**HIGH POINT FOR AGA KHAN**

His Highness the Aga Khan can have few finer moments to savour than watching his colts **Alamshar (Ire)** (Key of Luck) and **Dalakhani (Ire)** (Darshaan {GB}) battling out the finish of yesterday's G1 Budweiser Irish Derby at The Curragh. At the wire, it was the former winning the duel by a half length. Alamshar gave the Aga Khan his fifth success in the Classic, following in the hoofsteps of Shergar (GB), 1981; Shahrastani, '86; Kahyasi (Ire), '88; and Sinndar (Ire), 2000. Settled in mid-division by Johnny Murtagh off the strong early pace,

**SAINT-CLOUD REDUX**

In scenes identical to those witnessed 12 months ago, **Ange Gabriel (Fr)** (Kaldounevees {Fr}) beat **Polish Summer (GB)** (Polish Patriot) to win his second straight renewal of the G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud yesterday afternoon. As he had last year, Thierry Jarnet chose to follow the early pace and that proved wise. Positioned in a stalking role as Richard Hills enjoyed a soft lead on Godolphin's rabbit **Millstreet (GB)** (Polish Precedent), Ange Gabriel quickened in the straight to take control with 100 yards remaining and asserted from there for a comfortable score. Polish Summer closed to deny the game long-time leader the runner-up spot, producing the same exacta as last year. For Ange Gabriel, it was his third Group 1 triumph. In addition to his Saint-Cloud double, the colt defeated Aquarelliste (Fr) to win the G1 Hong Kong Vase at Sha Tin in December. Given a short break after that effort, he returned to fall 3/4 of a length short behind **Sulamani (Ire)** (Hernando {Fr}) in the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic at Nad al Sheba Mar. 29 before warming up for this by winning the G2 Grand Prix de Chantilly last time June 8. "This is a great horse who has never let us down," trainer Eric Libaud commented. "He is so brave and got a great ride from Thierry, who didn't ask him to quicken too early. When he did [ask him to quicken], Ange Gabriel took off--this was a great performance." As for future plans, the trainer said, "I will have to discuss whether he goes for the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. **An Off Day for Sulamani...**

Sulamani raced keenly without cover in mid-division throughout the early stages as Frankie Dettori ignored Millstreet to track Ange Gabriel. He stayed on into fifth in the closing stages, but did not stretch out as the winner had on the fast ground, which had concerned connections beforehand. "We knew he needed the run," Dettori commented. "Probably also the ground was too firm for him." Sulamani will be pointed for the King George VI. Millstreet was subsequently disqualified for causing interference in the closing stages and placed sixth. **Grand Prix chart, p2**

**Clear Sailing for Classic Winner...**

Johnny Murtagh enjoyed smooth sailing aboard **Alamshar** throughout the Irish Derby. "They were going very fast up front, so I just sat in and had a beautiful run," he said. "I got up behind Dalakhani turning into the straight and upsides him two down and there was only going to be one winner." Alamshar, who took the G3 Beresford S. at this track in October, was caught up in a tactical affair when second to Balestrini (Ire) in the G3 Ballysax S. on his return at Leopardstown Apr. 13. He came back to beat **The Great Gatsby (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) in the G2 Derrinstown Derby Trial May 11 before finishing third behind Kris Kin and that rival in the G1 Epsom Derby June 7. "I was a bit disappointed with him at Epsom," Murtagh continued. "He just came up a bit flat with me and I said to the boss, 'Don't worry, I think it was the track,' and I think it was. Today, he really ground it out. He stays really well and gets his head down and gallops. For a small horse, he's all heart and guts and his will to win is second to none." Alamshar suffered a pulled muscle in his back after the Epsom Derby and his participation yesterday was in doubt until conditioner John Oxx confirmed him fit to race Saturday. "I was a bit worried on Friday when I rode him and, although he was going well, he was not going like a Derby winner," Murtagh said. "John Oxx got the physio in and he and all the staff have done a great job." Oxx, collecting his second Irish Derby after the exploits of Sinndar (Ire) three years ago, was thrilled with the finish of this year's edition. "It's wonderful to see two horses fight it out like that," he said. "I didn't really know whether to laugh or cry as they passed the post, because Dalakhani is a great horse and it is a shame to see him beaten." As for what's next, he added, "All being well, the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. [at Ascot July 26] is the plan. He is a summer horse who likes fast ground, and not necessarily a horse you would want to keep for the autumn."

