Irish Derby winner **Alamshar (Ire)** (Key of Luck) struck for the sophomores as he powered 3 1/2 lengths clear of **Sulamani (Ire)** (Hernando {Fr}) to capture yesterday's G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot under an enterprising ride from Johnny Murtagh.

Always prominent, His Highness the Aga Khan's colorbearer was committed at the top of the short straight and quickened clear as Frankie Dettori attempted in vain to close on the wayward Sulamani. "I was in a

lovely position and they weren't going that fast and he just picked up the bridle himself," the winning jockey said of the compact colt, returned at odds of 13-2. "I waited until I got to the two before I let him go, and when I did, it went all quiet. He's some horse--he's improved out of all proportion." (cont. p2)

VOODOO GETS HER REVENGE

In last year's Diana H., **Voodoo Dancer** (Kingmambo) fell a nose short of catching the green silks with the pink sash carried by Jerry Bailey aboard *Tates Creek*. This year's finish looked a lot the same, but this time around, jockey Corey Nakatani and **Voodoo Dancer**

swept to the front in upper stretch and turned back the bid of Juddmonte Farms' **Heat Haze (GB)** (Green Desert) for the win. Another Bobby Frankel-trainee, **Pertuisane (GB)** (Zamindar), overcame a bit of trouble to be third. Saving ground

while racing towards the back of the pack, **Voodoo Dancer** was patiently handled, circled six wide into the stretch and refused to let **Heat Haze** by. "It's a good feeling to beat Juddmonte [Farms]," said winning trainer Christophe Clement, who was winning his second Diana, having saddled **Rumpipumpy (GB)** in 1997. (more p2)

A SPEC-TAK-ULAR PERFORMANCE

Heiligbrodt Racing Stable's **Lady Tak** (Mutakddim) set a new stakes record and came within a fifth of a second of Darby Creek Road's 25-year-old track record in winning yesterday's G1 Test S. at Saratoga by 4 1/2 lengths over MGISW **Bird Town** (Cape Town). Over a

track that was not especially speedy, the attractive chestnut held the rail while racing close to the pace, cruised to the front approaching the stretch and was not seriously menaced thereafter. "She is very special. Always has been," said winning trainer Steve

**King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. cont.
A Second King George for the Aga Khan...**

Alamshar, who was giving his owner his first Diamond S. since Shergar in 1981, has been brought along steadily by conditioner John Oxx. Unbeaten at two, including a win in the G3 Beresford S. at The Curragh in October, the bay returned to finish an eye-catching runner-up to Balestrini (Ire) in the G3 Ballysax S. at Leopardstown Apr. 13. The conqueror of The Great Gatsby (Ire) in the G2 Derrinstown Derby Trial back at that track May 11, the son of Key of Luck finished third behind **Kris Kin** (Kris S.) and that rival in the Epsom Classic June 7, but bounced back from that effort to beat G1 Prix du Jockey-Club winner Dalakhani (Ire) by a half-length in the G1 Irish Derby at The Curragh June 29. "He did win with a good bit in hand and he's progressing," Oxx said of yesterday's outing. "You expect good three-year-olds to get better and better, and he seems to be doing it, but you couldn't have predicted he'd win that well. It was a terrific effort--he was always traveling along very easily and when the pace slowed in the middle of the race, he was in the right position." Added Murtagh, "At Epsom [in the Derby] they slowed the pace up at Tattenham Hill and packed us all up and I was so tight I didn't really get out until the straight. That was only his fifth run and he wasn't really clued in enough, but it made a man of him. He rides big, covers a lot of ground and has a good presence about him. He's only going to get better." Oxx indicated that the the [10-furlong] G1 Irish Champion S. [at Leopardstown Sept. 6] is the next stop for the winner. No Disgrace in Defeat for Sulamani...

Frankie Dettori reported that 9-2 second favorite **Sulamani (Ire)** was unsuited by the moderate pace. "Alamshar kicked and got five lengths on me and I couldn't get him back," he explained. "A stronger pace would have suited me better but we're on course for the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe [at Longchamp Oct. 5]." The four-year-old colt was an excellent second in last year's Longchamp spectacle.

Voodoo Dancer closed 2002 with a second gut-wrenching defeat at the hands of Tates Creek in the GII Las Palmas H. Nov. 3 at Santa Anita, but was given a well-deserved rest off that effort. The Christophe Clement-trainee returned with a game third to Delta Princess (A.P. Indy) and Wonder Again (Silver Hawk) in the GIII Beaugay H. over the Aqueduct turf May 3 and traversed the continent yet again for her latest, charging from off the pace to win the 10-furlong GII Beverly Hills H. at Hollywood Park June 28. Given her recent success at distances up to 1 1/4 miles, Clement is considering the 9 1/2-furlong GI Beverly D. S. at Arlington Park Aug. 16 for the mare's next outing.

