**AUSSIE GETS THE GOLD**

**Choisir (Aus)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) put the finishing touches on the story of the week at Royal Ascot yesterday, adding the G1 Golden Jubilee S. to his victory in Tuesday's G2 King's Stand S. Australia's new equine hero set up this tantalizing prospect when beating Acclamation (GB) by a length from a low draw in Tuesday's five-furlong dash, but was drawn wide in the 20 hole over this stiffer six. Choisir broke fastest of all, and jockey Johnny Murtagh poached enough of an advantage to creep the 13-2 second choice across to the stands' rail inside the final quarter.

The chestnut achieved the landmark by holding off the persistent challenge of 11-8 favorite **Air Wave (GB)** (Air Express {Ire}), who closed with menacing ease before drifting right in the closing stages. *Jubilee cont. p2*

**AZERI'S FOES TAKE A POUNDING**

Horse of the Year **Azeri** (Jade Hunter) gave her six rivals from nine to 17 pounds, and gave them a thrashing, pulling away under only mild encouragement to take yesterday's GI Vanity H. at Hollywood Park by two lengths. It was a workmanlike performance, with the awesome mare doing the bare minimum to secure her 10th consecutive graded-stakes triumph, with eight of the wins coming at the Grade I level. "I think, with the weight, [jockey Mike Smith] didn't want to just blow by them," trainer Laura De Seroux said. "He could have, but he just didn't want to. He was just so ultra-confident and he was well aware of the weight spread. He was taking care of her." That's exactly what Smith was doing. "Going down the backstretch and into the far turn, I was thinking I could blow it open right now if I wanted," he said. "But if I did open it up and we win by 10, then they give her 130 or something next time." With the victory, Azeri became the fourth two-time winner of the Vanity, and the first since It's In The Air in 1979-80. Sent off the even-money favorite in the GI Ogden Phipps H. at Belmont Park yesterday, **Sightseek** (Distant View) ran and hid from the competition, drawing clear in the final furlong to beat second choice **Take Charge Lady** (Dehere) by five lengths. "The biggest question was the mud, but she's a classy horse and horses like her will run over anything," winning jockey Jerry Bailey said. Sightseek had never raced on a wet track before, but she had been first or second in all nine career starts. She tracked Take Charge Lady through swift fractions, went up to join her after six furlongs in 1:09.35, then left her in her wake en route to her second Grade I success. # ROYAL ASCOT

## ROYAL MEETING A BIG SUCCESS

Officials at Ascot racecourse yesterday declared the five-day Royal meeting a resounding success. Chief Executive Douglas Erskine-Crum commented, "Everything has gone extremely well, mainly due to the fantastic standard of the racing and the wonderful weather. The crowds have been excellent and race-goers have, on the whole, been very well behaved, so we are all very happy. We are delighted with the attendance figures for the meeting, especially Friday, which could well be challenging Gold Cup day in popularity soon. I was particularly pleased to see Choisir win the King's Stand S. for Australia on Tuesday and then succeed again today, as we have worked so hard for the past two years to attract international runners." Erskine-Crum attributed those endeavours to Clerk of the Course Nick Cheyne. "Nick has worked tirelessly spreading the gospel, and has travelled the racing globe searching out the top horses and doing his level best to get them to come to Royal Ascot," he said. The Tote registered a record £9.2 million in handle over the five days, an increase of 11.5 percent on last year. "It's the first time we've done £9 million in a week at any race meeting," said Tote spokesman Andy Clifton.


## FRANKIE SEALS TROPHY

Frankie Dettori captured the London Clubs Trophy for the top jockey at Royal Ascot after landing a final-day double. Having steered Hold to Ransom to success in the Listed Sandringham S., the Italian dead-heated with Ratio (GB) in the Wokingham H. to bring him level with Kieren Fallon, Richard Hughes and Kevin Darley on three winners. His five seconds proved decisive, however, and the honors were his for the fourth time. Less fortunate was jockey Martin Dwyer, who scored on High Accolade (GB) in Friday's G2 King Edward VII S. Dwyer was thrown from Trick Cyclist in yesterday's Windsor Castle S. and suffered a broken hand.

