Trainer Todd Pletcher, on a tear at Saratoga, sends out undefeated **Limehouse** (Grand Slam) in the GII Saratoga Special S. this afternoon. The chestnut has come from off the pace in each of his three victories, handing the highly regarded **Cuvee** (Carson City) his first defeat in the GIII Bashford Manor S. at Churchill July 6. Pletcher, who has a veritable armada of talented two-year-olds this year, says that Limehouse has qualities beyond pure speed. "For a lightly raced horse, he's pretty seasoned," he said. "He overcame some adversity in both of his stakes. The last two times, he's been pretty professional. He sat behind horses, took dirt, split horses and finished up well." Cuvee had a horrible time of it as the 1-2 chalk in the Bashford Manor, but persevered in the stretch and could be the one to beat with a better trip. Rain has been plentiful at the Spa this season and if those showers come again, look out for **Pomeroy** (Boundary). The bay colt dominated both of his career starts on sloppy tracks, breaking his maiden at Belmont June 13 and adding a Monmouth allowance July 10. He hails from the barn of Patrick Biancone and owners Michael Tabor and Derrick Smith, all of whom teamed up to win Monday's GII Adirondack S. with Whoopi Cat.

**ANABAA DEPARTURE DELAYED**

Leading sire **Anabaa** (Danzig) was forced to miss his Aug. 10 flight to Australia after suffering a paddock injury at Haras du Quesnay in France. The 11-year-old stallion, slated to stand the Southern Hemisphere season at Widden Stud, tore ligaments in his left fore fetlock and will travel to Australia in a month's time. "Anabaa is such a magnificent stallion and such a valuable horse we could not risk him in any way," Widden's Antony Thompson told *racenet.com.au*, "so the decision was made to delay travel arrangements, and at this stage we hope to bring him to Sydney toward the end of August, meaning he would be released from quarantine by September 12." Anabaa had been forced to miss nearly the entire 2000 breeding season at Widden after suffering a penile abrasion. His son Yell (Aus) was recently named Australia's champion sprinter for 2002/2003 on the strength of three Group 1 wins.

**WHOOPI CAT UPDATE**

Derrick Smith and Michael Tabor's **Whoopi Cat** (Tale of the Cat) has emerged from her victory in Monday's GII Adirondack S. in good order and could make her next start at the beginning of the upcoming Belmont meet, trainer Patrick Biancone commented yesterday. "I spoke with Mr. Tabor and Mr. Smith [this morning] and she is going to be aimed for the [GI] Matron S. [at Belmont Park Sept. 14]," the conditioner commented. "In the mud, I thought the Adirondack was a very tough race for a young filly, so we want to see how she comes back, but that's the plan for now." Following her six-length maiden victory in the Belmont mud July 11, the dark bay was purchased privately from owner Richard Giacobelli, who also bred the filly. Biancone is not part of the ownership group, as was incorrectly reported in Tuesday's *TDN*.

**JAPANESE DUO HEADED TO DEAUVILLE** Japan's Shadai Race Horse Co. will field a pair of contenders for Sunday's G1 Prix du Haras de Fresnay-le-Buffard Jacques le Marois at Deauville in **Lohengrin (Jpn)** (Singspiel {Ire}) and **Telegnosis (Jpn)** (Tony Bin {Ire}). The pair will bid to follow in the footsteps of Japan-based Taiki Shuttle (Devil's Bag), who won the one-mile race in 1998. Lohengrin has a pair of Group 2 victories this season in Japan and is coming off a third to Agnes Digital in the G1 Yasuda Kinen June 8. The four-year-old is a son of Carling (Fr), who took the G1 Prix de Diane and the G1 Prix Vermeille in 1995. Telegnosis took last year's G1 NHK Mile Cup, but ran seventh in the Yasuda Kinen.

**HUGHES KEEPS FAITH IN VALLEYS** Jockey Richard Hughes has elaborated on the performance of **Three Valleys (Diesis {GB})**, who was third in Sunday's G1 Phoenix S. at The Curragh. The impressive G3 Coventry S. winner was found to have mucus in his lungs by the racecourse vet; plans are on hold for Khalid Abdullah's talented colt. "After I'd gone a furlong I knew I wouldn't win," Hughes explained. "In the Coventry he took me there and nothing was going to beat me at any stage of the race, but because of my style of riding [at The Curragh] it made it look as though he was going easily, but I certainly wasn't happy. If they've got mucus on their lungs they don't win anything--the reason he finished third is because he's so good." While connections have yet to plan the remainder of the chestnut's campaign, Hughes is certain that the juvenile remains a colt of Classic potential. "He'll get further, but the reason he's so speedy is because most of the good ones have speed," said the jockey. "I'm not going to give up hope on him, and he'll probably come back for the G1 Middle Park S. [Oct. 3]."

