A WALK IN THE PARK

It wasn't exactly a walkover, but **Mineshaft** (A.P. Indy) didn't have to dig very deep to win yesterday's G1 Woodward S. at Belmont Park.

The 3-10 shot had only one horse behind him after a half, but was just biding his time. He moved to the outside on the far turn and the race was over, with jockey Robby Albarado doing little more than hand-riding the colt to the wire.

Still, the final time of 1:46.21 was third-fastest in the 50-year history

of the nine-furlong event. "I let him work a little," Albarado said. "The next race is going to be tougher. But he's amazing. It's unbelievable riding him. I've never felt anything like that." Mineshaft has won six of eight starts this year. He goes in the Sept. 27 G1 Jockey Club Gold Cup next. **Woodward cont. p2**

SPORTING CHANCE

Making her first start for new owner Peter Minikes and her first in America, 48-1 **Buy The Sport** (Devil's Bag) came running at the finish of the G1 Gazelle H. to beat 4-5 chalk **Lady Tak** (Mutakkdim) by a half length at Belmont Park yesterday. "We almost bought her before the Breeders' Cup last year, but there was a problem with the sale," Minikes said. "A month ago, I was looking at her form in Europe and...I kept saying, 'this horse is better on dirt.' I said, 'All right, let's take a shot, buy her and bring her over here.'" But the owner didn't expect to win a Grade I so quickly. "We pointed for this race thinking that we were taking a big step up," he admitted. "I can't believe she could beat these horses." The dark bay had not demonstrated elite form across the Atlantic. Off the board in six of her eight tries, she did win a Windsor conditions race at first asking in July of 2002. She tried the all-weather at Lingfield in her first outing this year and captured the Listed International Trial S., but was out of the frame in her next three, including a fifth in the July 9 G2 Falmouth S. in her European finale. **Gazelle H. cont. p2**

TOP GUN

High Chaparral (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) returned to the big time at Leopardstown yesterday. Making only his second start since last October, the four-year-old battled to a neck success from the luckless **Falbrav (Ire)** (Fairy King) in the G1 Ireland the Food Island Champion S. His connections had harbored reservations about the drying ground, as did the punters, who allowed him to drift to generous odds of 4-1. But, showing early dash while trapped wide to stalk furious early fractions, he was driven to take the lead with 250 yards remaining, then responded to Mick Kinane's urgings to hold off Falbrav, who escaped from prison too late. There was an objection by Falbrav's jockey Darryll Holland, who claimed that the winner "took his ground" in the closing stages, but the stewards decided to leave the placings unaltered. "It's a relief to have him back safe," winning trainer Aidan O'Brien said. The hero of the 2002 G1 Breeders' Cup Turf, the colt was sidelined with a shoulder injury until the G2 Royal Whip S. at The Curragh Aug. 10, but came back to score a smooth success under a penalty. He will be aimed at the Oct. 5 Arc.

Mineshaft was beaten 2 1/2 lengths by Balto Star in the Feb. 9 GIII Whirlaway H., but rebounded to take the Mar. 2 GII New Orleans H., the Apr. 25 GIII Ben Ali S. and the May 16 GI Pimlico Special. He missed by a head while giving winner Perfect Drift eight pounds in the June 14 GI Stephen Foster H. at Churchill Downs, but was back on track with a 2 1/4-length tally in the July 5 GI Suburban H. over Volponi last time out. Facing a softer field here, he settled in fourth off a moderate pace, but took control under his own courage and won as much the best. "There are some nice horses out there, but you would certainly have to include him in the upper group," trainer Neil Howard said.

Perfect in three previous appearances on the Belmont lawn, Lunar Sovereign ran his record over the course to four-for-four with a solid late kick here. The dark bay won back-to-back allowance races on the grass at the Long Island oval last September, then went to the shelf. He returned to finish seventh in the Al Rashidiya Prep at Nad al Sheba in January and was sidelined again off that effort. Back in New York after a four-month break, the Darley colorbearer earned another allowance victory May 21 before stepping up to the highest level and closing well to be third in the July 5 GI United Nations H. at Monmouth Park. The colt was a well-backed 4-1 in the GI Sword Dancer Invitational H. at Saratoga Aug. 9, but flattened out after sitting just off the early pace and finished eighth. Allowed to settle in fifth through soft splits on the yielding turf, Lunar Sovereign changed gears on the far turn, swept past the leaders and opened it up late for a handy score. "I pulled him out and he just inhaled them," winning jockey Richie Migliore said. "This was the first trip where everything went the way I wanted it to go." This marked the first American Grade I win for trainer Kiaran McLaughlin. "I don't know if we'll go to the Breeders' Cup," McLaughlin said. "We'll have to talk to the people that make those decisions." Always close, favored Denon made up some ground in the stretch, but was outfinished for second by longshot Slew Valley.

