CONN GAME

Four weeks ago, New York-bred **Whitmore's Conn** (Kris S.) upset the field in the GII Bowling Green H., breaking a seven-race losing streak to score as an 11-1 outsider. The dark bay was given even less chance in the GI Sword Dancer Invitational H. at Saratoga yesterday, but once again charged down the stretch to get the job done at 24-1. The five-year-old took the 2002 Bowling Green, then fell on hard times, finishing off the board five of his next seven outings, including a fifth-place finish in a Belmont allowance June 25. But he got it together with new jockey Jean-Luc Samyn in the irons last time, and it was Samyn on the green once again yesterday. "I knew this race wouldn't be easy...but he showed me great promise last time," Samyn said. The Frenchman had the longshot in last place after a mile, but began closing ground on the far turn, swung wide into the stretch and finished full of run for the surprise victory. OCEAN'S ELEVEN

Making her second start where the surf meets the turf, **Azeri** (Jade Hunter) will try to run her winning streak to 11 in the GII Clement L. Hirsch H. at Del Mar this afternoon. The five-year-old made it 10 in a row with a workmanlike two-length tally under 127 pounds in the June 21 GI Vanity H., but was not penalized even a pound for the victory. Instead, Del Mar racing officials chose to lower the weight on Vanity runner-up **Sister Girl Blues** (Hold for Gold), who carries 109 here; and fourth-place finisher **Tropical Blossom** (Thunder Gulch), in at 108. While 32 ounces is unlikely to give those two any more of an edge, the returning **Got Koko** (Signal Tap) could threaten the reigning Horse of the Year. In at 118, the four-year-old became the third filly in history to sweep the La Canada series with her 3/4-length score over the talented Sightseek in the Feb. 8 GII La Canada S. She makes her first appearance since running an even fourth in the Mar. 9 GI Santa Margarita H., but has been working sharply. "The presence of Got Koko makes it exciting," Azeri's trainer, Laura De Seroux, said, adding that she does not feel any heat to keep the streak alive. "I don't feel any undue pressure, as long as I get to remain focused and put her on the path that I think is the best one for her," she said. **Clement L. Hirsch field, p7**

MAGIC WANDO

Funny Cide fell one race short in his Triple Crown attempt, but **Wando** (Langfuhr) proved up to the task, completing the Canadian version of the grueling series with a 1 1/2-length victory in the Breeders' S. at Woodbine yesterday afternoon. The chestnut colt became just the seventh three-year-old to complete Canada's Triple since the concept was born in 1959. The first was New Providence in '59; the latest was Peteski in 1993. Dance Smartly (1991) is the only filly able to boast of the accomplishment. Wando had to fight his way between horses to join the elite group, but forged to the front in the stretch and drew clear as the crowd's 1-2 choice. **Breeders' S. cont. p7**

Aidan O'Brien sends out a select team of juveniles, headed by **One Cool Cat**, as he bids to extend his formidable record of five consecutive wins in this contest. He may surpass that if Susan Magnier's imposing \$3.1-million KEEJUL purchase lives up to the reputation earned with his smooth success in the G3 Anglesey S. at this track July 13. The manner of his facile score prompted O'Brien to describe the colt as a "stunner with unusual ability," leaving no doubt that he is among the elite of the Ballydoyle juveniles. His connections used the Anglesey as a stepping stone to this for Johannesburg two years ago and Spartacus last year. Ballydoyle will also field **Devil Moon** and **Old Deuteronomy**; both runners proved their class at Glorious Goodwood, where the former was third behind Lucky Story in the G2 Vintage S. July 30 and the latter finished runner-up to Carrizo Creek (Ire) in the G2 Richmond S. the previous afternoon. The largest obstacle for Team O'Brien is Khalid Abdullah's gifted **Three Valleys**. He stepped up off a fluent debut score in a conditions event at Nottingham May 16 to beat Botanical by an astounding eight lengths in the G3 Coventry S. at Royal Ascot June 17. A reproduction of that performance, which prompted a new juvenile track record and equaled Mill Reef's winning distance in the same race, would make him unopposable. However, the chestnut faces the might of the Ballydoyle army on their turf.

