VESPONE IS GRAND IN PARIS

Vespone (Ire) (Llandaff) led from pillar to post to beat the flying Magistretti (Diesis {GB}) and justify his supplementary fee for yesterday's G1 Grand Prix de Paris

at Longchamp. Always traveling strongly, the chestnut blazed clear in the final quarter, holding on as Magistretti drove into his advantage late. "He's a top-class horse and he's only led in his races because there has been no pace; he does not need to," trainer

Nicolas Clement said. Vespone has not stopped progressing since he was upped in trip after running second in the Listed Prix Djebel at seven furlongs Apr. 7. He took the G3 Prix la Force May 5 before making all to take the G1 Prix Jean Prat June 1. "He'll now have a break," Clement said. "I deliberately did not enter him in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe [at Longchamp Oct. 5] as I was convinced he would not stay, but I don't know if I'm wrong or not. We will see later on where he comes back, but traveling three-year-olds to take on older horses is tough on them." KEEP AN EYE ON THE TIGER

Eye Of The Tiger (American Chance) looks to be a colt with a future. The three-year-old was a 41-1 outsider in the May 3 GI Kentucky Derby, but acquitted himself admirably to finish fifth, beaten just 4 3/4 lengths by Funny Cide. Facing a much softer field in his first start since his Classic foray, the bay was sent off the 9-10 chalk in the GIII Affirmed H. at Hollywood Park yesterday and came through for the crowd. Eye Of The Tiger settled in third as **Ministers Wild Cat** (Deputy Minister) cut out moderate fractions. He went after the leader from the inside as they hit the quarter pole and pulled away in the final furlong for a decisive 4 1/2-length tally. "I was very impressed by this colt," winning jockey Alex Solis said. "When I got down on him the last part, he was really reaching out. It looks like added distance is going to help him even more. We'll be ready for the Swaps." Trainer Jerry Hollendorfer confirmed that the John Gunther homebred will go next in the July 13 GII Swaps S., adding, "He was a little bit tired after the Derby, and I just weighed my thoughts and told John Gunther that I didn't think we should put him to the test [in the Preakness]. [The Derby] was exciting for everybody, but we're trying to look after this colt and make sure that we can do the best with him. I think we made the best decision." Leadership made virtually all to upset the market leader Warrsan and provide Godolphin with their 99th success at the highest level. Taken to the front in the early stages, the colt dictated a steady pace before quickening early in the straight. Challenged by Warrsan inside the final quarter, he pulled out more to record a comfortable success. Leadership started his career at the Newmarket base of Sir Michael Stoute and progressed markedly throughout his sophomore campaign. Third behind Systematic (GB) and Highest (Ire) in the King George V H. at Royal Ascot 12 months ago, he followed with another sterling effort when third in the John Smiths Cup at York in July, then took a handicap at that track the following month. Thrown in at the deep end when contesting the G3 September S. at Kempton, he performed with credit to be beaten a neck by Asian Heights (GB). Subsequently purchased by Godolphin, Leadership made his first outing in the royal blue a successful one in the Listed Berkshire S. at Windsor last time June 1. "Leadership has progressed strongly since his last race and Richard Hills gave him a very good ride," Godolphin's Diana Cooper commented. "He acted well on the very fast ground and deserved his victory." She added, "There are no immediate plans. It is a very hot day today and we will see how the horse comes out of the race." Soaring Free had tired to be fifth behind Najran in his only other stakes try, the Perryville S. in the slop at Keeneland last October, then was disqualified and placed sixth after running second in his final start of the season, a Woodbine allowance test Nov. 7. The dark bay has been perfect this season, however, coming back from a six-month layoff to take a seven-furlong allowance at the Toronto oval by 7 3/4 lengths before adding an off-the-turf score over this track June 4. Trying the grass for the first time in his return to stakes competition, the Sam-Son homebred was the crowd's choice and got the job done. On the pace while three wide early, he took command at the top of the stretch, drifted in at the eighth pole, but responded when set down to get the win and equal the stakes record. "We were so high on this horse last year," winning jockey Todd Kabel said. "But he had bucked shins and this and that, [and was] very coltish. Finally [trainer Mark Frostad] gelded him and this horse has really turned around. He showed his strut today and there's a lot more left to be seen of this horse. He's a very, very good horse." Added Frostad, "We're very pleased with that effort, obviously. We thought he had a great shot coming into the race, but it was a tough race...a lot of good horses in this race." THE INDUSTRY AT WORK: LEGISLATION

