Team Frankel On the Move

Belmont S. winner **Empire Maker** (Unbridled), **Peace Rules** (Jules), who won the GI Blue Grass S., and GIII Swale S. victor **Midas Eyes** (Touch Gold) all visited Belmont Park's main track this week as trainer Bobby Frankel prepares the talented sophomores for their upcoming East Coast starts. Empire Maker breezed five panels Tuesday in :58 4/5 and his stablemate Midas Eyes covered the same distance in 1:02 4/5. Juddmonte Farm's homebred is likely to make his next start in the GII Jim Dandy S. at Saratoga Racecourse while the latter, owned by Edmund Gann, will be targeted for Belmont's GII Dwyer S. July 6. On Wednesday's

worktab, another Gann-owned star Peace Rules blazed through four furlongs in :45 2/5, the fastest of 69 moves on the day.

Sky Mesa Readies For 2003 Debut

Undefeated **Sky Mesa** (Pulpit), who won the GI Hopeful S. at Saratoga last summer, is likely to make his seasonal debut in the GII Dwyer July 6, although an allowance start against older foes is not out of the question. "With a stake [Dwyer], you know it's going to go. There will be some experienced horses in there," said trainer John Ward Jr. "You can't count on any of the allowance preps to go." According to assistant trainer Donna Ward, the \$750,000 KEESEP yearling purchase came out of a handy five-furlong work, which he covered in :59 over Belmont's main strip Tuesday, in good order. "He didn't get very tired [Tuesday], but I wanted him to get a little bit tired," said Donna Ward. "I think he's stronger than last year. He's very mature and settled in. He knows what's going on."

MISTER BAILEYS INFERTILE

Mister Baileys (GB) (Robellino--Thimbleigger {GB}, by Sharpen Up {GB}) will be retired after being found to be irrevocably infertile, the *Racing Post* reported yesterday. The winner of the 1994 G1 2000 Guineas will move from his current base at Chris Harper's Whitsbury Manor Stud in Hampshire to the home of Paul Venner, chief executive of Baileys Horse Feeds. After his Classic season, in which he was also fourth in the G1 Epsom Derby, he was due to stand at the National Stud, but was stricken with grass sickness and after his recovery was taken possession of by his insurers. After a five-season spell at Vinery, where he sired 163 foals, he was purchased by Kern Lillingston Associates and Warrender Associates, acting on behalf of a 45-share syndicate headed by Whitsbury Manor, in 2000. He produced 51 foals in 2002 and 38 in the current crop. "We stopped covering the first week in April, after 35 [mares] in a row scanned empty," said stud manager Charlie Oakshott. "We had the testing done and the labs found an increase in abnormal sperm and a decrease in their longevity. The combination of those two things was just too much." From his five crops, Mister Baileys sired five stakes winners, including this year's GIII Mr. Prospector H. winner Bailey's Edge and Cool Ashlee, second in the GI Mazarine Breeders' Cup in 1999.

BELLE DU JOUR RETIRED

Belle Du Jour (Aus) (Dehere--Delightful Belle {NZ}, by Balmerino {NZ}) has been retired to stud, it was announced yesterday. Following a career highlighted by a win in the G1 Golden Slipper at Rosehill in 2000 and G1 Newmarket H. at Flemington Mar. 8, the six-year-old will visit Sadler's Wells. Transferred to Dermot Weld after a fourth-placing in the G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen at Nad al Sheba Mar. 29, her best subsequent effort came when runner-up in the G3 Ballyogan S. at Cork June 15. She was 15th in Saturday's G1 Golden Jubilee S. at Royal Ascot. Weld told *PA Sport*, "She retires to stud sound, although she got a gash over her hock at Royal Ascot on Saturday." Belle Du Jour, Australian champion juvenile filly in 1999-2000, retires with nine wins from 35 starts and earnings of \$1,899,598.

Although it has been a subject of some debate, the general consensus is that stallions tend to lose potency with age. As a result of that belief, it's conventionally accepted wisdom that one should not breed an older mare to an older stallion. That, however, didn't stop Mr. & Mrs. Robert David Randal from sending their mare **Wicked Witchcraft** to **Wild Again**, a mating which involved parents who would both be 20 years old at the time the foal was born. The result of this convention-bucking mating is **Wild and Wicked**, who maintained his unbeaten record with a 3 1/4-length victory in Saturday's GII Ohio Derby.

Since this was only his third start, it will be no surprise if **Wild and Wicked**, whose connections briefly considered pointing him for the GI Belmont S., continues to improve. That is certainly what his pedigree suggests. The offspring of **Wild and Wicked's** sire **Wild Again** often progress with age, a point underlined by the fact that two of his best representatives this year are six-year-olds; **Milwaukee Brew**, who took back-to-back runnings of the GI Santa Anita H.; and GII **Genuine Risk** H. winner **Shine Again**. Incidentally, the veteran sire is having another excellent year as his other scorers include the GIII **Hawthorne H.** victor **Keys to the Heart** and GIII **Holy Bull S.** winner **Offlee Wild**.

Like Fine Wine...

