A GRAND STATEMENT

Caked with mud while attempting to keep his record spotless, the gritty Earle Mack homebred **Grand Hombre** (Grand Slam) roared from just off the leaders to wrest control of yesterday's GIII Pennsylvania Derby at Philadelphia Park and sailed home a much-the-best winner. The dark bay was well positioned in mid-pack, several lengths off the pacesetter **Gimmeawink** (Elusive Quality), who had opened up by two lengths with three furlongs to go. Targeting the leader with a four-wide bid, **Grand Hombre** took control in mid-stretch and left no doubt of the outcome as he pulled away under a Joe Bravo drive. A four-length debut winner at Gulfstream in early March, **Grand Hombre** ripped through his allowance conditions at Monmouth with open-length victories on June 29 and July 25, and was making his stakes debut amidst a solid group of contenders that included MGISW **Toccet** (Awesome Again) and GSW **Dynever** (Dynaformer).

HOW YOU DOIN'?

Just fine, answered **Joey Franco** (Avenue of Flags) to his own question, rebounding from a disappointing performance in the GII San Diego H. to capture with verve yesterday's GII Del Mar Breeders' Cup H. The handsome dark bay homebred established himself as one of the premier sprinters on the West Coast with a trio of stakes victories that culminated with a win in the GI Triple Bend Breeders' Cup Invitational H. going seven panels at Hollywood July 5. His connections attempted to stretch his speed to two turns in the mile-and-a-sixteenth San Diego at Del Mar Aug. 3, but he finished last of eight after a troubled trip. Scaling back slightly but still traversing two turns, Joey Franco proved that a mile at least was within his ability. The Darrell Vienna trainee was well held by jockey Patrick Valenzuela through the opening furlongs before being asked for his best on the turn. On top by the time they hit the quarter pole, he ran on well late to account for **Reba's Gold** (Slew o' Gold). **Captain Squire** (Flying Chevron), sent off the 6-5 chalk, did appear to have problems with yesterday's distance, faltering on the turn to be sixth. Shoal Water broke his maiden in his final start at two at Woodbine in November, then returned from his winter vacation to take an allowance race in Toronto May 30. Put on the Canadian Triple Crown trail, he was no match for Wando in the first two legs, running fourth in the June 22 Queen's Plate and third in the July 20 Prince of Wales S. The colt was much closer when switching to the turf for the Aug. 9 Breeders' S., finishing second by a length and a half. Favored here off that effort, the Sam-Son homebred tracked Sharp Impact through moderate fractions, swept past that rival as they straightened into the stretch and opened it up late. Trainer Mark Frostad, making his first appearance at Saratoga this summer on closing day, said, "We love to get down here whenever we can, but you have to have the horses to do it. This is a very versatile horse and he can handle anything, turf or dirt. Since there was nothing for him in Toronto, this looked like the perfect spot." Added jockey John Velazquez, who ended the meet with a record 61 winners, "He battled me the whole first quarter mile, but he calmed down on the backstretch. From then on, he was just cruising." As for taking the riding title, he said, "I can't say how awesome and unbelievable it was. It's a great feeling, really. Everything just kind of fell into place." The winner of the GI Ashland S. and the GI Overbrook Spinster S. last year, Take Charge Lady was a distant sixth behind Azeri in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff last year. The bay could do no better than second as the 4-5 chalk in the Nov. 28 GII Falls City H., but redeemed herself in her final start of the campaign, winning the Dec. 7 NTRA Great State Challenge Distaff S. at Sam Houston. Taking on much tougher foes in her three prior starts this season, the four-year-old filly was having trouble finding the winner's circle. Second in all three tries, she missed by a head to Azeri in the Apr. 5 GI Apple Blossom H. at Oaklawn, by five lengths to Sightseek in the June 21 GI Ogden Phipps H. at Belmont Park and by six lengths to Wild Spirit (Chi) in the July 20 GII Delaware H. last time out. Odds-on to break her bridesmaid streak here, Take Charge Lady lived up to her name, taking jockey Shane Sellers to the front after six furlongs and leaving the field in her dust down the lane. "I just love this filly," said Sellers, who was off for a year with a knee injury before returning to the saddle last fall. "She's something else. She has been the highlight of my comeback. It's horses like her that I came back for." Trainer Ken McPeek is hoping to have another crack at Azeri in the near future. "I think we could have beaten her at Oaklawn with a little bit more luck," he said. "We're going to be in the thick of it with her for the Breeders' Cup." Tour of the Cat led a guided tour of Calder's main track when this was taken off the turf and steered himself right into the winner's circle. Tasting victory for the first time since winning the GII Richter Scale Breeders' Cup H. at Gulfstream back in March, Tour of the Cat had been inconsistent in three subsequent starts. After finishing 15 1/4 lengths adrift of the winner when seventh in the Artax H. in early April, he overcame trouble to get the show spot in the grassy Linear S. at Calder June 14. The bay could do no better than sixth, beaten 10 1/2 lengths, in the GIII Smile Sprint H. during Calder's Summit of Speed July 12, but ran into some stiff competition there against the likes of Shake You Down and My Cousin Matt. Facing a more manageable group in his first route effort since February, he was allowed to set sensible fractions under jockey Abad Cabassa, Jr. and had plenty in the tank to rebuff Last Stand's challenge at the quarter pole. "This horse has good early speed, so I sent him away from the gate thinking that someone would outrun him early and we could sit just behind the pacesetters," said Abad. "As it turned out, he was so eager to run we wound up in front." Post time favorite Supah Blitz (Mecke) closed to be fourth. **Click for the [brisnet.com chart](#).**

