MENED 'LADY' TARGETS FLEUR DE LIS

Select Stable's **Take Charge Lady** (Dehere), who's been on the sidelines since suffering a foot bruise a few weeks after her valiant second to Horse of the Year Azeri in the Apr. 5 GI Apple Blossom H. at Oaklawn, worked a sharp five furlongs yesterday morning at Churchill Downs and is a possible for Saturday's GII Fleur De Lis H. at the Louisville track. Clockers caught the Ken McPeek trainee covering five panels in :59.40 over a track labeled fast, ranking her's the third fastest of 32 moves at the distance. "She worked well," said McPeek. "We're going to keep an eye on the foot for the next few days and make sure she's good, and if she's a 100 percent, we'll run her." Explaining the severity of her foot bruise, which derailed the four-year-old's intended go at the May 2 GII Louisville Breeders' Cup H., McPeek explained, "It's been kind of a long process. Originally, we thought it was just a small bruise. It turned into an abscess that worked its way through the cornet band and we had to cut it out and get the infection out of there. It's not a major deal, but certainly for a horse of her caliber, you've got to get it sorted out." Take Charge Lady won six of 10 starts last year, including victories in the GI Ashland S. in April and the GI Spinster S. in October, both at Keeneland. Though she could do no better than sixth against Azeri in last year's GI Breeders' Cup Distaff, her game effort against that one in the Apple Blossom offers hope for a dynamic rivalry in 2003. "I think we've got the only filly in the country that can compete against Azeri, but at the same time, it's early," said McPeek. "The truth is that time has done her some good. You try to look for some kind of positive out of the negative here and during the time off she's put on some weight and she's a little bigger and stronger than she was earlier in the year. We've got a lot of time between now and the Breeders' Cup, and that's our goal."

A CHANCELLOR'S RANSOM

Two days after Casual Look provided Red Ransom with a European Classic, **Ransom O'War** stepped forward in yesterday's G2 Grosse Muller Brot-Preis at Munich to offer portents that he could give his sire a follow-up in the G1 Deutsches Derby at Hamburg July 6. Trained by Mark Johnston at two, he managed to win a low-grade conditions race on Southwell's fibresand in November. Since being transferred to Erika Mader, he has been ambitiously campaigned, finishing runner-up in the G3 Preis des Gestut Wiesenhof-Dr Busch Memorial at Krefeld Apr. 13 before gaining a creditable third-placing behind Martillo (Ger) in the G2 Mehl-Mulhens-Rennen (German 2000 Guineas) at Cologne May 18. Settled in mid-division throughout the early stages of this contest by Stanley Chin, he unleashed a strong challenge to wear down **Silver Spur (Ger)** (Sillery) with 100 yards remaining as **Winning Dash (Ger)** (Dashing Blade {GB}) flew late. Connections have the utmost faith in Trumbaka and she justified that to register a second career stakes score in this contest. Admirably consistent last term, she followed runner-up placings in the G3 Prix Minerve at Deauville in August and G2 Prix de Royallieu at Longchamp in September with a length defeat of *Carib Lady* (Ire) in the G3 Prix de Flore at this track the following month. After running fifth in his debut, Utopia reeled off three straight wins, including the G1 Zennihon Nisai Hai last December. The chestnut started 2003 with a runner-up finish in the G3 Mainchi Hai and was coming off a fourth-place finish in the G1 NHK Mile Cup in May. Utopia, breaking from the outside in the 16-horse field, settled off the pace under jockey Katsumi Ando. He easily took over the lead in upper stretch and displayed an impressive turn of foot down the lane, drawing off to win by five lengths. "We were well behind the front runners, but when I asked him, he answered impressively and I was very confident at a furlong out," Ando commented.

Russian and Soviet Rematch Is on

Russian Rhythm (Kingmambo) and **Soviet Song (Ire)** (Marju {Ire}), first and fourth, respectively, in the G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket May 4, will meet again in next Friday's G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot. Russian Rhythm was reported to be in "good shape" by owner Cheveley Park Stud's representative John Marsh, who added of the Sir Michael Stoute-trained filly, "She worked under Sally Eddery on Saturday morning and she's very well." Connections of the James Fanshawe-trained Soviet Song are hopeful that their filly can reverse placings in the mile contest. "She's absolutely fine," Matthew Budden, racing manager for owners the Elite Racing Club, told *PA Sport* yesterday. "She was just a little bit under the weather when she ran in the Guineas and James's horses are in much better form and she's very well. Russian Rhythm was a good Guineas winner. It's going to be a very tough race but hopefully our filly will be there in very good form."

