TEMPESTUOUS FINISH TO MILLION

Storming Home (GB) (Machiavellian) crossed the finish line first in yesterday's GI Arlington Million, but not before crossing the paths of several rivals as he spooked from something on the inside rail just a stride from the wire. The dark bay threw his ears up and took a right-hand turn, bothering **Paolini (Ger)** (Lando {Ger}) and **Kaieteur (Marlin)**. Jockey Gary Stevens managed to hang on until the race was over, then tumbled to the turf. Andreas Suborics, aboard Paolini, and Rene Douglas, on Kaieteur, claimed foul and the stewards had no choice but to move those two, who had finished in a dead-heat for third, into the second spot, as Storming Home was demoted to fourth. That gave **Sulamani (Ire)** (Hernando {Fr}) the Million win and gave owner Godolphin its 100th Grade/Group One victory. **Arlington Million cont. p2**

FUR CAN'T STOP FASHION

It may not rank as the greatest upset in Saratoga's storied history, but the track's reputation as the Graveyard of Favorites came into play once more as 8-1 **Island Fashion** (Petionville) took command on the far turn to derail the Triple Tiara bid of 4-5 **Spoken Fur** (Notebook) in the GI Alabama S. at Saratoga yesterday. Island Fashion had previously been trained by Nick Canani, but recently joined Barclay Tagg's shedrow. "She was already a made horse when I got her, and she ran beautifully," said Tagg. "This is an awesome race to win, and I couldn't be any happier." Tagg had arrived at Saratoga hoping to run Funny Cide in next week's GI Travers S., but with that race looking increasingly doubtful for the Derby winner, the \$750,000 Alabama becomes a pretty solid consolation prize. "If you win the Kentucky Derby, Preakness and Alabama, you've got to have a pretty complete year," Tagg philosophized. Spoken Fur, so impressive in winning the GI Mother Goose S. and the GI Coaching Club American Oaks, came up empty this time. "She was in the bridle on the first turn," said jockey Jerry Bailey. "She came out of it and relaxed on the backside. I wanted to creep up on the leaders, but I had no horse." **Alabama cont. p2**

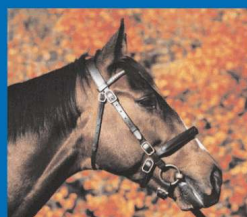

HOT STUFF

Juddmonte's **Heat Haze (GB)** (Green Desert) came from last to first under a well-timed ride by Jose Valdivia Jr. to snatch victory in the GI Beverly D. S. at Arlington yesterday afternoon. It was the fourth win in five U.S. starts for the nearly black filly, who is a 3/4-sister to 2001 Eclipse champ Banks Hill (GB). Local longshot **Bien Nicole** (Bien Bien) led nearly every step before settling for second. Heat Haze's victory was the 18th Grade I race won by trainer Bobby Frankel in 2003, leaving him just four short of the record set by D. Wayne Lukas in 1987. **Beverly D. cont. p4**

Stevens Held Blameless...**

Rene Douglas, who was booed by the Arlington crowd after disputing the outcome of the Million, did not blame Stevens for the incident. "It wasn't his fault, but it cost me," Douglas said. "He definitely bothered me. I had to do something, it's a million-dollar race." He was as concerned about Stevens' health as he was about the stewards' decision. "Is he OK?" he asked. "I only missed him by inches. It was very lucky that I was able to avoid him." A horse did step on Stevens' left shoulder. The results of the X-rays taken at Northwest Community Hospital were not immediately available, but Arlington Chaplain Dennis Nelson, who was with the Hall of Famer in the emergency room, said, "Gary is conscious and talking."

Godolphin Makes the Grade...