A Risky Change in Tactics...

Grand Hombre's jockey, Monmouth-based Joe Bravo, had never ridden the three-year-old in a race, yet decided that changing the horse's running style--from a free-running pacesetter to that of stalker--was a risk worth taking. "The track all day was favoring speed," said Bravo, "and it was better to be off the fence. I knew the other riders would be trying to get early position, so I decided to take back a bit. I was definitely concerned about how he might react [to dirt getting kicked in his face], but he never flinched. He stayed very relaxed and gave me every bit of confidence. He may have raced only four times, but he displayed maturity well beyond his experience." **Click for the [brisnet.com chart](#).**

Favorites Disappoint...

Handicappers had in large part boiled down this race to two horses--Dan Borislow's Toccet, who returned from a nine-month shelving to win the restricted Widener S. at Philly Park Aug. 19, and Catherine Wills and Peter Karches' Dynever, who ran a lights-out race in a runner-up performance to Soto in the GIII West Virginia Derby Aug. 9. Off slowly, 3-2 favorite Dynever rallied from near the back of the pack with a six-wide move up the backstretch, but flattened out on the turn and settled for sixth. Toccet, sent off the 5-2 second choice, had a prime stalking trip behind the leaders early, but came up empty when the question was asked and wound up fifth.

Third in this race last year, Derby Regno was looking for his first victory since taking the G3-JRA Shinzan Kinen in January of 2001. The chestnut was off the board in his first six starts this season, but showed improvement to be second in his latest, the G3-JRA Kitakyushu Kinen in July. Rated at the back of the pack early this time, he made smooth progress to close on the leaders in the stretch and drove past Camphor Best in the waning yards for the victory. The winner will be pointed for the G2-JRA Mainichi Okan Oct. 12 and the G1-JRA Tenno Sho in November. The third-place finisher, King Fidelia, was sold in utero for \$180,000 at the 1997 Keeneland November Sale. The five-year-old has won five races, including this year's Niigata Daishoten, and earned more than \$1 million.

