

### FALBRAV ECLIPSES FAVORITE

Falbrav (Ire) (Fairy King) was sent off at 8-1 to reverse Ascot form with the 6-4 favorite **Nayef** (Gulch), but belied those odds to beat that rival by 3/4 of a length in a thrilling renewal of the G1 Coral-Eclipse at Sandown yesterday. Supplied with the furious pace he requires from the market leader's rabbit **Izdiham** (Ire) (Nashwan), he reeled in the frontrunner approaching the quarter-mile marker. Falbrav quickened clear under Darryll Holland before holding the determined rally of Nayef on the uphill climb to the line. "I had a lovely position early--it was a rough race, but it went perfect for me," Holland explained. "It went like clockwork." ### An International Star...

Falbrav began his career in Italy under the care of Luciano d'Auria and capped a memorable 2002 season, which included successes in the G1 Premio Presidente della Repubblica and G1 Gran Premio di Milano, by taking the G1 Japan Cup in November. Transferred to Luca Cumani after that effort, he returned to finish third in the G1 Prix Ganay at Longchamp on unsuitably soft ground Apr. 27 before winning the G1 Prix d'Ispahan May 18. He suffered a troubled trip when fifth behind Nayef in the G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot, dashing connections' hopes of taking the inaugural BHB Summer Triple Crown. "He's a phenomenal horse and has never let me down, even at Ascot where he got bumped and never found his rhythm," Cumani said. "Today he showed what he is capable of--he had a beautiful position from the start, got his rhythm going and probably came a bit too soon, but showed tremendous courage to battle all the way up the hill. We really wanted to win the Prince of Wales's and go for the Grand Slam, as he's the sort of horse that could do it. However, now we have to think about whether we go for the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. [at Ascot July 26] or not, as it's easy to put him away for the G1 Juddmonte International [at York Aug. 19]." Marcus Tregoning suggested that Nayef may also miss the King George, while 100-1 outsider **Kaieteur** (Marlin), an upset third yesterday, will take in the Aug. 16 GI Arlington Million. **Coral-Eclipse chart, p2**

### SUBURBAN'S ALL MINE

It doesn't come much easier than this. Odds-on **Mineshaft** (A.P. Indy) stalked pacesetting longshot **Judge's Case** (Montbrook) to the three-eighths pole, took command and repulsed a bid from Breeders' Cup Classic hero **Volponi** (Cryptoclearance) at the top of the lane to win the GI Suburban H. yesterday at Belmont Park. **Bred In The Purple**

**Mineshaft** (A.P. Indy) was bred to be a good race-horse. His full sister Tomisue's Delight was a dual Grade I winner, including the 1997 GI Ruffian H. at Belmont Park. Despite a pedigree well suited to U.S racing, the handsome dark bay kicked off his career overseas, but was just a maiden winner in seven starts for trainer John Gosden. Returned to his country of breeding late last year, the homebred rattled off three consecutive victories and was second to Balto Star in the GIII Whirlaway H. in New Orleans Feb. 9, but stamped himself one to watch with a 3 1/2-length score in the GII New Orleans H. the following month. A comprehensive nine-length winner of the GIII Ben Ali S. at Keeneland Apr. 26, he registered his first Grade I success by 3 3/4 lengths in the May 16 Pimlico Special, but was most recently caught late by Perfect Drift in the GI Stephen Foster H., finishing second by a head.

**Cruising To Victory**

Mineshaft showed good early speed, but was taken back to run in second as **Volponi** (Cryptoclearance) and jockey Jose Santos monitored the favorite's every move from third. Allowed to cruise to the front with fully three furlongs to run, Mineshaft was tackled by the reigning Breeders' Cup Classic winner at the quarter pole, but spurted clear beneath a motionless Robby Albarado leaving the eighth pole and was ridden out to the wire. "He was going so easy the first three-quarters, it felt like he was getting into a trot. That's how easy he was going," the winning jockey added. "I was going to wait for Volponi or whoever the first challenger was and shake them off and that is just what happened." Victorious trainer Neil Howard confirmed that the winner would be nominated to the GI Whitney H. Aug. 2, but is "50/50" to run. "We're thinking about giving him a little freshening," Howard said. "We want to be careful with what we do relative to the fall."

Last September, Balto Star led the GI Man o' War S. to deep stretch before being overtaken by With Anticipation (Relaunch). Yesterday, facing another 11-furlong Grade I test on the turf, he forgot to stop. The dark bay handed Mineshaft one his two defeats in the GIII Whirlaway H. at Fair Grounds Feb. 9, but was ninth to that rival in the GII New Orleans H. Mar. 2. Second in the GIII Excelsior Breeders' Cup H. at Aqueduct Apr. 5, the gelding was ninth to Mineshaft in the Pimlico Special and was most recently second in this track's off-the-turf Oceanport H. June 14. The longest shot in the field of seven, Balto Star was allowed to set easy fractions of :48 3/5 for the half and 1:14 for six furlongs while hounded by The Tin Man. Asked for his best turning for home, the homebred dug in gamely and held the California shipper at bay for his first Grade I score. "The boss [trainer Todd Pletcher] said to put him on the lead and see how far he can go," commented assistant trainer Anthony Sciametta. "That's what [jockey] Jose [Velez Jr.] did." Joey Franco's career came full circle, as the attractive Cal-bred colt overcame the 10 hole and a jockey's objection to secure his first Grade I victory. Fifth in a \$100,000 optional claimer at Santa Anita Mar. 1 in his final outing for trainer David Hofmans, the dark bay came up the rail to complete the exacta behind Bluesthestandard (American Standard) in the Mar. 29 GII Potrero Grande Breeders' Cup H. in Arcadia. The one-length winner of the Tiznow S. for state-breds Apr. 26, the homebred made it two in a row with a one-length score over Kela (Numerous) and Publication in this oval's Ack Ack H. May 31. A stalking third for the opening half mile, Joey Franco rallied three wide into the stretch and held off a furious late rally from Publication for the win. A claim of foul by the rider of the runner-up, Kent Desormeaux, against the winner for interference in deep stretch was disallowed. **American Oaks cont.**