### *A Legend Down Under...*

Now set for legendary status in his native country, the four-year-old **Choisir** completed the Royal Ascot double on the back of one previous score at the highest level in Australia, the G1 Lightning S. at Flemington Feb. 9. He proved that victory was no fluke with a course-record setting effort at Royal Ascot yesterday. "I just said I'll jump out and, as he shows loads of speed, let him drift across as it does seem to be faster over there," Johnny Murtagh explained. "He just took me there the whole way and when I got to the furlong and a half, I knew nothing was going to beat me. He kept going. I could hear Airwave coming, but she wouldn't have got him." Trainer Paul Perry may find the challenge of the G1 July Cup at Newmarket July 10 impossible to resist now. "That was just sensational," he said. "I thought he had a bit of a job off the alley, but Johnny had the plan to go straight and slowly work across and it turned out super. Johnny said 'leave him here, he'll win everything,' so we'll talk about it." Owner Terry Wallace added, "They've all watched this in Australia and there'll be no sleep." Indian Creek produced his trademark late kick to swoop from last to first yesterday. After finishing runner-up to Grandera (Ire) in the G1 Prince of Wales's S. at this meeting 12 months ago, he tackled the championship 10-furlong events, producing his best effort when fourth behind Nayef in the G1 International S. at York in August. This term, he offered potents that he could emerge as one of the leading middle-distance performers when winning the G3 Gordon Richards S. at Sandown Apr. 26, but failed to land a blow when third behind Sights on Gold (Ire) in the G3 Brigadier Gerard S. at that track May 27. Stepped up to a mile and a half for the first time here, Indian Creek was held up off the generous early pace, quickened late in the straight and collared Bollin Eric inside the final 50 yards. "He's an odd character who drops himself out, but he needs a good strong pace," conditioner David Elsworth said. "We keep missing over a mile and a quarter, where we've often not had a gallop, but he is a very good horse and its nice to get on the score sheet. He's got a look about him--a good eye and a great presence and although he's quite an in-depth character, there's a lot of horse there. If you can channel all those energies into the right direction, he comes good." Bollin Eric will be aimed at the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot July 26. "He ran a blinder," trainer Tim Easterby said. "I suppose the Group 1 penalty might have beaten him." Hold to Ransom was fourth in the G3 Nell Gwyn S. over seven furlongs at Newmarket Apr. 15 before finishing second to Hi Dubai (GB) in the 10-furlong Listed Pretty Polly S. May 4. She was lit up at the head of affairs in the G3 Musidora S. at York May 13 and failed to last the course, fading to sixth. Held up towards the rear this time off the fast tempo, she was switched wide for her challenge passing the halfway mark and quickened to pass Chic with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining before surging clear. "I rode her in work on Tuesday and she was very keen, and I said we were doing the right thing going to a mile," Frankie Dettori said. Ratio and Fayr Jag flashed past the post on different sides of the Ascot track, but the photo failed to find any distance between them and the spoils were shared. In a testament to the state of the ground, both managed to beat the track record broken by Choisir (Aus) in the G1 Golden Jubilee S. While Ratio was stepping up off a Chantilly conditions event May 31, Fayr Jag was recording his third consecutive handicap success this month, having taken lesser contests at Pontefract and York. Ratio stayed on the far rail under pilot Frankie Dettori and was creeping to the front as Fayr Jag struck under Willie Supple before the furlong marker. As Supple eased his mount in the dying strides, Ratio was driven to the line and had done enough to close the gap. "He ran a lovely race and we're thrilled," Ratio's trainer John Hammond said. "Having the rail was a help, but if he could have had someone to take him another 100 yards and give him a lead, it would have helped a little bit more."

A winner in four of her five starts at three, Sightseek started 2003 with three consecutive second-place finishes at Santa Anita, missing by a half length in the Jan. 25 GI Santa Monica H., by 3/4 of a length in the Feb. 8 GII La Canada S. and by two lengths in the Mar. 9 GI Santa Margarita H. But she came to life in her latest, cruising to a 4 1/2-length victory in the May 3 GI Humana Distaff H. and made it two straight at the highest level yesterday. "Sightseek is a great filly," trainer Bobby Frankel said. "I just wish the Breeders' Cup was back east instead of at Santa Anita. I'm not sure how fond she is of Santa Anita." The runner-up, making her first start since running Horse of the Year Azeri to a head decision in the Apr. 5 GI Apple Blossom H. at Oaklawn Park, was second best again. "She tried really hard," jockey Edgar Prado said. "She broke clean and handed the track really well. She did everything perfect, other than win."

Azeri kicked off her current winning streak in the GI Santa Margarita H. last March, and has been unstoppable since, winning at five different tracks along the way. Given a break after her five-length romp in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff last October, she had to fight for her first win this season, besting Take Charge Lady by a head while defending her title in the Apr. 5 GI Apple Blossom H. at Oaklawn. The great mare was coming off a facile three-length tally in the May 24 GI Milady Breeders' Cup H. Bumped at the break this time, she took turns leading with longshot Sister Girl Blues, but always seemed to have that filly at her mercy. She finally took control at midstretch and edged clear. "I asked her to run just the last little bit only to get the weight going forward," Mike Smith said. "I didn't want to be idling between the sixteenth pole and the wire, in case somebody did make a run...when you're carrying that much weight, you want it going forward. That's the only reason I asked her to run at all." He added, "Gallop out, I went to pull her up and she took off. I had to get the outrider to come get me."

Second choice Midway Road, a distant second in the GI Preakness last time out, was steadied sharply on the first turn and was caught behind horses down the backstretch. "I owe all the credit to Mountain General," winning jockey Corey Lanerie said. "He was tons the best and I'm just glad it worked out. He ran into a lot of traffic problems and still got there." Added Scott Blasi, assistant to trainer Steve Asmussen, "It was a very competitive field and I couldn't be more proud of our horse." The runner-up, looking for his fourth in a row, had beaten Mountain General while getting five pounds in the Mar. 16 Pelleteri Breeders' Cup H., but had not been out since taking the Apr. 10 GII Count Fleet Sprint H. at Oaklawn Park and was giving his rival seven pounds this time. "It was a tough loss," jockey Jamie Theriot said. "We figured with one more work in him, we would have been 100 percent sure. **IT'S PRADO BY A NOSE AT LONE STAR** Before an on-track crowd of 13,558 on a warm Central Texas evening, jockey Edgar Prado became the first two-time winner of the NTRA All-Star Jockey Championship at Lone Star Park. The New York-based rider finished with a total of 22 points in the four-race competition, one point better than Shane Sellers. Under the rules of the competition, jockeys received points when they finished in the top four. "I love to compete in this event," Prado commented. "It's the only way you can keep sharp and prepare yourself mentally for the big races the rest of the year." Cleary, the sentimental favorite among the Lone Star faithful was third-place finisher Jose Santos, who was greeted with cheers and swarmed by autograph seekers all night long. Referring to the recently concluded Triple Crown, he said, "I've never been so happy through those five weeks. It was great for my family and it was great for me...to be part of the Triple Crown."
