WELL-TIMED FINISH FOR SIXTY SECONDS

Sixty Seconds (NZ) (Centaine {Aus}) showed her versatility and courage when she gained the decision following a blanket finish in yesterday's GIII Glens Falls H. at Saratoga Race Course. The winner of the 10-furlong G1 Arrowfield Stud S. at Rosehill last year, the New Zealand-bred displayed plenty of class in her American debut, also her only previous start this year, when she drew off to a three-length victory in a four-other-than allowance event going a mile over the soft Belmont sod July 11. Moved back to her favorite distance, the five-year-old settled off a pedestrian early pace before launching her attack on the turn for home. With a head of steam, Sixty Seconds took aim at **Alternate** before poking her head in front of that foe on the wire. According to trainer Christophe Clement, the mare may make her next start in Belmont's GI Flower Bowl Inv. H. Sept. 28 before a possible tilt at the GII Long Island H. Nov. 15.

DEAUVILLE SHOWS GAINS ON DAY 3

There was a significant change of trend for the third day of the Deauville Yearling Sale, with high international demand from bloodstock agents such as Amanda Skiffington, Charles Gordon-Watson, Hubie De Burgh, BBA Ireland, Peter Doyle and BBA Italia. There was also a strong contingent of very active French buyers and, after showing a slight downward trend through the first two sessions, the sale is closing the gap. Yesterday's totals showed a rise of six percent for the aggregate, but with only 148 on offer compared to 202 last year. The average rose by 29.54 percent on the day. Over the first three days, the average has edged up six percent from last year, again outlining how strong the market was Monday. "Many important buyers remained in Deauville for that third session," Jocelyn de Moubray, the Agence Francaise international representative, said. "There were very nice animals to be sold on the day. Prospective buyers had the opportunity to inspect them the previous days and they realized that there were some opportunities not to be missed. We expected a good session and we are very happy with the results." Nine horses sold for €150,000 or more yesterday, compared to only two last year.

Diktat Takes the Top Spot...

The top seller on the day was knocked down to John Ferguson, who secured [Hip 243](#), a colt by first-season sire Diktat (GB) (Warning {GB}) out of the unraced Aloma's Ruler mare Catania, paying €230,000 on behalf of Darley. Consigned by Haras des Capucines, the yearling is from the family of GISW Mandy's Gold (Gilded Time) and champion sprinter Gallant Bob (Gallant Romeo). His half sister by Poliglote topped last year's October Yearling Sale in Deauville at €60,000. The top filly on the day was [Hip 234](#), the only Lemon Drop Kid in the sale. From the Haras de Gouffern et de Rabodanges consignment, she is out of Group 2-placed Attractive Crown (Chief's Crown). Jonathan Pease made the winning €190,000 bid.

New Kid On The Block...

Top English jockey Pat Eddery, who is to retire at the end of the season, was active for the first time at a major yearling sale, buying [Hip 124](#), a filly by Bluebird, for €55,000. The daughter of the unraced mare Kathleen's Dream (Last Tycoon {Ire}), whose 2000 foal was stakes winner Castor Troy (Ire), is from a family that traces back to the speedy filly Ancient Regime, winner of the G1 Prix Morny and the dam of Group winners Rami, Crack Regiment and La Grande Epoque. The 11-time champion jockey revealed, "I liked that filly, she is lovely and very athletic and looks like she might be an early runner. I am putting together syndicates and all will run under the 'Pat Eddery Racing' colours. We will be going through all major yearling sales this year and, obviously, for the first season we are looking for precocious types that will make it to the races early. It has not been decided yet who will train these horses. It is a new and exciting challenge."

He Is the One...