Heavy preceding rain was not what connections of Oasis Dream wanted but it came just in time for Somnus, who denied the odds-on favorite the sprinting "triple crown" in a pulsating finish. Held up towards the rear throughout the early stages, he was short of room as Oasis Dream quickened the tempo from the front inside the final quarter. Switched out by jockey Ted Durcan for his run, the gelding wrested the advantage from the blue-blood in the final 75 yards before asserting for the upset. "He loves the ground and is exceptionally good," commented conditioner Tim Easterby. "He won on good ground last year but he's only had fast ground ever since. He goes on it but I'm not into running him on real firm ground as he has all his career in front of him." A mere 13,500 guineas yearling purchase, Somnus took the St Leger Yearling Sales S. last year before beating subsequent G1 Dewhurst S. winner Tout Seul (Ire) in the Redcar Two-Year-Old Trophy in early October. The winner of the Listed Hackwood S. at Newbury July 19, the bay gelding suffered a troubled trip when fourth in the Shergar Cup Sprint at Ascot Aug. 9 and when runner-up in a conditions race at Newmarket Aug. 22. He could make his next appearance in the G1 Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp Oct. 5. Oasis Dream will also be aimed at that contest before a tilt at the GI Breeders' Cup Mile at Santa Anita Oct. 25. Fairly Ransom won three in a row while racing in France, ending the streak with a victory in Listed company at Longchamp, than capped his European campaign with a third-place finish in the Apr. 20 G2 Prix Greffulhe. Freshened for three months prior to his American debut, the roan colt was bet down to 3-2 in the July 23 Oceanside S. going a mile over this course and came up just a half-length short, running second to Devious Boy. The Kentucky-bred tried a mile and a sixteenth in his latest, the Aug. 16 GIII La Jolla H., and once again finished well, this time running fourth behind fellow Del Mar Derby hopefuls Singletary (Sultry Song), Devious Boy and Senor Swinger (El Prado {Ire}). Singletary, who led gate to wire last time, was sent to the front and led the field into the stretch, but Fairly Ransom bulled his way between horses in the final drive to take the lead late and edge clear as the pace-setter faded to fifth. Having belied greenness on her debut when taking a Goodwood maiden May 21, she took the step up in class in her stride when comfortably winning the Listed Distaff S. at Sandown July 5. She was no match for the smart Chorist (Ire) when runner-up in the G3 Daffodil S. at Chepstow last time July 25, but may have found the extended 10 furlongs beyond her there. Cutting back in distance for this, she settled in a stalking second off the fast early fractions and hit the front at the top of the short straight before asserting under a hand ride. Comfortably clear as Perfect Touch made steady progress from the pack, she was eased in the final 50 yards to flatter the proximity of that runner-up. House Party, an impressive 8 1/2-length winner in her only other appearance at Delaware in the Legal Light S. Apr. 26, faced Grade I competition in her last three outings. She ran fourth in the GI Acorn S. June 6, first in the GI Prioress S. July 4 and third in the GI Test S. last time out July 26. Sent off as the chalk here, the gray filly sat in the middle of the pack as Haunted Lass and Mooji Moo blazed the way in :21 4/5 and :44 2/5. The homebred moved closer leaving the turn, closed with good energy and ran down Vision in Flight to edge away late. "The last quarter mile I basically let her do what she wanted to do because she was going so easily," winning jockey Jose Santos said. "If I had known she was going to equal the track record, I would have probably pushed her a little bit and she probably would have [broken] it. GRAND LODGE IN CRITICAL STAGE

Grand Lodge (Chief's Crown) faces a critical period in the next few days following surgery to repair damage to his right knee suffered in a paddock accident Thursday at Woodlands Stud in Australia's Hunter Valley. Woodlands bloodstock manager Trevor Lobb said the stallion shattered his carpus and his ulnar carpal bone. "He was playing around in his paddock, as all horses do, and he slipped," Lobb explained. "It was just one of those things." Woodlands flew a team of three of Australia's pre-eminent equine surgeons, including Randwick-based Jonathan Lumsden, to Scone in New South Wales to operate Friday. Lobb reported Saturday that 12-year-old Grand Lodge is holding his own. "The surgery went extremely well and we are happy with the way it went, but the most crucial time, the most critical time for him is the next few days," he said, adding, "He is eating up and he is extremely bright." Grand Lodge, owned by Woodlands Stud, Coolmore and Plantation Stud in England, was due to cover more than 100 mares this season at a fee of A\$38,500. He has stood in Australia since 1995.

BBAG SALE AN AFFAIR OF UPS AND DOWNS

Yesterday's Baden Baden Yearling Sale got off to a sluggish beginning, but trade picked up in the afternoon, especially at the upper end of the market. Leading the proceedings was lot 184, a well-made son of Dashing Blade (GB) out of the Chilean Classic winner Blumme (Chi) (Jadar {Chi}). Consigned by Gestut Karlshof, this half-brother to the multiple Listed winning and Group-placed Baleno from the immediate family of South American champion Galaxy (Chi) fetched €165,000 and was knocked down to Roger Alles, acting on behalf of Manfred Hellwig, the new president of the German Thoroughbred Breeders Association. Hellwig has been rather lucky in the last few years, buying the likes of G1 German Oaks heroine Salve Regina (Ger) and this year's Classic-winning and leading three-year-old miler Martillo (Ger). The highest-priced filly was lot 213, the only horse offered from Baron Georg von Ullmann and presented by Gestut Schlenderhan. An elegant daughter of Dashing Blade, this half-sister to the dual Group 2-winning Simoun (Ger) from the immediate family of U.S. champion turf horse Steinlen (GB) realized €150,000. Hannes Gutschow secured the filly on behalf of the French Haras St. Martin. Of 248 horses through the ring, 164 were sold for a clearance rate of just 66 percent. The average was off 4.5 percent against last year's figure.
