STRONG SHOWING IN DWYER

Strong Hope (Grand Slam) made his stakes debut a winning one, leading gate to wire to take the GII Dwyer S. by a neck over **Nacheezmo** (Carson City) at Belmont

Park yesterday. The bay started his career with a fourth-place finish behind Grand Hombre at Gulfstream Park in March, but has been unbeatable since. He broke his maiden in front-running fashion at Aqueduct Apr. 12, added a Belmont allowance score May 14 and was once again on the lead throughout as

he made it three in a row June 7. Stretching out to nine furlongs for the first time in the Dwyer, the \$1.7 million FTSAUG yearling was tracked by **Albaaz** (Swain {Ire}) and previously undefeated **Sky Mesa** (Pulpit) as he dashed through fractions of :45.73 and 1:09.60. He opened up a little daylight at midstretch and was all out to hold off the runner-up. **Dwyer cont. p2**

DAI-JA VU

Andreas Schutz saddled the first three home in the G1 Deutsches Derby last year and it was nearly a case of deja vu all over again at Hamburg yesterday. Schutz sent out five of the 19 runners in the German Classic this year and it was Gestut Schlenderhan's **Dai Jin** (GB) (Peintre Celebre) who got the job done, with three of his entrymates filling the third, fourth and fifth spots. It was the trainer's fourth victory in this event since 1998. Dai Jin arrived from the rear with a power-packed run in the straight under Olivier Peslier. Racing widest of all, he grabbed the lead before edging clear. Dai Jin is the 10th Deutsches Derby winner to be sold at Baden Baden and the 17th to be bred by Gestut Schlenderhan, but the first since Stuyvesant (Ger) in 1976. "I had to nurse him along a bit, but he produced a beautiful turn of foot when I asked him," Peslier, who partnered Borgia (Ger) to victory in this in 1997, said. Unbiased Effort...

The Belmont main track wasn't favoring speed yesterday, but **Strong Hope** didn't need a track bias to get him home. "The track wasn't kind towards speed necessarily," trainer Todd Pletcher said. "It wasn't biased, but it wasn't one of those speed-carrying tracks. On the middle of the turn, you could see Nacheezmo revving up...I knew Strong Hope would have to produce a pretty strong effort to hold him off and he was able to pull it off." As for the future, Pletcher said, "The next step is two turns...we'll probably go to the Jim Dandy [GII, Aug. 3 at Saratoga] or the Haskell [GI, Aug. 3 at Monmouth Park] next and see where he fits. With Funny Cide and Peace Rules most likely going to the Haskell, right now, as far as you can project those things, the Jim Dandy would probably have a slower pace scenario." Strong Hope is inbred to 4x3 to blue hen mare Sex Appeal, dam of champions Try My Best and El Gran Senor and the broodmare sire of Grand Slam. First Loss for Sky Mesa...

Sky Mesa, three-for-three at two, was making his first start since taking the GII Lane's End Breeders' Futurity last October. The crowd's 3-2 choice, he pressed the pace and finished evenly to be third. "I was pleased," trainer John Ward Jr. said. "That nine [furlongs] was a little more than he wanted to do, but he sucked it up and finished. For his first race back, I was totally happy." Added jockey Edgar Prado, "He came back super and is ready for some big times later this year." The colt will go next in either the Jim Dandy or the Aug. 23 GI Travers S.

Colita Scratched...

Colita (Grindstone), a Belmont allowance winner in his most recent start May 21, had to be scratched from the Dwyer after his left stifle locked up the morning of the race. "He was feeling so good and jumping in his stall," trainer Carlos Morales said. "That must have been how it happened. The vets told me that most of the time, everything turns out OK. The ligament should pop back into place on its own."

