**SEEK SIGHTING AT THE SPA**

**Sightseek** (Distant View) delivered a dominant performance yesterday at Saratoga to take the GI Go for Wand H. by a resounding 11 1/2 lengths. Racing fans at the Spa bet the Juddmonte Farms homebred down to 1-10 in the wake of impressive victories in the May

3 GI Humana Distaff H. and last out in the June 21 GI Ogden Phipps H. Sightseek sat just off the front-running **Miss Linda (Arg)** (Southern Halo) as that mare set easy fractions of :25.06, :49.25 and 1:13.55. Jerry Bailey barely moved on the favorite as she overtook Miss Linda turning for home and Sightseek strolled effort-

lessly clear. "She got to that other filly on her own," Bailey, winning his fourth straight race at the Spa yesterday, confirmed. "She did what she was supposed to do against this field." Sightseek has now finished first or second in all 11 career starts. "She's a very classy filly, a nice filly to be around," trainer Bobby Frankel said. "Her record speaks for itself. When I saw the fractions, I thought Miss Linda was going to run a good race today. Sightseek is just too good for these fillies." Of a possible meeting with reigning Horse of the Year Azeri, Frankel added, "Azeri can come here if she wants; I'm not going to duck her. The purses are bigger here, so I am going to stay on the East Coast. I may run her back at Belmont." Frankel also has another challenger for Azeri in recent GII Delaware H. winner **Wild Spirit (Chi)** (Hussonet). **RING SPEEDS TO READ WIN**

The last time **Special Ring** (Nureyev) raced at Del Mar, the six-year-old gelding set a course record while winning the one-mile Wickerr H. He returned to the seaside oval yesterday and blitzed his way to another track record, taking the nine-furlong GI Eddie Read H. by an authoritative five lengths. The bay set the pace in both his previous 2003 starts, the May 26 GI Shoemaker Breeders' Cup Mile and the July 4 GII American H., but had to settle for runner-up finishes in both contests. Special Ring went right to the early lead yesterday, while under a snug hold by jockey David Flores. He spurred clear in upper stretch and finished much the best as **Decarchy** (Distant View) won the battle for second. "I was just hoping he'd break good," Flores said after the win. "I knew if he did, it would be all over. He won this so easy. I never hit him. It was like he rebroke at the eighth pole." Special Ring's final time of 1:45 4/5 bettered Al Mamoon's stakes and track record of 1:46.60 set in 1986. 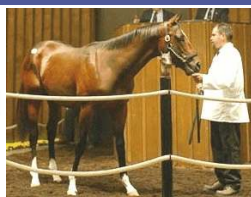

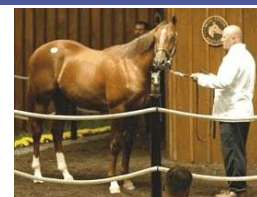

**COLIC SURGERY FOR SARAVA** A day after running sixth in his first start in over a year, Belmont S. victor **Sarava** (Wild Again) was battling for his life after undergoing emergency colic surgery, according to *The Blood-Horse*. The four-year-old suffered a fractured cannon bone after his Belmont victory and was sidelined for 14 months. He returned Saturday at Del Mar and ran sixth in a 1 1/16-mile optional claimer. "He came back to the barn and cooled out fine," trainer Bob Baffert told *Blood-Horse*. "But then he began to colic and we sent him to the equine hospital at San Luis Rey. He had surgery for a twisted colon." Veterinarian Joe Cannon performed the surgery at 1 a.m. "They didn't have to cut any of his intestine or anything. It was a matter of getting in there and untwisting the colon. If he recovers, he'll be able to keep racing, but the next 72 hours are critical. He's in a fight for his life."