Sulamani, who had earned a Group 1 win for Godolphin when taking the 2003 Dubai Sheema Classic, rallied to give the stable its 100th victory at the elite level despite finishing a half-length behind Storming Home. "Having won 100 Group/Grade One races on three different continents in 11 countries over 10 years has been quite an accomplishment," Godolphin Racing Manager Simon Crisford said. "However, we would have much preferred not to have won in this manner." Sulamani captured the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club while carrying the colors of the Niarchos family last year, then changed hands after finishing 3/4 of a length back in second in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe. He followed his Dubai score with an even fifth in the June 29 G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud, and was also moved up in that event, getting fourth after Millstreet (GB) was disqualified from third. Last time out, he finished a troubled second in the July 26 G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S. He was dropping back to 10 furlongs for the first time since April of 2002. "I'm happy with the way he ran," trainer Saeed bin Suroor said. - Island Fashion's three career wins have all come in stakes races, a unique accomplishment. Under the guidance of Nick Canani, the grey debuted in the Arizona Oaks at Turf Paradise Feb. 1, running fourth, then travelled to Santa Anita for a maiden Mar. 5. She missed by a nose in that 6 1/2-furlong test and was back on the road to New Mexico, graduating by two lengths in the WinStar/Sunland Park Oaks Mar. 29. Sent into top-flight competition, she weakened to be seventh behind Bird Town (Cape Town) in the GI Kentucky Oaks May 2 and was given a brief vacation. Returning to action in the GIII Delaware Oaks July 19, Island Fashion shook off an early challenge and drew off to win handily. Awesome Humor, winner of the GI Spinaway S. last year, had chased Island Fashion all the way around at Delaware, but got off to a better start this time and went up to set the pace while closely shadowed by her rival. Jockey John Velazquez pushed the button aboard Island Fashion heading into the far turn and his mount responded, opening up in the lane to give Velazquez his fifth winner on the card. "She's got a really nice cruising speed," said Velazquez. Never worse than second in his four prior tries on the turf, Kicken Kris belied his odds with a decisive victory in his first graded-stakes attempt. The bay had finished off the board in four of five dirt tries, then switched to the grass and scored at 18-1 at Gulfstream Mar. 13. He came back to take an allowance test at the Florida oval Apr. 4 before taking a break. Beaten a nose on his return in a Delaware allowance July 1, he came back 11 days later and was the runner-up again, rallying for second in the 10-furlong Virginia Derby at Colonial Downs. Overlooked by the Arlington crowd despite the solid effort at the Secretariat distance, Kicken Kris tracked 69-1 Native Hawk (Northern Afleet) for a mile, came with a three-wide move on the final bend and pulled away late to post the upset. "[Owner Mrs. Elizabeth Moran] wanted a horse to run on the dirt, but once we got him on the turf, well, it looks like this horse's true talent is on the turf and he showed it today," trainer Michael Matz said. Added jockey Javier Castellano, "He broke sharp and I rode him comfortably and confident. I knew I had the horse today." The 3-1 favorite, Just Wonder (GB) (Hernando {Fr}) made a mild middle move and flattened out before fading to 10th.

Puzzlement had knocked on the door in several prior tries against graded company, but finally broke through yesterday, rallying along the rail to post his first win at the level. The four-year-old was third in both the GI Donn H. and the GII Gulfstream Park H. earlier this season, then finished off the board in three of his next four appearances. He picked up his first win of the campaign in the slop at Saratoga July 24, closing from off the pace to take a nine-furlong allowance test. Last time out, the bay colt was sent off an unconsidered 21-1 shot in the Aug. 2 GI Whitney H. and ran a promising fourth, beaten just 2 1/2 lengths by Medaglia d'Oro. The third choice facing a softer field this time, Puzzlement trailed through the opening half as Volponi pressed Blue Boat (Gulch) on the front end. The pacesetter carried Volponi wide as they raced into the stretch and the winner took advantage, grabbing the lead from the inside at the eighth pole and drawing clear. "Today we got lucky," trainer Allen Jerkens, once again playing the role of Giant Killer, said. "Horses that run in his style have to get lucky. It looked like the pace was too slow for him, but he slipped through nice and we got a good ride and that's what you have to have unless you have a champ." Puzzlement could make his next start in the GI Woodward S. Sept. 6. Odds-on favorite Volponi held second. "No excuses," trainer Phil Johnson said. "The winner just outran him in the stretch." Heat Haze once again exhibited her patented late run to earn her first Grade I win. Like her older siblings Banks Hill and Dansili, she began her career in France, but with less fanfare, concluding her sojourn there with a win in the Listed Prix Coronation last September before heading to California. Jockey Jose Valdivia Jr. piloted her to a pair of wins at Santa Anita, including the GIII Las Cienegas H. Apr. 5, then joined her at Churchill and guided her to a rallying win in the GIII Distaff Turf Mile on Derby Day. Heat Haze stretched out an additional furlong with Jerry Bailey aboard in the G1 Diana H. at Saratoga July 26 and just failed to hold off Voodoo Dancer by a neck. Settled at the back of the pack through soft fractions here, she waited for room at the quarter pole, then found a seam and shifted gears. "She has an enormous turn of foot," said Valdivia. "After she switched leads, I just tapped her twice and she was gone." Mubtaker is a thoroughly genuine performer and loves Newbury. He has been beaten only once at the track, losing to Grandera (Ire) in the Listed Arc Trial in September 2001, and enjoyed his finest hour in this contest 12 months ago. He surpassed that effort here to become the first horse since Ardross (GB) in 1982 to win back-to-back renewals. The six-year-old, who, for the second year in a row was injured while wintering in Dubai, had shown he retained all his ability and enthusiasm last time when beating Parasol (Ire) by 1 1/2 lengths in the Listed Steventon S. at this venue July 19. Reined back into third from the gate yesterday, he demonstrated his customary keenness in the hands of Richard Hills, but soon settled off the solid fraction set by Systematic. Traveling strongly on the heels of that rival in the straight, he quickened to the front passing the three-furlong marker before stretching clear for an emphatic victory. He has the options of tackling the G1 Irish St Leger at The Curragh Sept. 13 before a tilt at the G1 Melbourne Cup at Flemington Nov. 4, or dropping back to a mile and a half for the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe Oct. 5. A perfect four-for-four on the year coming into this race, Soaring Free remained undefeated in 2003 with this determined effort. The Sam-Son homebred, who was gelded over the winter, started the year with a 7 3/4-length allowance win at Woodbine May 10, made it two in a row June 4, then switched to the turf and added a victory in the GII Nearctic H. June 22. The dark bay was bet down to 1-5 facing fellow Canadian-breds in the July 19 Ontario Jockey Club S. and kept the streak alive, but just barely, eking out a 3/4-length success. Odds-on once again here, he pressed Jeb's Wild through the opening quarter, took control after a half and held the runner-up at bay down the lane. "He was excellent today," winning jockey Todd Kabel said. "I was worried coming off that last race--he wasn't quite himself. But in the post parade today he was perfect. He was a lot more relaxed and he ran a tremendous race." Kabel added that while Soaring Free has been kept to sprint distances this term, he should handle a slightly longer trip. "I'm pretty sure he'll handle a mile without a problem," he said. That's good news, as trainer Mark Frostad remarked that the Sept. 14 GI Atto Mile is next. "That's what we've been pointing for all year," he said. "The outcome of his last few races says he probably deserves a shot in there. I think he'll be pretty tough. The more seasoning they get, the smarter they get. He's used to winning now and I think he likes that. He's becoming much more professional." Could the decision to geld the four-year-old have made the difference? Kabel says yes. Godolphin could start on their second century of Group or Grade One wins with **Dubai Destination** today at Deauville. The colt has become something of a flagship for the boys in blue, providing the highlight of their Royal Ascot experience when annihilating a competitive field in the G1 Queen Anne S. June 17. His four-length victory provided vindication for Sheikh Mohammed's decision to persevere with the four-year-old after a series of setbacks earlier in his career and suggests he can provide Godolphin with their third renewal of this race. Based on his G1 Breeders' Cup Mile victory at Arlington last October, **Domedriver** is a worthy opponent. He was giving seven pounds to Dandoun (GB) when beaten a short neck in the G2 Prix du Muguet on his return at Saint-Cloud May 1 before disappointing when fourth, 20 lengths behind Hawk Wing, in the G1 Lockinge S. at Newbury May 17. Last time out, he had no luck in running and ended up fifth behind **Special Kaldoun** in the G3 Prix Messidor July 13. Sophomores **Martillo** and **Clodovil** represent Classic-winning form. After Martillo took the G2 Mehl-Mulhens-Rennen and Clodovil won the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains, the two crossed paths in the G1 St James's Palace S. at Royal Ascot. Martillo came out on top, finishing third as Clodovil ran fifth behind Zafeen (Fr). Martillo came back to capture the G2 Grosser Porsche Preis July 13 and rates a serious threat, as does **Nebraska Tornado**. The filly took the G1 Prix de Diane Hermes last time June 8. The other distaffer is **Six Perfections**, runner-up in the G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket May 4, the Irish equivalent May 25 and the G2 Prix d'Astarte Aug. 3.