As was rumored yesterday, the new man at the sales is standard bred owner Lucien Urano. After buying three Saturday, including [Hip 26](#), the Sadler's Wells--Monevassia filly that he purchased through Quesnay Bloodstock for €320,000, and Sunday's saletoper, [Hip 110](#), for €370,000 through Guislain Bozo, he bought quite a few more Monday, including [Hip 139](#), a colt by first-season sire King's Best out of stakes winner Maggi for Margaret (GB) (Shavian {GB}) for €225,000. The man built a textile empire in France. "I started from nothing and I did it through hard and honest work," he said. "I expect the same from people that work for me and hope it will be exactly the same in that new involvement. I started with harness horses as I used to go racing there with my grandfather, but I have also seen great Thoroughbreds run, like Molvedo (GB). With harness horses, I first started buying top horses in training three years ago as I wanted quality. Now I own four farms and I love breeding. I have bought the Haras des Monceaux near Deauville and I want to have Thoroughbreds on it, so I am buying horses here in Deauville to start. I will also buy at other major sales in Europe, including breeding sales. I am looking for quality, but it's not contradictory with quantity." He added, "Some say that I do things too quickly, but I am not that young and I want to find something that will last. I hope that when the sale is over, I will have about 15 heads. Criquelette Head and Carlos Lerner will train for me, but possibly others also."

Back in Action...

Several major buyers at Deauville had a hard time buying during the first two days of the sale, regularly getting outbid, but found good opportunities Monday. That include 6C Racing of Andreas Pusch, owner of last year's G1 Prix Vermeille winner Pearly Shells (GB), as well as Peter Doyle Bloodstock, Bozzi Bloodstock Services, BBA Italia and French trainers Freddy Head; Henri Alex Pantall, Jean-Claude Rouget, Robert Collet, Jonathan Pease and David Smaga.

First Time Lucky...

Known as a successful buyer of young horses, trainer Mark Johnston was in Deauville Sunday to saddle Darasim (Ire) to win the G2 Prix Kergorlay. An hour later he went to the Deauville Sales for the first time ever and bought one, [Hip 115](#), a colt by Theatrical (Ire) out of stakes-placed Hasene (Fr) (Akarad {Fr}). The dam is a sister to Group 2 winners Execute (Fr) and Tot Ou Tard (Ire). Johnston stayed overnight and bought [Hip 133](#) yesterday, a colt by Anabaa out of Les Planches (GB) (Tropular {GB}), herself a sister to Group winners Mousse Glacee (Fr) and Majoune (Fr); and [Hip 217](#), a filly by first-season sire Diktat (GB). "Deauville is a lovely place and I will certainly be back," he said, but added, "I would have liked to have more horses to look at as it is hard to justify the trip for just three horses." he continued, "Two of the three horses that I bought are foreign-bred horses, which is strange in France because the French-bred horses are eligible for such high premiums. But foreign-bred seem to be cheaper than the French-bred."

PEDIGREE INSIGHTS

SONS OF NUREYEV

A few weeks ago I wrote in this column that "if Peintre Celebre can continue to sire performers of this calibre, he is going to justify Coolmore's faith in Nureyev as a sire of sires, as is Fasliyev, judging by his very encouraging early results....With Stravinsky also notching up some promising winners from his first crop, it looks as though there are going to be plenty of chapters to add to Nureyev's story as a sire of sires."

Well, last week provided one of those chapters, with each of these three Nureyev stallions being represented by a high-class juvenile winner. Stravinsky got off the mark at Group level when his son Balmont won the G2 Gimcrack S., then Fasliyev notched up his fourth Group winner from his remarkable first crop when Carry On Katie maintained her unbeaten record in the G2 Lowther S. Finally, Peintre Celebre completed an extraordinary treble when Pearl of Love ran out an impressive winner of the G3 Futurity S.

With the future in mind, it could pay to take a look at each of these three very talented two-year-olds, especially as there are some strong links between them. I apologise in advance if the explanation of these links becomes a little hard to follow.

The most obvious of these connections is that Balmont and Pearl of Love each has a Seattle Slew mare as his dam and each has a grand-daughter of Raise A Native as his second dam (Balmont's is the Alydar mare Altair, while Pearl of Love's is Mr. Prospector's daughter Mr. P.'s Girl). The Seattle Slew connection looks all the more significant in view of the fact that one of Fasliyev's Group scorers, the impressive Russian Valour, is out of a mare by Seattle Slew's son Septieme Ciel.

Strong ties to Seattle Slew..

