HOLIDAY IN HOLLYWOOD

Harlan's Holiday (Harlan), set to make his West Coast debut in Sunday's GI Hollywood Gold Cup, arrived at Hollywood Park Thursday. The four-year-old, freshened after running second in the Mar. 29 G1 Dubai World Cup, comes off a fifth-place finish in the June 14 GII Brooklyn H. He was scratched from last Saturday's 10-furlong GI Suburban H., which starts on Belmont Park's clubhouse turn, to go after the Gold Cup instead. "[Trainer Todd

Pletcher] feels that he is a true two-turn horse, and he is training well," said assistant Michael McCarthy, who accompanied the colt on the trip from New York. "He turned in a real nice breeze the morning after he was scratched." The Ohio-bred Harlan's Holiday prepped for his Hollywood foray Sunday at Belmont, going five furlongs in 1:01.26. Two other Gold Cup hopefuls worked Thursday, with GII Californian S. winner **Kudos** (Kris S.) going a half in :47 1/5 at Santa Anita and Californian runner-up **Piensa Sonando (Chi)** (Gallantsky) breezing an easy five-eighths in 1:04 4/5 at Hollywood. Trainer Richard Mandella, who took the Gold Cup with Siphon (Brz) in 1996 and with Gentlemen (Arg) in 1997, saddles the late-running Kudos this year. "There is some pretty classy speed in front of us, but he does like a mile and a quarter," Mandella said.

LOOKING GOOD AT THE CURRAGH

G1 Epsom Oaks heroine **Casual Look** (Red Ransom) was yesterday reported to be doing well ahead of tomorrow's G1 Darley Irish Oaks at The Curragh. Trainer Andrew Balding said he was happy with the filly, who bids to become the fourth English Oaks winner to follow up in the Irish equivalent since 1987. To do so, she must confirm her neck beating of the Aidan O'Brien-trained **Yesterday (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) in the Epsom Classic. "Obviously it's going to be another tough task, but we're confident she's in good form," Balding told *PA Sport* Friday. "Yesterday could well have been unlucky--we will find out on Sunday just how unlucky she may have been. Of course there's Hanami and some other very good fillies, too." Trainer James Toller has booked Kieren Fallon to ride G2 Pretty Polly S. winner **Hanami (GB)** (Hernando {Fr}) in the Classic. He is hoping that she can bury the memory of her disappointing sixth at Epsom. **Field, p4**

COOL CHOICE

Australian sprint sensation **Choisir (Aus)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}--Great Selection {Aus}, by Lunchtime {GB}), a valiant second in Thursday's G1 Darley July Cup, has been purchased for a reported £10 million by Coolmore Stud and will go into quarantine in Ireland before shuttling to Coolmore Australia for the upcoming stud season, subject to a veterinary inspection. The champion Australian two-year-old colt in 2001-2002 and a winner of the G1 VRC Lightning S. in his homeland, Choisir arrived in Britain three weeks before Royal Ascot, where he blitzed 19 rivals in the five-furlong G2 King's Stand S. with an awesome front-running display, despite carrying a penalty for his Group 1 score. Wheeled back on just four days' rest, he overcame a wide draw to break the track record in the six-furlong G1 Golden Jubilee S. emulating his grandsire Danehill, who had broken the track record in the same race in 1989. Choisir became only the third horse in history to land the Royal Ascot sprint double and the first since Diadem in 1920. Coolmore's Christy Grassick said, "A really strongly made colt from the sire-producing Danehill line, I think he'll prove very popular with commercial breeders both here in Ireland and in Australia. We're delighted to have got him." Choisir's Southern Hemisphere stud fee has been set at A\$32,500.

That career-best effort confirmed that there was more to come from the lightly raced mare, who was fifth in the Listed Sceptre S. at Doncaster in September on her only previous try at stakes level. Held up in last place by a confident Jamie Spencer throughout the early stages off a fiercely contested lead, she quickened impressively to cut down her rivals at the eighth pole before asserting from the inseparable Khulood and Golden Nun. Defending champ **Gold Mover** ended 2002 with a 7 3/4-length score in the Safely Kept H. on the Breeders' Cup undercard at Arlington Park. She opened this season with a runner-up finish behind **Harmony Lodge** in the Feb. 14 GIII Shirley Jones H. at Gulfstream Park, then turned the tables on that rival, beating her by 3 1/2 lengths in the Mar. 16 Hurricane Bertie S. Second to Sightseek in the May 3 GI Humana Distaff H., the five-year-old mare was a non-threatening third in the June 8 GII Vagrancy H. last time out. **Harmony Lodge** followed her Hurricane Bertie effort with a third in the May 11 Genuine Risk H., then trounced the field in the June 22 Sweet Briar Too S. at Woodbine, winning by 5 1/2 lengths. **Shawklit Mint** capped a four-race winning streak with a front-running score in the Vagrancy, while **For Rubies**, three-for-four on the year, followed a 5 1/2-length allowance victory in the slop at Churchill May 15 with a three-length success in the June 14 GIII Chicago Breeders' Cup H. at Arlington.

A pair of Scott Lake-trained former claimers headline the 21st running of this event. **Shake You Down**, haltered for \$65,000 at Aqueduct Mar. 12, has reeled off four consecutive victories since, including scores in GIII Bold Ruler H. and GII True North H. at Belmont. The speedy Montbrook gelding is likely to be sent off as the lukewarm favorite in this wide-open affair. Lake's other runner, **My Cousin Matt**, is coming off a game second-place finish in the J.B. Moseley H. at Suffolk June 21. The son of Matty G, claimed for \$85,000 at Belmont last fall, captured the GII General George H. at Laurel in February. **Echo Eddie**, last year's runner-up in this event, appears to be back on track after a June 4 turf score at Hollywood versus allowance company. Look for him to be sitting in a perfect spot right off the leaders in this speed-packed race.

After taking an optional claimer Apr. 25, the chestnut moved into stakes company and captured the May 12 Supah Jess S. and the June 13 Race Artist S. He toted 122 pounds to a head victory in his latest, the June 16 Heckofa Ralph S. **Coach Jimi Lee** earned triple-digit Beyers with his win in the Apr. 5 Lost Code Breeders' Cup S. at Hawthorne and a solid third behind Posse in the May 10 Matt Winn S. at Churchill Downs. He comes off a victory in the June 15 Shecky Greene S. at Arlington Park.

A 3/4-brother to turf champion Ryafan, **Epicentre** will represent the team of Juddmonte and trainer Bobby Frankel in his stakes debut. The four-year-old captured his U.S. bow Apr. 13 at Keeneland and followed with a solid second May 21 to Lunar Sovereign, who was third in last Saturday's GI United Nations H. **Quest Star** won three of his first four starts this year, including the GI Pan American H., in wire-to-wire fashion, but got tired en route to a fifth-place effort in the GIII Louisville H. May 31 last time. "We've decided to give him that time between races," trainer Elliott Walden said. "He's pretty versatile in terms of distances and courses." Dubai-based **State Shinto** had been running on the sand at Nad al Sheba for the last two years, finishing fifth in the G1 Dubai World Cup Mar. 29, but went back to the grass June 25 at Belmont and looked sharp winning a 10-furlong allowance. 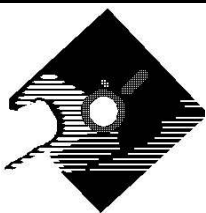
