**HOW SWEET IT IS**

Jockey Julie Krone yesterday became the first female rider to win a million-dollar race, guiding **Candy Ride (Arg)** (Ride the Rails) to a 3 1/4-length victory over favored **Medaglia d'Oro** (El Prado {Ire}) in the GI Pacific Classic at Del Mar. In the process, she handed trainer Bobby Frankel his fourth loss of the weekend in Grade I company. "Bobby's got to give us a break some-time," said Hall of Famer Ron McAnally, celebrating his

first victory in the event. The final time for the 10-furlong test was 1:59.11, a new stakes and track record. "I have to give all the credit to the horse," Krone said. "I just had to shake the reins at him. **NOT AGAIN**

**Shine Again** (Wild Again), the two-time defending champ in the GI Ballerina H. at Saratoga, came up about one stride short yesterday, finishing a nose behind **Harmony Lodge** (Hennessy). "She was fanned out coming home and I had to go four wide, but there was nothing I could do about it," said Shine Again's pilot, Jose Santos. "She's a good mare, she was just a jump short today." Harmony Lodge broke on top and set a pressured pace, clipping off fractions of :22.70 and :45.06. She opened a little daylight at the eighth pole, then was all out to hold off the hard-charging favorite. "I got a great trip," winning rider Richie Migliore said. "The post played in our favor and I was able to get out there early and easily. **JUST DESSERTS**

Adding her name to the long list of Grade I winners by her illustrious sire, **Dessert** (Storm Cat) led the field from gate to wire to take the GI Del Mar Oaks by a diminishing neck over **Solar Echo** (Spinning World) yesterday afternoon. Winning jockey Corey Nakatani also rode the filly's dam, two-time Canadian champion and MGISW Windsharp. Of the daughter, Nakatani said, "She's a strong-minded filly, just like her mother. You've got to be patient." Added trainer Richard Mandella, "This is a nice filly. She's loaded with talent and loaded with pedigree. **Six Starts...Six Wins...**

Now a perfect six-for-six, **Candy Ride (Arg)** started his career in his native country, but couldn't find a horse that could compete with him. The bay won his three Argentine outings, including two Group 1 stakes, by a combined 28 lengths. After seeing tapes of the colt, trainer Ron McAnally, who made U.S. champs out of South American stars Bayakoa (Arg) and Paseana (Arg), was sure he'd finally found his Pacific Classic winner. "We picked this horse out in January," McAnally said. "I showed the tapes to [owners Sid and Jenny Craig] and told them, 'this is the horse that can win the race you want to win.'" The colt made his U.S. debut in an optional claimer at Hollywood in June, winning by three lengths, but had to work hard to keep his perfect record intact last time. The even-money favorite in the GII American H. on July 4, he outgamed Special Ring to win it by 3/4 of a length. Candy Ride didn't have nearly so tough a fight of it yesterday. He tracked Medaglia d'Oro early, went up on even terms at the top of the stretch and opened up on his rival to win handily. "How good a horse is he?" said Julie Krone. "Wow, that's how good he is. Amazing. He is a rocketship." The final time broke the standard of 1:59.40 set by Bertrando in 1993 and tied by Tinnors Way in 1994.

**No Excuses for the Favorite...**

**Medaglia d'Oro** came into this event on a three-race winning streak after taking the GII Strub S. at Santa Anita Feb. 1, the GII Oaklawn H. Apr. 5 and the GI Whitney H. at Saratoga Aug. 2. The dark bay was allowed to set a reasonable fractions, but could not match strides with the winner down the lane. "Basically, we were second best today," jockey Jerry Bailey said. "Everybody wanted to find out just how good Ron's horse was. Well, we found out. He's pretty damn good. My horse was going along easy--he was doing it on his own. I never asked him to run at all until we hit the far turn. When Candy Ride came to me and then went on by, I just called out to Julie, 'Go get 'em, girl.' They were best. My horse ran a good race, but we got beat." The other half of the Frankel entry, **Milwaukee Brew** (Wild Again), made a mild bid after six furlongs, but faltered late and finished fourth in the four-horse field. "Obviously something is amiss with him," his Hall of Fame trainer said. "I don't know what." Added jockey Edgar Prado, "Today just wasn't his day."