Private Account was a fine racehorse and an outstanding sire and broodmare sire. The late-developing son of Damascus won the GIII Jim Dandy S. at three, but peaked early the following year, when he captured the GI Gulfstream Park and GI Widener H. At stud he sired 61 stakes winners from 588 foals, including the undefeated Personal Ensign, other champions East of the Moon, Inside Information and Chimes of Freedom, and at least 12 more Group/Grade I winners, headed by Valley Crossing, Personal Flag, Private Terms, Unaccounted For, Corporate Report and Secret Hello.

Private Account's daughters have become sought after producers, and in that role he already appears in the pedigrees of more than 70 stakes winners. There is one area, however, in which success has eluded Private Account, and that is as a sire of sires. It's true that at least 15 sons of Private Account have sired stakes winners, but none have established themselves as a top commercial sire, the leaders being New York's Personal Flag (a brother to Personal Ensign), who is responsible for 26 stakes winners, including the all-time record earning New York-bred Say Florida Sandy, and Private Terms, who is responsible for Grade I-winning Afternoon Deelites and \$2,000,000-plus earner, Soul of the Matter.

This weekend, though, was an unusually notable one for Private Account sons, with two of his less heralded representatives recording their first graded stakes winners. First to tally was Alamocitos, whose son Dashboard Drummer put away odds-on favorite Deputy Storm to win the GIII Sapling S. We have to confess we had never heard of Alamocitos, nor for that matter, had ever previously come across Magic Moment II, Just Groovin, Telekinesis or Kings Blood, the sires of Dashboard Drummer's first four dams. This is not entirely astonishing, however, since none of these ever conspired to win a stakes event. Dashboard Drummer's female line is equally uninspiring, as none of his first five dams ever produced a stakes winner prior to the weekend, and the first four dams have only produced 14 winners between them.

At least Alamocitos did bring some quality to the situation in terms of his pedigree. Out of the Hoist the Flag mare Raclette, he is a brother to graded stakes winner Tong Po, and half-brother to the stakes winning Willamae, herself the dam of GISWs Will's Way and Willa on the Move as well as the excellent Maryland stallion Citidancer. Alamocitos himself was a \$320,000 Keeneland September yearling in 1995, but after breaking his maiden at Santa Anita, his form declined and he ended his career competing at Prairie Meadows. Alamocitos retired to stand at stud in Oklahoma and Dashboard Drummer is a member of his first crop.

Dashboard Drummer is an outcross at five generations, and although one might speculate about some build-ups of various strains further back in the pedigree, it's more realistic to regard him as a genetic lottery ticket winner, the odds of such a background producing a graded stakes winner being at least as long.

Private Account was a superior sire of off-track performers and while the slop may have assisted Dashboard Drummer, there's little doubt that it played a major part in the victory of Private Horde in the GIII Alfred G. Vanderbilt H. The longshot in the field, Private Horde, who has won four of seven in the mud, splashed home five lengths clear. He is the first graded stakes winner for the Private Account stallion Brunswick. Out of the Mr. Prospector mare Doff (a 3/4-sister to Forty Niner), Brunswick was a very talented performer on his best day, recording his sole stakes triumph when winning the GI Whitney H. by 3 1/2 lengths over West By West and Devil His Due. Retired to stud in Kentucky, Brunswick has sired only one other stakes winner from his first four crops. Consigned to the most recent Keeneland January Sale, he realized just \$5,000 and now stands in Canada.

Private Horde's dam Manila Rose failed to hit the board in five starts, but the daughter of Manila has produced three winners with her first three foals, including the Repriced filly Pricearose, runner-up in the GIII Locust Grove H. There is a significantly better record of achievement in the female line of Private Horde, as his granddam Golden Horde captured the GI Monmouth Oaks and his fourth dam Czarina took third in the Coaching Club American Oaks.

Private Horde is a product of the Private Account/Lyphard cross which has also produced other graded stakes winners Miss Pickums (like Private Horde, out of a mare by Manila). It's probably also significant that Private Horde has a double of the mare Pocahontas (by Roman out of a mare by Princequillo), through her sons Tom Rolfe and Chieftain, while his fourth dam Czarina is by Princequillo out of a mare by Roman, and so bred on the reverse cross to Pocahontas.