Megahertz, denied a Grade I victory in the Del Mar Oaks by the nose of Dublino last summer, turned the tables on that rival, who shared in a rare triple dead heat for the place in the GI John C Mabee H. The chestnut, who started in no fewer than six claiming races in France at two, has become a solid stakes performer in this country, while just a shade below the upper echelon. The diminutive filly recorded her lone win this term in the GII Santa Barbara H. at Santa Anita Apr. 19 and was coming into this off third-place efforts in the GI Gamely Breeders' Cup H. and the GII Beverly Hills H. at Hollywood May 26 and June 28, respectively. Content to trail through pedestrian early fractions, she swung three wide into the stretch and stormed to the lead late, accounting for the dead-heating trio.

Lady Tak won each of her first five career starts, the first three around one bend, including the Jan. 4 Thelma S. at Fair Grounds. She proved her ability to handle the stretchout in distance with facile scores in the Jan. 26 Tiffany Lass S. at a mile and the GII Fair Grounds Oaks at 8 1/2 furlongs before finishing second to loose-on-the-lead Elloluv in the GI Ashland S. at Keeneland Apr. 5. Sixth to Bird Town as the favorite in the GI Kentucky Oaks May 2, the Florida-bred filly found the Oaks winner just a head too good in the June 6 GI Acorn S. in her latest effort. Yesterday's victory was especially sweet for the winning connections.

"This was our target for her for the year and I couldn't be any happier for her," victorious trainer Steve Asmussen commented. "Everything fell into place. She was away smoothly and Jerry [Bailey] gave her a great ride." The winner could make her next appearance in the GI Gazelle H. at Belmont Sept. 9, while the runner-up remains on track for the GI Alabama S. Aug. 16.

Arkansas-bred Beau's Town forced the early pace drew clear to beat California's best sprinters yesterday at Del Mar. The easy winner of the Feb. 1 King Cotton S. at his Oaklawn base and the Pelleteri Breeders' Cup H. in New Orleans Mar. 16, the chestnut registered his first graded-stakes score in the GIII Count Fleet Sprint H. in Hot Springs Apr. 10. He returned from a brief freshening to finish a head second in the GIII Aristides H. at Churchill June 21 and was the third choice in the wagering. Beau's Town dueled for the early lead outside a rival, took over for good entering the stretch, drew clear and held sway to comfortably account for favored Captain Squire. The final time was a little more than a fifth of a second off the 30-year-old track record. "I didn't know he was that fast," said winning jockey Pat Valenzuela. "When I asked him, he just cut like I couldn't believe. He really went." Added a hoarse winning trainer Cole Norman, "I love California!"

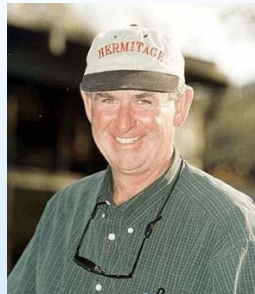

A solid allowance winner over the Gulfstream turf course Feb. 1, Honor In War registered a half-length allowance victory over Eddie Read hopeful Irish Warrior at Keeneland two starts later Apr. 17, but arrived on the national scene with a 24-1 upset in the GI Woodford Reserve Turf Classic at Churchill Downs on Derby Day May 3. The chestnut did not disgrace himself when he finished sixth over a boggy Belmont turf course in the GI Manhattan H. on the Belmont Stakes undercard June 7 and was favored in this local prep for the GI Arlington Million. Allowed to lope along towards the rear for the opening half mile, Honor In War advanced a bit wide on the final turn, claimed a short lead turning for home and was hard ridden to hold off Better Talk Now. "He got a little bit rank at Belmont [in the Manhattan]," explained jockey David Flores, who flew in for the ride. "Today he broke so nice and I got a great spot. When I shook him a little bit he responded real strong." Winning trainer Paul McGee said that his charge would be returned to Kentucky to prepare for a possible start in the Aug. 16 Million.

Last year Owsley won the GIII Glens Falls H. at Saratoga and the GII WinStar Galaxy S. at Keeneland back-to-back, but was finished last in the GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf at Arlington. In her seasonal bow in the GIII Beaugay H. at Aqueduct May 3, she placed fourth then finished a well-beaten second behind Mariensky in the GII Sheepshead Bay H. at Belmont May 31. Last time out she lacked a rally in a fourth-place finish behind Snow Dance in the GII New York H. at Belmont, but was in receipt of some class relief here. The favorite raced in the middle of the pack, came three wide into the stretch, took the lead a furlong out and held sway under urging while setting a new stakes record. Bien Nicole, the second choice, set a pressured pace and held on gamely to finish second. "This is my first stakes win at Arlington," winning trainer Randy Schulhofer said. "I'm glad we got a win with this filly this year. We'll definitely consider the [Aug. 16 GI] Beverly D., but there's a stakes race at Saratoga that we might consider." Three weeks ago, jockey Jose Velez Jr. piloted 37-1 Balto Star to victory in the GI United Nations H. at Monmouth. Aboard another longshot in the Salvator Mile yesterday, Velez got the job done once again, driving 14-1 Vinemeister to the upset. Unsuccessful in three previous tries at a mile, the four-year-old colt had not visited the winner's circle since taking an optional claimer at Monmouth last August and had finished off the board in all four of his starts this season. But he found new life yesterday. Vinemeister settled in second as 21-1 Dhaffir (Chi) (Smooth Performance) set a moderate pace. He put a head in front after six furlongs and held off the late surge of Jersey Giant for the victory. "I was expecting my horse to go to the lead, but [trainer Alan Seewald] told me, 'you know how to ride, just ride him,'" Velez said. "If he breaks good and goes to the front, he goes to the front. If not, put him second, third or fourth and go from there. He was sitting second real easy. At the three-eighths pole, I moved my hands and he went on. I knew I had a lot of horse left at the top of the stretch and it paid off."

