WHIPPER PROVES FASTER AT DEAUVILLE

Whipper (Miesque's Son), overlooked at odds of 25-1, provided one of the biggest shocks in the history of the G1 Prix Morny Casinos Barriere, brushing aside 11-10 favorite **Much Faster (Ire)** (Fasliyev) to record a two-length success at Deauville yesterday. Settled in a stalking role early by Sebastian Maillot amongst the group racing in the centre of the track, the dark bay tracked the market leader and was in prime position as that rival was committed by Thierry Thulliez passing halfway. Quickening best of all in the loose ground, Whipper hit the front with 100 yards remaining before forging clear in the closing stages. Whipper has come a long way since finishing fifth behind Much Faster on his debut in the G3 Prix du Bois at this track July 5. Subsequently third in a conditions race at Vichy July 20, he finished fourth behind **Denebola** (Storm Cat) in the G3 Prix de Cabourg at this track Aug. 2 before winning a minor event at Chateaubriant Aug. 18. "I have always liked him, but he's not EBF-registered so he had to run first time in a group race," conditioner Robert Collet explained. "He was slightly nervous next time at Vichy and again in the Cabourg, where he finished a decent fourth. Last time was like a workout, but he won it so easily I was confident that he was coming to himself." As for what's next, Collet said, "I will savor the moment for now, but of course the G1 Grand Criterium [at Longchamp Oct. 5] has to be a possibility." Pascal Bary, trainer of Much Faster and the staying-on Denebola, commented, "Much Faster ran a great race and seemed to travel easily when she hit the front, but six furlongs on soft ground is her limit and she just got a bit tired. Denebola proved herself at this level and we can look forward to her now." *Prix Morny chart, p2*

Aldebaran (Mr. Prospector) has put together a stellar 2003 campaign with victories in the GI San Carlos H., GII Churchill Downs H., GI Met Mile and GII Tom Fool H., and the five-year-old continued to add to his resumé

with a supremely easy 4 3/4-length win in yesterday's GI Forego H. at Saratoga. Aldebaran, off since the July 4 Tom Fool, was allowed to settle well off the early pace set by the gray speedster **Najran** (Runaway Groom), who blitzed through fractions of :22.11 and :44.29. Aldebaran burst

through an opening along the inside turning for home and effortlessly overtook the long-time leader to win going away. "I think this is his best race all year," winning trainer Bobby Frankel said after watching Aldebaran win his third Grade I race of 2003. *Cont. p. 2*

Aldebaran Wins Forego (cont. from p. 1)

Aldebaran (Mr. Prospector) has finished first or second in all nine of his seven-furlong starts, but the six furlongs of the Breeders' Cup Sprint remains a question mark. Last year, the bay bypassed the Sprint to run in the Breeders' Cup Mile where he finished 11th. Jerry Bailey, aboard Aldebaran in his last five starts, is confident his late-running mount is up to the Sprint challenge. "He's got a tremendous kick," Bailey said after winning yesterday's GI Forego H. "Today, he took me up on his own. He made the lead early in the stretch. If he can run like that, he can be effective going three-quarters. He gets up to the back horse quicker than he did last year and takes me through the pack quicker." After setting the pace, **Najran** (Runaway Groom) held on for second in the Forego, while **Gygistar** (Prospector's Music), in only his third race of the year, was four wide into the lane and raced evenly in the stretch to finish third. Necklace was threaded through the pack to provide Aidan O'Brien with his third renewal of this contest in the last four years. Held up in rear by Michael Kinane throughout the early stages dominated by her rabbit Oh So Precious (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), she made smooth progress up the inner in the straight. Switched wide to challenge the battling duo Red Feather and Menhoubah, she quickened to grab the lead with 75 yards remaining before asserting under strong driving. Necklace was beaten 3/4 of a length by Soviet Belle (Ire) (Soviet Star) in a six-furlong maiden on her debut at this track July 12 before besting Caldly Dancer (Ire) in the G3 Debutante S. at this venue last time Aug. 10. "She has loads of heart and scope," Kinane commented. "There is a lot to look forward to with her." Necklace may race again this term in the G1 Fillies' Mile at Ascot Sept. 27 or G1 Prix Marcel Boussac Oct. 5, according to O'Brien. "She may run again this year, but she will be trained for the 1000 Guineas and Oaks," he said. "She would probably prefer some ease in the ground." Red Feather may be aimed at the latter contest, while Menhoubah will be put away until next season. Necklace was quoted at odds of 14-1 as ante-post favorite for next year's G1 Epsom Oaks by bookmakers William Hill and at 25-1 for the G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket. Irish Warrior had eked out a solid record this season while facing some top company. The chestnut nosed out an allowance victory over Decarchy at Hollywood in June before a third-place finish behind subsequent GI Pacific Classic winner Candy Ride and Special Ring in the GII American H. and he was third again, this time behind Special Ring and Decarchy, in the GI Eddie Read H. in his last trip to the post July 27. Settled in a stalking position early, Irish Warrior moved up four wide into the home stretch, hooked up with Continental Red late and gamely outbattled that rival for a narrow score.

"They got the right name for him," winning rider Alex Solis admitted after the race. "He was a warrior out there today." Winning trainer Wally Dollase added, "He's been in tough the last two races, but still ran really well. Maybe the mile and three-eighths made the difference for him. Alex rode him just perfectly. He knows the horse and he swung him out just beautifully. He was really moving down the stretch and Alex was getting after him pretty good." Jockey Julie Krone, aboard Irish Warrior in the Eddie Read, had the mount on Continental Red yesterday. Of the first two finishers, Krone said, "They were two warriors coming down to the wire. It was a shame one of them had to lose. He ran great. Policy Maker was outbattled by Polish Summer in a driving finish, but was awarded the race in controversial circumstances by the stewards. Held up in rear by Dominique Boeuf off the tepid early tempo, Policy Maker quickened to challenge Polish Summer and Christophe Soumillon in the straight, but was carried right in the closing stages by that rival. That interference was judged sufficient to deny Polish Summer back-to-back renewals of this contest. Policy Maker took conditions events at Longchamp and Saint-Cloud in April and May, but was put firmly in his place when beaten four lengths by Doyen (Ire) in the G3 Prix du Lys at Longchamp June 22. Connections offered excuses for that performance and he bounced back to take the Listed Prix de Reux in impressive fashion at this track Aug. 5. "He has progressed with each race and his last win gave me confidence in him," trainer Elie Lellouche commented, adding, "It looked obvious to me from the head-on that Polish Summer was going in on him. He also received two cracks on the nose with the whip and that would definitely have hurt his chance." 
