### VINTAGE YIELD

He had not saddled a Group 1 winner on the flat since 1973, but trainer Paddy Mullins returned with a bang as **Vintage Tipple (Ire)** (Entrepreneur {GB}) reeled in **L'Anresse (GB)** (Darshaan {GB}) to win yesterday's G1 Darley Irish Oaks at The Curragh by 1 1/2 lengths. Sent off at odds of 12-1, she was settled in fifth by Frankie Dettori throughout the early stages as Seamus Heffernan sent the 33-1 chance L'Anresse into a commanding lead. With five lengths to make up in the straight, Vintage Tipple accelerated to wear down the game long-time leader with 75 yards remaining as **Casual Look** (Red Ransom) stayed on to fill the third spot. Emotional scenes in the winner's enclosure afterwards brought back memories of Cheltenham in 1986 when the 84-year-old conditioner's brilliant national hunt mare Dawn Run (Ire) took the Gold Cup. Thirty years after he sent out Hurry Harriet (GB) to win the G1 Champion S. at Newmarket, Mullins saddled the €16,000 Goffs purchase, for whom owner Patrick O'Donovan had turned down an offer of \$3 million at the start of the year, to win him his first Classic. Vintage Tipple had looked a smart prospect at two, when she took a Tralee maiden in August and a conditions race at this track the following month. She chased home Walayef when runner-up on her return in the G3 Athasi S. back here Apr. 27, but was forced to miss the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas due to a hairline fracture of a cannon bone. Allowed time to heal, the filly was forced to endure three weeks' rest but, had been shaping well in her work. "She's a very good filly," Mullins commented. "She just had a hiccup and took a lame step, but came through it all well. The first time we worked her was with bumper horses and she slaughtered them. ### CONGAREE SETS THE GOLD STANDARD

**Congaree** (Arazi) had a string of five straight first or second graded stakes finishes interrupted with an uncharacteristic sixth-place effort in the May 26 GI Metropolitan H., but the consistent chestnut got back to the winner's circle with an impressive three-length score in yesterday's GI Hollywood Gold Cup at Hollywood Park. Sent off the even-money favorite in the field of seven, Congaree settled off the pace as 21-1 outsider **Golden Ticket** (Deposit Ticket) zipped along through early fractions of

:22.90 and :45.71. Congaree pulled to the lead leaving the backstretch, turned back the challenge of **Harlan's Holiday** (Harlan) at the top of the stretch and pulled off to an easy victory. "When we turned into the backside, they slowed it up just a shade and he kind of got aggressive," explained winning rider Jerry Bailey. "So I just decided to go ahead and let him go. **BAFFERT AND BAILEY SHARE GOLDEN DAY**

Congaree (Arazi)'s emphatic win in yesterday's GI Hollywood Gold Cup completed a Hollywood stakes double for trainer Bob Baffert and jockey Jerry Bailey, who also teamed up to take the GII Swaps S. with **During** (Cherokee Run). Of his handicap star, Baffert said, "He's just a fast horse. He can't help himself. He wants to get it on. He's got a wonderful fluid stride and he is just a magnificent-looking horse." Baffert added that the five-year-old, winner already this year of the GI Carter H., GII San Antonio H. and GII San Pasqual H., will now get some time off. "I won't run him for a while," the trainer commented. "He's really not at the top like he was this winter. I think by the fall, the main thing is to have him ready for the Breeders' Cup."

**THE RUNNER-UP Harlan's Holiday** (Harlan) returned from a second-place finish in the G1 Dubai World Cup to run a dull fifth over a sloppy track in the GII Brooklyn H. The bay four-year-old looked to be making a serious challenge to Congaree, but couldn't sustain his bid and finished second. "I thought our horse ran very well, just second best today," said trainer Todd Pletcher. "To his credit, he put in a long sustained run and there were some pretty nice horses that dropped pretty far out of the race and were unable to get by him late."

