### LIKE FATHER, LIKE SON

Six years ago, trainer Wally Dollase decided that Deputy Commander had matured enough to discard the blinkers, and the horse responded to win a stirring renewal of the GI Travers S. over Behrens. Yesterday, it was blinkers on for **Ten Most Wanted** (Deputy Commander) and the good-looking colt adapted well to the equipment change, collaring **Peace Rules** (Jules) at the quarter pole before powering home. "I think we'll use them again," Dollase said, referring to the blinkers. The runner-up to Empire Maker in the GI Belmont S., the colt seems to like the Empire State. ### CLASSY QUARTET FOR THE CLASSIC

Despite having its field trimmed from five to four with Friday's declaration of Kudos, this afternoon's \$1-million GI Pacific Classic features an accomplished quartet of older horses, headed by the Bobby Frankel-trained duo of **Medaglia d'Oro** (El Prado {Ire}) and **Milwaukee Brew** (Wild Again). While either one of those two dual Grade I winners could edge Frankel towards a record, owners Sid and Jenny Craig hope to derail that train with their rising star **Candy Ride (Arg)** (Ride The Rails). Undeclared in three starts in his native land, the bay, purchased privately for a reported \$900,000, is perfect in his two U.S. tries, including a win in the GI American H. over Special Ring, who returned to set a track record at Del Mar. The Classic is a race the Craigs desperately want to win. "It's in our backyard. It's where we are," Sid Craig told *Daily Racing Form*. "The Derby is the top race in the world, but except for that, this is the most important race for us." (Cont. p9)

### SLOW START, SOLID FINISH AT DEAUVILLE

After seeing six of the first 16 yearlings bought back, there was every reason to believe that day one of the Deauville August Yearling Sale might turn out to be a nightmare. But, with better animals being led through later in the session, activity resumed around the sales ring. While last year's opening day featured a €2-million Indian Ridge (Ire) filly, yesterday's proceedings had no such fireworks and figures were down across the board, bar the clearance rate, which rose to 75.5 percent this year from 64 percent in the corresponding session in 2002. The sale was hurt by the withdrawal of a colt by Dubai Millennium (GB) as well as the late declaration of hip 60, a half brother to French 2000 Guineas runner up Catcher In The Rye (Ire) by Giant's Causeway half an hour before he was scheduled to sell due to a high fever. Topping yesterday's activity was hip 51, a €900,000 colt by champion sire Sadler's Wells out of Sister Dot (Secretariat), making the Jan. 16 foal a half brother to the accomplished stallion Dehere (Deputy Minister). "He has a stallion pedigree and obviously when you go for that kind of money the looks match the pedigree," commented the BBA's Anthony Stroud. "I was prepared to go further, but in a boutique market, very selective, it can be sporadic and patchy." (Deauville August cont. p7-8)

**Taking Command...**

Given a bit of a breather following his outstanding effort in the Belmont, **Ten Most Wanted** resurfaced in the GII Swaps S. at Hollywood Park July 13. Over a track that was carrying inside speed the whole afternoon, the GII Illinois Derby winner challenged four wide into the lane and poked a head in front at the stretch call, but was outgamed by the pacesetter **During** (Cherokee Run) and settled for second. Trainer Wally Dollase made the decision to add blinkers following the Swaps and the colt proceeded to fire three bullet works in as many weeks at Santa Anita, which had him sitting on go for the return to New York.

**How The Race Was Won...**

Ten Most Wanted broke inward and brushed with **Peace Rules** (Jules), who was sent off the post-time favorite at odds of \$2.30-1. After bumping with longshot **Congrats** (A.P. Indy) entering the clubhouse turn, the dark bay settled into a nice gallop beneath jockey Pat Day as Peace Rules continued to slug it out on the front end with GII Jim Dandy S. winner **Strong Hope** (Grand Slam).