Curragh for Summitville

Trainer James Given yesterday confirmed that **Summitville (GB)** (Grand Lodge) will take her place in the line-up for the G1 Darley Irish Oaks at The Curragh July 13. Having finished third behind Casual Look in Friday's G1 Epsom Oaks, the filly will bid to provide her conditioner with his first Classic. "She's very well, but very tired," Given said. "She gave her all on Friday, but she's come out of it well and we are looking forward to going to the Curragh for the Irish equivalent. It was a heart-stopping moment and then she got to the front and two just came and did her. You've got to be incredibly proud of her."

Kin on 122

Britain's official handicappers have allotted a rating of 122 pounds to **Kris Kin** (Kris S.) following his success in Saturday's G1 Epsom Derby. Rated four pounds inferior to last year's hero High Chaparral (Ire) and three pounds below Sinndar (Ire) in 2000, the Sir Michael Stoute-trained colt was raised 14 pounds from his previous mark by the British Horseracing Board's senior handicapper Nigel Gray.

Look to the Curragh

Casual Look (Red Ransom) may head to The Curragh for the G1 Irish Oaks July 13, connections announced yesterday. The Andrew Balding-trained filly, who beat **Yesterday (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) and Summitville (GB) in a tight finish to Friday's G1 Epsom Oaks, will face a rematch with those rivals if she takes up the engagement. "I have got to talk to Mr. Farish about it later tonight, but she's entered in the Irish Oaks, so that's the next logical step and would be favourite," Balding said yesterday. Michael Kinane was considered unlucky on the beaten favourite Yesterday, who went down by a neck after repeatedly failing to find a clear run. "Every time I went to go for a gap that looked likely to open, it closed," he commented. "That's the way it is. You've just got to be able to take it and move on."

It is now 31 years since Roberto snatched victory in the Derby, thanks to a carpet-beater ride from Lester Piggott, and in the process he helped stimulate European demand for American-bred horses. That demand is still strong, and so is Roberto's influence, as was evident at Epsom last week. Firstly, we saw the Oaks fall to Casual Look, a filly by Roberto's fast son Red Ransom, and then the Derby was won in eye-opening style by Kris Kin, a colt by Kris S., another son of the Darby Dan star.

Kris Kin's buyer, the astute Charlie Gordon-Watson, has said that he liked the colt's pedigree, including the fact that his grandsire had won the Derby. Indeed, Gordon-Watson is sure to have noticed that many of Roberto's descendants have done well over the years in Epsom's mile-and-a-half Classics.

Although Roberto never sired an Epsom Derby winner, his sons Touching Wood, Silver Hawk and At Talaq respectively finished second, third and fourth and his stallion sons have kept up the good work. Silver Hawk was responsible for the 1997 winner Benny the Dip, plus Silver Wisp (third in 1992) and Fahal (fourth in 1995), while Robellino sired Mister Baileys (fourth after a very bold show in 1994), Sunshine Forever supplied Sunshine Street (fourth in 1998) and Dynaformer gave us Beat All, the 1999 third.

Significantly, Beat All carried the same Saeed Suhail colors as Kris Kin after being bought by Gordon-Watson for \$280,000 at Keeneland September as a yearling, so it is hardly surprising that Gordon-Watson returned to the same well in 2001, when he paid \$275,000 for Kris Kin.

Roberto's daughters have also got into the act in the Oaks, including Slightly Dangerous and Last Feather, who filled second and third places in 1982. Slightly Dangerous went on to produce Commander In Chief, winner of the 1993 Derby, and Dushyantor, runner-up three years later. Another Roberto mare, Modena, became the dam of the Oaks winner Reams of Verse and the Derby third Elmaamul.

I'd hazard a guess that another aspect of Kris Kin's pedigree which would have appealed to Gordon-Watson was the fact that the colt's dam, Angel In My Heart, was a highly talented daughter of Rainbow Quest.

