THE BIG THREE....PLUS ONE

Justifiably so, today's GI Haskell Invitational H. at Monmouth Park has been billed as a clash between Kentucky Derby and Preakness winner **Funny Cide** (Distorted Humor), GI Toyota Blue Grass winner and Kentucky Derby third-place finisher **Peace Rules** (Jules) and top 2002 juvenile colt **Sky Mesa** (Pulpit). But just

one of today's entrants, **Wild And Wicked** (Wild Again), can boast of having beaten any horse he's faced. Trainer Ken McPeck, who trains or has trained such talented horses as Repent, Harlan's Holiday, Belmont winner Sarava, Take Charge Lady and

Kentucky Derby runner-up Tejano Run, has been duly impressed by Wild And Wicked from the start. "He may be the best horse I've ever laid a hand on," the conditioner admitted during Thursday's post position draw and added about today's competition, "I'm not sure that I fear any of them at this point." His confidence is understandable. Wild And Wicked has progressed smoothly from his Keeneland maiden score to his two-turn bow at Churchill in May and finally his victory in the GI Ohio Derby last out, where he had Preakness S. runner-up Midway Road back in third. The attractive dark bay made the pace in each of his first two career starts, but showed a new dimension at Thistledown, coming from just off the speed before drawing clear. "He's got tactical speed," McPeck indicated. "I think he can come from third or fourth, but I wouldn't expect him to be much further back than that." (*Field p6*)

The Supporting Cast...

Each of the Haskell's other three competitors have stakes victories. Locally based **Max Forever** (Montbrook) won the GI Long Branch BC S. in his latest; **Kool Humor** (Distorted Humor) comes in off a win in the Alysheba BC S. at Lone Star Park; and **Excessivepleasure** (In Excess {Ire}) counts the WinStar and Iowa Derbies among his four career victories.

AS GOOD AS GOLD IN THE WHITNEY

He hadn't raced in almost four months, but **Medaglia d'Oro** (El Prado {Ire}) showed no signs of rust, turning the tables on Breeders' Cup Classic hero **Volponi** (Cryptoclearance) to win yesterday's GI Whitney H. at Saratoga. The four-year-old, now a three-time stakes winner at the Spa, stalked early pacesetter **Northern Rock** (Jpn) (Northern Taste) for seven furlongs, took command in upper stretch and responded to hold off the late bid of Volponi.

Saratoga No Graveyard For Medaglia...

A 13 3/4-length winner of the GII Jim Dandy S. last season, Medaglia d'Oro gutted out a 1/2-length score over Repent in the GI Travers S. before his runner-up effort while in receipt of five pounds from Volponi in the Breeders' Cup. Rested off that effort, the dark bay returned in fine fettle at four, registering a seven-length victory in the GII Strub S. at Santa Anita Feb. 1 and a workmanlike 2 3/4-length tally in the GI Oaklawn H. in Hot Springs Apr. 5. But the colt suffered a foot injury which precluded starts in either or both the GI Pimlico Special in May and the GI Stephen Foster H. in June and thus was making his first start in 118 days in the Whitney, giving three pounds to the Classic winner.

Victory Especially Sweet For Frankel...

After the race, trainer Bobby Frankel took issue with trainer P.G. Johnson, who was quoted in Saturday's *Daily Racing Form* as saying, "He's just getting all the hype," referring to Medaglia d'Oro. Actions speak louder than words, according to Frankel. "I wanted to win this race. And then I wanted to win it more when I read in the papers that my horse was 'all hype,'" he said. "I wasn't mad, but I've learned that winning is the best revenge. If you win, you don't have to say anything. You just smile." Harlan's Holiday Scratched...

Trainer Todd Pletcher scratched **Harlan's Holiday** (Harlan) from the race yesterday morning and will instead point the four-year-old to the GII Saratoga Breeders' Cup H. Aug. 16. "I'm not crazy about the track condition," Pletcher said of the drying-out main track at the Spa. "That's not the only factor, but it makes it easier to make this decision." The runner-up in the G1 Dubai World Cup earlier this year, Harlan's Holiday was a bang-up second to Congaree in the GI Hollywood Gold Cup in his latest effort July 13.