Claimed for \$50,000 after a 5 1/2-length tally in his 2002 finale on New Year's Eve, **Bluesthestandard** opened 2003 with four consecutive victories, including a two-length score in the Mar. 29 GII Potrero Grande Breeders' Cup H. and a four-length tally in the Apr. 26 GIII Texas Mile. Defending Pat O'Brien champ **Disturbingthepeace** has been held winless since taking this race last August. The five-year-old was third vs. Grade II company in his first two tries this year, but could do no better than 13th when shipped to Japan for the Mar. 30 G1 Takamatsunomiya Kinen. He returned to be fourth in the May 10 GIII L.A. Times H., took a short break, and comes into this after a lackluster sixth-place effort in the Bing Crosby. But the Cal-bred has won three of his five starts at Del Mar and four of six at this trip.

FAIR GROUNDS FILES FOR CHAPTER 11 In response to a court decision that could cost the New Orleans track more than \$100 million in video poker commissions, Fair Grounds has filed for protection under Chapter 11 of the U.S. Bankruptcy Code. Fair Grounds, which has been owned by the Krantz family since 1986, has offered video poker for 10 years. In 1994, the Louisiana Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association filed a lawsuit claiming that the state's tracks were taking too many deductions from the video poker revenues before determining the horsemen's share of the proceeds, and therefore were not properly supplementing the purses. While Evangeline Downs and Delta Downs had earlier reached settlements with the horsemen and Louisiana Downs settled when the Louisiana Supreme Court upheld the original ruling in favor of the horsemen this June, Fair Grounds, the only one of the four tracks not owned by a casino company, will continue to fight the decision. In a statement released yesterday, Fair Grounds officials said, "Fair Grounds vigorously disagrees with the court's ruling. Further, if the ruling stands, it is confident other parties involved in the litigation will ultimately be responsible for payment of what might be due to the horsemen. Fair Grounds is now proceeding to press its claim proving it is not the party responsible for the money due under the court's ruling. This process will take time." The statement continued, "Since the inception of video poker, the Fair Grounds has done exactly as directed by [an agency of the state of Louisiana] and has utilized the monthly reporting form provided by it to calculate and distribute funds." To protect itself while the case is ongoing, the track filed for bankruptcy, but said the decision will not affect the day-to-day racing and OTB operations. The 2003-2004 meet is slated to start on Thanksgiving, Nov. 27.
