“FUR” FLIES AT BELMONT PARK

Two down, one to go. **Spoken Fur** (Notebook) moved one race closer to a \$2 million bonus yesterday, cruising to a decisive 3 1/2-length victory in the second leg of New York's new Triple Tiara, the GI Coaching Club American Oaks at Belmont Park. In the process, the gray gave trainer Bobby Frankel his sixth Grade I win at the Belmont meet. There have been nine Grade I events at the meeting, but Frankel has had runners in only seven of them. The Hall of Fame horseman believes the Triple Tiara bonus is all but in the bag. The final race in the series is the GI Alabama S. at Saratoga Aug. 16. "She won so big in the Mother Goose and she's really come on since the last race. If she runs like she has in the last two races, she should be very tough to beat," he said. CCAO cont. p2

PERFECT SUMMER

Summer Colony (Summer Squall), three-for-three at a mile and a quarter, puts her perfect record at the distance on the line in the GIII Delaware H. today. The five-year-old, who took this event by a neck last year, followed the victory with an impressive 4 1/2-length score in the 10-furlong GI Personal Ensign H. at Saratoga. Freshened after running eighth in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff, she returned to be second by a neck to **Mandy's Gold** (Gilded Time) in the May 16 GIII Pimlico Distaff H. The Edward Evans homebred comes into this race off a three-length score in the June 28 GII Molly Pitcher Breeders' Cup H. at Monmouth Park. Also perfect at the Delaware H. route is the Bobby Frankel-trained **Wild Spirit (Chi)** (Hussonet). The four-year-old filly won a pair of Group 1 races at the distance in her native country. She made her U.S. bow in the May 17 GII Shuvee H. going a mile and cruised to a 3 1/2-length tally. But **Take Charge Lady** (Dehere) has yet to go beyond a mile and an eighth. First or second in 15 of her 17 starts, she was beaten a head by Azeri in her 2003 debut, the Apr. 5 GI Apple Blossom H., and had to settle for the runner-up spot again in her most recent outing, the June 21 GI Ogden Phipps H. at Belmont. Both of her starts this season have been at a mile and a sixteenth. "There is a little bit of concern [about the added distance]," trainer Ken McPeek said. "She has never run that far before, but she is doing extremely well and I think she will perform well." Mandy's Gold, who sandwiched her Pimlico victory between third-place finishes in the Apple Blossom and the Ogden Phipps, also tries a mile and a quarter for the first time.

Getting the Distance...

Spoken Fur has been unbeatable since breaking her maiden by 6 1/4 lengths at Keeneland in April. She returned to take back to back allowance races at Churchill for trainer Austin Smith, then shipped to Belmont for the June 28 GI Mother Goose S. "They sent her to me from Kentucky to train, but I knew she was for sale, too," Frankel said. "I

needed a nice three-year-old filly." Purchased by Frankel's client Amerman Racing Stables LLC, the Florida-bred made her debut under new silks in the Mother Goose and ran her winning streak to four in a row. **Spoken Fur** was trying a mile and a half for the first--and likely only--time in her career yesterday, but the result was nearly identical. Allowed to settle off a solid early pace, she swept past the field on the far turn, opened up eight lengths at midstretch and needed no more than a hand ride to hold **Fircroft** (A.P. Indy) safe to the wire. "I was surprised how fast they were going early," winning jockey Jerry Bailey said. "I figured no one would be anxious for the lead, considering no one really wanted to go a mile and a half. I was very confident down the backstretch with the fast pace. You don't see too many horses accelerate like she did in a mile-and-a-half race. She put the race away at the quarter pole. She's very good." The runner-up, last early, finished well, but was second best. "Overall, this was a good effort," trainer Rusty Arnold said. "We'll take a look at the Alabama."

A Trip Too Far...

Yell (A.P. Indy), the second choice at 3-2, pressed the pace and took the lead after a mile, but weakened late to be fourth. The early leaders, longshots **Shapes and Shadows** (Dynaformer) and **Skipamiss** (Skip Away), tired badly and were both eased in the stretch.

