## HERE COMES THE SUN

Sir Michael Stoute knows what it takes to win the G1 Darley Irish Oaks, and **Spanish Sun** (El Prado {Ire}) is primed to add to his impressive tally at The Curragh this afternoon. Stoute has won this Classic no less than six times since 1978. Spanish Sun, a Kempton maiden winner in September, was put on the shelf after that effort and missed the Epsom Oaks due to a setback. She made a successful return in the G2 Ribblesdale S. at Royal Ascot June 19, where she appeared to win despite the firm ground on that occasion, holding **Ocean Silk** (Dynaformer) by a hard-fought head. Although Ribblesdale scorers have a mixed record in this, with only three fillies following up here since 1980, she has the scope to surpass those that contested the Classics earlier this term. **Casual Look** (Red Ransom), **Yesterday (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) and **Hanami (GB)** (Hernando {Fr}) renew rivalry for the third time this season and there is very little between them. Hanami was ahead of that pair when fifth in the G1 Sagitta 1000 Guineas, but trailed them in sixth in the Epsom Oaks June 6 before taking the G2 Pretty Polly S. at this course two weeks ago. Trainer James Toller told *PA Sport*, "I think it was a bit unfortunate at Epsom that we got stuck on the outside from our draw, and she didn't really seem to handle the hill. If you are struggling down the hill, it blunts your run...I think she used a lot of energy to maintain her position. I hope she's better than she looked at Epsom." *Irish Oaks cont. p2*

## SHAKE YOU DOWN SCALES SUMMIT

The streaking **Shake You Down** (Montbrook) captured the \$500,000 GIII Smile Sprint H., the final event at Calder Race Course's fourth annual Summit of Speed. Favored **Gold Mover** (Gold Fever) successfully defended her title in the \$500,000 GII Princess Rooney H., holding off another Montbrook, 64-1 **Vision in Flight**, to win by a nose. Among the three-year-olds, the underlay **Ebony Breeze** (Belong to Me) won the \$300,000 Azalea Breeders' Cup S. for fillies, while **Valid Video** (Valid Wager) scored a mild upset in the GIII Carry Back S. for males. Calder offered a Pick Five wager Saturday, which returned \$11,260.40 for a \$1 investment.

## CONGAREE GETS TOP BILLING IN HOLLYWOOD

**Congaree** (Arazi) will be the likely favorite in the \$750,000 GI Hollywood Gold Cup this evening, his first start since disappointing as the 4-5 favorite in the GI Met Mile May 26. The Stonerside colorbearer has come up just short in his two previous tries at the 10-furlong distance, finishing third in the 2001 Kentucky Derby and, more recently, missing by a head in the GI Santa Anita H. Mar. 1. But the chestnut will be making his first start at level weights this year, having given away weight through victories in the GI Carter H., the GII San Antonio H. and the GII San Pasqual H. However, it won't be a cakewalk for Congaree. New York shipper **Harlan's Holiday** (Harlan), a multiple Grade I winner, will be hoping to erase memories of a fifth (and last)-place finish in the GII Brooklyn H. June 14. The locally based **Kudos** (Kris S.) and **Piensa Sonando (Chi)** (Gallantsky) ran one-two in the GII Californian H. June 14 over this surface, and the speedy **Western Pride** (Way West {Fr}) could be dangerous if left alone on the front end. Trainer Richard Mandella will be hoping a hot pace develops up front for the stretch-running Kudos. "There is some pretty classy speed in front of us, but he does like a mile and a quarter," Mandella commented.

**Double Take?**

**Casual Look**, who battled to a neck success over **Yesterday** at Epsom, will try to become the eighth filly to complete the Epsom-Curragh Oaks double since 1971, and the 10th overall. **Yesterday**, who had previously beaten **Six Perfections** (Fr) in the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas at this track May 25, has the vital home advantage to her favour this time as she bids to provide Aidan O'Brien with his first-ever success in this Classic. But she has to avoid following in the hoofsteps of full sister, **Quarter Moon**, who was second in both the Irish and English Oaks last year.

**Overcoming a Hurdle...**

Paddy Mullins, famed for training Cheltenham Gold Cup winner **Dawn Run**, has not saddled a winner at the highest level on the flat since 1973, but **Vintage Tipple (Ire)** (Entrepreneur {GB}) may have the right credentials. She shaped with promise when finishing runner-up to the smart **Walayef** in the G3 Athasi S. at this track Apr. 27 and will relish this step up in trip, but has not been out for 2 1/2 months. The going at The Curragh is forecast as good for tomorrow's card. "I expect us to have good ground...we will be using a fresh six-yard strip, which hasn't been raced on this year, for the Oaks," Course Manager Paul Hensey told *Racing Post*.

Gold Mover had to call upon all of her class to earn a narrow victory in the Princess Rooney, successfully defending her championship in the process. The chestnut mare, who upset Xtra Heat in last year's renewal, won the Safely Kept H. on the Breeders' Cup undercard last October, but was shelved thereafter and returned from a four-month vacation to finish second behind Harmony Lodge in the GIII Shirley Jones H. at Gulfstream on Valentine's Day. A 3 1/2-length winner of the Mar. 16 Hurricane Bertie S. in South Florida, the homebred was runner-up for a second consecutive year in the GI Humana Distaff H. May 3, but most recently failed to handle an off track when third to Shawklit Mint (Air Forbes Won) in the GII Vagrancy H. at Belmont June 8. Harmony Lodge jumped well and cut out sharp fractions of :21 2/5 and :44 2/5, stalked all the while by Gold Mover. The latter moved up to challenge the front-runner approaching the eighth pole, was joined and passed by Vision In Flight with 70 yards to come, but dug back in gamely for the win. "This filly has been one of my all-time favorites throughout her career," commented winning trainer Mark Hennig. "It was a thrill to come here and have her beat Xtra Heat last year and great to come back and win it again."

