TRIPLE THREAT

Nayef (Gulch), continuing on the trail for the inaugural BHB Summer Triple Crown, bids to add this afternoon's G1 Coral-Eclipse at Sandown to his success in the G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot. Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid al Maktoum's homebred renews rivalry with **Islington (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), **Olden Times (GB)** (Darshaan {GB}), **Falbrav (Ire)** (Fairy King), **Kaieteur** (Marlin) and **Grandera (Ire)** (Grand Lodge), who chased him home at the Royal meeting, as well as a select crew of sophomores taking on their elders at the highest level for the first time. Shadwell's blue and white silks were first carried to victory here in 1989 by Nayef's half-brother Nashwan, who went on to take the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. That great colt was the last to complete what is now the Summer Triple Crown (he used the alternative first leg, the Epsom Derby). It would poetic if Nayef was the first to cement the BHB initiative. Sir Michael Stoute has an enviable record in this race, having collected four renewals since 1993. He saddles Islington, who bids to become the first filly to win since Kooyonga (Ire) in 1992. Last year's G1 Nassau S. and G1 Yorkshire Oaks heroine has 3 1/2 lengths to make up with Nayef on the form of the Ascot contest, but she is entitled to improve on that first outing of the season.

SUBURBAN WARFARE

A quartet of Grade I winners take their places in today's GI Suburban H. at Belmont, led by W. S. Farish's **Mineshaft** (A.P. Indy). The winner of six of eight starts since arriving in the U.S. late last year, the four-year-old scored by nine in the GIII Ben Ali S. Apr. 25 before taking his first win at the highest level in the GI Pimlico Special May 16. The dark bay is coming into this off a head defeat at the hands of Perfect Drift in the GI Stephen Foster H. June 14. Some have laid the blame for the loss on a premature move by jockey Robby Albarado, but trainer Neil Howard is sticking with his go-to rider. "Things happen sometimes," he said. "Not every race goes as smoothly as you think it should." Breeders' Cup Classic winner **Volponi** (Cryptoclearance), making his third start off the layoff, is back at the Classic distance. Second to loose-on-the-lead Iron Deputy in the GII Brooklyn H. in his most recent start June 14, the bay will get the blinkers back on this afternoon. "If he would have had them in his first two races, he would have burned himself out," said Hall of Famer P.G. Johnson. **Harlan's Holiday** (Harlan), second to Moon Ballad (Ire) in the G1 Dubai World Cup, will try to atone for his last-of-five finish in the Brooklyn, an effort that trainer Todd Pletcher is willing to toss. "He turned his head exactly when the gates were opening," he said. "He broke behind the field on a [sloppy] track he didn't like and you couldn't make much ground up on." Grandera represents Godolphin, who have captured this prize three times and accounted for the first three home in 1998. He finished runner-up to Medicean (GB) in this contest as a three-year-old before marking his arrival on the international scene by taking the G1 Singapore Airlines International Cup at Kranji, G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot and G1 Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown last year. He was a short head behind Nayef when that pair trailed Moon Ballad (Ire) in the G1 Dubai World Cup at Nad al Sheba Mar. 29, but has questions to answer based on his 12-length beating when seventh in the Prince of Wales's S. last time. Nine three-year-olds have won this since 1980, but only three have managed to best their elders since 1991. Two of those came from Ballydoyle; Aidan O'Brien has a two-pronged attack here with **Hold That Tiger** (Storm Cat) and **Balestrini (Ire)** (Danehill). While the former is stepping up in trip after an eye-catching fourth in the G1 St. James' Palace S. at Royal Ascot June 17, Balestrini drops back after his creditable fifth placing in the G1 Epsom Derby June 7. He split **Norse Dancer (Ire)** (Halling) and **Dutch Gold** (Lahib) in that Classic, but there is not much between the trio.