Angled out leaving the three-eighths pole, Ten Most Wanted forged to the front at the head of the lane, dueled with the Bobby Frankel trainee to the eighth pole before pulling away to win easily. "He's an awesome looking horse and looks so much like his sire. Both got it together mentally at this time of the year," commented winning trainer Wally Dollase, who became only the second in history to train both sire and son to victory in the Travers. "I didn't think he would win that easily. It's a real thrill to have an animal like him. I'm really privileged." Dollase indicated that he is inclined to leave the winner with his peers for now. Frankel was not disappointed in the effort of the runner-up. "He ran his race. He was game," he said

Valid Video became the second straight gelding, following Gygistar, to win this prestigious event. Winner of the GIII Sapling S. last summer, the Florida-bred won a pair of restricted events in the Sunshine State over the winter, then suffered a pair of losses. He got back on track with an impressive win in the GIII Carry Back S. at Calder, earning a 110 Beyer, but was the fifth choice in this competitive contest. Tucked into a ground-saving fourth by jockey Joe Bravo, Valid Video was full of run in midstretch, but was caught behind pacesetter Great Notion. He finally got to the outside and found the wire just in time. "I was a little leery, we were down on the inside, and I was screaming, 'Joe, get him out! Get him out!'" said trainer Dennis Manning, who was winning his first Grade I. "Once he got out, I know he would go on about his business. I think that Mr. [owner Mack] Fehsenfeld would want to take him to the Breeders' Cup [Sprint, Oct. 25 at Santa Anita]." A multiple Group 1 winner in his native South Africa, Trademark couldn't get near Ipi Tombe (Zim) in Dubai, but has blossomed since arriving in the U.S. Following a half-length loss to War Zone (Danzig) in the GIII Poker H. July 5, the bay put up an impressive performance in coming from just off the pace to land the GII Bernard Baruch H. July 25. He mirrored that performance here, skimming the rail in fourth as Quest Star led up front. Jockey Richard Migliore said 'go' at the head of the lane and Trademark responded, opening up a clear advantage in a matter of strides. "Lasix is the big issue with him," said winning trainer Kiaran McLaughlin. "When we brought him here, he bled when we first worked him. It was amazing how well he ran without Lasix." The South African-bred will await Keeneland before making his next start. "We'll probably give him a break and point for the Shadwell Mile [GI, \$600K, Keeneland, 10-4] in October," McLaughlin added. Priors Lodge, who took the Listed City of York S. at three and Listed Sovereign S. at Salisbury at four, sustained a fractured jaw after finishing third behind Olden Times (GB) in the G3 Earl of Sefton S. at Newmarket Apr. 16. He returned to Salisbury in a bid to win back-to-back renewals of the Sovereign S. last time Aug. 14, but came out second best by a short head to Passing Glance. That form was reversed in a virtual repeat of that race as the game duo bested more fancied rivals in this contest. Stalking Passing Glance, Priors Lodge was in prime position when that rival was kicked into a clear advantage at the top of the straight. Answering Willie Ryan's battle call in game fashion, he wore down Passing Glance in the final strides before asserting for this career-best score. "It was a dour battle again and they were always traveling well," trainer Marcus Tregoning commented. "It was a terrific ride by Willie [Ryan] and he was very confident today." Last year's winner Tillerman closed from rear to take third from the penalised Where or When (Ire), while the 5-4 favorite Arakan appeared not to stay having held every chance in the straight. Pearl of Love made every yard of this race to power to an impressive score, providing trainer Mark Johnston with his third victory in this contest. Taken to the front in the early stages, he had the Ballydoyle rabbit Mahogany (Ire) (Orpen) in trouble by halfway, lengthened clear inside the final quarter and was never in any danger from there. The Aidan O'Brien-trained Tumblebrutus held stable companion The Mighty Tiger in the battle for a distant second. "He's a proper Guineas horse," winning jockey Darryll Holland said. "There was a fifth gear there, which I didn't have to use." Pearl of Love recorded an impressive maiden score going six furlongs at Doncaster in his second start and relished the step up to seven furlongs when accounting for the Listed Chesham S. at Royal Ascot June 18. He had an imposed break after that outing due to a foot abscess, but has apparently thrived during his time off. The colt may return for the G1 National S. Stylish extended her winning streak to three races with a determined late run in yesterday's Ballston Spa. A three-length victress in the Lady Canterbury Breeders' Cup S. in mid-June, the Thoroughbred Corp. colorbearer won by a hard-fought neck in the GIII Eatontown H. over a soft Monmouth lawn July 19. Sent off a modest longshot here at the Spa, the bay was well placed in fourth under jockey John Velazquez while Cozy Corner led the way through splits of :23 2/5, :47 1/5, and 1:11 1/5. The latter stubbornly maintained her lead into the stretch as the rest of the pack readied their challenges, but couldn't fend off the game Stylish, who responded to her rider's urging to wrest away the lead in the final furlong. Snow Dance came running late to get the place spot. "It went perfectly," said Velazquez. "She settled nicely and when I pulled her out, she was right there. She responded right away." Those weren't bowling shoes he was wearing. Tenpins, sent off the even-money favorite, was sporting his running shoes yesterday. The five-year-old grabbed the lead at the half-mile pole and held off all challengers to win by a length over Aeneas. "We started pointing for this race at the beginning of the year," trainer Don Winfree said. "The timing was right--it's five weeks before the Hawthorne Gold Cup [GII, Sept. 28]. I don't like to run him a lot because he puts so much into his races." The Michigan-bred certainly gave it all he had here. Quick from the starting gate, he dogged 10-1 shot Private Lap (Private Terms) through the early fractions. The crowd's choice put a head in front after a half in :48.07, but he had to fight off first Jersey Giant, then Aeneas, before edging clear in the final strides. According to jockey Robby Albarado, the margin of victory could have been more. "When he gets out there by himself, he kind of waits for horses," Albarado said. "That's why he never wins by too much." The Iselin was Tenpins' fifth career stakes victory. The eye-catching chestnut took the GIII W.D. Schaefer H., GII Washington Park H. and GII Fayette S. last season. After running fourth in the GII Clark H. to end the campaign, the Joseph Vitello homebred was given a break, then had his return delayed by a bruised foot. He came back in the July 12 GIII Prairie Meadows Cornhusker H., winning by two lengths. Secret Liason stole away on the front end through sensible early fractions and kicked clear when the question was asked to stage the mild upset here. The sporadically raced five-year-old made just four starts last year, but won three of her four trips to the track and was a good head second in the other, the GII A Gleam H. last July. That effort was followed by seven-month respite, on which she finished a well-beaten seventh in her return to racing in the GIII Las Flores H. at Santa Anita in late February. A fourth in the Pine Tree Lane S. a month later prompted another shelving, and the bay went missing for five months before wiring a field of \$80,000 optional claimers over trip and track Aug. 6. Away best of all from post nine under jockey Corey Nakatani, Secret Liason dictated a quarter in :22 2/5 and a half in :45 flat while favored Cee's Elegance (Cee's Tizzy) tracked her intently while saving ground. That one failed to fire coming off the turn and Secret Liason left the quarter pole up by 2 1/2 lengths. The always game Lacie Girl attempted to mount a bid in mid-stretch, but could offer no serious threat as Secret Liason scampered home clear by open lengths.

