FIELD ECLIPSES ALL BAR ONE

Tomorrow's G1 Coral-Eclipse S. at Sandown has attracted the second-largest ever field since its inception in 1886. The field of 15 has only been bettered once when Star Appeal proved best of 16 in the 1975 renewal. The draw will therefore play a more significant role than usual and likely favourite **Nayef** (Gulch), who is attempting the second leg of the BHB's Summer Triple Crown, will exit the five hole towards the outside, three lanes in from stablemate and potential rival, **Izdiham (Ire)** (Nashwan). Other leading fancies **Islington (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) and supplementary entry **Norse Dancer (Ire)** (Halling) have been posted in gates seven and 10, respectively. David Morris, managing director at Sandown, said, "Coral-Eclipse Day promises to be one of the racing highlights of the year with a fantastic feature race backed up by a very strong supporting card." Of the track condition, director of racing Andrew Cooper added, "We had a sharp shower at 7 p.m. on Wednesday night producing about three millimetres of rain and there is a possibility of a couple more showers during Thursday. We are then forecasting dry days on Friday and Saturday. Following Wednesday's rain the ground is good on the sprint course and good, good-to-firm in places, on the round course."

PRIORESS ALL ABOUT PACE

Eight talented three-year-old fillies are slated to go postward this afternoon in the 56th running of the G1 Prioress S., which has been won the past two years by sprinting stars Carson Hollow (2002) and Xtra Heat (2001). Most of the entrants have done their best running on the front end, including California shipper and 3-1 morning-line favorite **Princess V.** (Memo {Chi}), but the presence of so much early speed suggests that a closing style might be preferable. The Allen Jerkens-trained **House Party** (French Deputy) earned the field's highest Beyer of 106 in winning the six-furlong Legal Light S. at Delaware Apr. 26, which she followed up with a score in the GIII Nassau County S. May 10 going seven panels over this surface. A mile and

foes such as Bird Town and Lady Tak proved too much for her when she ran fourth in the G1 Acorn S., but the grey drilled a bullet five furlongs in :59 4/5 June 29 and looks set for a big effort. "She likes to come from behind off fast speed up front," said Jerkens. "I was going to try for the Test [G1, 7-26], but I think the Test will probably be a lot tougher than this one." A graded stakes winner at two, **Wild Snitch** (Forest Wildcat) kicked off 2003 with a facile five-length allowance win at Monmouth June 11 and should make her presence felt from post six. "We were hoping to have her ready early in the spring, but all the rain pushed back our schedule with her. This should be a good spot for her because she likes to sit just off the pace and she has good acceleration." Trainer Louie Roussel III brings his unbeaten **In Secure** (A.P. Indy) in from Chicago. Out of the sprinting Deputy Minister mare Morelia, In Secure was the wire-to-wire winner of her first two career outings at Hawthorne, then showed a new dimension by coming from just off the pace to win Arlington's Real Delight S. May 31.

Grade I winner **Riskaverse** might stand the best chance of defeating trainer Bobby Frankel's three-pronged entry of **Lilac Queen**, **Pertuisane** and **Trekking**. The dark bay has made two starts this year going a mile, winning a May 18 allowance before getting caught in a bog when second to Mariensky in the GIII Just A Game Breeders' Cup H. on the Belmont undercard. Her two starts beyond nine furlongs have been her worst performances to date, but trainer Pat Kelly is convinced that Riskaverse is ready to step up. "I've been waiting to run her this long," he said. "She had a 14 post in the American Oaks [eighth] and got shut off in the Breeders' Cup [seventh, beaten 2 3/4 lengths]. I think she can run all day. I want to run her next in the Beverly D. [GI, 8-16], which is a mile and three-sixteenths." Trekking, who ran stablemate Megahertz to 3/4 of a length when second in the GII Santa Barbara H. Apr. 19, was forced to scratch out of a recent allowance race with a shoe problem and will likely show the way early.

The Tom Fool features a field of seasoned veterans and marks **Aldebaran**'s return to sprinting. The Bobby Frankel trainee, winner of the GI San Carlos H. at Santa Anita in early March, lodged the second Grade I victory of his career with an impressive late-running score in the Metropolitan H. at Belmont May 26. Frankel thought the bay might be able to translate his form into routing when attempting the nine-furlong GI Stephen Foster H., and though Aldebaran didn't disgrace himself with a non-threatening third, the race showed the five-year-old is probably most effective at a mile or under. "He's a one-turn closer," said Frankel, who was also considering Hollywood's GI Triple Bend Saturday. "I didn't want to have to ship him again. I want him as fresh as possible. The race in California looks like a tougher spot." One of the more interesting horses in the race is Sheikh Mohammed's **Northern Rock**. The gelding, who stabled in Dubai last year, blitzed a solid group of allowance foes in his stateside debut, winning by six lengths and earning an impressive 113 Beyer. His trainer, the red-hot Kiaran McLaughlin, indicated that Lasix played a large role in the eye-catching performance. "He's a bleeder and the Lasix was a big issue," said McLaughlin. "Sometimes horses are just on Lasix, but he really needs it." A rejuvenate **Peeping Tom** also figures in the mix. The Grade I stakes winner finished third in the Met Mile and most recently won the J.B. Moseley H. at Suffolk Downs over a good pair of sprinters in My Cousin Matt and True Direction.

Candy Ride has been brilliant thus far in his four-race career and makes his North American stakes debut in this nine-furlong affair. The bay posted eight-length victories in a pair of Group 1 events in Argentina, both over a mile on turf, then switched to the main track in his first start for trainer Ron McAnally. He drew off smartly in that 8 1/2-furlong optional claimer June 7, earning a 111 Beyer and looks to be something special. He'll have to run down **Special Ring**, a confirmed front-runner who most recently was second to Redattore (Brz) in the GI Shoemaker Breeders' Cup Mile May 26. **Irish Warrior** has acquitted himself well against some big names this year. Second by a neck to Century City (Ire) at Turf Paradise in February, he ran third to Blue Steller (Ire) at Santa Anita in March, then missed by a half-length to subsequent GISW Honor In War in an Apr. 17 Keeneland allowance. The chestnut rallied to defeat Decarchy in a local allowance June 13; he has three wins and two seconds from five starts over this course.

A History: The PRIORESS S.

The PRIORESS was named for the first American Thoroughbred ever to win in England. Prioress was bought by Ten Broeck from General Wells as a three year old in 1857 for \$2,500. She was then sent to England, where she won both the Great Yorkshire Stakes and the Cesarewitch Handicap in 1858. In the latter, Prioress finished in a triple dead heat with El Hakim and Queen Bess; she then won the run off.

MY BOSTON GAL SIDELINED My Boston Gal (Boston Harbor) will be forced to miss the rest of the racing season because of a leg injury. The three-year-old filly, winner of the GII Stonerside Beaumont S. and GII Golden Rod S., suffered a minor fracture of the tibia while training Tuesday at Churchill Downs. The injury will not require surgery, according to trainer Carl Nafzger, but My Boston Gal will be sidelined for at least 120 days. Owned by Chester Porter, Phil Milner and Randal Bloch, My Boston Gal underwent throat surgery following a fifth-place effort in the GI Kentucky Oaks and was just returning to training. "She galloped on around here and they pulled up and came off the track," Nafzger explained. "But by the time she got about 100 yards off the track and nearly to the barn, she started walking on her toe." My Boston Gal has won four of seven starts and has earned \$411,251.