The longest shot on the board at nearly 13-1, Harmony Lodge had shown an affinity for the Saratoga surface in the past, breaking her maiden at the Spa three years ago and adding an 11-length allowance score last year. She started this season with back-to-back Grade III wins at Gulfstream Park, including a three-length tally over Gold Mover in the Feb. 14 GIII Shirley Jones H., but finished second to that rival in the Hurricane Bertie S. in Hallandale Mar. 16. Freshened after that effort, the chestnut was third to Shine Again in the May 11 GII Genuine Risk H. on her return. She shipped to Woodbine to post a 5 1/2-length tally in the June 22 Sweet Briar Too S., then traveled to Calder and was third to Gold Mover after cutting out fast fractions in the July 12 GII Princess Rooney H. last time out. "The only thing missing on her resume was a Grade I win," trainer Todd Pletcher said. "She has run well enough at times to win a Grade I, it was just a matter of getting the right set-up. The outside post helped...when you're on the outside, you can kind of dictate your pace as opposed to having someone outside dictating it to you...and Richie [Migliore] rode a beautiful race. This was just the perfect set-up."

Dessert started her career in France, but was badly beaten in two outings last season. She was transferred to the U.S. at the end of the year and showed promise in her stateside debut, running third on the turf at Santa Anita Feb. 20. A 3/4-length maiden winner over Fudge Fatale in her next appearance Mar. 23, she then took a two-month break, returning to finish second by 3/4 of a length to that rival in an optional claimer at Hollywood May 24. Rested again after that effort, the dark bay teamed up with Corey Nakatani for the first time in her latest and cruised to a front-running 3 1/2-length tally in a Del Mar allowance test Aug. 4. The crowd's choice as part of an entry in her stakes debut, Dessert once again made all the running before hanging on gamely to win her second straight. "With her speed and ability, she could be special," Nakatani said. "She's still young and learning, but she's learning fast." Trainer Richard Mandella has been working overtime to school The Thoroughbred Corporation homebred. "We give her a special-education class every day," he said. "She can be real sweet or real bad. It depends on how the wind blows. But she's getting a little better every day--maybe a lot better today. It takes a lot of patience and a lot of repetition." Entrymate Atlantic Ocean (Stormy Atlantic), who likely accounted for the duo's role as favorite, pressed the pace from second before tiring to be fifth.

