**RUSH TO JAPAN; BREW MAY RACE AGAIN**

Adena Springs announced yesterday that second-crop sire **Wild Rush** (Wild Rush--Rose Park, by Plugged Nickel) has been sold for \$1.5-million to Arrow Stud in Japan. The nine-year-old stallion, who will stand on behalf of a Japanese syndicate, will take up stud duty at the Hokkaido-based stallion station in 2004. Winner

of the GI Carter H. the GI Metropolitan H. and the GIII Kentucky Cup Classic at four, the bay also registered wins in the GII Illinois Derby and the Remington Park Derby during his sophomore season. Wild Rush retired in 1998 with eight wins from 16 starts and earnings of \$1,386,322 and

entered stud at owner Frank Stronach's Adena Springs in Kentucky for the 1999 season. In related news, two-time GI Santa Anita H. winner **Milwaukee Brew** (Wild Again), who appeared set to take up stallion duties at Adena Springs Kentucky in 2004, may make it back to the races after all. According to Adena Springs Stallion Manager Dan Hall, the six-year-old will be reevaluated to determine whether he will race again. A final decision will be made within a couple of weeks.

**REFUSE TO BEND TO FRANCE**

Trainer Dermot Weld will send **Refuse to Bend (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) to Longchamp for Sunday's G1 Netjets Prix du Moulin instead of the G1 Ireland the Food Island Champion S. at Leopardstown Saturday. This year's G1 2000 Guineas winner returned from a disappointing run in the G1 Epsom Derby to win the G3 Desmond S. at Leopardstown last time Aug. 17. He will be partnered by Pat Smullen in Sunday's mile contest which is set to feature the Elie Lellouche-trained **Bright Sky (Ire)** (Wolfhound), the Pascal Bary-trained **Domedriver (Ire)** (Indian Ridge {Ire}), the Richard Hannon-trained **Reel Buddy** (Mr. Greeley) and the Aidan O'Brien-trained **Statue of Liberty** (Storm Cat).

**PORT PURCHASES ALBERTO GIACOMETTI**

Sidney Port, who acquired Group 1 winner Ballygarry (Ire) from Susan Magnier last year, has added another son of Sadler's Wells to his roster with the purchase of 2002 G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud victor **Alberto Giacometti (Ire)**, *Thoroughbred Times* reported yesterday. The sophomore has arrived at his new base, San Luis Rey Downs in Southern California, where he will be trained by Laura de Seroux, who also conditions Ballygarry. Alberto Giacometti, who finished sixth last time out in the G1 Juddmonte Grand Prix de Paris at Longchamp June 22, is likely to make his next start in the GI Hollywood Derby at Hollywood Park Nov. 30. The bay has won two of six lifetime starts and has earned \$124,966.

