

## FUNNY CIDE WORKS TOWARDS HASKELL

Kentucky Derby hero **Funny Cide** (Distorted Humor) continued to work well in preparation for the Aug. 3 GI Haskell Invitational at Monmouth Park, hitting the track at 5:30 yesterday morning at Belmont Park. The handsome chestnut worked six furlongs in 1:12 and change, according to trainer Barclay Tagg, who was pleased with the move. "That was a pretty good work," said Tagg. "The track was kind of dead today. I had him galloping out seven [furlongs] in 1:25 and change, though I think the clockers caught him in 1:26 and change. I was happy with it. He came out of it fine." Funny Cide annexed two-thirds of the Triple Crown when winning the Derby and the GI Preakness S., but faltered over a muddy Belmont track and could do no better than third in GI Belmont S. Asked if he was looking forward to the Haskell as a chance to avenge the Belmont loss, Tagg quipped, "I'm just trying to win the \$1 million purse." Today's work comes on the heels of Friday's announcement of weights for the Haskell, when Funny Cide was assigned top weight of 123 pounds. Tagg confirmed that the goal for the summer was the \$1 million GI Travers S. at Saratoga Aug. 23. Racing officials at the Spa are dreaming of a rematch between Funny Cide and Belmont S. victor **Empire Maker** (Unbridled), who trainer Bobby Frankel is pointing towards the GII Jim Dandy S., to be held at Saratoga on the same day as the Haskell. Respective victories by Funny Cide and Empire Maker would set up one of the most highly anticipated rematches in recent years. Funny Cide, however, is by no means guaranteed victory in the Haskell. Another Frankel runner, GI Blue Grass S. winner **Peace Rules** (Jules), is expected to start in the race, while two-year-old star **Sky Mesa** (Pulpit), third in the GII Dwyer S. in his lone 2003 start, also looms a threat.

Princely Venture came out of a ninth-place finish in last year's G1 Irish Derby with an injury, but returned to action with a Goodwood conditions win May 21. He secured a career best and first group race win here with a determined final furlong drive. "He deserved to win this race," said jockey Kieren Fallon, adding, "He has progressed this year and he has come on for his Goodwood win." The winner tracked the leaders in third as Private Charter (GB) (Singspiel {Ire}) made the running, then moved into second at the top of the stretch. Ridden along to challenge with three furlongs remaining, the well-related chestnut led approaching the last furlong and responded gamely to strong driving to stave off Sights On Gold. Millennium Bio set a track record en route to a win in the G2 Milers Cup last April before finishing third in the G1 Yasuda Kinen in June. On the sidelines until a fourth-place finish in the Miyako Oji S. in May, the five-year-old wasn't able to improve on last year's Kinen result and finished off the board in 11th in that same event last month. Undeterred, the crowd made Millennium Bio the favorite and he did not disappoint as he closed from off the pace for the emphatic score. "I was worried about the track condition and my horse never had a problem" said winning jockey Yutaka Take.

"When I asked him turning for home, he answered gamely to take the lead." Millennium Bio will now be targeted for a fall campaign which will include the G1 Mile Championship Nov. 23.

One new stallion guaranteed to attract a lot of attention at the upcoming yearling sales has to be War Chant, and the prospects of this Breeders' Cup Mile winner can only be helped by the success currently being enjoyed by several of Danzig's other stallion sons.

Danehill holds second place behind Sadler's Wells on the leading sires' list in Britain and Ireland and ranks third in France, while Green Desert has a potential star to his credit in the English sprinter Oasis Dream. Then there's the French-based Anabaa, who has been in very good form throughout the year, with group winners in the U.S., France, Germany, Ireland, Hong Kong and Australia. And Danzig has also been ably represented in the U.S. by Belong to Me and Langfuhr, both of whom rank among the top 25 sires.

Belong to Me's second Kentucky crop, sired at a fee of \$20,000, is busily confirming that he merited his transfer from New York. Miss Houdini became the first graded winner from this crop when she took the GI Del Mar Debutante last year, and since then Belong to Sea, Ebony Breeze and the English-trained Membership have also become group or graded winners. *Cont. p3*

For his part, Langfuhr has been dominating the Canadian scene with his very able sons Wando and Mobil. These two filled first and second places in the Queen's Plate, respectively, and Wando kept alive his chances of taking the Canadian Triple Crown on Sunday, when he took the Prince of Wales S., with Peef, another son of Langfuhr, in fourth place. In the meantime, Mobil has collected the GIII Toronto Cup H.

Langfuhr's yearlings didn't meet with much favour at last year's sales, achieving a median of only \$15,000, probably because his winners had largely been noted more for their quantity than their quality. However, he is clearly capable of coming up with a very good performer, given the right mare. His first crop contained that very good filly Imperial Gesture, who had the distinction of reaching the first three in two Breeders' Cup events, in addition to gaining Grade I victories in the Beldame S. and Gazelle H.

Now his second crop has also come up with some high-profile representatives, with Wando building a record of seven wins and two seconds from 10 starts, while Mobil boasts a similar record of six wins and two seconds. Appropriately, Wando and Mobil were bred by Gustav Schickedanz, who also bred and owned Langfuhr.