Martaline managed just a single conditions race victory in a six-start sophomore campaign, but started this year the right way by posting his first stakes success in the G3 Prix d'Hedouville at Longchamp Apr. 17. He moved up a class to finish third in the G2 Prix Jean de Chaudenay at Saint-Cloud May 21, went one place better in the G2 Grand Prix de Chantilly June 8 and secured his most important win to date with this dominant stretch display. Leading jockey Christophe Soumillon maintained a stalking position in second aboard the grey, behind British raider **Zindabad (Fr)** (Shirley Heights {GB}), until pushing his mount to the front at the quarter-mile marker. The result was never in doubt from there as Martaline exhibited an abundance of stamina in the closing stages to easily hold the late rally of **Westerner**. Martaline shares his second dam **Bahamian (Ire)** with recent G1 July Cup victor **Oasis Dream (GB)** and 2002 G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches heroine **Zenda (GB)**. Perfect Drift, who handed divisional leader Mineshaft a head defeat in the June 14 GI Stephen Foster H., drew off smartly to post his third win in four starts this year. Third in last year's GI Kentucky Derby, the bay was freshened up following a 10th in the GI Belmont S. and returned to win the GIII Indiana Derby in Oct. 8. However, he ended the year with a 12th in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic and went back on vacation. Trainer Murray Johnson opted to bring the gelding back on the turf and Perfect Drift duly responded with an allowance win at Keeneland Apr. 11, then ran a respectable fourth in the GI Woodford Reserve Turf Classic on Derby Day. But it was back to the dirt for Perfect Drift in the \$750,000 Stephen Foster, and he came up with a big effort in outbattling Mineshaft for a narrow victory, which made him the odds-on choice against these lesser foes. Never far from the front, Perfect Drift moved into contention on the far turn and entered the stretch with a narrow lead and his ears up. Aeneas moved to his hip, but the favorite had all the answers as he opened up on his rivals with a furlong to run. "We were breathing down the leader's throat around the turn in hand," said winning rider Pat Day. "When [Aeneas] mounted a challenge on the outside, I smooched a little. He had his ears pricked and was still well within himself." Perfect Drift's next start will come at Arlington, but under different circumstances. "The Arlington Million [GI, Aug. 16] has been one of our goals," said Johnson. "[Dynaformer] is a versatile sire and affords us the chance to use different races to get him where we want." The start of the race was marred by a bizarre incident, as jockey Javier Castellano was forced to get off the fractious Cherokee Lite (Cherokee Run) in the starting gate, then was unable to get back into the saddle before the latch was sprung. The Nick Zito-trained runner was declared a non-starter. Without the speedy Cherokee Lite to contend with, Island Fashion ended up on the front end. The gray was head-and-head with Wildwood Royal (Royal Academy) for the opening half, but took control after six furlongs and galloped away to an easy score. "I did not expect the race to set up like that at all," winning jockey Iggy Puglisi said. "It was kind of a fumbled break. She made the lead and put away [Wildwood Royal] on the backside. Once she relaxed, it was just a matter of when I would call on her." The winner of the WinStar Sunland Oaks two starts back, Island Fashion was rebounding from a lackluster seventh-place effort in the GI Kentucky Oaks May 2. Awesome Humor, the even-money chalk, had her chances compromised by the break. "My horse was not ready," jockey Robbie Albarado said. "She was cutting up a little bit and squirming a little bit. I was waiting for the other jockey to get on his horse. If I had known [the gates were going to open], I would have straightened her up." [Click for the brisnet.com chart](#).

A bargain yearling at \$4,700, Perfect Moon dashed the hopes of \$400,000 purchase Ruler's Court by pulling away in the lane for his first stakes win. From the first crop of Malibu Moon, himself an impressive Hollywood maiden winner, Perfect Moon had three educational runs over a quarter-mile before finally breaking through against \$40,000 maidens going 4 1/2 furlongs May 14. That effort set him up for a runner-up finish in the Haggin S. June 21, and he went postward as the second choice here. The Maryland-bred settled into a stalking fourth as Blairs Roarin Star led through hot fractions, then moved up to challenge with the favorite to his outside. Ruler's Court came up empty, but Perfect Moon, who drifted in a bit as he passed the pacesetter, pulled clear. "It's so good to have something like this happen," said winning trainer Mel Stute. "I trained his father [Malibu Moon], and that's the only reason I bought him. I believe his father was the best horse in the country when he was a two-year-old. He was just unlucky when he broke his knee."

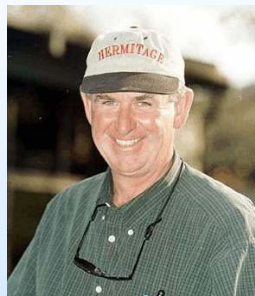

It was a close finish, but the crowd had it right. Stylish, sent off the 2-1 choice, finished fastest of all to win by a neck. There were five horses on the wire, with Something Ventured hanging on for second. Stylish, adding this success to her wins in the 2002 Rockingham Breeders' Cup H. and the June 15 Lady Canterbury Breeders' Cup S. last time out, ran trainer Bill Mott's record at the Monmouth meet to four-for-five. The Monmouth grass course was labeled soft, but the early fractions were anything but. La Tizona (Shuailaan) duled Win's Fair Lady (Dehere) early, but was through after a half in :46.05. That left Win's Fair Lady alone on the lead after six furlongs in 1:10.50, but she too would give it up as the cavalry charged from the back of the pack. Something Ventured took over at midstretch, but Stylish was closing and just got up to take the photo. "The pace was unbelievable, but we were sitting back there comfortably," winning jockey Heberto Castillo Jr. said. "We had a great trip. At the three-eighths pole, I made my move and it worked out." After three poor efforts to start the year, **Continental Red** broke through with a front-running win over course and distance in the Quicken Tree H. for state-breds June 15. The seven-year-old won last year's GII San Luis Rey H., but he will likely have company on the front end from ex-claimer **Asong for Billy**, who defeated **Puerto Banus** and **Nazirali** going 10 furlongs over this course in a June 22 allowance. Though **Cagney** hasn't visited the winner's circle since taking the GIII Carleton F. Burke H. in October of 2001, the dark bay put in a solid late run when third to Storming Home (GB) in the GI Whittingham H. June 14.