A purchaser can now write off up to \$100,000 of the cost of horses, provided total purchases of depreciable property during the year do not exceed \$400,000. The \$100,000 expensing allowance applies to purchases made 1/1/03-12/31/05. In addition to the allowance and regular depreciation, "bonus" first-year depreciation increases to 50%. The first-year write off for an individual paying \$200,000 for several young horses would be \$155,357.

Grabbing the lead at the furlong marker, War Blade was driven out to assert from **Royal Price**. Bred and owned by **Gestut Karlshof**, War Blade is the only foal from the **Dancing Brave** mare **Warluskee**, a winner at three in England and a half sister to the G1 **Nassau S.** winner **Zahrat Dubai (GB)**.

Jockey Kieren Fallon will be reunited with the chestnut in the race, as the Jockey Club has suggested that his one-day suspension picked up at Royal Ascot last week would be deferred. Bookmakers Coral make Dalakhani the 1-3 favorite, with Kris Kin quoted at odds of 2-1.

SUSSEX FOR DESTINATION **Dubai Destination** (Kingmambo) is being prepared for the G1 Sussex S. at Goodwood July 30, Godolphin announced yesterday. Having marked his comeback from injury with an impressive score in Tuesday's G1 Queen Anne S. at Royal Ascot, the four-year-old will continue on the mile route for the remainder of the season. "We were delighted with Dubai Destination's victory at Ascot, proving himself a top-notch miler," racing manager Simon Crisford said. "He showed a great turn of foot on that occasion to destroy a high-class field. The plan at the moment is to aim for the Sussex--the course should suit him." While that mile contest was a provisional target for **Moon Ballad (Ire)** (Singspiel {Ire}) earlier in the spring, plans are on hold for the four-year-old, who disappointed when ninth in Wednesday's G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot. "Moon Ballad did not run up to form in the Prince Of Wales's S. on his first outing since winning the Dubai World Cup," Crisford added. "Grandera also failed to sparkle in the same Royal Ascot race. We do not have any plans for Moon Ballad at the moment. We are just going to wait and see before we decide on his programme." **Grandera (Ire)** (Grand Lodge), seventh Wednesday, has been tabbed a "likely" contender for the G1 Coral-Eclipse S. July 5.

CHOISIR BOUNCES OUT OF JUBILEE **Choisir (Aus)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}), who completed the historic double of the G2 King's Stand S. and G1 Golden Jubilee S. at Royal Ascot, was yesterday reported to be doing well after his exploits. Having beaten Airwave (GB) by a half length in Saturday's six-furlong contest, the four-year-old may bid to confirm the form in the G1 Darley July Cup at Newmarket July 10. "He's pulled up fine," trainer Paul Perry told *PA Sport* yesterday. "He's really well this morning. He's in the July Cup and that's probably the only race for him really. I would just give it a week now and see how he goes."

MINESHAFT TO SUBURBAN **Mineshaft** (A.P. Indy), who suffered a narrow defeat when second to Perfect Drift in the June 14 G1 Stephen Foster H., will make his next start in the July 5 G1 Suburban H. at Belmont Park, trainer Neil Howard said yesterday. The original plan was to wait for the Aug. 2 G1 Whitney H. at Saratoga, but the four-year-old has trained very well since the Foster, causing the change in the schedule.