I find it interesting that Langfuhr's three good winners are all very well suited by a reasonable test of stamina. Imperial Gesture and Mobil both thrived at around a mile and an eighth, and Wando is proving very much at home at around a mile and a quarter. Langfuhr, though, made his reputation as a leading sprinter-miler on dirt after failed attempts to turn him into a Canadian Triple Crown horse and then a turf horse.

Langfuhr was strongly fancied to win the Queen's Plate over a mile and a quarter, following his very narrow defeat in the Plate Trial over a furlong less, but he faded into fifth after forcing the pace. It was only when Langfuhr was kept to around seven furlongs that he finally began to fulfil his owner's high hopes. His wins, which included the GI Vosburgh S., GII Forego H. and GI Carter H., were in line with his pedigree, which featured 3x3 inbreeding to Nearctic, an exceptional sprinter-miler who set several track records from five furlongs to a mile.

Langfuhr showed that his stamina stretched to a mile when he won the Metropolitan H. as a five-year-old, but he probably needs a little help from his mares to get good winners at a mile and an eighth or more.

Wando's dam, the Woodman mare Kathie's Colleen, won the GII Monmouth Oaks over a mile and an eighth and was second in the Canadian Oaks. Kathie's Colleen's Grade I-winning half-brother Beau Genius was also highly effective at up to a mile and a quarter, as he showed during an exceptional season as a five-year-old, when he collected nine stakes wins from 14 starts. Wando's next dam, the stakes-placed Royal Colleen, was by Viceregal, a sensational performer who appeared to have the Canadian Classics at his mercy when he took the title of Canadian Horse of the Year as a two-year-old. Unfortunately he suffered a career-ending injury while on the Kentucky Derby trail and was then overshadowed by his brother Vice Regent as a stallion.

As Viceregal was by Northern Dancer, Wando is inbred 3x4 to this great stallion--winner of the 1964 Queen's Plate--and 4x4x5 to Nearctic.

**SPENDTHRIFT ACQUIRES INTEREST IN CUVEE**

A half interest in the speedy graded stakes winning two-year-old colt **Cuvee** (Carson City) has been purchased by Spendthrift Farm and partners from Winchell Thoroughbreds. Bred by the late Verne H. Winchell, Cuvee easily won his debut at Churchill Downs May 20, then romped by 8 1/4 lengths in the GIII Kentucky Breeders' Cup S. five weeks later. The chestnut had a nightmarish trip in his most recent, the GIII Bashford Manor S. at Churchill, and had to settle for third, but hopes to rebound in the Aug. 13 GII Saratoga Special. Cuvee will continued to be trained by Steve Asmussen.

**PLANET HOLLAND FINDS POT OF GOLD IN RAINBOW FUTURITY** Proving his record-setting time trial victory was no fluke, **Planet Holland** (Holland Ease) gave co-owner R.D. Hubbard a long-awaited first win in the \$625,000 GI Rainbow Futurity at Ruidoso Downs Sunday night. "I have tried to win this race for I don't know how long," Hubbard said. "This is a big thrill for myself [and co-owners John T.L. Jones and Butch Holmes]. There's nothing more exciting than winning a Grade I race, whether it's with Quarter Horses or Thoroughbreds. This ranks right up there with any of the big races I've won." Hubbard has owned Quarter Horses since 1961, long before he became involved in Thoroughbred racing. He currently has 15 Quarter Horses and 50 Thoroughbreds in training. Jones, who has just five Quarter Horses, but owns about 150 Thoroughbreds, trained the winner of the Kansas Futurity in 1967. But Holmes is new to the game. "He recently bought a place in Ruidoso and he came to the sale with us last year," Hubbard explained. "We talked him into buying a piece of three or four horses and he has had a lot of luck so far." While Hubbard has won about 10 percent of the 100 races worth more than \$500,000 that he's raced in, Holmes is now batting 1.000, with a perfect one-for-one record. Planet Holland, trainer by American Quarter Horse Association champion Paul Jones, was sent off the 5-2 second choice Sunday. Bumped at the start, he got his head in front of 30-1 Cognac Kid in the final yards and dug in gamely to beat the longshot by a nose, earning \$300,000 for the victory in the process. "He got hit coming out of the gate and that cost him a little bit," Hubbard said. "And [Cognac Kid] ran one hell of a race--our horse really had to run to beat him. He came back awful tired, but he came out of the race well and we're looking forward to the All American Futurity." The \$2 million All American will be run on Labor Day, with time trials set for Aug. 14.

**VESPONE JOINS GODOLPHIN** **Vespone (Ire)** (Llan-daff), winner of this season's G1 Prix Jean Prat at Chantilly June 1 and the G1 Grand Prix de Paris at Longchamp three weeks later, has been bought by Godolphin for an undisclosed sum and will move from the Chantilly stable of Nicolas Clement to Saeed bin Suroor's European base at Moulton Paddocks in Newmarket. The sophomore, second on his only juvenile outing at Maisons-Laffitte last year, has won four of his five starts this season. Immediate plans for the dual Group 1 winner have yet to be announced.