Quality action continues at the Baden-Baden International Festival. The sole British challenger, **Passing Glance**, can be expected to adopt his forceful pacesetting tactics to secure a career-best success here. Having bested Priors Lodge (Ire) in the Listed Sovereign S. at Salisbury Aug. 14, he narrowly failed to hold the same rival in the G2 Celebration Mile at Goodwood Aug. 23 on his most recent outing, and has a lesser calibre of opponent. French-trained **Saratan**, the only other foreign raider, can give the likely favourite the most work. The six-year-old gelding returns to Germany for the second time in a month and will bid to go one better than a second-place finish behind Scapolo (Ire) in the G3 Otto Wolff-Meile at Cologne Aug. 3. He had stepped up to a mile for that contest after two previous efforts over seven furlongs at Longchamp--a third in the Prix de la Porte-Maillet June 22 and a win in the G3 Prix du Palais-Royal a month earlier. Of the home defence, **Zarewitsch** appeals the most and has a solid claim if reproducing the form of his win in the G3 Badener Meile over course and trip May 25. **Up And Away** was a surprise winner of the G3 Deutscher Herold-Preis at Hamburg June 28 and has place chances if replicating that form.

As many people have learned to their cost, running a large breeding operation can be tremendously expensive--to the extent that even the wealthiest of owners sometimes have to try to balance the books by selling on the open market.

But how do these powerful owner-breeders obtain a realistic price for their stock? Various ploys have been tried in attempts to persuade would-be buyers that the animals on offer aren't simply substandard rejects. For example, some have tried selling all their colts one year and all their fillies the next year, which works well in the marketplace, but leaves an unbalanced racing operation.

Perhaps the best way for an owner-breeder to stimulate interest in their horses at the sales is simply to sell some youngsters which develop into very good winners. This approach takes time, but it is going to pay dividends for the Niarchos family, who operate Flaxman Holdings in the U.S.

Buyers were perhaps too suspicious at Keeneland in 1989 when Flaxman Holdings offered a well-bred Woodman colt, which apparently failed to reach his modest reserve. Named Hector Protector, he carried the Niarchos colors to victory in five Group 1 contests, including a Classic.

Buyers were also somewhat underwhelmed when a well-bred Sadler's Wells colt was part of the 1996 Deauville consignment from the Niarchoses' Haras du Fresnay-le-Buffard. After he had failed to reach his reserve, a half-share was sold privately and the colt--Dream Well--proceeded to win both the G1 French Derby and G1 Irish Derby in the Niarchos colors.

Surely, the Niarchos yearlings will never again be seen simply as rejects now that the family has sold another Classic winner, in this year's G1 Epsom Derby winner Kris Kin. After that victory, the Fresnay-le-Buffard manager Tim Richardson explained, "Obviously, we would love to have him running in our own colours, but we do have a policy of selling certain yearlings. The horse was raised in America and was a nice yearling, but our budget for the year is based on selling a certain number, and that helps pay for the whole operation."

The Flaxman breeding operation was again in outstanding form on Sunday, when two of its alumni--Aldebaran and Whipper--scored Grade I victories. While Aldebaran's win was widely expected, virtually no one anticipated Whipper's success at odds of over 25-1 in the Prix Morny. Remarkably, this well-connected colt by Miesque's Son was sold for only \$4,000 as a weanling, as part of the Lane's End consignment.

Whipper's lack of popularity at the sales in 2001 no doubt owed quite a lot to his sire, who attracted only 15 mares the following spring in his sixth and last season at Three Chimneys Farm. Miesque's Son has since been transferred to Lakeview Thoroughbred Farm in California, where his powerful bloodlines may be better appreciated.

Like Aldebaran, Miesque's Son was sired by Mr. Prospector from one of the Niarchos family's very best broodmares. In fact, his dam Miesque must be considered one of the best mares of recent times. Although this magnificent daughter of Nureyev could finish only third in the Prix Morny on her stakes debut, she suffered only three more defeats during a 16-race career which yielded 10 Group wins, including Classics in Britain and France and two runnings of the GI Breeders' Cup Mile. *Caulfield cont. p6*

Miesque has since proved similarly effective as a broodmare. When her very promising A.P. Indy colt Mingun won the G3 Meld S. in July, he became her fifth stakes winner and fourth at Group level. The predecessors include two Classic winners in Kingmambo (G1 French 2000 Guineas) and East of the Moon (G1 French 1000 Guineas and Oaks) and Kingmambo's brother Miesque's Son.