A DANDY SEPTET Some 25 minutes before his arch-rival Funny Cide begins his second season in the Haskell, **Empire Maker** (Unbridled) will attempt to become the first winner of the GI Belmont S. since Conquistador Cielo in 1982 to tack on a victory in the GII Jim Dandy S. The Juddmonte Farms colorbearer will be looking to give trainer Bobby Frankel and jockey Jerry Bailey their second and fourth consecutive wins in the event, respectively. A three-time Grade I winner this year, the son of Toussaud is using this as a springboard to a possible clash of the titans in the GI Travers S. in a little less than three weeks and his trainer thinks the colt will be up to the task. "He's trained hard," Frankel commented. "He looks good. He's ready to run." Added Bailey, "He's the best three-year-old I've ever ridden, but he's got to run and beat older horses before he can be compared to the top handicap horses." First things first. **Strong Hope** (Grand Slam), impressive winner of the GII Dwyer S. over **Nacheezmo** (Carson City) and Sky Mesa July 6, will try to rain on the Empire Maker parade. **During** (Cherokee Run), who defeated Travers possible Ten Most Wanted in the GII Swaps S. July 13, ships in for trainer Bob Baffert and is joined in the starting gate by fellow upstart **Awesome Time** (Awesome Again), who makes his first start since upsetting the GIII Leonard Richard S. at Delaware Park June 14. The field is completed by allowance winners **Tafaseel** (Belong To Me) and **Congrats** (A.P. Indy).

She left it late, but when Russian Rhythm got into her stride there was only going to be one winner. The 4-5 favorite, she wore down Ana Marie in the final strides to provide Sir Michael Stoute with his fourth renewal of this race since 1990. The Cheveley Park colorbearer stalked the early pacesetter Zee Zee Top, but was trapped on the rail under Kieren Fallon as Ana Marie quickened to the front passing the quarter-mile marker. Switched out for her run, she steadily gathered in the French filly in a pulsating final 100 yards to record her third consecutive success at the highest level. "She'd lost her momentum at a vital stage," Stoute commented. "We didn't want her to have to pull out so wide because we've finished up on the worst ground--its more packed in on the inside rail. She really dug deep and showed she gets the trip, but she definitely wants livelier ground. She was on false ground and she couldn't get a real grip of it."

Russian Rhythm burst onto the scene when winning the G2 Lowther S. at York last August, then suffered the sole defeat of her career at the hooves of the brilliantly fast Airwave (GB) in the G1 Cheveley Park S. over six furlongs at Newmarket in October. She returned to establish herself as the best miling filly by beating Six Perfections (Fr) in the G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket May 4 and Soviet Song (Ire) in the G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot June 20. While connections of the winner were non-committal as to where the chestnut will appear next, Ana Marie's trainer Philippe Dermacastel revealed that she will head to the G1 Prix de l'Opera at Longchamp Oct. 5. Zavata went on a three-race tear last summer, including wins in the GIII Tremont S. at Belmont and this track's GII Saratoga Special S. Aug. 14, but had that streak snapped when he found a bit of trouble in the GI Hopeful S. and could do no better than third behind Sky Mesa. Eased when hopelessly defeated in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile in October, the bay could not handle the slop when last of five in his May 26 comebacker at Belmont, but atoned for that effort with a game one-length victory in Monmouth allowance company June 26. Connections originally planned on running back in the GIII Carry Back S. at Calder July 12, but decided to pass and were rewarded for that decision here. The second choice in the wagering, the muscular dark bay showed good speed and pressed the early pace to the inside of the returning Trust N Luck as favored Posse (Silver Deputy) trailed in the early going. Still traveling sweetly beneath jockey Jerry Bailey, Zavata cut the corner into the stretch, overtook the Florida invader and spurred clear. Longshot Great Notion finished well to earn the place spot. Mother Nature played a role in the victory, according to winning trainer Patrick Biancone. "If the track hadn't dried up, I would have scratched him," the Frenchman admitted. "The sunshine came out and I thought the track might be fast for us and it was." Posse was having his first run since winning the GII Riva Ridge Breeders' Cup June 7 and struggled with the drying-out surface. "I thought he ran well," said jockey Corey Lanerie. "The track wasn't really to his liking. I would rather it stayed sloppy." While the winner is on the fence for the GI King's Bishop S. over an additional furlong Aug. 23, that is definitely the next stop for Posse. Stakes placed in five juvenile starts overseas for Richard Hannon, Katdogawn had made a name for herself in turf sprints, taking a May 8 optional claimer at Hollywood and overcame trouble to register a two-length score in the Manhattan Beach S. June 1. The diminutive filly showed that she could get two turns in her latest, missing by 3/4 of a length in the July 6 Flawlessly S. at Hollywood over this trip and was sent off as part of a 5-1 entry. A handy fifth beneath Julie Krone while scraping the paint early, the bay advanced on her own courage at the quarter pole, was switched to the outside for clear sailing, pinned her ears and swooped past favored Atlantic Ocean for the win. "She's so professional and such a sweet horse," the winning rider commented. "It's fun to be a passenger on a horse like her."