This contest offers an intriguing clash of proven seven-furlong specialists and milers taking on established sprinters. Heading the former category is **Nayyir**, who returned to his best when winning the G2 Lennox S. at Goodwood last time July 29, where **Tante Rose** was third. His performance in winning was all the more creditable as he was racing under a penalty for his impressive score in the G2 Challenge S. at Newmarket. But doubts surround his ability to act on a fast surface, and he needs to dispel those if he is to improve on his third to May Ball (GB) in this 12 months ago. **Etoile Montante** drops back from a mile after finishing third in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches May 11 and beating subsequent winner State of Art (Fr) in the Listed Prix des Lilas Compiègne May 26. Of the proven sprinters, **Ziping** has little improvement to find on his fine fourth-placings behind Choisir (Aus) in the G1 Golden Jubilee S. at Royal Ascot and to Oasis Dream (GB) in the G1 July Cup at Newmarket. He was a disappointing sixth in this race on testing ground last year, but will find this livelier going more to his liking. **Swedish Shave** holds **Vasywait** on his short-head beating of that rival in the G3 Prix de Ris-Orangis at this track July 6, but may find this trip stretching his stamina too far, as may **Porlezza**, who has yet to build on her two successes in the G2 Prix du Gros-Chêne over Chantilly's five.

Looking like she will live up to the accomplishments of her talented brothers, Tizdubai remained undefeated with another solid score. The bay filly made her debut at Hollywood July 6 and, after finding herself trapped behind horses at the quarter pole, unleashed an impressive late run that carried her to a 1 1/2-length tally. Trying stakes company in her second start, she was sent off the second choice, but proved best. The Calbred tracked favored Dirty Diana, an 8 1/2-length winner of the CTBA S. over this track July 25, as that one dashed through fractions of :22.09 and :44.35. The pacesetter held a 1 1/2-length lead at midstretch, but Tizdubai dug in with determination to take over inside the eighth pole before drawing away to win handily.

They may not be Affirmed and Alydar (yet), but Soto and Dynever put up one heck of a horse race in the stretch at Mountaineer, with Soto narrowly prevailing while clipping a full second off the track record. The chestnut colt had been earmarked as one to watch on the strength of three stretch-running victories at two, including a win in Churchill's GII Kentucky Jockey Club S. Nov. 30. But shin problems derailed the colt's Triple Crown chances, and trainer Michael Dickinson opted to point his charge towards a campaign during the latter half of 2003. Soto returned to action in an allowance at Philly Park July 19, defeating his elders by 3 3/4 lengths while covering six panels in 1:08 4/5. Sent off here as the second choice to Dynever, he tracked Cat Singer (Sir Cat) down the backstretch and struck the front turning for home. Dynever came up on the outside and had a head in front in midstretch, but Soto fought back bravely on the inside and won by a neck. "He's definitely a super horse," winning rider Ramon Dominguez told *The Blood-Horse*. "I'm not saying that because he won the race, but because of the way he did it. When [Dynever] came up to him, he had already gone past. But [Soto] put him away. By the feeling I got from him in the paddock, I was really confident." Soto's exploits have made their mark in sales catalogues. His half brother by Forest Wildcat brought \$675,000 Wednesday at Fasig-Tipton Saratoga. Click for the [brisnet.com chart](#).