The lightly raced **During** was let go at 8-1 despite the high-powered team of trainer Bob Baffert and jockey Jerry Bailey. Second behind **Best Minister** in the Sir Barton S. at Pimlico May 17, the dark bay colt was coming off a third-place finish behind **Champali** in the June 14 Northern Dancer S. at Churchill Downs. **During** went right to the early lead, set fractions of :24.09, :48.18 and 1:11.74. He looked like a beaten horse when Belmont runner-up **Ten Most Wanted** and GIII Affirmed winner **Eye of the Tiger** stormed into contention at midstretch, but **During** battled back and determinedly held off **Ten Most Wanted** in the final strides. "There was no speed in the race really," Bailey admitted. "He had an easy first half-mile and I had enough left to kick them off. When **Ten Most Wanted** got by me, I thought he'd probably open up a length, knowing who it was. But he seemed to ease up a little bit. My horse dug back in and that's what it took. I really was surprised that he would be that game to fight back and win like that." Pat Day, on the beaten favorite, commented, "I knew they were walking up front, but I got into a contending position leaving the three-eighths pole. Coming off the turn, I thought it was his to win or lose. The way he was moving, I just expected him to kick on. He did until he got clear of these horses, then he just lost his concentration."

Cee's Elegance ran second behind Starrer in the GII Bayakoa H. last December and began 2003 from the same position, finishing runner-up in the Sunshine Million Distaff in January. The gray mare returned from a three-month freshening to best Cal-breds in the Apr. 26 B Thoughtful S. over track and trip before finishing sixth in the June 7 GIII Desert Stormer H. last time out. Cee's Elegance sat just off the pace of Bear Fan (Pine Bluff) before overtaking that rival in upper stretch and safely held off favorite You under a hand ride. "This is a very professional mare," said winning rider Victor Espinoza. "She didn't run that well last time because three-quarters is too short for her. Today, at seven-eighths, I had more chance to relax her and come around from the outside. Turning for home, I had a lot of horse so I opened it up as much as I could because I knew all the favorites would want to come running at me. So I tried to take advantage when I had it and she did the job." MGISW You stalked the early leaders. She split foes in deep stretch, but couldn't catch the winner. "She probably broke best of anybody, but then couldn't quite keep up down the backside," explained jockey Jerry Bailey. "She came running, but it was too little too late." The 3-2 second choice Affluent toiled near the back of the pack early, rallied three wide into the lane and closed for third. "She ran a big race and closed a lot of ground," said the filly's jockey Gary Stevens. "But they didn't back up like I was hoping. Martillo burst onto the scene with an impressive six-length success in the G2 Mehl-Mulhens-Rennen (German 2000 Guineas) at Cologne May 18 before being supplemented to the G1 St James' Palace S. at Royal Ascot last time June 17. He justified connections' faith by finishing third behind Zafeen (Fr) and Kalaman (Ire) after a troubled trip. Here, he broke well and stalked the early pacesetter Mail the Desert before quickening past at the quarter-mile marker. Kicking clear in a matter of strides for jockey William Mongil, he was in no danger as he coasted to the line in impressive fashion. Bred by Gestut Katharinenhof and raised at Gestut Schlenderhan, the Gestut Hony-Hof-owned colt was a paddock mate of the recent G1 Deutsches Derby winner Dai Jin (GB) before they were sold at the Baden Baden Yearling Sale. Martillo's dam is the Affirmed mare Maltage, a half to the Grade II winner Terra Incognita and the prolific producer Youpickem, from the direct dam line of the G1 Hollywood Oaks winner A Gleam. Sharp Impact opened his career with an Arlington maiden win last fall and added a victory in the Chicago track's Spectacular Bid S. before running seventh in the GIII Arlington-Washington Futurity. Wintering in Dubai, the colt ran eighth in the G3 UAE 2000 Guineas and returned to the U.S. to take a June 8 allowance over a muddy Belmont strip last time out. Sharp Impact, making his turf debut, broke on top, was allowed to set easy fractions and had enough left down the lane to gamely hold off Hidden Truth. "The grass was a question mark, but all of these Siphons seem to move up on turf," explained winning trainer Kiaran McLaughlin. "I was a little worried about the distance, but he was able to set comfortable fractions." Winning rider Richard Migliore added, "He handled the turf real well. The first half of the race set things up nicely. He was going along real comfortably. By the half-mile pole, I knew I could stretch the field out some. He just kept throwing :24 quarters at them.
