**THE REEL DEAL**

Pat Eddery threatened to bring down Goodwood's timber after conjuring up a fairy-tale success aboard the 20-1 outsider **Reel Buddy** (Mr. Greeley) in yesterday's G1 Sussex S. In his final year as a jockey, the legendary figure of the turf coaxed the five-year-old from last place at the quarter-mile marker to do battle with a clutch of rivals in a pulsating final 100 yards. Although the first five were separated by less than a length, it was Reel Buddy who had the call at the wire, denying **Statue of Liberty** (Storm Cat) by a head to provide Eddery with his sixth success in this race. "That was the icing on the cake," he commented after receiving an ovation from the public and fellow jockeys in the winner's enclosure afterwards. (cont. p2)

**IPI TOMBE SIDELINED**

Team Valor, WinStar Farm and Sunmark Partners' **Ipi Tombe (Zim)** (Manshood {GB}) will miss her expected engagement in Arlington Park's International Festival of Racing Aug. 16 and will likely be given the rest of the year off after failing to recover from a minor leg injury sustained in a workout at Churchill Downs June 24.

Despite the minor setback, the five-year-old won the GIII Locust Grove H. at Churchill Downs just four days later, but the injury resurfaced and forced trainer Elliott Walden to pass on the July 26 GI Diana H., which was to serve as a prep for either the GI Beverly D. S. versus her peers or the GI

Arlington Million against males. Those plans are on hold for now, according to the conditioner. "She rapped herself pretty good in a very sensitive area where there is a lot of soft tissue," Walden told *Thoroughbred Times*. "We tried to make a go of it, but her safety comes first. Once you finalize a decision like this, you wind up feeling good about it because you know you're doing right by the horse. She'll be back as good as ever next year." Ipi Tombe has been spectacular thus far in her career, with 12 wins from 14 starts, including her three-length victory against the boys in the G1 Dubai Duty Free S. at Nad al Sheba Mar. 29.

**SARAVA ON THE MEND**

New Phoenix Stable's **Sarava** (Wild Again), who suffered a severe episode of colic Saturday night after making his first start in over 14 months, has taken a turn for the better and could eventually make it back to the races. The 2002 Belmont winner underwent surgery early Sunday morning and is showing signs of improvement. "He's headed in the right direction and we're all guardedly optimistic," owner Gary Drake told *Thoroughbred Times*. Should Sarava fully recover, he could return to the barn of Bob Baffert in 60-90 days.

**Reel Buddy** has a temperamental nature which has occasionally compromised his ability, and is regarded as a tricky character based on his nervousness at the start and tendency to drop himself out in his races. Nevertheless, he showed he had the speed to beat

subsequent dual Group 1-winning sprinter Continent (GB) in the Listed Abernant S. over six furlongs at Newmarket last April and the stamina to finish third behind Rock of Gibraltar (Ire) in this event 12 months ago. Despite flashes of ill-nature this term, he had produced eye-catching runs when third in the G2 Sandown Mile Apr. 26 and when runner-up in the G3 Diomed S. at Epsom last time June 7. His trainer's son, Richard Hannon Jr.,

knows the horse's quirks well. "That welcome was more about Pat but I think the horse deserves it as well," he said. "He's won it fair and square, sat out the back and he's quickened by them. You couldn't fancy him, but he's that sort of horse that can pull one out of the bag. He really does accelerate and this track seems to suit him."

**Eddery Goes Out a Sussex Winner...**

One of the all-time greats of the British turf, Pat Eddery last won the Sussex in 1994 with Distant View and was seeking to tie the six wins of Lester Piggott in this event. "He gave me a lovely ride throughout the race and picked up well," he said of the winner. "I settled him out the back and they went flat out and got to the furlong-marker and all stopped. My little fellow had plenty and he enjoyed them coming back at him so I brought him through them--he got a half-length near the line then eased up on me. You've got to do everything really nice with him; so as long as you pet him and look after him he's fine--I just had to squeeze him, as if you give him a slap he pulls up with you."

Lucky Story lived up to his tall reputation to provide trainer Mark Johnston with his first winner of this contest since Mister Baileys (GB) in 1993 and add further gloss to his stable's array of juvenile stars. With G3 Norfolk S. winner Russian Valour (Ire), Listed Chesham S. winner Pearl of Love (Ire) and dual group-scoring filly Attraction (GB) heading the Middleham team, Lucky Story had major strides to make to justify his trainer's comment in the spring that he was the best he had. He did not do so when fourth behind subsequent G3 Premio Primi Passi winner Clifden (Ire) on his debut in a conditions race at Ayr May 29, but he began to show his potential when winning a maiden at that track June 20 and a conditions event at Pontefract 10 days later. Ridden prominently by Keith Dalglish throughout the early stages here, Lucky Story was committed approaching the quarter-mile marker and soon had command. Despite running greenly in front, he was kept up to his work and was always holding The Mighty Tiger and Michael Kinane in the drive to the line. "It was hard for us to be absolutely sure he was one of the best we had," commented Johnston. "He had one defeat on the gallops at the start of the year and that was behind Russian Valour, but that was just idleness as well. We felt at the time that, given an extra furlong or two, he would be top-class and he's proving it.