There seem to be two Darasims, but the right one turned up at Deauville on this occasion to record a career-best effort in imperious fashion. Left alone on the lead by his rivals, he was coaxed through easy early fractions by jockey Joe Fanning and set alight at the top of the straight. Despite the attentions of Westerner and Swing Wing, he lengthened further clear inside the final eighth for a convincing score. Darasim picked up his first stakes score in the Listed Glorious S. at Goodwood in similar fashion last August, then finished third in the G3 Lonsdale S. at York later that month before ending the season with a third-place showing in the G3 Doncaster Cup in September. His connections were hopeful that he would develop into a top stayer this term, but his form had begun to tail off until he bounced back to win a handicap at the Glorious Goodwood meeting July 29. Looking to repeat in the Glorious S. three days later, he sulked throughout the early stages of the race, but came flying late to finish third. The bay made his French debut here. "We took him to France as the races are run at a slower pace here and it helps him," trainer Mark Johnston commented. "He likes to have his own way in front [before] quickening on the turn for home and Joe [Fanning] got it right here. This is his best performance and a big step up. The winner of the GI Hollywood Gold Cup and the GI Mervyn Leroy H. last season, Sky Jack was the favorite facing lesser foes here and got the job done in style. Sidelined after running 11th behind Came Home in the GI Pacific Classic last August, the veteran made his comeback in an allowance race at Hollywood June 13, finishing sixth. The gray improved sharply in his second start after the lengthy layoff, winning an allowance in Inglewood July 5, and proved more than ready to face stakes company in his third start of the season. Always prominent, the Cal-bred had a head in front after six furlongs in 1:08.20 and jetted away from the field in the final furlong to win as much the best. The final time for the mile was a track-record 1:33. "We were going fast, but he was relaxed," winning jockey Russell Baze said. "He started to gawk when he got the lead, but I asked and he responded. I just tapped him a little and went on. I was a little worried when he went to the front, but he just needed a little extra encouragement. I didn't want to take any chances that someone would run him down from behind." Added trainer Doug O'Neill, "Everything went perfect. This horse really has been very special. I told Russell to try and take the lead if they weren't going too fast. I said just use your experience. Gracefully provided rookie trainer Sylvester Kirk with his most important success when she delivered a decisive turn of acceleration to take this contest. Purchased for just 10,000 guineas at the Doncaster St Leger Yearling Sales in September, she was sharp enough to win on her debut in a six-furlong maiden at this track June 20 before following up in a conditions race at Salisbury last time July 12. Stepped up in trip here, she was settled in a distant third by John Egan as the tearaway leader Dubaian Duel ripped through the early stages. Quickening alongside Ithaca in the straight, she stayed on the strongest of that duo to lead 300 yards out and remained clear for the score. "She looks like a really good filly," Kirk said. "It was amazing. The biggest problem is what to do with her now, but it's a nice problem. We have to think about the 1000 Guineas after that." State of Art has overcome a serious injury sustained as a two-year-old to emerge as one of her country's leading sophomore fillies. She started off this term in fine fashion when winning a Saint-Cloud conditions event May 7 before finishing a half-length runner-up to Etoile Montante in the Listed Prix des Lilas at Compiègne May 26. She spent June and July off the track due to the prevalent fast ground, but showed a dramatic turn of acceleration on her return to win the Listed Prix de la Calonne at this track Aug. 2. Stalking the steadily increasing tempo set by Jamie Mackay on Hoh Buzzard throughout the early stages of this contest, she was asked to quicken at the top of the straight and responded by passing the long-time leader with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining. Driven out to assert from there, she had to battle to subdue the game runner-up, while Felicity proved the best closer from the waiting pack in behind. "She proved again what a smart filly she is," commented winning trainer David Smaga. "She has never been out of the first two in her career and could have been even better but for the bad fracture she suffered last year. She has progressed with each race and will go for the G1 Prix Vermeille [at Longchamp Sept. 14]."

**LADIES DAY AT DEAUVILLE** The top 10 lots sold yesterday at the Deauville Yearling Sales were all fillies as activity during the second day remained solid. Top price on the day was Hip 110, a bay filly by Diesis (GB) out of stakes-placed Gontcharova (Ire) (Zafonic), who is herself a half sister to six stakes horses, including Grade I winner Roi Normand (Exclusive Native) and MGSW Trampoli (Trempolino). Consigned by Haras du Mezeray, she was knocked down for €370,000 to young bloodstock agent Guilain Bozo, who was having his first major purchase in a sale. "She is a beautiful filly, who walked very well and was quite athletic," Bozo said. "I bought her for a new French investor who wants to build up a breeding operation from sound families. She will be trained in France." He added, "The market was healthier than yesterday, with no patches." The second-highest price yesterday was for Hip 109, a daughter of top sire Kingmambo out of Gold Bust (GB) (Nashwan). The filly is out a half sister to G1 Coronation S. and G1 Prix Marcel Boussac winner Gold Splash (Blushing Groom {Fr}); her third dam is Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe heroine Gold River (Fr). From the Watership Down Stud consignment, she was purchased for €350,000 by Gérard Larrieu of Chantilly Bloodstock, who was bidding on behalf of owner Jean Louis Bouchard, owner of probable G1 Prix Morny favourite Much Faster. The agent, who bought one Saturday night and three more Sunday, felt that the market was strong. "It is indeed," he said. "We were beaten on quite a few Saturday. It is very selective and, when a good animal goes through the ring, there are real bidding fights. We liked that filly for her looks and pedigree and we were quite happy to get her."