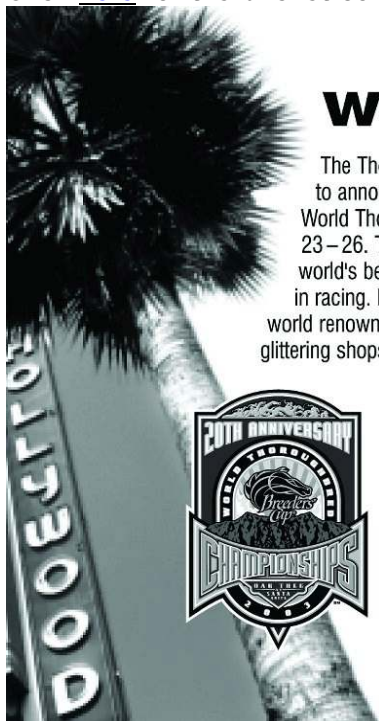

King's Best (Kingmambo) made a nice impression at yesterday's opening session, with seven sold from nine through the ring for an average of just over €175,000. John Ferguson signed the tickets on two of the Darley stallion's colts, including yesterday's second highest-priced offering. Hip 18, consigned by Haras d'Etream, is out of the Listed stakes winner Manureva (Nureyev), making the colt a half brother to GI Atto Mile winner Riviera (Fr) (Kris {GB}). He sold for €450,000. "We are happy with what we got," commented Haras d'Etream's Marc de Chambure, who sold both top colts. "The Sadler's Wells sold for a million dollars and everytime you sell a horse for that kind of money you have to be happy. He was a good looking animal with the right pedigree. The King's Best also sold well. He comes from a good family, had a good conformation and can certainly be a top racehorse." Robert Nataf of Horse France also went to €450,000 for hip 56, a colt by Anabaa out of Supergirl (Woodman), making him a half brother to this year's G1 French Derby runner-up Super Celebre (Fr). Nataf signed the ticket for an undisclosed client, but was next to trainer Elie Lellouche, the mentor of Super Celebre, during the bidding and there is strong speculation that Alec Wildenstein, owner of Super Celebre, is back buying yearlings.