Miesque's Son had a distinctly unusual record as a racehorse, with physical problems and injury limiting him to only four starts before the age of four. He won none of them, but finally realised his potential at four, when he won the G3 Prix de Ris-Orangis over six furlongs and finished second in two Group 1 events, with one defeat being by only a head in the Prix de la Foret.

Whether this record justified an initial fee of \$20,000 when he retired is open to question, but he attracted 63 mares in his first season in '97. Although his fee fell slightly in his second season, so did his book (to 55 mares), and it was a similar story in his third year (fee \$15,000, book 42 mares). By his fourth year his fee had been halved to \$10,000 and this year it was only \$4,000.

Clearly, Miesque's Son hasn't enjoyed anything like the same degree of success that has made Kingmambo one of the most respected stallions in Kentucky. His best representative prior to Whipper was his second-crop son Miesque's Approval, who is a Grade III winner on turf, and he has also done well with Private Son, who failed by only a neck to beat Cetewayo in last year's GIII Stars and Stripes Breeders' Cup Turf H.

Kingmambo, of course, initially made his name as a sire through his exceptional Japanese son El Condor Pasa, who put up such a good effort against Montjeu in the 1999 Arc. One striking aspect of El Condor Pasa's pedigree was that his sire was out of a mare by Nureyev, while his dam Saddlers Gal was by Nureyev's three-parts brother Sadler's Wells. The Niarchos team took the hint and sent Sadler's Wells' talented daughter Myth to Reality to Miesque's Son in 2000, with Whipper being the result. With two Group 1 winners bred to this pattern, the Nureyev/Sadler's Wells cross clearly merits further exploration.

Whipper may have commanded little respect in the sales ring, but he has some very impressive bloodlines. His second dam, Millieme, was a sister to Shirley Heights, a winner of the Derby and Irish Derby who developed into a very good stallion. Millieme was also a half-sister to Bempton, a very good broodmare who ranks as the second dam of the champion middle-distance horse Pentire.

It bodes well for Whipper's prospects that there is plenty of stamina in his family, to balance the speed of Miesque's Son. Myth to Reality gained two of her three stakes wins over a mile and a half and her brother, Casamasa, stayed even better, being Group-placed at up to 1 7/8 miles. As Myth to Reality's mating to Kingmambo resulted in Indigo Myth, a talented performer at around a mile and a quarter in France, Whipper should have no stamina problems when the distances lengthen in France's next few Group 1 events for two-year-olds.

The Woodward, Ruffian and Beldame are all contested at Belmont Park in New York. De Seroux added, "We'll be staying home. My main concern is not to take her to a deep track that she has not trained on and risk taking too much out of her."

Saratoga Concludes Another Successful Meet:

With records falling like the rain that dampened the final day of racing, Saratoga Race Course yesterday wrapped up another successful meet. The 36-day run was highlighted once again by Travers Day, when a record 71,337 people witnessed Ten Most Wanted's convincing victory in the Midsummer Derby. The previous record was 69,523 set in 2002. The meet also saw impressive displays by trainer Todd Pletcher and jockey John Velazquez, who amassed 35 and 61 wins, respectively. Several wagering and attendance records fell, despite the poor weather that hampered the meet's early days. In total, a record 1,049,309 people poured through the turnstiles during the meet, up 5.4 percent from last year. "What could go wrong did during the first half of the meet, but in spite of that, we rallied strongly during the second half of the meet," said NYRA president and COO Terry Meyocks. "The poor weather resulted in 31 cancelled turf races, and we had a couple of costly gate scratches the first weekend of the meet. When the weather improved, our business took off."