There's still an awful lot of learning to do and we've just got to hope that the best is still to come. We've brought some hot horses here and this is certainly the best since Mister Baileys." **Persian Punch** prepares for battle once again as he bids to repeat his success in this contest two years ago. The 10-year-old has captured the heart of the nation and is arguably their favorite racehorse, having been involved in the majority of the stayers' dogfights over the past six years. Those who had written the gelding off prematurely at the start of last term were made to eat humble pie when he staged a late-summer revival in finishing runner-up to **Boreas** in the G3 Doncaster Cup in September before reversing those placings in the G3 Jockey Club Cup at Newmarket the following month. After a couple of warm-up races this season, he beat everything bar Mr Dinos (Ire) in the G1 Ascot Gold Cup at the Royal meeting June 19 and then gave five pounds and a beating to Cover Up (Ire) in the Listed Esher S. at Sandown July 5. Boreas was fifth when Persian Punch was fourth behind Mr Dinos in the G2 Henry II S. at Sandown last time May 26 and will relish these easier conditions as he puts it up to his veteran foe. **Zindabad** faces a stiff task stepping up in trip on ground he has never appreciated. He has had a busy campaign so far with his best performance coming when third behind Indian Creek (Ire) in the G2 Hardwicke S. over a mile and a half at Royal Ascot June 21.

**HASKELL INVITATIONAL H.-GI**, \$1,000,000, 3yo, 9f  
 For the first time in his brief career, **Sky Mesa** (Pulpit) will carry a new rider when he takes his place in the starting gate alongside favorites **Funny Cide** (Distorted Humor) and **Peace Rules** (Jules) in the Monmouth centerpiece. Trainer John Ward Jr. has tabbed jockey Robby Albarado to pilot the handsome bay colt, replacing Edgar Prado, who has elected to stay with Peace Rules. "Robby's a top rider and a very aggressive rider when the time comes," the conditioner told the *Blood-Horse*. "He's got that long, lean body that fits the horse, too." Albarado's first and only trip to the Haskell was a memorable one, as he guided Tom Durant's Touch Tone to a close runner-up finish behind Point Given in 2001. Sky Mesa, who worked five furlongs in :59 4/5 last Saturday at Saratoga, will gallop up to the race and is scheduled to arrive by van Saturday.

Undefeated **Wild and Wicked** (Wild Again) had his final pre-Haskell work at Saratoga Tuesday, breezing a half mile in :48 for trainer Ken McPeck. The winner of the GI Ohio Derby in his most recent effort June 21, the dark bay colt will be ridden by Shane Sellers.

**JIM DANDY S.-GII**, \$500,000, 3yo, 1 1/8m  
 Trainer Kiaran McLaughlin has green-lighted Shadwell Stable's **Tafaseel** (Belong to Me) for Sunday's feature after he worked a brilliant five-eighths of a mile in :59 1/5 over the Saratoga main track Tuesday morning. Third in his career bow at the Spa last summer, the son of GI Alabama S. winner Runup The Colors was once third from three starts over the winter at Nad al Sheba, but has improved dramatically since returning to the States this spring. A 9 3/4-length maiden winner at Belmont June 6, the \$550,000 KEESEP yearling purchase added a 4 1/2-length allowance score in Elmont July 2. "He's a very impressive colt," McLaughlin told *Daily Racing Form*. "I've been excited about him from the beginning, but he had a little history and we finally discovered in Dubai that he needed Lasix." Richard Migliore has the call on Sunday.

**MUTAKDDIM TO REMAIN IN STATES** Mutakddim (Seeking the Gold--Oscillate, by Seattle Slew), a success in both North and South American breeding sheds, will no longer shuttle to Argentina, it was announced yesterday. The sire of Lady Tak, winner in stakes-record time of the GI Test S. at Saratoga last weekend, as well as five other Group 1 winners in South America, Mutakddim will remain at his U.S. base at John Sikura's Hill 'n' Dale Farm near Lexington. "We are delighted at the outstanding job that Haras La Quebrada has done in managing Mutakddim's Southern Hemisphere career," Sikura commented. "We feel that with the level of success Mutakddim is enjoying that he is just too valuable and therefore have decided to keep him permanently in Kentucky and not shuttle him any longer." His 2004 stud fee is yet to be determined.

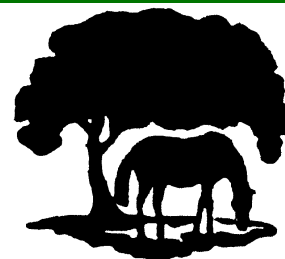

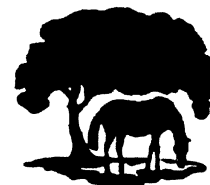

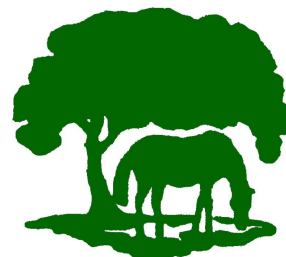
