### RACING RETURNS TO ROYAL ASCOT

The star studded Royal Ascot meeting gets underway Tuesday and action will heat up quickly with a pair of Group 1 events scheduled for opening day. A field of 11 three-year-olds will line up for the G1 St James's Palace S. The one-mile race marks the culmination of Europe's Guineas season and features three winners of those Classics; **Clodovil (Ire)** (Danehill) (French), **Indian Haven (GB)** (Indian Ridge {Ire}) (Irish) and **Martillo (Ger)** (Anabaa) (German), as well as Irish Guineas runner-up and third-place finishers **France (GB)** (Desert Prince {Ire}) and **Tout Seul (Ire)** (Ali-Royal {Ire}) and English



runner-up **Zafeen (Fr)** (Zafonic). Also on tap for Tuesday is the G1 Queen Anne S. The one-mile event has attracted a quality field of 11 older horses. More than a dozen winners from the 2002 meeting are expected to line up for a crack at back-to-back Royal Ascot glory, with six horses looking for repeat wins in the same race. **Grandera (Ire)** (Grand Lodge) was an easy winner of last year's Prince of Wales's S., but is expected to face a tough field of challengers Wednesday, including stablemate and G1 Dubai World Cup winner **Moon Ballad (Ire)** (Singspiel {Ire}). **Malhub** (Kingmambo) may attempt a second straight Golden Jubilee victory on Saturday, but the five-year-old has yet to make a start this season. After coming up just a head short in 2001, **Zindabad (Fr)** (Shirley Heights {GB}) won last year's G2 Hardwicke S. and will attempt the repeat on Saturday, while **Dominica (GB)** (Alhaarth {Ire}) will seek a second G2 King's Stand S. win on Tuesday. Handicappers **Norton (Ire)** (Barathea {Ire}), winner of the Royal Hunt Cup a year ago, and **Capricho (Ire)** (Lake Coniston {Ire}), winner of the Wokingham, complete the list of repeat hopefuls. Among the horses seeking wins in different races this year are G3 Queen's Vase winner **Mamool (Ire)** (In the Wings {GB}), one of the favorites for Thursday's G1 Gold Cup and **Statue of Liberty** (Storm Cat), winner of last year's G3 Coventry S. and entered in the St. James's Palace S. The last horse to register consecutive victories at the Royal Meeting was Royal Rebel, winner of the Gold Cup in 2001 and 2002.

Perfect Soul was off the board in his last two starts of 2002, but, after a four-month vacation, came out running this season. The homebred opened his 2003 account with a 5 1/4-length Keeneland allowance tally Apr. 13 and then finished a gutsy second in the May 17 GII Citgo Dixie S. at Pimlico. The crowd's choice to get back to the winner's circle in this event, he took a bad step when the gates opened, but was quickly into stride to take up a staking position while three wide. The bay was even wider as they raced around the far turn, but swept past the leaders to take command at the top of the stretch and held Strut the Stage at bay to the wire. Dai Jin delayed the start by losing a shoe, but came home strongest of all in this trial for the G1 Deutsches Derby at Hamburg July 6. After finishing runner-up in the Listed Preis der Dreijahrigen at Dusseldorf Apr. 27, he was beaten a head by Darlan (Ger) (Law Society) in the Listed Jean Harzheim-Rennen at this track May 18. Settled in a staking role throughout the early stages of this contest, he struggled with the strong pace laid on by Palmridge and looked beaten on the final turn. However, while he took time to reach top gear, Dai Jin was quickening best of all in the final quarter and collared both the long-time leader and North Lodge at the eighth pole, then held the game rally of the latter for the victory. Dai Jin is the second major three-year-old stakes winner for his sire following the G2 Prix Noailles success of Super Celebre (Fr). His third dam is the excellent racemare and producer White Star Line, winner of the GI Kentucky Oaks and granddam of the G1 Oaks d'Italia winner Valley Of Gold (Fr) and the G1 Moyglare Stud S. scorer and champion Preseli (Ire).  Miss Anabaa finished fifth behind Swedish Shave (Fr) in the Listed Prix Cor de Chasse before filling the third spot behind that rival in the Listed Prix Servanne at Maisons-Laffitte in April. After finishing fifth behind Best Walking (Ger) in the G3 Prix de Saint-Georges at Longchamp May 11, she showed impressive acceleration to take the Listed Naas Sprint June 2. Always prominent in this dash under Fran Berry, she again displayed that turn of foot to burst between Marino Marini and Belle du Jour in the final 50 yards and edge this contest. "She takes her racing well, but will have a little break until the autumn," commented trainer Rae Guest. "I'd love to win a Group 1 with her--we'll try and find one for her when there's cut in the ground." The runner-up, a Group 1 winner in her native country, had finished fourth behind State City in the G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen in March. Savedbythelight, a maiden winner over the Belmont turf last October, ended her juvenile campaign with a runner-up finish behind Roar Emotion in the GII Demoiselle and was coming off a third-place effort in her lone sophomore start, a May 9 main track Belmont allowance. After contesting the early pace, the dark bay filly was asked for run in upper stretch and responded by opening up on the field of five en route to an easy win. "She was a well-prepared, well-placed filly," said winning rider Richard Migliore. "I knew we would be fairly close to the pace. The race was devoid of any true front-runner." Fircroft (A.P. Indy), the 6-5 favorite, never threatened and finished fourth. "It looked like she was floundering in the back and beat a turf horse," said the filly's trainer Rusty Arnold.

Buyers can now write off up to \$100,000 of the cost of horses. The expensing allowance applies to purchases from January 1, 2003 through December 31, 2005. "Bonus" first-year depreciation increases to 50% and is in addition to the \$100,000 expensing allowance and regular depreciation. With bonus and regular depreciation, about 56% of the price of a yearling can be written off in the year of purchase.
