IPI TOMBE MAKES U.S. DEBUT

They could only find five rivals to line up against South African star **Ipi Tombe (Zim)** (Manshood {GB}) in today's GIII Locust Grove H. at Churchill Downs. It's no surprise. The five-year-old mare has won 11 of her 13 career starts and comes into the nine-furlong Locust Grove on a seven-race winning streak. The bay beat the boys in her South African finale, the G1 Durban July Cup H., then shipped to Dubai and added three more wins vs. colts, including a three-length victory in the Mar. 29 G1 Dubai Duty Free H. last time out. "She's shown me enough in the morning to know that she's for real," said Elliott Walden, who took over the training chores from Michael de Kock when Ipi Tombe shipped to the U.S. in the spring. "I'm looking forward to running her. It's exciting." Ipi Tombe has been working steadily for her American bow, and her jockey, Pat Day, has had the chance to get to know his mount during a couple of those breezes. "She really accelerates," he said. "She'll rock you back in your seat." The Zimbabwe-bred will be giving away from six to 18 pounds today. Most likely to take advantage of the weight spread is **Quick Tip** (Unaccounted For), who is a perfect two-for-two at the Locust Grove distance. The five-year-old mare has been second over this course in her last two starts, missing by 1 1/2 lengths in the May 3 GIII Distaff Turf Mile and by a troubled neck in the May 24 GIII Mint Julep H. She has been first or second in six of her last seven starts.

ALAMSHAR "50-50" FOR IRISH CLASSIC

Trainer Aidan O'Brien could field two-thirds of the field for tomorrow's G1 Budweiser Irish Derby at The Curragh if **Alamshar (Ire)** (Key of Luck) is forced to miss the Classic. His conditioner, John Oxx, yesterday warned that Alamshar is only "50-50" to run after it was revealed that the colt has a pulled muscle in his back and that the significant rainfall at the track would not suit him. He is currently quoted as the second favorite based on his third behind Kris Kin in the G1 Epsom Derby, but Oxx told *PA Sport* yesterday, "We have a couple of question marks over him now. The rain we have had today was more than we expected and, depending on how much more we get, the question of the ground could be up in the air. He's got a little back injury, which he's having intensive physio on...he hasn't missed any work, but there's a question there to be resolved." Oxx will leave the decision as late as possible. "If he were to run, his back would have to be right. We could take a chance on the ground, but we can't if his back is not right." Oxx has also entered the rabbit **Alisar (Ire)** (Entrepreneur {GB}). "We left [Alisar] in as a precaution, as Aidan O'Brien has six runners and we don't know what his plan is," he added. O'Brien yesterday confirmed all six of his entries, with Mick Kinane choosing **The Great Gatsby (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), runner-up at Epsom June 7, over Jamie Spencer's mount **Brian Boru (GB)** (Sadler's Wells), who disappointed when only 16th in that Classic. Also among the Ballydoyle sextet is **Powerscourt (GB)** (Sadler's Wells), not seen since finishing runner-up to Brian Boru in the G1 Racing Post Trophy in September. Seamus Heffernan takes the ride. G1 Prix du Jockey-Club hero **Dalakhani (Ire)** (Darshaan {GB}) bids to follow in the hoofsteps of Montjeu (Ire), who completed the Irish-French double in 1999. "Dalakhani will be a little heavier on this occasion and that's a good thing," conditioner Alain de Royer-Dupre told the *Racing Post*. Christophe Soumillon added, "The colt appears well and in really good form." The ground was easing yesterday after significant rain, which is forecast to continue into the weekend. DAY OF STARS IN BUENOS AIRES The best of Argentinian racing gathers this afternoon at Hipodromo San Isidro near Buenos Aires for the Carreras de las Estrellas, Argentina's version of the Breeders' Cup. A short field of five will face the starter for the Classic, but the complexion of the race was changed Thursday when morning-line choice **Equal Stripes (Arg)** (Candy Stripes) was withdrawn from the race. The sophomore colt, second to Freddy (Arg) in last year's Gran Premio Estrellas Juvenile, suffered a minor training injury earlier in the week. Favoritism in the \$100,000 event could fall to Stud La Providencia's **Genereux (Arg)** (French Deputy), winner of the G1 25 de Mayo at San Isidro. The race also features 2001 Classic winner **Mr. Mat (Arg)** (Numerous). **Tanganyika (Arg)** (Interprete {Arg}) is back to defend her championship in the Distaff. The five-year-old mare is the winner of the G2 Gran Premio Particula Mar. 8. The fleet **Asset (Arg)** (Salt Lake) looks to continue his dominance of the juvenile sprint division this afternoon. The bay colt carries a four-race winning streak into today's 1000-meter event, including a three-length success in the G3 Velocidad June 4, covering the five-furlong distance in :55.15. **Emergente (Arg)** (Salt Lake), two-for-three in his career with a win in the G1 Raul Y Raul E Chevalier Apr. 19, could score another victory for his sire in the Juvenile. **Sebi Halo (Arg)** (Southern Halo), beaten 2 1/2 lengths into second in last year's Sprint, is the choice to get the job done this time, while **Halo Ola (Arg)** (Southern Halo), winner of the G1 Gran Premio de Potrancas May 31, could register a double for her sire in the Juvenile Fillies. **Fields, p3**

