HUNTING FOR A GRADE I

The \$500,000 Diana H., a Grade I event for the first time this year, will feature nine of the best turf distaffers on the East Coast. New York-based **Voodoo Dancer** (Kingmambo), who lost by a nose to **Tates Creek** last year in the Diana, traveled to Hollywood to annex the GII Beverly Hills H. June 28 over Dublino and Megahertz (GB). The blaze-faced bay's predilection for firm going, however, will dictate her participation. Trainer Bobby Frankel has won eight Grade I races in New York so far this year and saddles a pair of four-year-olds here.

Jerry Bailey has the mount aboard **Heat Haze (GB)** (Green Desert), a 3/4-sister to turf champion Banks Hill (GB). The Juddmonte colorbearer is unbeaten in three U.S. starts to date, unleashing a spectacular late run in winning the GIII Citgo Distaff Turf Mile May 3. Frankel is co-owner of his other entrant **Pertuisane (GB)** (Zamindar), who ran third to **Wonder Again** (Silver Hawk) and **Riskaverse** (Dynaformer) in the GI Garden City Breeders' Cup H. last September. The

bay was most recently second to **Snow Dance** (Forest Wildcat) in the GII New York H. July 4. Wonder Again had her coming out party last year over this course, winning an entry-level allowance prior to her score in the GII Lake Placid H. But after her win at Belmont in the Garden City, the bay hasn't had her picture taken in three subsequent outings. She missed by a half-length when second to **Delta Princess** (A.P. Indy) in the GIII Beaugay H. May 3, then ran third to **Mariensky** (Gulch) over boggy ground in the GIII Just a Game Breeders' Cup H. June 7. "She's been running good, she just hasn't had any luck yet this year," said trainer Jimmy Toner. "All she has to do is run back to the races she's been running. She loves Saratoga and she'll handle anything." **Diana field, p3**

Trademark became the second U.S. graded stakes winner bred in southern Africa by bounding away from his rivals in securing his first stakes success. A close seventh to Ipi Tombe (Zim) in the G1 Durban July H. last July, he followed that filly to Dubai, finishing third to her in a Listed race Feb. 6 and fifth to her in the G3 Jebel Hatta Mar. 8. He ran fourth in his Dubai finale Apr. 10, but turned things around in his U.S. bow, finishing second by a half-length in the GIII Poker H. July 5. After saving ground while fourth in the early stages, Trademark was crying out for room at the top of the stretch. Jockey Richard Migliore found a seam and the seven-year-old responded, striding clear in the final furlong. "He was third to Ipi Tombe in Dubai and she would have been 1-9 in here," said winning trainer Kiaran McLaughlin. "He's a bleeder and Lasix has been a huge plus for him." Chorist, who continues to improve, made all under Darryll Holland to record her third stakes score here. After winning the Listed Upavon Fillies' S. at Salisbury last August, she finished a solid second to the smart Dermot Weld filly Irresistible Jewel (Ire) in the G3 Blandford S. at The Curragh in September, but could do no better than eighth behind the then Weld-trained Dress to Thrill (Ire) in the G2 Sun Chariot S. at Newmarket the following month. Freshened over the winter, she returned to finish a length runner-up to the smart Zee Zee Top (GB) in the Listed Middleton S. at York May 14. Last time out, she beat Monturani by a head in the Listed Hoppings S. at Newcastle June 28. Taken to the front in the early stages this time, she responded to every call in the straight to quicken clear of the chasing Monturani before comfortably holding Favourable Terms and Kieren Fallon.

VINDICATION BREEZES HALF-MILE Last year's champion two-year-old colt **Vindication** (Seattle Slew) continued on the comeback trail with a half-mile breeze at Padua Stables Training Center in Summerfield, Florida, according to *Thoroughbred Times*. The undefeated colt covered the distance in :48.60, according to Padua's racing manager Randy Bradshaw. "He's doing very, very well," Bradshaw told *Thoroughbred Times*. "He'll work another half next week and then we're looking at putting him on a plane to send him back to Bob [Baffert] at Del Mar." The dark bay reeled off four straight wins at two for trainer Bob Baffert in 2002, culminating in a victory in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Oct. 26. He sustained a suspensory injury over the winter and missed his chance at the Triple Crown. **Vindication**, a \$2.15 million FTSAUG yearling purchase, is slated to enter stud next year at Hill 'n' Dale Farm near Lexington, Kentucky.

☆ KING GEORGE CONT. ☆

BY GEORGE, IT'S A GOOD FIELD Godolphin will bid for their fourth King George since 1995 with a three-pronged entry, headlined by one of their biggest guns in **Sulamani (Ire)** (Hernando {Fr}). The Niarchos Family homebred, winner of the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club and runner-up in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe last year, landed the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic at Nad al Sheba Mar. 29 in his first start in Godolphin's blue colors, but failed to land a blow when fifth (promoted to fourth) in the G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud June 29. His connections pointed to the moderate early pace and fast ground as the reason for his rusty display and he can be forgiven for the one bad performance of his career. The fierce opposition is led by **Nayef (Gulch)**, who went down by a head to **Golan (Ire)** in a memorable battle in this contest 12 months ago. He produced a fluent performance when returning to Europe this term to win the G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot June 18, but just failed to catch **Falbrav (Ire)** (Fairy King) in the G1 Eclipse S. at Sandown July 5. Falbrav's impressive turn of acceleration took him to a 3/4-length defeat of **Nayef** there and if last year's G1 Japan Cup winner can sustain that over this longer trip, he is a major threat. **Kris Kin (Kris S.)** had **Alamshar (Ire)** (Key of Luck) a length back in third when winning the G1 Epsom Derby on only his fourth start June 7. He bids to provide Sir Michael Stoute with his fourth renewal since fellow Epsom victor **Shergar (GB)** opened the scoring back in 1981. **Alamshar**, who progressed off his Epsom run to beat **Dalakhani (Ire)** by a half length in the G1 Irish Derby at The Curragh June 29, has a similar profile to **St Jovite**, who was beaten at Epsom before completing the Irish Derby-King George double in 1992.