Wild and Wicked's dam **Wicked Witchcraft** has also produced two horses who showed significant progress with age. Her 1989 Far North colt **The Wicked North** didn't take a stakes until he was a four-year-old, when he captured the GIII **Bing Crosby H.** and GIII **San Francisco H.** The following year, he gained honors as champion handicap horse with three graded stakes triumphs, headed by the GI **Californian S.**, in which he set a new track record for nine furlongs, and the GI **Oaklawn H.**

Similarly, **Wicked Witchcraft's** 1995 filly, **A Lady From Dixie** (by **Dixieland Band**), had to wait until her four-year-old season to earn black-type, but at that age she captured the GII **Chula Vista H.** and finished third in the GI **Three Chimneys Spinster S.**

It's the same story when we look at the racing career of **Wicked Witchcraft** herself. A winner of 10 races and \$218,559, she took both her stakes wins, the Governor's **Lady H.** and the **Marion H. Van Berg H.**, as a five-year-old.

Wicked Witchcraft is a daughter of **Good Behaving**, winner of the **Swift, Gotham and Wood Memorial S.**, in the spring of his three-year-old season. Her dam **Surrogate** is a daughter of the Argentinean-bred **Yatasto**, and is half sister to the relatively minor stakes winners **Sight to See** and **Lynnheim**. The next dam, the **Alibhai** mare **Alibhai Lynn**, was a very accomplished performer in California, when she won the **Los Cerritos, San Mateo, Bing Crosby** and **Golden Poppy H.**, and equaled **Santa Anita's** track-record for six furlongs. When we studied the pedigree of **Wild Again's** daughter **Shine Again**, we mentioned that **Wild Again** has worked with a remarkably wide range of mares.

He's now got stakes winners out of mares by 70 different broodmare sires and no one broodmare sire is responsible for more than three **Wild Again** stakes winners. At the time we suggested that the key to this pattern is that **Wild Again** has a pedigree which is much older than most of his mates, his paternal grandsire **Nearctic** being born in 1954 and his maternal grandsire horse **Khaled** was a foal of 1943. As a consequence, strains close up in the pedigree of **Wild Again**--he has **Nearco 3x4** and **Hyperion 4x3**--and their backgrounds are found back in a large proportion of the breed, enabling a sizeable segment of the broodmare population to have the potential to supply **Wild Again** with reinforcements of the key ancestors in his pedigree.

Of course, Wicked Witchcraft's pedigree is of a similar vintage to Wild Again, and she particularly reinforces the Hyperion background of the pedigree, as her dam is inbred 3x3 to Hyperion. The particularly interesting horse here is Alibhai, the sire of Wild and Wicked's third dam. He's a very close relative to Lady Angela, the dam of Wild Again's grandsire Nearctic. Lending credence to the potential effect of this connection is the fact that Wicked Witchcraft's other graded stakes winners, The Wicked North and A Lady From Dixie, are by sons of Northern Dancer, who like Wild Again's sire Icecapade is a son of Nearctic.

DANCER SET FOR ECLIPSE *Norse Dancer (Ire)* (Halling) will be supplemented for the £350,000 G1 Coral-Eclipse S. at Sandown July 5. The David Elsworth-trained colt, who was third in the G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket May 3 before finishing fourth in the G1 Epsom Derby June 7, will be added to the 10-furlong contest at a cost of £20,000 at the next stage in four days' time. "The horse is in excellent condition at present," Elsworth commented yesterday. "He runs to a very high standard whatever the distance and the trip is not a concern really. He did run on atrocious ground in the Racing Post Trophy. He seemed to cope with that and his recent races have been on faster ground, so one has to assume that most goings come alike to him, but I'd prefer good ground in an ideal world. He's one of the better three-year-olds and they receive a very favourable weight allowance at this time of year. I'd be disappointed if it isn't as good a crop this year as most years and they do have a fair record against the older horses in the Coral-Eclipse." The Sponsors reacted to make the three-year-old the 4-1 second favourite behind the G1 Prince of Wales's S. winner Nayef, who is currently quoted at odds of 2-1.

MAN AMONG MEN SHELVED FOR YEAR *Man Among Men* (Gentlemen {Arg}), winner of the Sham S. over Empire Maker in February, will miss the remainder of the 2003 racing season with an injury to his left hind ankle, reports the *Blood-Horse*. The injury was first detected after the chestnut zipped a bullet five-furlong work in :59 3/5 at Hollywood May 25. "He worked great," said trainer Gary Mandella, "but he came out a little funny behind, so we did a nuclear scan, which found a little area. His left hind leg lit up. It's actually a blessing that we found it now. We were able to get ahead of it and give him the time off he needs to bring him back next year." The three-year-old will recuperate at Crystal Springs Farm in Paris, Kentucky. Campaigned by R.D. Hubbard and Connie Sczesny, Man Among Men won the Pinjara S. at Santa Anita as a juvenile, then put himself on the Derby trail with a game victory in the Sham. Subsequent poor outings in the GII San Felipe S. and GII Arkansas Derby, however, took him out of contention for the springtime Classics.

State Shinto spent the winter amongst the sand dunes of Dubai and had moderate success racing against some of the world's best. Second in Round 1 of the Maktoum Challenge in January, he finished an honest fourth to Grandera in Round 3 in mid-March. The dark bay finished fifth, beaten nine lengths, to the likes of Moon Ballad, Harlan's Holiday and Nayef in the world's richest race, the G1 Dubai World Cup Mar 29. Let go at juicy odds in his 2003 stateside debut, he raced just off the pace through the opening seven furlongs before asserting through the lane to stave off the determined Revved Up.