SOPHS DOT SARATOGA WORK TAB With the second season for this year's talented crop of three-year-olds set to kick into high gear next weekend, some of the chief protagonists got some fine tuning at Saratoga yesterday morning. Prepping for next Sunday's GII Jim Dandy S., GI Belmont S. hero **Empire Maker** (Unbridled) earned the six-furlong bullet, stopping the clock in 1:12 with his regular exercise rider, jockey Aaron Gryder, in the irons. Stablemate Special Rate, a Pulpit half brother to Sightseek and Bates Creek, broke off about five lengths ahead of Empire Maker, who made up ground on the inside before finishing on even terms. Special Rate's time was 1:13 1/5. "I think this work will make him a little more focused," trainer Bobby Frankel said of Empire Maker, who was having his first official breeze at the Spa. Shortly thereafter, GI Toyota Blue Grass S. winner **Peace Rules** (Jules) got in his final work for next Sunday's GI Haskell Invitational H., covering five furlongs in 1:00 with jockey Javier Castellano aboard. "[Javier] was really happy with him and said he galloped out pretty strong," Frankel commented. "I tell you, he's doing pretty good, Peace Rules. He's more relaxed up here than he was at Belmont." The Edmund Gann-colorbearer ships to New Jersey the morning of the race. Also bound for the Haskell is **Sky Mesa** (Pulpit), who zipped five-eighths of a mile in a handy :59 4/5 for trainer John Ward. The imposing bay colt, injured on the eve of last year's Breeders' Cup Juvenile, returned to the races with a solid third-place finish behind the Jim Dandy-ticketed **Strong Hope** (Grand Slam) in the GII Dwyer S., earning an excellent Beyer in the process. Still, his trainer thinks there is room for improvement. "Anytime you run a 104 [speed figure] off a nine-month layoff, that's a pretty big accomplishment," he submitted. "He'll only get better with it under his belt."

Volponi Works Well for Whitney:

Amherst Stable's **Volponi** (Cryptoclearance), runner-up in each of his three trips to the post this season, worked a half mile yesterday at Saratoga. New York Racing Association clockers missed the work, but credited the five-year-old with a time of :47 4/5. He makes his next start in Saturday's GI Whitney H. "He looked good, finished up good and [jockey Jose Santos] had a hard time pulling him up," commented Hall of Fame trainer P.G. Johnson. "He's run three big races this year and each one has been better than the last," the conditioner added. The upset winner of last year's Breeders' Cup Classic, Volponi has completed the exacta in a seven-furlong allowance, the GII Brooklyn H. and most recently the GI Suburban H. July 5.

Biancone Back With Another Promising Baby:

Last year, trainer Patrick Biancone made waves at Saratoga, taking the GII Sanford S. with Whywhywhy, a colt he owns with Fabien Ouaki, and the GII Saratoga Special S. with Michael Tabor's Zavata. Owner and trainer will try to defend their championship in the latter event when they send out **Pomeroy** (Boundary) in this year's race, set for Aug. 13. The bay colt, co-owned by Derrick Smith, worked an easy half mile in :48 3/5 with jockey Tony Farina up at Saratoga yesterday morning. Smith and Tabor are also the owners of last Thursday's GII Sanford S. winner **Chapel Royal** (Montbrook). "He looked good [this morning]," Biancone said of Pomeroy. "So far we've been lucky. His two races are good preparation." Those two races have been just flat-out good. A six-length maiden winner in the Belmont slop June 13, the \$300,000 FTFEB two-year-old in training purchase came back to win a sloppy Monmouth allowance by 11 1/2 lengths July 10. "When you come into a stakes with two races, that's better than one. He's more than ready for the Special," Biancone said.



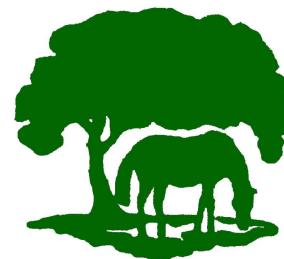