Sixth in the GI Beverly D. last August, **Tates Creek** is unbeaten in her last four trips to the post and looks to have turned the corner this year at five. Winner of the GIII Noble Damsel H. and GII Las Palmas H. to close out 2002, the half sister to Sightseek defeated **Megahertz** by 3/4 of a length in the GII San Gorgonio H. at Santa Anita Jan. 11 and returned fresh for her summer campaign, accounting for **Dublino** by a length in the May 26 GI Gamely Breeders' Cup H. at Hollywood. For good measure, she is perfect in two tries at Del Mar and jockey Pat Valenzuela has opted not to jump ship in favor of **Golden Apples**. The latter, the reigning Eclipse Award winning turf distaffer, defeated Astra in the Beverly D. and added the GI Yellow Ribbon S. before finishing a troubled fourth in the Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Turf. She is making her first start since getting caught at the wire by Dress To Thrill (Ire) in the GI Matriarch S. Dec. 1. Gary Stevens has the call aboard the bay, who was sidelined with ankle trouble. "We took a chip out of each ankle in December last year and gave her all the time she needed before coming back," explained trainer Ben Cecil. "I wonder if those chips weren't in there for quite awhile without us really knowing about it. She's happy, she's very sound, she's fresh. I think she'll run very well. It's been a long wait to get her back to the races, and finally it's here and it's all gone so smoothly for her."

Undefeated in Grade I company, **Bird Town** goes for her third straight at the top level. The Marylou Whitney homebred, 18-1 when she cruised to victory in the May 2 GI Kentucky Oaks, was the 5-2 second choice in the June 6 GI Acorn S. and outgamed **Lady Tak** for a head tally. First or second in eight of nine career starts, the bay will use the Test as a stepping stone to yet another Grade I event, the Alabama S. Aug. 16. Trainer Nick Zito wants to win both races. "The Test is one of the most revered races around," Zito said. "We're absolutely not taking it lightly. It's always a tough, hard race. Hopefully, she gets through it and has three good weeks into the Alabama." Hoping to turn the tables on Bird Town is Acorn runner-up Lady Tak. The Florida-bred filly won her first five starts, including the Mar. 8 GII Fair Grounds Oaks, before running second in the Apr. 5 GI Ashland S. A troubled sixth in the Kentucky Oaks two starts back, she showed a new dimension with her rallying finish in the Acorn and has been working sharply at Saratoga since mid-July. "We feel very good about her," trainer Steve Asmussen said. "She's an extremely talented filly...[who] went from all speed to settling and becoming very manageable." **House Party** is another who will be coming from off the pace. The gray, two-for-three at seven furlongs, was fourth in the Acorn, but closed for a 3 1/4-length score in the July 4 GI Prioress S. last time out. **Final Round** won the seven-furlong GIII La Troienne S. at Churchill May 1, then ran third, beaten a length, to Bird Town and Lady Tak in the GI Acorn. The dark bay then ran third in the GI Mother Goose S. June 28. The speedy **Country Romance** makes her stakes debut after winning three in a row at Churchill Downs. The Overbrook colorbearer went gate to wire to win a six-furlong allowance test in her latest June 29.

The winner of this event in 2000 and 2001, **Kona Gold** looks to take his seashore record to a perfect six-for-six this afternoon. A respectable fourth in last year's GI Breeders' Cup Sprint, the nine-year-old kicked off the New Year with a win in the GIII El Conejo H. Jan. 1, but was sixth to **Avanzado** in the GII Palos Verdes H. Jan. 26 and is unraced since his third-place effort behind **Bluesthstandard** in the GII Potrero Grande Breeders' Cup H. in Arcadia Mar. 29. **Disturbingthepeace** won the two major sprint tests at this meet in 2002, including a 3/4-length score in last year's Crosby and a head success in the GII Pat O'Brien Breeders' Cup H. Aug. 18. The gelding goes in search of his first victory in six tries and was most recently fourth in the May 10 GIII Los Angeles Times H. at Hollywood. He gets blinkers off today. **Beau's Town**, winner of Oaklawn's GIII Count Fleet Sprint H. in April, invades from the Midwest off a narrow defeat in the GIII Aristides H. at Churchill June 21. "Since he's shipped out here, he's been doing really well," said Tim Ice, assistant to trainer Cole Norman. "He likes the track. He's getting hold of it well. And he loves the weather, as we all do." The Midwestern runner has drawn the outside. "He's on the outside and that gives Pat [Valenzuela] a chance to see everything what happens inside of him," Ice added.

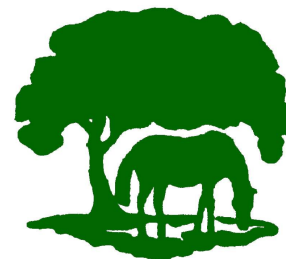
