**FIREWORKS ON THE FOURTH**

There will be seven graded stakes across the nation on Independence Day, headlined by the GI Prioress S. at Belmont Park. The \$200,000 sprint will feature a rematch between unbeaten **Belong to Sea** (Belong to Me) and **Chimichurri** (Elusive Quality), who finished heads apart in the GIII Miss Preakness S. May 15. Met Mile hero **Aldebaran** (Mr. Prospector) stars in the seven-furlong GII Tom Fool H., while three of his stablemates--**Lilac Queen**

(Ger) (Law Society), **Pertuisane** (GB) (Zamindar) and **Trekking** (Gone West)--from the Bobby Frankel shedrow will line up in the GII New York H., a 10-furlong turf test. Churchill's holiday feature will be the GIII Debutante S. for two-year-old fillies, where trainer D. Wayne Lukas will be searching for his fifth victory in the race with the pair of **Be Gentle** (Tale of the Cat) and **Renaissance Lady** (A.P. Indy). Hollywood Park will host a pair of graded events, the GII American H. and the GIII Landaluce S. The speedy **Special Ring** (Nureyev) will face off against Argentine sensation **Candy Ride** (Arg) (Ride the Rails) in the American, a nine-furlong turf affair. Trainer Julio Canani opted to keep Special Ring at home rather than ship to Churchill for Saturday's GIII Firecracker Breeders' Cup H. "This horse is very fragile in the head, and I don't need to put him on a plane," Canani explained. "He's doing good here."

Hastings mainstay Lord Nelson had figured prominently in the past two runnings of the Lieutenant Governors' H. and rounded into form at just the right time to win his second consecutive renewal of this event. Third in the 2001 edition of the Lieutenant Governors', he won last year's by a 2 1/2-length margin before going on to take the Sir Winston Churchill H. later in the year. After an eight-month shelving following that one, the dark bay was second in the May 10 George Royal S. and entered the Governors' off a third-place effort in the May 31 Hong Kong Jockey Club H. The outcome here was never really in doubt as the homebred tracked a sensible early pace in third, then drew clear under his jockey's urging to win going away. **FALBRAV COMMITTED** Luca Cumani has confirmed **Falbrav (Ire)** (Fairy King) on target for Saturday's G1 Coral-Eclipse at Sandown with Darryll Holland set to take the ride. Since regular jockey Kieren Fallon has already booked for the mount on Islington (Ire), Holland has been handed the chance to partner last year's G1 Japan Cup winner, who was fifth in the G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot last time June 18. "I rode Falbrav work this morning and it was a pleasure to sit on a quality horse," Holland told *PA Sport* yesterday. "The ground is all-important for Falbrav, but Sandown appears to have missed most of the rain so far and we're hoping that continues." Meanwhile, Godolphin look likely to rely on **Grandera (Ire)** (Grand Lodge) and **Narrative (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) in the 10-furlong contest after revealing that G3 Brigadier Gerard S. winner **Sights on Gold (Ire)** (Indian Ridge {Ire}) may wait for the G3 Scottish Derby at Ayr July 14.

**NYRA RETAINS SECURITY FIRM SAFIRROSETTI**

New York Racing Association Chairman Barry Schwartz has announced that the security firm SafirRosetti has been retained to evaluate the security operations, cash handling, supervisory training and other procedures for the organization. The firm will also assist NYRA in its daily compliance with all applicable laws and regulations. NYRA has retained the firm in response to New York State Attorney General Elliott Spitzer's recent report which criticized NYRA's parimutel and money-handling operations. Schwartz met with Spitzer yesterday and said, "As a result of my meeting with the Attorney General, I am satisfied that he and I share and are dedicated to the same core principle: that NYRA's business practices must at all times possess the highest integrity to ensure that Thoroughbred racing in New York State remains the best in the world." The NYRA Board of Trustees has also set up a special committee to oversee all efforts being made to respond to the issues raised in Spitzer's report. The committee consists of Albert Fried Jr., Stuart S. Janney III, Peter F. Karches, Richard T. Santulli and Stuart Subotnick.

**Empire Maker Breezes:**

Belmont winner **Empire Maker** (Unbridled) continued training for next month's GI Jim Dandy S., covering five-eighths in :59.02 over the main track yesterday morning. It was the second fastest time of the day. "He went a little quicker than I wanted, but he's a good horse and good horses work fast," said trainer Bobby Frankel. While the Juddmonte homebred will be up at Saratoga for the Aug. 3 Jim Dandy, his Kentucky Derby conqueror **Funny Cide** (Distorted Humor) will be running the same day at Monmouth Park in the GI Haskell Invitational H.; the two are set to meet again in the GI Travers S. at Saratoga Aug. 23. "Hopefully, we win the Jim Dandy and [Funny Cide] wins the Haskell," Frankel continued. "Of course it's exciting. It's good for the game."

Given a bit of a breather off that effort, the Live Oak homebred was an even fifth over the Aqueduct main track Apr. 10 and was most recently second after setting the pace over this turf course May 15. Favored to get back in the win column here, the dark bay filly showed good early speed, but was content to ease back to allow Twilights Prayer to set a good pace. Given her cue approaching the stretch, she struck the front approaching the eighth pole and pulled clear.

Kentucky Derby-winning trainer Barclay Tagg selected a Not for Love filly as the grand champion at the Maryland Horse Breeders Association's 69th Annual Yearling Show, which was held June 29 at Timonium. She was one of 112 yearlings on view at the show, which was restricted to Maryland-bred youngsters. Out of the Somethingfabulous mare Fabulous Vee, the dark bay is owned by Spring Meadow Farm in Cooksville, Md. Reserve champion was a Tale of the Cat colt out of Azusa (Flying Paster) from Bittersweet Farm in Westminster, Maryland.

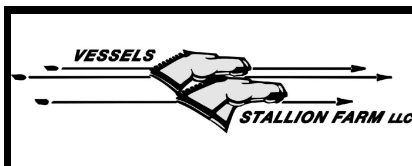