***Nataf Stays Busy...***

Nataf added to his coffers when he went to €420,000 for a filly by leading freshman sire Fasliyev. Hip 54, consigned to the sale by Haras de la Reboursiere et de Montaigu, is out of Style for Life (Ire) (Law Society), the dam of Group 1 winner Night Style (Fr) and stakes winner and group-placed Maid of Dawkins (Ire). "The filly has been bought for Mr. Javier Gispert and, like some of his previous purchases, she will be trained in the Southwest of France at Pau by Francois Rohaut," Nataf explained. "She was the most beautiful filly in the sale, from a great family and, being by the new sensation sire Fasliyev, you must be prepared to pay some money."

**Day One By The Numbers...**

While the clearance rate rose to 75.5 percent from 64 percent a year ago, gross receipts totaled €7,036,000, down by 15.5 percent, and the average was off by 10 percent at €175,900. Much of the disparity in the figures is attributable to last year's overall sales topper. "We have a slight decrease, but we had a few top prospects taken out and we didn't have a €2-million horse in the sale tonight," commented Philippe Augier, general manager of Agence Francaise. "Therefore we are quite hopeful that by tomorrow night we will have filled the gap and be able to show an increase compared to last year's first two days."

**Anthony Stroud, BBA England (bought the top colt):**


*"I feel that it is a big mistake that there was no real top racing at Deauville on the weekend of the sale. It would have been better with the running of a race like the Le Marois or Prix Morny. It definitely attracts more people."*

**Martine Head, Haras du Quesnay, who bought the second highest priced filly:**

*"Personally, beside managing Haras du Quesnay, I am developing a new activity as a bloodstock agent under the name Quesnay Bloodstock and this filly is my first ever purchase. She is a lovely looking filly and it is wonderful to be able to access such a top family. She sold for exactly the same price as her full sister last year, so it shows that there is no inflation in the market. I can't yet say who I bought her for. She will be trained in France, but it has not yet been decided by who." She added, "I am quite disappointed at the outcome of this first day. There were some very nice horses that didn't sell as well as you could expect and colts are selling better than fillies. It is disappointing compared to the overall quality on offer."*

**LEATHERBURY SADDLES 6,000TH WINNER**

King Leatherbury made history yesterday at Timonium, becoming just the third trainer to hit the 6,000-win plateau. The mark was reached when Cherokee Sunrise (Cherokee Run), a two-year-old runner making his third career start, romped by 4 1/4 lengths to break his maiden in the seventh race. "We've been waiting for this so long," said the Leatherbury, who took out his trainer's license in 1958 during the Eisenhower administration. "It was very exciting to see [Cherokee Sunrise] make his move at the head of the stretch, because it was obvious we were going to win. It was exciting, but we thought we'd be doing this three weeks ago. We just couldn't win a race at Laurel [Leatherbury went 0-26 at the summer meet] and it got very frustrating." When asked about the staggering number of victories he's accrued, the 70-year-old added modestly, "I don't know how it happened. The wins just added up over the years. It is amazing to think that only two trainers in history have won more races. I am honored to be in their company." Leatherbury now sits behind Dale Baird (8,819 wins) and Jack Van Berg (6,334) on the all-time wins list.

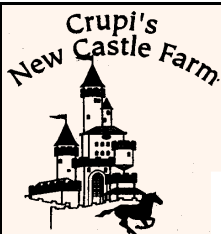

He finished sixth behind the subsequent G2 Richmond S. winner Carrizo Creek (Ire) in the Goffs Challenge at The Curragh June 27 before finishing third in a decent conditions event at Sandown last time Aug. 13. Sent to the front in the early stages by Jimmy Fortune, he turned an uncontested lead to his advantage, quickening at the top of the straight to comfortably hold Voix du Nord in the drive to the line. "He has a tendency to look around too much in his races," trainer John Gosden explained. "That's why we fitted him with blinkers today and he really enjoyed himself over this mile. A Group 3 is the logical next step and the softer the better."