House Party bobbed at the break in the June 6 G1 Acorn S. and could do no better than fourth. Away cleanly this time, the gray filly settled off a fast early pace and finished full of run to win going away. It was the fourth stakes win of the season for the Joseph Shields Jr. homebred, who also took the Feb. 2 Old Hat S. at Gulfstream, the Apr. 26 Legal Light S. at Delaware Park and, two starts back, the May 10 GII Nassau County Breeders' Cup S. at Belmont. "That was a thrill," Hall of Fame trainer Allen Jerkens said. "That kind of pace in front really helps her. She's done so well all year. I didn't think she should have been favored today, but I'm glad they were right." As for what's next, Jerkens said, "If she is doing very well, we'll go for [the G1 Test S. at Saratoga July 26]." Previously undefeated In Secure (A.P. Indy) was making a run up the rail as they raced into the stretch, but had to steady sharply when caught in tight quarters and dropped back to be fifth. 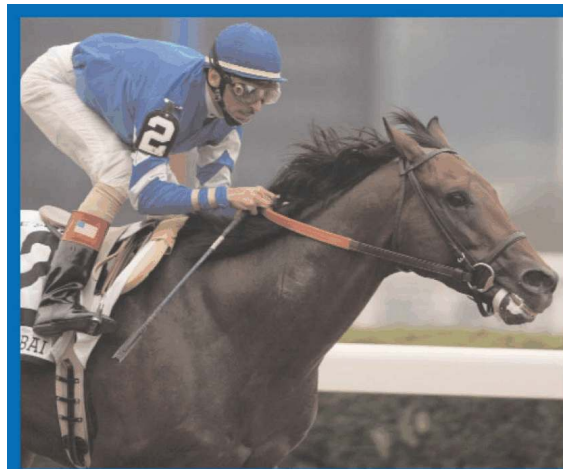