Chopinina placed second in last year's GI Atto Mile over the Woodbine turf Sep. 8, then closed out the year with an 11th-place finish in the GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf at Arlington Oct. 26. In her first start this season she ran second, beaten a half length, in the GII Nassau S. at Woodbine June 1 and finished sixth last time out in the GIII Dance Smartly S. July 5. Cutting back in distance for this one, the chalk was close-up while racing four wide, came five wide into the lane, gained command in upper stretch and drew off while drifting in under left-handed encouragement. "It's very nice to win a stake with this filly," trainer Alec Fehr said. "We were worried about the shorter distance and the rain today, but we have a nice horse here and we're happy with this. That's a good race for her. We're going to decide in about a week [what her next start might be]. We might try the GI Atto Mile [at Woodbine Sept. 14] again." [Click for the brisnet.com chart.](#)

Denebola is the latest representative of the outstanding mare Coup de Genie, who beat Foxhound and Green Tune in this race 10 years ago and has already produced Snake Mountain, Glia and Loving Kindness, who also won this 12 months ago. Denebola took a tall reputation to this track for a conditions event on her debut July 9, but ran greenly and finished fourth behind Marching West. Held up towards the rear throughout the early stages of this race by a confident Thierry Thulliez, she made smooth progress onto the heels of the long-time leader Clifden (Ire) (Gold Away {Ire}) and favorite Saville Row (Gone West) approaching the final eighth. Quickening emphatically when the gap appeared between those rivals, she cut down Bonaire, who had first run wide in the track under Olivier Peslier, before asserting in the final 150 yards. She emanates from the stable of Six Perfections (Fr), who took Deauville by storm last year en route to Group 1 success later in the year. The Niarchos Family's racing manager Alan Cooper is in no doubt that she can go the same way. "We were disappointed when she only finished fourth on her debut as we like her a lot," he commented. "However, she didn't have a good trip that day and was very green. Today we told Thierry to wait with her and she won in good style--like her sister and mother. I will have to discuss it with her owner, but the logical next step is the G1 Prix Morny back here [Aug. 31]."

She will relish the return to a mile. That also applies to **Acago**, who took the G3 Prix Chloe in impressive fashion at Longchamp last time June 24. German Classic form is represented by **Diacada**, who took the G2 Henkel-Rennen at Dusseldorf May 11 before disappointing when eighth in the G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot last time June 20.

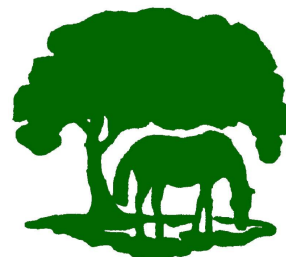

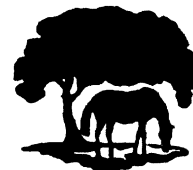

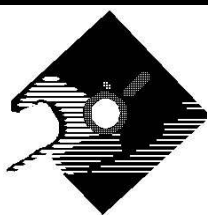
