LADY OUT AND YOU IN FLEUR DE LIS

Select Stable's **Take Charge Lady** (Dehere), who ran second most recently in the G1 Apple Blossom at Oaklawn Park Apr. 5, will not run in Saturday's G1 Fleur de Lis H. at Churchill Downs, according to trainer Ken McPeck. Forced out of the May 2 G11 Louisville Breeders' Cup H. because of a bruised left front foot,

the four-year-old had been training well since, including a strong five-furlong work in :59.40 Monday. "I think she still needs a little bit more time," said McPeck following a Wednesday morning jog in the Churchill slop. "It's so close [her recovery], but this weekend is too quick." Despite making significant progress

over the past few weeks, Take Charge Lady is still only "95 percent" ready, admitted McPeck. The multiple Grade I winner remains possible for the G1 Ogden Phipps H. at Belmont Park June 21. The race will not be lacking in star power, however, as trainer Bobby Frankel has opted to run multiple Grade I winner **You** (You and I), third in the May 17 Shuvee H. last time out, instead of Juddmonte's **Sight Seek** (Distant View) in Saturday's filly and mare feature. You has won five Grade I races to date, including last year's Santa Anita Oaks, Acorn S. and Las Virgenes S. The Edmund Gann-owned filly, a winner of eight of 18 lifetime starts, has earned \$1,688,055.

DAY TO RIDE PERFECT DRIFT IN FOSTER

Trainer Murray Johnson announced yesterday that jockey Pat Day will get the call aboard Stonecrest Farm's **Perfect Drift** (Dynaformer) for Saturday's G1 Stephen Foster H. at Churchill Downs. The four-year-old gelding was accompanied by Kent Desormeaux in his two most recent starts, including a fourth-place finish last time in the nine-furlong G1 Woodford Reserve H. at Churchill Downs, but the 33-year-old rider is unable to make it for the race due to other riding engagements in Japan. "We are delighted to have [Day]," said Johnson. "We think he fits him [Perfect Drift] like a glove."

Dalakhani Bound for The Curragh

Dalakhani (Ire) (Darshaan {GB}), the highly impressive winner of the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club (French Derby) at Chantilly June 1, is on course for the G1 Budweiser Irish Derby at The Curragh June 29. Stablemate **Alamshar (Ire)** (Key of Luck) is also being pointed for the Irish Classic. His Highness The Aga Khan's spokesperson Pat Downes told *Racing Post*, "The plan is for Dalakhani to run in the Budweiser Irish Derby, but the ground situation will be very important if it's to happen. Alain de Royer-Dupre [trainer of Dalakhani] and John Oxx [trainer of Alamshar] will train the two horses for the race. However, if the ground is soft, then Alamshar will not run and if it comes up very soft, then neither horse will run." Dalakhani worked at Chantilly Tuesday. De Royer-Dupre told *Racing Post*, "He did a nice canter on his own and looks in really good shape."

MOON BALLAD SET FOR PRINCE OF WALES'S

Dubai World Cup hero **Moon Ballad (Ire)** (Singspiel {Ire}) will return to the turf for his next start in the G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot June 18, according to *Thoroughbred Times*. The five-length winner last time out in the \$6-million Cup, Moon Ballad will attempt to emulate another Godolphin flag bearer, Dubai Millennium, who recorded the World Cup/Prince of Wales's double in 2000. A winner of half of eight lifetime starts, the chestnut has amassed \$4,187,827 to date.

OASIS DREAM TO DEBUT GOLDEN JUBILEE

Highweighted English Juvenile **Oasis Dream (GB)** (Green Desert), winner of the G1 Shadwell Stud Middle Park S. last year, looks likely to make his 2003 debut in the Golden Jubilee S. at Royal Ascot June 21, when he will face last year's G1 Cheveley Park S. victor **Airwave (GB)** (Air Express {Ire}). Owner trainer Khalid Abdullah's Racing Manager, Teddy Beckett, told *Racing Post*, "Oasis Dream was slow to come to hand this spring, but he is in good form now." Oasis Dream has won two of four starts and has earned \$169,167.

BAFFERT PONDER'S TEAM'S FUTURE

Congaree (Arazi), who is recovering from a sore stifle sustained at the start of the GI Metropolitan H. at Belmont Park May 26 when he finished sixth, is doing well and has resumed jogging, reports *The Blood-Horse*. According to trainer Bob Baffert, the chestnut may make his next start in the GI Hollywood Gold Cup July 13. Another Baffert trainee, **Senor Swinger** (El Prado {Ire}), who was a 5 1/2-length winner in the GIII Jefferson Cup June 7, will likely make his next appearance in the GIII Virginia Derby on the turf at Colonial Downs. "He's going to go wherever it's green," Baffert told *The Blood-Horse*. The roan is undefeated in two lifetime turf starts, including the 8 1/2-furlong GIII Crown Royal American Turf May 2.

Having won on his debut at Galway last July, **Abunawwas** was tried in stakes company next time out and finished fifth to **Alamshar (Ire)** and **Brian Boru (GB)** in the G3 Beresford S. at The Curragh in October on his only other juvenile outing. He continued the stakes theme on sophomore debut when second to **Tomahawk** in the Listed Loughbrown S. at The Curragh Mar. 23, and was then fourth to **France (GB)** in the G3 Tetrarch S. at the same track Apr. 27. Most recently, he was seventh to **Indian Haven (GB)** in the G1 Irish 2000 Guineas again at The Curragh May 24. Stepped back to seven furlongs for this contest, he produced a last-to-first display to earn a career first stakes victory. "That's his trip, and if he's like that he'll get a mile around here," said winning conditioner **Kevin Prendergast**. "It was the ideal race for him and he got a good run coming between horses. I was hopeful, but I wasn't confident beforehand, but he will get better." Jockey **Declan McDonogh** reserved his mount in rear as **Great Pyramid (Ire)** (**Danehill**) led, but came under pressure once into the home straight. He made continued progress into second at the distance and ran on well in the closing stages to best **One More Round** a shade cosily.

10-Percent Purse Increase at Churchill:

Churchill Downs has announced that it will offer a 10-percent purse hike for overnight races, effective June 18, for the remainder of the 2003 Spring Meet. Record wagering on the Kentucky Derby, steady on-track business and a significant increase in simulcast wagering have enabled the purse boost. Overnight races include allowance, maiden special weight, claiming and maiden claiming events. Stakes races will not be affected. The 10-percent increase will add an average of \$31,773 per day, and will cover all eligible races in the track's final condition book (Book 4), which covers the 15 racing days during the period of June 18-July 6.