I would have struggled to predict the scale of this successful link between Nureyev's sons and Seattle Slew line mares, even though Theatrical, Nureyev's most accomplished stallion son, has the likes of Astra, Humbel and Showlady among his sizeable number of foals out of Seattle Slew mares. Seattle Slew himself sired three stakes winners from a relatively small number of foals out of Nureyev mares, while Nureyev's matings with Pearl of Love's dam Aunt Pearl resulted in Social Charter, a dual Grade III winner at up to 1 3/16 miles, and the Group-placed Kalidasa.

To get back to Balmont and Pearl of Love, it is interesting that Pearl of Love's third dam, the celebrated Native Street, is also the third dam of Balmont's sire Stravinsky. Native Street, of course, was a daughter of Native Dancer, a stallion who has exerted a powerful influence in the pedigrees of each of the juveniles under review.

Carry On Katie is inbred 3x3 to Mr. Prospector, and 5x5x5x6 to his grandsire Native Dancer, while Balmont is inbred 5x6x5x5x6 to Native Dancer, including 5x4 to Mr. Prospector's sire Raise A Native. For his part, Pearl of Love is inbred 4x4 to Raise A Native and 5x5x5x4 to Native Dancer.

I have pointed out before that, to my eye, Fasliyev bears a much stronger physical resemblance to his broodmare sire Mr. Prospector than to Nureyev. It already looks as though doubling up on Mr. Prospector is going to play an important part in Fasliyev's success story, because his other very fast juvenile daughter, Much Faster, is inbred 3x4 to Mr. Prospector and so is his son Sgt Pepper, a stylish winner of a Listed race over a mile earlier this month.

The second line of Mr. Prospector has come through his sons Woodman (Carry On Katie), Gone West (Much Faster) and Hello Gorgeous (Sgt Pepper). Woodman also appears as the broodmare sire of Super Celebre, whose second in the French Derby confirmed his standing as one of the best members of Peintre Celebre's first crop.

Breeders using sons of Nureyev are bound to try to reinforce the influence of Nureyev's dam Special, who also ranks as the second dam of Sadler's Wells and Fairy King. Fasliyev already has a Listed winner, Needles And Pins, out of a Fairy King mare, while Peintre Celebre has sired the very good colts Fantastic Love and Carpanetto from daughters of Sadler's Wells. These animals are inbred 3x3 to Northern Dancer and 3x4 to Special. Sadler's Wells also sired Miss Profile, the second dam of Carry On Katie, so there is plenty of encouragement for further experimentation with this type of cross.

Special's dam Thong was a sister to Ridan, Moccasin and Lt. Stevens, which has allowed the Wildenstein family to try doubling up on their parents, Nantallah and Rough Shod. They have sent Peintre Celebre mares by Lear Fan and Alysheba, who were produced by a pair of sisters by Lt. Stevens, and their Group 2 winner Vallee Enchantee is out of a Lear Fan mare.

Perhaps we should be careful in attributing all the credit for Carry On Katie and Much Faster to their inbreeding to Mr. Prospector because they are also inbred to Northern Dance (3x4 and 3x5 respectively). Balmont is also inbred 3x4 to Northern Dancer.

All three winners under review also have at least one famous name in their bottom line. I have already mentioned that Pearl of Love's third dam is Native Street, while Balmont's fourth dam is none other than Queen Sucree, dam of the Kentucky Derby winner Cannonade.

Perhaps less well known, but equally worthy of mention, is Carry On Katie's fourth dam, Cawstons Pride, who won the Lowther S. some 33 years before her highly-strung great-great-grand-daughter. Although she was unfashionably bred, Cawston's Pride showed exceptional ability in winning all eight of her juvenile starts and she extended her sequence to nine at three, before her temperament got the better of her.

Cawston's Pride lived only long enough to produce four foals but they included the champion sprinter Solinus and the dam of the champion American mare Kostroma.

SKY MESA MAY HAVE FOOT BRUISE TO BLAME FOR DULL TRAVERS EFFORT Trainer John Ward Jr. suggested that stable star **Sky Mesa** (Pulpit), who finished last in Saturday's GI Travers S. at Saratoga, showed signs of heat in his right front foot yesterday, reports *Thoroughbred Times*. "He might have bruised his foot a little bit," Ward told *Thoroughbred Times*. "That may be the reason why he stopped so short after the half-mile pole." Undefeated at two, the bay recorded his best finish two starts back when second, beaten 1 3/4 lengths, to Peace Rules in the GI Haskell Invitational at Monmouth Park Aug. 3.