**QUEEN FOR A DAY** German-based **Walzerkoenigin** (Kingmambo) stretched her legs ahead of Saturday's GI Beverly D. S., covering five furlongs in 1:06 3/5 on the Arlington turf, with the dogs well out from the rail. "We only cantered," said Paul Harley, traveling manager for the Von Ullmann operation. "All our major preparations were done at home. The ground was beautiful today. I don't think you can get better ground anywhere than you have right here at Arlington." The peripatetic four-year-old, a winner of group events in France, Germany and Italy, is coming off a third in the G2 Falmouth S. at Newmarket July 9. "She loves to travel, and she travelled with no problem this time," said trainer Peter Schiergen. The bay will face a stiff test in the Beverly D., with **Voodoo Dancer** (Kingmambo), **Dress to Thrill (Ire)**, **Dublino** (Lear Fan) and **Owsley** (Harlan) slated to start, while **Heat Haze (GB)** (Green Desert), **Riskaverse** (Dynaformer) and **Bien Nicole** (Bien Bien) are listed as possible. Walzerkoenigin carries the colors of Baroness Karin Von Ullmann, whose son Georg races the undefeated **Soto** (Dehere), hero of last Saturday's GIII West Virginia Derby. It marked Von Ullmann's first visit to Mountaineer Park. "The trip was very enjoyable," said Von Ullmann, "and the winner's share [\$360,000] of the purse added to the enjoyment."

**SULAMANI GOING FOR A CENTURY** **Sulamani (Ire)** (Hernando {Fr}) will likely be favored in Saturday's GI Arlington Million, but the four-year-old will also be seeking to give owner Godolphin Racing their 100<sup>th</sup> Group 1 victory. The bay, who kicked off the year with an impressive tally in the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic, has dropped two starts since, but will be looking to build on his solid second in the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. July 26. "He's ready to go forward and get ready for the Breeders' Cup," said Simion Crisford, Godolphin's racing manager. "He went into the King George very well and we do think he's progressed since then."

**TRF PROGRAM FEATURED IN NY TIMES** The issue of Thoroughbred retirement, recently thrust into the national spotlight following news of the demise of Kentucky Derby hero Ferdinand at a slaughterhouse in Japan, received prominent coverage on the front page of **Sunday's New York Times**. The paper did a feature on a program that pairs convicted felons with retired racehorses in upstate New York. The work initiative, which has been operated in partnership with the Thoroughbred Retirement Foundation (TRF) for the past 18 years, teaches inmates at Wallkill Correctional Facility the basics of caring for an 1,100-pound animal. Diana Pikulski, Executive Director of the TRF, commented, "I hope that people interested in the rehabilitation of prison inmates will take a new look at the TRF program as a result of the story in the *New York Times*, because it not only helps to rehabilitate the horses, but makes the inmates involved in the program into better citizens. To date, it has pretty much been a one-sided affair supported by the horse industry. It's personally gratifying for me to be part of such a beautiful, positive good-news story which sheds light on the support the racing industry has given to this partnership that we created between our sport and the department of corrections." The TRF also operates partnerships with the Blackburn Correctional Facility in Lexington, Ky., and the Marion County Correctional Institution in Lowell, Fla. **SMOKESTER COLT TOPS DEL MAR SALE**

A dark bay colt by Smokster out of the unraced Prized mare Prizes are Lovely brought a \$160,000 final bid Monday night to top the second and final session of the annual California Thoroughbred Breeders' Association Del Mar Yearling Sale held at the Del Mar Horse Park. Consigned by Jack and Barb Hatch's Green Acres Stable, agent, [hip 115](#) was purchased by the partnership of Dave Hulkewicz and Mercedes Stables. The colt will be trained by California trainer Bruce Headley. [Hip 59](#), a dark bay colt by In Excess (Ire) out of Gift to the World (His Majesty) realized the second highest price of the sale when NW Management/Fleetwood closed the deal at \$140,000. The colt was consigned by Mary Knight, agent. This year's gross receipts decreased from \$4,289,500 for 98 head sold last year to \$3,105,500 for 90 lots this term. Also on the down side, average slumped from \$43,770 in 2002 down to \$34,506 this year while median fell 25.5 percent, from \$32,000 to \$25,500.