By the time the colt came on the market, Rainbow Quest had 19 foals of racing age out of mares by Roberto and among them were the Group winners Suntrap, Rainshack and Panoramic, as well as the Group-placed fillies Summer Breeze and Tuning. Suntrap and Rainshack both won the French St Leger, with Sunshack also landing the G1 Coronation Cup over the Derby course and distance. Rainbow Quest's broodmare daughters had also started to show promise with the Roberto line, with one mare producing two G2 winners to Robellino.

Kris Kin is the third foal of Angel In My Heart and represents another triumph for the Niarchos family's excellent breeding operation (Flaxman Holdings), which also hit the Grade I target later in the day with Denon in the Manhattan H. on the Belmont undercard. Kris Kin's half-brother, Venturer, by Gone West, was above average at around a mile in England in 2001.

Angel In My Heart first showed how good she was when she ran out a four-length winner of the G3 Prix de Psyche over 1 ¼ miles at Deauville in 1995 and she confirmed her class with a good second to the top-class Timarida in the G2 Prix de l'Opera. The Niarchos team then decided to follow a well-proven route by sending the daughter of Rainbow Quest to race on America's fast turf courses. Rainbow Quest had already done very well with his runners in North America, which included Quest for Fame (GI Hollywood Turf H.), Urgent Request (GI Santa Anita H.), Raintrap (GI Rothmans International) and Passagere du Soir (GI Tidal H.). Angel In My Heart improved his record further. She failed by only half a length to take the GI Yellow Ribbon Invitational on her American debut and then finished second again in the GI Matriarch S.

Unfortunately, Angel In My Heart also found one too good for her in two further Graded contests at Santa Anita early the following year, but these efforts boosted her American earnings to more than \$400,000. She added another \$250,000 to the coffers last September through her yearling son by Cherokee Run, which is inbred 3 x 3 to Blushing Groom.

It was appropriate that Scobie Breasley, the former champion British jockey, was on hand to meet the riders in the Derby because he trained Kris Kin's second dam, Sweetly, for Ravi Tikoo. This daughter of Lyphard won three small races at up to 1 1/16 miles in the USA in 1978, but raced mainly over sprint distances after her transfer to England. She passed into the ownership of Stavros Niarchos soon afterwards. Part of her appeal to an owner of Niarchos' magnitude must have been that she was closely related to Ghadeer, a Lyphard colt who more than doubled the record price for a yearling in Britain when he made 625,000gns in 1979. Ghadeer, who became a G3 winner at up to 1 ¼ miles before developing into a leading sire in Brazil, was by Lyphard out of a daughter of Sweet And Lovely, whereas Sweetly was by Lyphard out of Sweet And Lovely.

Niarchos had every reason to be pleased with his purchase of Sweetly. Mated to Kris (no relation to Kris S.), she produced Common Grounds, a two-year-old G1 winner who did well as a stallion, and Lightning Fire, a versatile stakes winner who became the dam of Beyrouth (GI All Along S.).

Kris Kin's third dam, Sweet and Lovely, never raced, but she had a first-rate French pedigree, by Tanerko out of the smart racemare Lilya. By one of those odd coincidences which often crop up in racing, Sweet and Lovely also ranked as the third dam of Warrsan, winner of the G1 Coronation Cup on the day before the Derby. This much-improved son of Caerleon is the fourth Group winner (by four different stallions) out of Sweet and Lovely's grand-daughter Lucayan Princess. This daughter of High Line had previously been represented by Luso, a very big international earner who scored at G1 level in Italy and Germany, and Needle Gun, another with an impressive bank-roll. One of Lucayan Princess' daughters, Lunda was also represented in Kris Kin's Derby, but fared much less well than Angel In My Heart, with her son Lundy's Lane finishing 19th of 20.

If Kris Kin fulfils the considerable promise of his Derby display, he is going to be in great demand after he retires. With Northern Dancer no closer than the fourth generation of his pedigree, he is going to have endless options as a stallion. Also, together with the Japanese champion Symboli Kris S., he represents a rich legacy from Kris S., who died last year. Considering that Kris S. started his stallion career covering small books of mares in Florida, he did extraordinarily well to sire four Breeders' Cup winners and it would be marvelous if Kris Kin were to prove similarly effective once his racing career is over.
