triple Crown generated the highest overnight rating for any horse race since the 1990 Kentucky Derby, won by Empire Maker's sire, Unbridled, and the best for the Belmont since Alysheba's failed Triple attempt in 1987. The broadcast, which aired from 5:30-7 p.m., earned a 10.4 overnight rating and a 24 share, according to Nielsen Media Research. The numbers were up 13 percent from last year, when War Emblem was making his bid for Triple Crown glory. "This rating demonstrates that the unbelievable saga of Funny Cide brought all kinds of new fans to horse racing, which bodes well for the future," NBC Sports President Ken Schanzer said. Each overnight ratings point represents 717,310 households. The ratings are taken from 55 markets representing 69 percent of the country.

**Epsom Heralds Success**

Officials at Epsom racecourse were yesterday celebrating a highly successful Epsom Derby meeting that boasted a Saturday crowd of "around 100,000," according to Stephen Wallis, managing director of Epsom Downs. On-course cash Tote pool turnover topped the £1 million-mark for the first time Saturday, reaching £1,070,125. That represented an increase of 18.7 percent on 12 months ago.

**Bend Back in Trip**

Trainer Dermot Weld yesterday confirmed that **Refuse To Bend (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) will return to a mile after his disappointing 13th-placing in Saturday's G1 Epsom Derby at a mile and a half. Options in France in mid-summer are the most likely for the G1 Sagitta 2000 Guineas winner, who will later be prepared for the G1 Breeders' Cup Mile at Santa Anita Oct. 25. "Obviously he's a miler," Weld said yesterday. "He didn't come down the hill too well and [jockey] Pat Smullen, who had him perfectly positioned, was not too hard on him. The horse is perfect and will have a total break to freshen him up for a campaign over a mile later on that will take in the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois [at Deauville Aug. 17], G1 Prix du Moulin [at Longchamp Sept. 7] and Breeders' Cup Mile."

**Next Stop for Kin?**

Connections of Derby winner **Kris Kin** (Kris S.) are so far refusing to commit to a clash with **Dalakhani (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) in the G1 Irish Derby at The Curragh June 29. "As far as I know the horse is fine this morning," Joe Mercer, racing manager for owner Saeed Suhail, told *PA Sport* yesterday. "It was a wonderful win and a marvellous performance. We have no idea where the horse goes next yet."

**O'Brien Ponders Team's Future**

Whether or not Kris Kin is at The Curragh, trainer Aidan O'Brien will send Saturday's runner-up **The Great Gatsby (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) to the Classic. He may be joined there by stable companion **Powerscourt (GB)** (Sadler's Wells), not seen since finishing runner-up in the G1 Racing Post Trophy at Doncaster in October. That colt pleased O'Brien in a racecourse gallop at The Curragh yesterday with stablemates **Ice Dancer (Ire)** and **Chevalier (Ire)**. O'Brien also described the disappointing performance of **Brian Boru (GB)** (Sadler's Wells), who trailed in 16th, as "too bad to be true," adding, "In an ideal world, he could have had a better preparation. Michael [Kinane] said it was a big shock for the horse, with the track and everything else on the day." **Balestrini (Ire)** (Danahill), who finished fifth, did not stay, according to his trainer and will be dropped back to 10 furlongs, while **Alberto Giacometti (GB)** (Sadler's Wells), who was 12th, may tackle a mile.

**Other Plans in the Works**

Trainer John Oxx, trainer of third-placed **Alamshar (Ire)** (Key of Luck), will await the decision on His Highness the Aga Khan's **Dalakhani (Ire)** before building a program for the colt. "He's fresh and well this morning," the conditioner said yesterday. "Coming here for the Derby would be the obvious route, but there are other considerations. We will have to sit down and thrash it out. He came home well and hit the line running strongly, pulling up in front, but he was a bit green and didn't travel that well in the race--I think there is more improvement in him." David Elsworth was yesterday weighing up options for the fast-finishing **Norse Dancer (Ire)** (Halling), who was in an impossible position in rear at the top of the straight, but who closed best of all to finish 2 1/2 lengths back in fourth. "For a horse of that class, one would be looking at the G1 Eclipse S. [at Sandown July 5] or possibly the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. [at Ascot July 28]," Elsworth told *PA Sport* yesterday. "Three-year-olds have a fair record in the King George, so that would be a consideration. There wouldn't be as many runners and I think he's in the same street as the best of them. He was only beaten two lengths, so we have to look at all the options."

"Bonus" first-year depreciation increases to 50% and is in addition to the \$100,000 expensing allowance and regular depreciation. With bonus and regular depreciation, about 56% of the price of a yearling can be written off in the year of purchase.

Japanese champion Agnes Digital, whose wins include the G1 Hong Kong Cup and the G1-Jpn Tenno Sho, returned to his winning ways with a late-charging win in yesterday's G1 Yasuda Kinen at Tokyo Racecourse. Following a rough start, where Dantsu Judge (Warning {GB}) unseated his rider, favored Lohengrin took command early, but 127-1 longshot Mideon Bit (Adjudicating) would take over from that foe and hold the advantage until the final turn. Meanwhile, fourth choice Agnes Digital was settled in midpack as the favorite once again moved to the fore at the top of the stretch and appeared poised to collect his third score of the year. Admire Max and Agnes Digital had other plans, however. The former collared the favorite in the final furlong before being passed late by the hard-running American-bred, who just made it in front in the final strides to record his first win this year.

Next Gina produced a power-packed stretch run to give conditioner Andreas Schutz his fourth renewal of this Classic. After finishing third behind subsequent G1 Oaks d'Italia winner Meridiana (Ger) in the Listed Kolner Fruhjahren-Stuten-Preis at Cologne Apr. 21, she had been well-supported to win the G2 Henkel-Rennen (German 1000 Guineas) at Dusseldorf May 11. She performed dismally in that event, finishing last of 15, but put that firmly behind her with a display to echo the exploits of the stable's past winners Elle Danzig (Ger), Flamingo Road (Ger) and Salve Regina (Ger). Settled in a stalking role throughout the early stages by Andrasch Starke, she quickened to the head of affairs at the top of the straight and immediately put safe distance between her and her chasing rivals. White Rose, who had to challenge wide on the final turn, closed out of the pack to best Mandela for the runner's-up spot. With no Sulamani (Ire) to deal with here, Thierry Jarnet did not require the extra gears that separate Ange Gabriel from the majority of his peers. Since finishing runner-up to Anabaa Blue (GB) in this contest 12 months ago, Ange Gabriel has progressed markedly, upsetting Aquarelliste (Fr) in the G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud in June before defying a hefty penalty when winning the G2 Prix du Conseil de Paris in Longchamp in October. He confirmed form with Aquarelliste when taking the G1 Hong Kong Vase at Sha Tin in December on his favoured fast ground, and only Sulamani could pass him in the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic at Nad al Sheba last time out Mar. 29. Always travelling comfortably in midpack for Jarnet in this contest, he made up the ground on Balakheri with minimal effort inside the final quarter, hitting the front with 300 yards remaining before comfortably holding the vain closing effort of Martaline. "Once again he has proved his class," a delighted trainer Eric Libaud said. "He had an easy time after Dubai, and the target is the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. [at Ascot July 28]. This was his first step and he took it in his stride.