**Solid Turnover on Day 2...**

A total of 78 percent of the horses through the ring on day two at Deauville sold, up significantly from the second day of the 2002 sale when 68 percent of the yearlings changed hands. With a smaller catalogue on offer this year, a consequence of a tighter selection process employed by the Agence Française, the gross showed a decline over the first two sessions, but sales officials were pleased with the start of their showcase event. "We knew that, with less animals, it would be difficult to match last year figures," said international representative Jocelyn de Moubray. "But the market remains solid and, with an average only slightly down, it shows that we're doing as well as in 2002."

**Montjeu Yearling Tops the Colts...**

Eleven of the 12 yearlings that sold for €200,000 or more on Sunday were fillies, with only one colt able to reach that mark. [Hip 92](#), from the first crop of G1 Irish Derby and G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe hero [Montjeu \(Ire\)](#) (Sadler's Wells), was bought for €200,000 from the consignment of Haras de La Reboursière et de Montaigu of Mrs. Aliette Forien. Her husband, bloodstock agent Gilles Forien of FIPS agency, signed the ticket on behalf of The Marquesa de Moratalla. The colt is out of Dibenoise (Fr) (Kendor {Fr}), an unraced daughter of Group winner Boreale (Fr) (Bellypha). Aliette Forien felt it was a good sale. "We are happy that he sold for that price," she said. "He is a beautiful mover and looks a lot like his sire."

**Harnessing New Buyers...**

Some standardbred owners in France are getting more and more interested in the game of flat racing. On Saturday night, Lucien Urano of Ecurie des Charmes, a leading standardbred operation in France, bought two through trainer Carlos Lerner, getting [Hip 2](#), a filly from the first crop by Epsom and Irish Derby and Arc victor Sinndar (Ire) (Grand Lodge) for €45,000, and [Hip 15](#), a filly by Montjeu (Ire) for €85,000. He was also rumored to have bought more expensive yearlings through bloodstock agents over the weekend. Also on Saturday night, leading standardbred trainer Philippe Allaire bought [Hip 53](#), a colt by Anabaa, for owner Alain Swarcz, who is venturing for the first time into the Thoroughbred world. Top owner, breeder and trainer Jean-Pierre Dubois, who owns and manages an international operation of standardbred racing in France, Italy and Canada, is the breeder of [Hip 56](#), a half brother to Group 2 winner Super Celebre (Fr) by Anabaa that sold Saturday for €450,000.

**Charles Henri de Moussac, owner of Haras du Mezeray, who consigned the top filly Sunday:**

*"As it was last year, the market over the first two days has been very selective--only good horses sell. Buyers are realistic and want quality and vendors have to be realistic, too, about their reserves. Some important buyers have been beaten throughout the weekend, in the €200,000 to €300 000 price range. We sold our own horses well, as we have been pricing them accordingly. We didn't do as well with our client's horses--sometimes they were too optimistic."*

**Aliette Forien, Haras de La Reboursiere et de Montaigu, who consigned the top colt Sunday and the top filly Saturday:**

*"On Saturday, [the market] was patchy and selective. On Sunday, there were clients on each horse and it was a good and solid market. Horses sell at the right price. We are delighted with our sale. We had two really good horses on Saturday, with our Fasliyev filly that topped the fillies' prices and the brother to Super Celebre. On Sunday, the Montjeu colt was our best horse and he sold well at €200,000. We could not hope for a better sale."*