Yell will try to get back on track after going down to defeat in her last two starts. The Claiborne and Adele Dilschneider homebred was the six-length winner of the GII Davona Dale S. at Gulfstream in February, but came up empty in the Apr. 5 GI Ashland S. at Keeneland and could do no better than fourth. She improved last time out, running third behind Bird Town after a troubled trip in the May 2 GI Kentucky Oaks, and is the one to beat here. Never off the board in eight career starts, **Final Round** followed a win in the May 1 GIII La Troienne S. at Churchill with a solid third to Bird Town in the June 6 GI Acorn S. "She was training like she was going to improve and she did," trainer Rusty Arnold said. **Roar Emotion**, never worse than second in her five career starts, came home a half-length winner in the May 16 GII Black Eyed Susan S. in her latest. "We sat out some of the big races, like the Breeders' Cup and the Kentucky Oaks, with the Mother Goose in mind," trainer Carlos Martin said. "We haven't abused her. She's fresh. She's getting stronger, if that's possible. There's definitely room for improvement."

Summer Colony was the 7-10 favorite in the Molly Pitcher last year, but fell victim to an enterprising ride by jockey Eibar Coa, who stole an early lead with Atelier and was never caught, crossing the finish line a length in front of the crowd's choice. Summer Colony came back to win the GIII Delaware H. and the GI Personal Ensign H. at Saratoga, but tailed off at the end of the season, finishing third in the GI Beldame S. and a totally uncharacteristic eighth in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff. The five-year-old enjoyed an extended vacation after that effort, returning to run second by a neck in the GIII Pimlico Breeders' Cup Distaff H. May 16, and should be even better in her second start off the layoff. Trainer Shug McGaughey, who engineered the upset with Atelier last year, sends **Alchemilla** down this time. The four-year-old filly comes off a nose victory over **She's Got The Beat** in the June 7 Affirmed S. at Belmont.

Tates Creek has rattled off four straight victories, including the GI Gamely Breeders' Cup H. over **Dublino** and **Megahertz** May 26, but the five-year-old chestnut will likely be sit out this race because trainer Bobby Frankel is reportedly not pleased with the 123 pounds assigned to his morning-line favorite. **Dublino** has found the wire in front of **Megahertz** in each of their three previous meetings, including one over course and distance in the American Oaks last July. Though the stewards disqualified her from that win, the dark bay looked sharp in opening 2003 successfully in the GII Wilshire H. Apr. 27 and will be tough to deny over these 10 furlongs. **Megahertz** may be small in size, but the chestnut showed her customary turn of foot in taking the GII Santa Barbara H. Apr. 19 prior to her third in the Gamely. **Voodoo Dancer** ships in from her New York base in search of her first win since the GII Palomar H. at Del Mar Sept. 8. The blaze-faced bay most recently ran third in Aqueduct's GIII Beaugay H. May 3.

Graded stakes winner **Lismore Knight** was sidelined following a runner-up finish to Peace Rules in the GI1 Generous S. Nov. 30 at Hollywood, but returned to action with a sharp allowance victory at Belmont May 17 and merits top billing. A pair of Irish colts making their U.S. bows could provide the biggest challenge. **Good Day Too** won at first asking Mar. 23, then missed by just a half length to subsequent G1 2000 Guineas hero Refuse to Bend (Ire) in the Listed Leopardstown 2000 Guineas Trial S. Apr. 13. The bay colt then came up short by a head in the 10-furlong Listed Silver S. at The Curragh May 25 and should appreciate today's distance. Unbeaten **European** defeated Catcher in the Rye (Ire) in a Curragh maiden last year and kicked off his three-year-old campaign with a win in the Listed Amethyst S. May 11 at Leopardstown.

Luckless in the mile Classic, she appeared to run out of stamina at the business end of the latter and may find this intermediate trip more to her liking. **Zee Zee Top** has been brought along steadily by Sir Michael Stoute, and his patience is being rewarded with some progressive displays on the track. She was forced to do much of the hard work to win the Listed Middleton S. at York May 14 last time, but her beating of Chorist (GB) and the much-improved Aldora (GB) sets the standard.

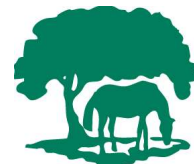

The five-year-old mare, unbeaten in two starts this year, would have been forced to miss the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff in October after veterinarians informed owner George Krikorian that she would require at least 60 additional days off. "[The Breeders' Cup] was always the goal," Krikorian told *Daily Racing Form*. "If we can't do that, it doesn't serve any practical purpose to go through all the training and vigor of getting ready to be back in December or January. The best plan, reluctantly, is to turn her out and let her be a mom next year." Acquired by Krikorian for \$35,000 at Fasig-Tipton October, Starrer ran third in the GIII Landaluce S. at two and captured both the GII Princess S. and the GII Bayakoa H. during her three-year-old season. The dark bay won just once at four when successfully defending her title in the Bayakoa, but appeared to be hitting her best stride in 2003. She defeated You in the GI Santa Maria H. in February, then added a victory over Sightseek in the GI Santa Margarita H. Mar. 9, which made her a millionaire. Starrer heads to the breeding shed with a record of 20-6-5-3 and earnings of \$1,043,033.