PLETCHER PRIMES TEAM Trainer Todd Pletcher, who has been smoking hot with 33 winners at the current Saratoga meeting, worked a trio of top juveniles yesterday in preparation for their respective Grade I debuts. Derrick Smith's **Chapel Royal** (Montbrook), winner last time out in the GII Sanford S. at Saratoga July 24, worked five furlongs in 1:01 1/5, the 10th fastest of 20 moves on the day. GIII Bashford Manor S. victor **Limehouse** (Grand Slam), owned by Dogwood Stable, also hit the track yesterday, covering a half mile in :49 1/5 over the main track. The chestnut recorded the 13th fastest of 30 works over the surface. "[Limehouse] worked well and came back in good shape," said Pletcher, adding, "[Chapel Royal] put in a super work. They are both feeling great." Both colts look likely to make their next starts in the seven-furlong GI Hopeful S. over the track Saturday. "In a perfect world, you would never run two of your horses against each other," Pletcher said. "But you have to do what's best for each horse and each owner." **Value Plus** (Unbridled's Song), a runaway winner in his debut at Saratoga July 26, negotiated six panels in 1:14 flat over the main track. The roan is scheduled to make his next start in the GI Futurity S. at Belmont Park Sept. 14. Pletcher also sent out turf specialist **Balto Star** (Glitterman), winner of the GI United Nations H. at Monmouth Park July 5. The five-year-old worked a half mile in :48 3/5 and completed five furlongs in 1:02 2/5. The Antsu Stable gelding will make his next start in Belmont's 11-furlong turf affair, the GI Man o' War Sept. 6, or the nine-furlong GII Kentucky Cup Classic over Turfway's main track Sept. 13. According to Pletcher, "The pace scenario will be the biggest factor in picking a race."

SHINE AGAIN POSSIBLE FOR RUFFIAN Hall of Fame trainer Allen Jerkens is considering the 1 1/16-mile GI Ruffian H. Sept. 13 for **Shine Again** (Wild Again), who just missed recording a third-consecutive victory in the seven-furlong GI Ballerina H. at Saratoga Sunday. "We're thinking of stretching her out," admitted Jerkens. "She doesn't have that burning desire of going to the lead, but I know she can rate kindly. I think a mile would be better for her, but we'll try her at a mile and a sixteenth." Personal Ensign heroine **Passing Shot** (A.P. Indy) may also start in the Ruffian.

STUD FEE SET FOR VINDICATION Two-year-old champion **Vindication** (Seattle Slew), who arrived at Hill 'n' Dale Farm Monday, will stand for \$50,000 in 2004. "We are excited to be managing the career of one of the finest racehorses and stallion prospects in recent years," said Hill 'n' Dale President John G. Sikura. "Hill 'n' Dale and their clients will be supporting the stallion with their very best mares, which include champion Silverbulletday, among many others." Sikura added, "The reception to Vindication has been overwhelming. We expect to breed an outstanding book of mares."

FRENCH SIRE LAHINT DEAD AT 12 **Lahint** (Woodman--Count on Bonnie, by Dacing Count) was found dead in his stall at Haras de St. Gatien in France earlier this month after suffering a ruptured aneurism. The winner of the 1996 Connaught Cup S. and the 1995 Afleet H., both on the turf at Woodbine, Lahint also placed in three graded stakes during his career, including the GII Peter Pan S. over Belmont Park's main track. The bay won eight of 28 lifetime starts and earned \$376,991 through five seasons on the track. Retired to owner Harry T. Mangurian's Jr.'s Mockingbird Farm near Ocala, Florida, the stallion stood two seasons there before heading to France in 2001. From three crops, Lahint has sired five winners, chief among them is dual group stakes-placed Leila.

Il Bacio finally made it to the ranks of stakes winners in her 44th start. Twice a winner earlier in the year, the six-year-old was coming off a fifth-place finish in the Aug. 3 Sekiya Kinen. She rated at the back of the pack through the opening fractions, but rallied to take the lead two furlongs from home before holding off the late charge of T.H. Grace.