Shake You Down extended his winning streak to five as he rolled through the stretch for his third consecutive graded stakes victory. Claimed for \$65,000 out of a Mar. 12 runner-up finish at Aqueduct, the Florida-bred rattled off a pair of impressive allowance wins before stepping up to annex the GIII Bold Ruler H. May 10. He was the hard-fought hero of the GII True North Breeders' Cup H. June 7 and was sent off as the slight choice in this \$500,000 test while breaking from the outside. Jockey Mike Luzzi had him just off Here's Zealous (Dehere) through a :21.24 quarter, but Shake You Down was just a head back after a half in :43.83 before taking charge. The ex-claimer drew off under a hand ride from Luzzi, while fellow Scott Lake stable-mate My Cousin Matt just missed second. "I really hadn't followed him too long before the claim, but when he went in for a tag that day, I thought he'd be worth the money," explained Lake. "Realistically, I was just hoping he'd be a nice allowance horse in New York, and if not, I'd just take him to Maryland. I can't say I had any idea he'd turn out this good." Shake You Down will now try to follow in the hoofprints of last year's Smile winner Orientate, who captured the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint to cap off his championship season. "The goal now will be to get him to the Breeders' Cup, but how we get there is open," added Lake. "There are races for him at Saratoga that I'll consider." The New York track has a pair of graded sprints in August, the six-furlong GII A.G. Vanderbilt H. Aug. 10 and the GI Forego H. over 6 1/2 furlongs. Aug. 31. The winner of the GIII Sapling S. at two, Valid Video kicked off his sophomore campaign with victories in the \$250,000 Sunshine Millions Dash at Gulfstream Jan. 25 and the OBS Champions Day Sprint Mar. 17. Connections experimented with two turns in the Apr. 5 Aventura S., but the gelding could do no better than sixth behind Dynever and was most recently the runner-up at odds-on in the off-the-turf Gilded Time S. at his Monmouth base May 24. Settled in midpack off the early pace, Valid Video launched his bid three wide on the turn, assumed command at the head of the lane and kicked clear to defeat Cajun Beat. It was the second stakes win on the day for jockey Joe Bravo. "I planned this race for him a long time ago," admitted winning trainer Dennis Manning. "When I saw the purse and I realized he wasn't going to go long, I knew I had to try it. He ran 1:10 flat, I guess that's pretty fast at Calder." The winner will be pointed at the GII Amsterdam S. at Saratoga Aug. 2.

Ebony Breeze returned to sprinting with a vengeance, taking command in midstretch en route to an authoritative victory. It took the homebred five tries to break her maiden, which she did by 9 3/4 lengths over this surface Nov. 24, but you couldn't keep her out of the winner's circle after that. She made her next three starts at Tampa, winning the six-furlong Sandpiper S. by 6 3/4 lengths Jan. 11, the Gasparilla S. Feb. 1 and added the GIII Florida Oaks, a 1 1/16-mile affair Mar. 16. The bay then missed by a half-length when third in Churchill's Edgewood S. on the turf May 2, then ran fourth in an allowance won by subsequent GSW Sand Springs over the same course May 21. Local standout Storm Flag had a clear advantage through fractions of :21.59 and :44.81, but Ebony Breeze came after her turning for home. The pair hooked up at the top of the stretch before the Kinsman colorbearer shifted gears and opened up to win by 4 1/4 lengths. "I think my filly was the best filly in the race," said winning rider Cornelio Velasquez. "The last two times she tried the turf, she didn't like it." Sea Dart was fourth behind Delacroix in a Gowran Park maiden on his debut in October before winning a similar event at Leopardstown later in the month. Off the track until returning in a Limerick conditions race July 4, he came back with a fluent score that prompted connections to make the leap to stakes company. "Hopefully Sea Dart is going to go on from this," trainer John Oxx commented. "We liked him when he won his maiden at Leopardstown late last October, but he had hold-ups over the winter and it has taken us time to get him back. He won nicely at Limerick and again here, and the plan is to go for the G3 Desmond S. [at Leopardstown Aug. 17]." An 11-1 outsider facing Grade III company, the dark bay colt led the field past the half-mile pole, but dropped back to third on the far turn as favored Christine's Outlaw and Chilly Rooster swept to the front. He was far from finished, however. Jockey Jose Ferrer asked his mount for the ultimate effort and the three-year-old answered, giving it his all down the stretch to catch the leaders inside the eighth pole. Chilly Rooster gave it up late, but Max Forever had to battle to the finish to beat Christine's Outlaw by a head. "My horse just kept digging and digging all the way to the wire," Ferrer said. "He's still learning and getting better and better with each start." Max Forever had won two of his eight previous starts, including a one-mile allowance at Monmouth May 25. He had not fared well in his two prior stakes attempts, running seventh in the GIII Gotham S. at Aqueduct in March and fourth in the Restoration S. at Monmouth in his last appearance June 15, but looked a picture in the paddock yesterday and ran to his looks. "It looked like he was dropping back a little bit on the turn, but Jose chirped to him and he got right back into it," trainer Ben perkins Jr. said. As for taking a shot in the Haskell, Perkins said, "He's a solid horse, we've liked him all along, but I don't know about the Haskell. There's plenty of time to think about that."