It took second-crop sire Grand Slam just 13 minutes to come up with a pair of graded-stakes winners. Three-year-old Strong Hope won the GII Dwyer S. at Belmont just before juvenile Limehouse maintained his unbeaten record here. After coming from off the pace to capture his debut at Keeneland Apr. 16, the Dogwood colorbearer employed similar tactics to win the Three Chimneys S. on the Kentucky Derby undercard. However, those efforts weren't enough to make him the favorite this time. That honor instead went to Cuvee, impressive victor of the GIII Kentucky Breeders' Cup S. May 26. Limehouse was bumped at the start and was in tight through the opening quarter, but avoided serious trouble approaching the turn, where Cuvee was forced to take up sharply. Jockey Robby Albarado angled Limehouse to the outside and the chestnut colt took charge, collaring longshot First Money in the final sixteenth before going on to win by daylight. Albarado, who piloted Mineshaft to win Saturday's GI Suburban H., said, "It's been a great weekend. This is a nice colt, I'll tell you. With his running style, I think he's going to get better and nothing fazes him." Dogwood Stable President Cot Campbell added, "We'll run him next in the Saratoga Special [GII, Aug. 13]. That was impressive today. He's done everything right...he has a nice pedigree and the ingredients to be a nice horse." Cuvee finished gamely on the outside to save third. "He bounced off the fence...damn the luck," his trainer, Steve Asmussen, said. "The main thing is just that he comes back all right and we'll go from there." [Click for the brisnet.com chart.](#)

Swedish Shave, fifth in this event a year ago, began the season by rattling off three consecutive successes at Maisons-Laffitte, including the Listed Prix Cor de Chasse Apr. 1 and Listed Prix Servanne Apr. 23. He disappointed when seventh behind Porlezza (Fr) (Sicyos) in the five-furlong G2 Prix du Gros-Chene at Chantilly last time June 1, but bounced back to win here. Taken to the front in the early stages by regular pilot Thierry Jarnet, he claimed the stands' rail and held on in a desperate finish as Vasywait ate into his advantage. "Last time at Chantilly he didn't run his race because the weather was hot and he just hates it," conditioner Richard Gibson explained. "It is also worth mentioning that he has never won over five furlongs and we know now that six is his best trip. We have to try the G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest here [Aug. 10]. DYNASTY TAKES DURBAN JULY Three-year-old **Dynasty (SAf)** (Fort Wood) outfinished fellow sophomore **Yard-Arm (SAf)** (Western Winter) to win the G1 Durban July S. at Greyville in South Africa Saturday, according to the *Thoroughbred Times*. The time for the 2200-meter test was 2:15.20. Dynasty had won three straight Group 1 events coming into the race, annexing the Feb. 15 Cape Derby, May 3 South African Guineas and June 8 Daily News 2000, but was taking on his elders for the first time. Rank early, he was wide throughout, but closed like a rocket to win handily as the crowd's choice.

CHOISIR TRIES JULY COURSE **Choisir (Aus)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) enjoyed a breeze over three furlongs of the July course yesterday morning as he prepares for Thursday's G1 Darley July Cup. The G2 King's Stand S. and G1 Golden Jubilee S. winner was overseen by trainer Paul Perry, who told *PA Sport*, "He had a look at the course and everything and he worked up nice. He looks great to me, very fit. The track's in good order, it looked great."

FRANKEL PAIR WORK IN COMPANY **GISW Medaglia d'Oro (El Prado {Ire})** and **GII Shuvee H. winner Wild Spirit (Chi)** (Hussonet) breezed in company at Belmont Park yesterday morning, going five furlongs in :58 3/5. It was the fastest of 25 moves at the distance. Medaglia d'Oro has been out twice this year, taking the Feb. 1 GII Strub S. and the Apr. 5 GII Oaklawn H. Sidelined by a foot injury since the Oaklawn, he is expected to go next in the GI Whitney H. at Saratoga Aug. 2. "He's coming along," trainer Bobby Frankel said. A three-time Group 1 winner in her native country, Wild Spirit broke off behind last year's GI Travers S. hero, but finished on even terms with the colt. She is being pointed for the GII Delaware H. July 20.

THE INDUSTRY AT WORK: NEW TAX INCENTIVES FOR BUYERS

Buyers can now write off up to \$100,000 of the cost of horses. The expensing allowance applies to purchases from January 1, 2003 through December 31, 2005. "Bonus" first-year depreciation increases to 50% and is in addition to the \$100,000 expensing allowance and regular depreciation. With bonus and regular depreciation, about 56% of the price of a yearling can be written off in the year of purchase.

Ridden by Jose Santos in this one, last year's GII Pegasus H. winner rated along the inside, responded when roused, dug in gamely while between rivals and prevailed after a long drive.