Placed in two starts at two, Dimitrova opened her three-year-old season with a Leopardstown maiden score Mar. 29 and came right back to take the Listed Leopardstown 1000 Guineas Trial Apr. 13. Let go at 16-1 in the Irish 1000 Guineas at The Curragh May 25, the bay led from the quarter-mile marker to 100 yards out and ran on in determined fashion to finish third, beaten just 3/4 of a length by Yesterday (Ire). The Kentucky-bred made her U.S. bow with Lasix added. She stalked the pace while racing just off the fence, drove between horses as they headed into the far turn and rallied outside to take the lead at midstretch before opening it up late. "What a filly!" winning jockey David Flores said. "The moment I saw her, I could tell. There was something special there when I saw her in the paddock." As for the running of the race, Flores said, "I was expecting to be closer, but she was very comfortable where she was. I was never nervous. I was just waiting patiently. She gave me a tremendous run in the last eighth of a mile." Added trainer Dermot Weld, who also handled the winner's dam and granddam, "She's a very solid, very sound, mentally tough filly. I just thought she was the right filly for the race, and I picked the right rider in Flores. I thought he gave her a perfect race." As for the future, Weld said, "Maybe we'll try her in the Yellow Ribbon or the Matriarch [in the fall], races like that, but today was the day for her." Santa Catarina (Unbridled), the 5-2 favorite in her turf debut, pressed the pace and weakened late to be fourth. "She ran well, but a mile and a quarter may be stretching it for her," jockey Gary Stevens said. "She wasn't aggressive with me, but I think she likes a few more targets to run at. She handled the grass fine. I just think that, on turf, a mile and a sixteenth, mile and an eighth would be perfect for her." The bay was coming off a four-length score in the June 14 GII Hollywood Breeders' Cup Oaks at a mile and a sixteenth and had never been beyond nine furlongs.

Tap The Admiral took a Belmont allowance test Sept. 20 and crossed the line first in the John Henry H. at Arlington Park Oct. 25, only to be disqualified to second, then went to the shelf for 6 1/2 months. He made it three in a row on his return, taking an allowance at Belmont May 11, but faltered in the final furlong of the June 15 GII King Edward Breeders' Cup H. at Woodbine and finished fourth. Shortening up off that nine-furlong test, the chestnut broke sharply, but was reined in to sit near the back of the pack for six furlongs. He swept six wide around the far turn and rallied stoutly to catch Package Store as they reached the sixteenth pole, then had enough left to turn back the late bid of Freefourinternet. "He's a real confident little horse and every once in a while he has the ability to back it up," trainer Del Carroll II said. The winner gave jockey John McKee his first Churchill stakes score and his first graded victory. Ballingarry's second trip to the Windy City proved much more successful than his first, as he found a seam in upper stretch and outfinished GII Dixie S. winner Dr. Brendler to win the Stars and Stripes Breeders' Cup. Third in the G1 Irish Derby and G1 Irish St Leger last season, Ballingarry bested older rivals to win the G1 Canadian International over this trip Sept. 29, travelled back to Europe and returned to Chicago to finish seventh in the G1 Breeders' Cup Turf. Rested off that effort, the bay was seventh over an insufficient nine panels in the Apr. 6 GII Arcadia H. at Santa Anita and was most recently third to pro-tem divisional leader Storming Home (GB) in the Jim Murray H. at Hollywood Park May 10. Turf saving throughout beneath leading rider Rene Douglas, the Irish-bred colt picked it up approaching the far turn, waited for room at the quarter pole, got through in the two path and finished well for the win. "Our plan was to go [to the front] off the break and go on from there and let him be himself," the winning rider commented. "It didn't work that way because he didn't break that sharp. I had to go to plan B and stay on the rail. I just waited for the opportunity to get through and he exploded."

I was able to save ground all the way...and when I asked for run, he took off."

He added a 9 1/4-length score in a nine-furlong off-the-turfer last time out June 18. **Strong Hope**, a \$1.7-million FTSAUG yearling, graduated over a sloppy Aqueduct track in April before nosing out a win in a May 14 one-mile Belmont allowance. He makes his stakes debut off a June 7 allowance victory. **Best Minister** stormed to a 12-length maiden win at Keeneland in April and added a three-length score at this distance in the May 17 Sir Barton S. last time out. The colt was considered for the Belmont S., but was not entered after developing a cough just days before the race.