It was a case of third-time lucky for Gestut Fahrhof's homebred Sabiango as he recaptured his old form to take this contest in authoritative style. Having finished runner-up to Anzillero (Ger) two years ago and last of six behind Marienbard (Ire) 12 months ago, the half to Arlington Million hero Silvano (Ger) came good for jockey Eduardo Pedroza, stalking Levirat before striking early in the straight and quickening clear. Sabiango promised much at three, winning the G2 Oppenheim-Union-Rennen and the G1 Credit Suisse Private Banking-Pokal at Cologne before finishing third behind Morshdi (GB) in the G1 Grosser Preis von Baden in September. He only appeared twice last term, when finishing fifth behind Falbrav (Ire) in the G1 Gran Premio di Milano in June and disappointing in this race. Nevertheless, he offered portents that he was returning to his best when third behind Aolus (Ger) (Winged Love {Ire}) in the G2 Hansa-Preis at Hamburg last time June 29. Sabiango will now be aimed at the G1 Credit Suisse Private Banking-Pokal at Cologne Aug. 17. Much Faster enjoyed a golden rail to take her record to a perfect four-from-four under Thierry Thulliez. Left alone on the stands' side as her rivals were diverted across to the middle of the track, she was always traveling easily and was the last to be asked the question. As only Colossus and jockey Mick Kinane appeared from the pack to offer a vague threat approaching the eighth-pole, one smack with the whip ensured victory as Much Faster quickened clear to register a facile score. Along with Royal Ascot scorer Russian Valour (Ire), she has proved a flag bearer for her sire Fasliyev, from whom she has inherited a physical dominance over the rest of her peers. She imposed her superiority over the colts when winning the Listed Prix la Fleche over course and distance June 17 and barely needed to work to beat Leila in the G3 Prix du Bois at Deauville last time July 5. Lateen Sails finally found the easier conditions he has needed and duly turned this seemingly competitive affair into a non-contest under a confident Frankie Dettori. Despite having done all his racing on a fast surface so far in his career, the chestnut has collected the Listed Glasgow S. at York May 15 and finished a creditable fourth behind Vespone (Ire) in the G1 Grand Prix de Paris at Longchamp June 22 on his last two starts. Taken straight to the head of affairs in the early stages, he set a steadily increasing tempo and caught his rivals flat-footed at the quarter-mile marker, where he quickened instantly. Stretching clear from there, he was eased in the closing stages as Shakis closed to take the runner-up spot. "That was very good," commented trainer Saeed bin Suroor. "Lateen Sails is improving all the time and he was impressive. He loved the soft ground and it should be easy to find similar conditions later in the year. We have no definite plans at the moment and will see how he comes out of this race. Last year's GI Travers victor **Medaglia d'Oro** (El Prado {Ire}) worked six furlongs at Saratoga yesterday in 1:12 1/5 with jockey Aaron Gryder aboard. "He looked very good on the track," trainer Bobby Frankel said of the four-year-old. "He went by himself. There happened to be a horse that broke off way in front of him and made him pay attention. Looking at him, it looks like he's on top of his game." Medaglia d'Oro has not run since winning the GI Oaklawn H. in April. After that race, the dark bay colt injured his foot while getting cast in his stall. "He pulled a lot of the wall off on his front foot," Frankel explained. "It's grown out now and he's doing very good."

Kentucky Derby and Preakness winner **Funny Cide** (Distorted Humor) worked six furlongs Sunday over Saratoga's main track in 1:12 2/5. Over a track labeled fast, the chestnut gelding galloped out seven furlongs in 1:26 with assistant trainer Robin Smullen in the irons. "Robin said he went really well over the track," said trainer Barclay Tagg. "He was pulling her through the work. He came back well and he looks good. Everything went really smoothly." Tagg added that Funny Cide would likely ship to Monmouth Sunday morning.

Also working towards the Haskell, **Excessivepleasure** (In Excess {Ire}) worked five furlongs at Santa Anita Saturday in 1:01 1/5. The Doug O'Neill trainee, coming off a win in the Iowa Derby, is expected to ship to New Jersey Tuesday.

**ALAMSHAR TOPS THE CHARTS Alamshar (Ire)**

(Key of Luck) was yesterday rated the best winner of the G1 King George VI And Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. in recent years by senior British Horseracing Board handicapper Nigel Gray. After the John Oxx-trained sophomore's 3 1/2-length defeat of Godolphin's **Sulamani (Ire)** (Hernando {Fr}) in Saturday's contest at Ascot, Gray has handed the winner a rating of 131 pounds, placing him above recent scorers Golan (Ire), Galileo (Ire), Montjeu (Ire) and Daylami (Ire). "We had a really top-class field with 10 of the 12 horses rated 118 or more, and I felt Alamshar really stamped his authority on the race," he told *PA Sport* yesterday. "I kept Sulamani on 126 as he didn't have a clear run."

**Nayef and Sulamani 'fine' Following King George...**

Trainer John Oxx's wife Cairiona reported the winner in "brilliant" form yesterday, while disappointing favorite **Nayef** (Gulch), who finished seventh, was "absolutely fine," according to conditioner Marcus Tregoning. "You could see on the way to the start that he wasn't going to like the sticky ground," he told *PA Sport* yesterday. "He's got too good an action. It was a disappointing run, but it's nice to know there was a good reason. The most important thing is that we have got him back in great shape." Tregoning will take his time before deciding whether to send the five-year-old to York for a bid to win back-to-back renewals of the G1 Juddmonte International S. Aug. 19. Sulamani was also reported to be "sound, healthy and happy" by Saeed bin Suroor, who added, "He ran a big race and his target is the [Oct. 5 G1] Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe."

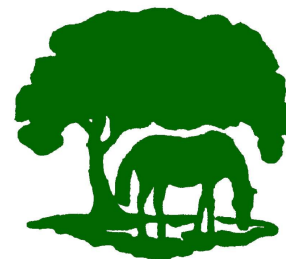