**STORM FLAG FLYING SIDELINED** Last year's champion juvenile filly **Storm Flag Flying** (Storm Cat) suffered a small fracture in her right hind leg and will be shelved for approximately 60 days. "We've sent her home," explained trainer Shug McCaughey. "We discovered a small--and I mean small--fracture of her right hind cannon bone. She was never lame, but I knew something wasn't right. I couldn't figure it out, so we sent her to Rood and Riddle [Equine Hospital in Lexington, Ky] as a place to start. That's what they found." The regally bred Phipps colorbearer was undefeated in four 2002 starts, including a strong performance in the G1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies. She disappointed in two starts this year, however, most recently finishing sixth in the G1 Acorn S. at Belmont June 6. A cautious McCaughey was optimistic about a 2003 return for the three-year-old daughter of My Flag. "They said it would take about 30 days of walking and 30 days of turn out, then we will re-evaluate," he continued. "We're hoping to have her ready for late fall or for next year."

The 44th running of this event drew six Group 1 winners. Hishi Miracle was the least fancied of that group, but rallied to earn his third victory at the top level. The gray colt, well back early, closed ground steadily down the backstretch and into the far turn. Favored Symboli Kris S (Kris S.) powered to the lead at the top of the lane, but Hishi Miracle and runner-up Tsurumaru Boy were closing fast, catching the even-money choice with 100 meters to race. They came to the wire together, with Hishi Miracle prevailing in a photo. Three-year-old Neo Universe (Sunday Silence), the winner of the Japanese 2000 Guineas and the Japanese Derby, closed to be fourth in his first try against older horses.

 High Praise appears an excitable filly, but she is not short on talent based on this impressive performance. As she had before the G1 Epsom Oaks June 6, she became uneasy in the preliminaries, bursting through the stalls and delaying the start. Those antics did not subdue her in the race itself, however, as she broke on top, racing enthusiastically under Richard Hughes. She set an even tempo early, but took a tow from Approach (GB) (Darshaan {GB}) and Sweet Folly when those two were committed to the front with five furlongs remaining. Quickening in the straight, she found a gap between that duo at the quarter-mile marker and accelerated through before comfortably holding the late challenge of Underwater and Olivier Peslier. High Praise has done much of her racing in France, finishing third in the G3 Prix d'Aumale at Longchamp in September before beating Welcome Millenium (Fr) in the G3 Prix des Reservoirs at Deauville the following month. Trainer John Gosden admitted to setting her a stiff task on her return this year in the Epsom Classic, where she failed to land a blow, finishing 12th. "Running her first time out in the Oaks was a little bold and she didn't behave too well when I was saddling her that day," he explained. "It was all a bit much, but she's come on for the race and Richard gave her a great ride here, especially when he just let Approach go on. She is all heart and is very brave and found more when she needed to. All being well, she will go for the G1 Yorkshire Oaks [Aug. 20]." Antonius Pius, who took a Gowran Park maiden on his debut May 14, got the better of Spanish Ace to provide Aidan O'Brien with his sixth renewal of this contest since 1997. Settled in a stalking fifth by Mick Kinane throughout the early stages, he traveled easily before being momentarily squeezed as Spanish Ace and Johnny Murtagh passed him inside the final quarter. Asked to quicken in pursuit, he responded to join the battle inside the final eighth before edging ahead with 175 yards remaining and asserting in the final strides. "He is always on the bit in his work, in fact it is very hard to get him off the bridle," O'Brien commented. "He has a lot of speed, as he showed there, but he stayed seven furlongs well on his first run so we have plenty of options. Hopefully, he will be around for the G1 National S. [at this track Sept. 14], but he could go for the G1 Phoenix S. [at this track Aug. 10] over six if we want to go that way." Aolus missed out on the G1 Deutsches Derby last year due to an injury, but has always been highly regarded by connections. He has begun to reward their faith this term. After finishing second in the Listed Kolner Grand Prix Aufgalopp Mar. 16, he beat Epalo in the G3 Grosser Preis der Bremer Wirtschaft Apr. 6 before following up in the G2 Gerling-Preis May 4. Racing outside of Cologne for the first time here, he stalked arch-rival Epalo through the early stages. He was momentarily left flat-footed at the top of the straight as the front-runner opened up a clear advantage, but jockey Andrasch Starke was not to be panicked and Aolus responded to his urgings to close on Epalo and grab the lead with 150 yards remaining before asserting in the closing stages. His dam is a full sister to the Ceske Derby winner Arvan and a daughter of the champion mare Arva. Just Wonder, who opened his American campaign with an optional claimer win at Santa Anita in January, tried the main track when sixth in the GII San Rafael S. and was back on the turf for a fifth-place effort in the Apr. 12 La Puente H. He made a return visit to the winner's circle last out in the May 10 Ascot H. at Bay Meadows. Off since then, the bay colt trailed the field for much of yesterday's race, but unleashed a powerful rally to blitz from first to last on the final bend.