It had been a tough first half of the year for John Oxley's Snow Dance, but she got the second half off to a flying start with a victory in the New York H. at box-car odds. Second in the GII WinStar Galaxy S. at her Keeneland base to close out her four-year-old campaign, the grey mare kicked off the new season with a third-place finish as the favorite in the Mar. 1 Bayou Breeders' Cup H. at the Fair Grounds. Returned to Lexington for her next, the John Ward trainee was a rallying third to Sea of Showers in the GIII Jenny Wiley S. Apr. 13 and was coming into this off a sixth-place effort, beaten 37 lengths, in a boggy renewal of the GII Sheepshead Bay H. at Belmont May 31. The second longest shot in the field, Snow Dance broke alertly to chase early pacesetter Trekking (Gone West) from within easy striking distance. Asked for her best by jockey Richard Migliore leaving the far turn, she drew clear in upper stretch and held off Pertuisane for her first win of 2003. "I was looking forward to running on natural turf...last time, it was a natural bog," the winning trainer commented. "She's matured. Last year, she was three to four lengths off the best grass mares because she hadn't matured yet." Snow Dance is likely to meet Ipi Tombe (Zim) in the GI Diana H. at Saratoga July 26. Back at his best distance, Aldebaran came up the fence to post his fourth win in six starts this campaign. After kicking off the year with a five-length tally in the GI San Carlos H. at Santa Anita, the regally bred five-year-old ran second to Congaree in the GI Carter H. Apr. 12 before rattling off consecutive wins in the GII Churchill Downs H. May 3 and the GI Met Mile May 26. The latter victory convinced trainer Bobby Frankel to try him over nine furlongs in the \$750,000 GI Stephen Foster H. at Churchill June 14. The bay ran an honest but distant third to Perfect Drift and Mineshaft that day, and it was back to sprinting for him. Typically unhurried early as Voodoo (Petionville) showed the way up front, Aldebaran advanced stealthily along the inside, split horses at the head of the lane and won going away. "I rode him like he was the best horse," jockey Jerry Bailey said. "You just have to let him find himself for the first half mile. Then he starts to roll...he's a strong finisher." Added Frankel, "I brought him back a little quick for this, but he will probably get two months off now. I'll look to bring him back in the Forego [Grade I, seven furlongs at Saratoga Aug. 31]." Candy Ride was a perfect three-for-three in his native Argentina and has done nothing to spoil his record since shipping to the U.S. The bay broke his maiden by 12 lengths in his career opener on the dirt last August, then switched to the turf and added an eight-length victory in the G1 Gran Premio San Isidro in October. He closed his South American stand with an eight-length score in the grassy G1 Gran Premio J S de Anchorena Dec. 14. Imported over the winter, the colt made his stateside debut in an optional claimer on the main track at Hollywood Park June 7 and proved much the best, winning by three lengths as the 7-5 chalk. Even-money to remain undefeated while taking on American graded-stakes foes and returning to the turf, Candy Ride pressed second choice Special Ring through a moderate opening half, kept pace with the frontrunner as the tempo quickened though a second half in :46.34 and fought past his gallant rival after belatedly switching leads to take a narrow decision. "The leader went slow early, but so did I," winning jockey Gary Stevens said. "I was spotting Special Ring three-quarters of a length, and this horse has a hell of a turn of foot. This horse is very, very special. Right now, I would rate him on par with Gentlemen (Arg). He is just a particularly gifted horse." Trainer Ron McAnally will point the winner to the GI Pacific Classic at Del Mar Aug. 24. Fellow Argentine Gentlemen won the race in 1997. Wacky Patty began her career with a 2 1/2-length victory in an Apr. 30 maiden event and quickly added a two-length score in the May 11 Nursery S. She suffered her first defeat when a troubled fourth behind Yogi's Polar Bear in the June 8 Cinderella S. last time out. Favored in the field of six juvenile fillies, Wacky Patty battled Cherish Destiny through fractions of :22.07, :44.67 and :57.24. She opened a slim lead in upper stretch and inched clear to the wire. "I feel bad in a way, because if she had broken the way she did today in the Cinderella, she would be undefeated," jockey Jose Valdivia Jr. said. "We had a perfect break on the outside today. Taking nothing away from the second-place finisher, but my filly was just playing around out there. I think the longer she goes, the better she'll be. I can't wait until she goes two turns." Added trainer James Chapman, "She may not be a Grade I filly when it's all said and done, but she wants to run longer than her pedigree says, with the way she trains and the way she finishes out after races. But she's got natural speed." Second choice Platinum Princess bobbled when the gates opened. She moved up to stalk the pace, but couldn't match strides with the top two late and had to settle for third. "I don't know what happened at the start," jockey David Flores said. Be Gentle kicked off her career with an impressive 8 1/2-length victory at Churchill Downs May 11. Given a little break after that big effort, the dark bay came back here as the crowd's second choice. The Virginia-bred broke on top and dueled for the early lead, then opened a little daylight in the stretch and held sway to the wire to run her record to two-for-two. In the process, she gave trainer D. Wayne Lukas a record fifth win in the Debutante. Gators N Bears had followed his second-place finish at Pimlico with a front-running allowance victory vs. fellow state-breds at Monmouth June 14. Sent to the lead again yesterday, the bay battled Only the Best (Smokester) through a rapid opening quarter in :21.80. He opened up three lengths after smoking the half in :44.35 and had 4 1/2 lengths on the field as they raced into the final furlong. Mt. Carson closed steadily, but had to settle for the runner-up spot. "The only horse I was afraid of was Mt. Carson," owner/trainer Leo Nechamkin II, celebrating his first graded-stakes score, said. "But he has tender feet and needed a softer racetrack. If it had rained, he might have caught us like he did in the Hirsch Jacobs." He added, "This horse has always shown a great amount of ability and I knew he was going to love this racetrack. He was bred to run here." 

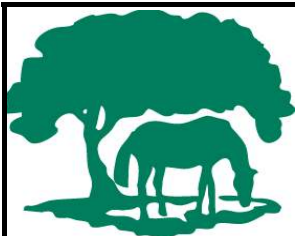

A Graded Race is defined as a non-restricted race with added money or guaranteed purse value of \$50,000 or more which has been run at least twice under similar conditions and on the same surface and has been assigned graded stakes status for the year contested by the American Graded Stakes Committee of the Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association (TOBA) for the United States, or The Jockey Club of Canada for Canada.