Stormont showed promise as a juvenile in conditions events but disappointed when last of eight behind Striking Ambition (GB) on his return in the Listed Carnarvon S. at Newbury May 16. He finished eighth behind Dazzling Bay (GB) in a handicap at Newmarket May 31 before finishing runner-up to that rival in a similar event at York June 14. After finishing sixth in a handicap back at Newmarket June 28, he finished third behind past Goldene Peitsche winner Vision of Night (GB) in a conditions race at Yarmouth last time Aug. 24. Here he was held up in mid-division off the early speed duel involving Lucky Strike, Soave and Fiepes Shuffle (Ger) (Big Shuffle) before quickening to pass those rivals inside the final quarter. Driven out in the closing stages, he was always holding Soave, who had stayed on past the game Lucky Strike, to fill the runner-up spot. Stormont's second dam Keep In Step (Ire) produced the Group 1-winning South African champion sprinter Super Sheila (Aus) to a mating with Marju's sire Last Tycoon (Ire). Naheef was a promising juvenile, winning the G3 Vintage S. at Goodwood before chasing home Hawk Wing in the G1 National S. at The Curragh. He disappointed in both the G1 2000 Guineas and G1 Epsom Derby before winning the G3 Winter Hill S. at Windsor in his sophomore year. After an indifferent spring in Dubai, he returned to finish a half-length runner-up to Carnival Dancer (Ire) in the La Coupe at Longchamp June 19 before finishing third behind the smart Ikhtyar (Ire) in the Listed Gala S. at Sandown last time July 4. Stalking the early pace setter Bourgainville (GB) (Pivotal {GB}) under Frankie Dettori here, he pounced with three furlongs of the knavesmire still to run. Catching the favorite Akshar flat-footed with that decisive move, he had enough in the tank to hold the late challenge of Eventuail in the drive to the line. "Naheef ran a big race and Frankie gave him a good ride," conditioner Saeed bin Suroor commented. "We used a visor for the first time and it worked. **FABULEUX JANE DEAD AT 29** Fabuleux Jane (\*Le Fabuleux--Native Partner, by Raise a Native), the dam of Grade I winner Joyeux Danseur and grand dam of champions Arazi and Noverre, died from the infirmities of old age Aug. 18 at Graham Beck's Gainesway Farm near Lexington, Kentucky. A half sister to English champion sprinter Ajdal, Grade I winner Flying Partner and Group 1 victor Formidable, the chestnut placed in the G1 Prix Vermeille and G1 Prix de Diane de Revlon in 1977 before taking the G3 Prix de Pomone the following year. Fabuleux Jane retired at the conclusion of her four-year-old campaign with four wins in 20 starts and \$145,655 in earnings.

**A Fabulous Lady..**

Fabuleux Jane, who was a hombred for Ralph Wilson Jr., also proved successful during her second career, that of a broodmare, during the '80s. A gem in the breeding barn, the mare pushed Wilson to even greater heights when she produced the Group 3-placed filly Danseur Fabuleux, who would go on to produce champions Arazi and Noverre; and the Northern Dancer colt Jareer, who sold for \$7.1 million at the 1984 KEEJUL sale.

**The success continues..**

Fabuleux Jane's fifth foal, Doubles Partner (Damas-cus), won the 1987 GIII Arundel H. and continued to rack in the big numbers for the family when she sold for \$2.75 million at the 1989 KEENOV breeding stock sale; and her seventh foal, a colt by Danzig named Bound For Honor, realized a \$1.4 million final bid at the 1987 KEEJUL yearling sale. Sold to Gainesway Thoroughbred Services for \$800,000 at the 1989 KEENOV sale, the mare produced five foals for the operation, including GI Turf Classic S. winner Joyeux Danseur. In all, the mare produced 14 foals, 12 of which started, and nine were winners.

**BOUNDARY COLT TOPS FT CANADIAN SALE** A colt by Boundary out of a half sister to two Canadian champions topped the one-day Fasig-Tipton Selected Canadian-bred Yearling Sale at Woodbine on Monday, bringing a bid of C\$175,000 from trainer Roger Attfield. Hip [130](#), consigned to the sale by Fred Seitz/Brookdale Farm, agent, is out of the Affirmed mare Affirmative Choice, who is a half to Canadian Horse of the Year Imperial Choice and Canadian three-year-old champion Golden Choice. Hip [107](#), consigned by Windfields Farm, agent, earned top honors for the ladies, eliciting a bid of C\$120,000 from BBA (Ireland) Limited. The dark bay is out of Sweet Vale (Wild Again), herself out of MGSW Unacceptable. While the number of RNAs saw a dramatic rise, up 34.6 percent from last year's figure, the sale's average remained virtually unchanged, up 1.8 percent from 2002. "While running in the Fourstardave H. at Saratoga on Aug. 23, Finality re-injured his left front tendon," said Campbell, adding, "We are shipping him to Dr. Robert Copelan in Lexington for his final examination, but we are reluctant to bring him back from a re-injury of this magnitude." The winner of the 2002 GII Jamaica H. and Saratoga's West Point H. this term, the New York-bred, who was voted Champion Turf Male by the New York Thoroughbred Breeders' Association last year, retires with five wins from 15 starts and earnings of \$375,075.