Bare Necessities is really getting to like the Midwest, as the grey filly ran her record to three wins from four starts in the country's midsection with a facile victory in Ellis Park's lone graded event of the year. The eight-length winner of the GIII Indiana Breeders' Cup Oaks in 2001, she closed her sophomore campaign with a narrow defeat in the GII Churchill Downs Distaff H. last November. After finding Got Koko a bit too tough when third in the GII El Encino S. and fourth in the GII La Canada S. over the winter at Santa Anita, the homebred filly went on a three-race tear, capped by a 2 1/2-length score in the GIII Sixty Sails H. at Hawthorne Apr. 26. She was most recently a good third to Azeri in the GI Vanity H. June 21, but shipped East for this, bypassing a rematch with the champ in today's GII Clement L. Hirsch H. Content to race in midpack behind solid early fractions, Bare Necessities was asked to quicken approaching the stretch, charged three wide off the turn and powered home the way a 2-5 chance should. Sue's Good News started her career with three straight victories at Oaklawn, taking a maiden special weight first time out Mar. 2, an allowance Mar. 23 and the Instant Racing Breeders' Cup S. Apr. 12. She remained unbeaten in her next start, a \$62,500 optional claimer at Arlington June 19, but suffered her first defeat last out with a sixth-place finish in the GIII Delaware Oaks July 19. Sent off as the lukewarm favorite in this one, she raced near the middle of the pack, angled out for the drive, rallied late and was along in the closing yards. "When I got a chance to get her to the outside and give her a chance to run, she responded real well," winning jockey Tim Doocy said. "That day [in the Delaware Oaks], when they opened the gates, I knew something was wrong. She just wasn't herself. Thank God she came back healthy and it was just a minor thing. Dashboard Drummer outran his pedigree to earn his first graded score. The undefeated Oklahoma-bred is the son of Alamocitos, a stallion by Private Account who was purchased for \$320,000 as a KEESEP yearling and broke his maiden at Santa Anita, but ended his career at Prairie Meadows. Dashboard Drummer made his debut in Iowa, breaking his maiden May 9, then returned in the June 27 Prairie Gold Juvenile S. and scored by five. Interested in making a purchase, trainer Allen Iwinski flew out to Prairie Meadows after that race to take a look, but, at first glance, it seemed a wasted trip. "I wasn't that high on him when I first looked at him," Iwinski admitted, "but when I watched him train, I got excited." He was excited enough to spend \$200,000 to buy the juvenile, and it didn't take long for that investment to pay some dividends. Sent off the third choice, Dashboard Drummer sat near the back of the pack as Deputy Storm smoked through fractions of :21.31 and :43.82. Congaree Passing Pacific Classic?

Stonerside Stable's **Congaree** (Arazi) will likely skip the Aug. 24 GI Pacific Classic, according to trainer Bob Baffert. "He's training here," said the conditioner, "[but] I probably won't run him." Winner of Grade I events on both coast this year--the seven-furlong Carter H. at Aqueduct and the 10-furlong Hollywood Gold Cup--the five-year-old chestnut has the Oct. 25 GI Breeders' Cup Classic as his ultimate goal for the season. Congaree's efforts last year at Del Mar, a win in the GII Del Mar Breeders' Cup H. and a third in the GII San Diego H., were not among his career best. "This is not one of his favorite surfaces," Baffert told *Daily Racing Form*. "I want to have him ready for the Breeders' Cup. He likes to run fresh."

Seashore Breezes:

Preparing for the GI Pacific Classic two weeks hence, **Kudos** (Kris S.) flew through seven-eighths yesterday morning, in company with stablemate **The Tin Man** (Affirmed), who goes next in Saturday's GI Arlington Million. The pair covered the distance in 1:23.60. "They worked fantastic," said Richard Mandella, who trains both geldings. "They went strong all the way around and galloped out a strong mile."

Return of Miss Houdini:

Unbeaten **Miss Houdini** (Belong to Me), out of action since her win in the GI Del Mar Debutante a year ago, returns to the races this afternoon in the third race, a \$62,500 optional claimer going six furlongs. YORK GETS THE ROYAL MEETING Ascot's Chief

Executive Douglas Erskine-Crum yesterday announced that York will stage the 2005 Royal meeting, ending months of speculation as to which of York, Cheltenham, Newbury or Newmarket would host the meeting during Ascot's redevelopment "We had four very strong bids and we've decided to go to York," said Erskine-Crum. "We're going to shut down for 20 months and the current plan, pending the planning process, is that we will start the redevelopment in October next year and finish it in May 2006. We felt that York was already a world-class flat racecourse and they've got marvellous new facilities and a very strong management team. It's going to be called Royal Ascot at York and the model we have is the Breeders' Cup, where the Cup goes to a racecourse and they organise the event with the support and assistance of the host course. We will finance everything--the prizemoney and everything." Ascot will also fund the building of a new round course at the Knavesmire venue to accommodate the traditional staying races. "They are going to build a track extension so they have got a round course," he added. "All the long-distance races that are held at Royal Ascot will be able to be held on this new round course." William Derby, chief executive at York, responded by stating, "We're proud of our racecourse and hope the decision to transfer the meeting to York will be widely welcomed. We're delighted and honoured by this decision, which promises a unique spectacle for people in York and the surrounding region. There has been a lot of excitement and positive comment in the area since the move became a possibility."
