WANDO SEEKING SIXTH STRAIGHT IN ATTO

Canadian Triple Crown hero **Wando** (Langfuhr) is the 5-2 morning line favorite in the GI Atto Mile this afternoon at Woodbine, but the handsome chestnut will have to dispatch a solid field in order to keep his five-race winning streak alive. "This is his stiffest test to date for sure," acknowledged trainer Michael Keogh, "but I think he'll run a huge race. I think he's a bloody good horse." The Gustav Schickedanz homebred has made two career starts on the turf, missing by a neck in the GII Summer S. last year on the Atto undercard, but coming home clear in the Breeders' S. Aug. 9 to cap his Triple Crown. **Atto Mile cont. p10**

ONE COOL CUSTOMER

Aidan O'Brien has sent out Desert King (Ire), King of Kings (Ire), Beckett (Ire) and Hawk Wing to win the G1 National S. since 1996. **One Cool Cat** (Storm Cat) heads the Ballydoyle quartet bidding to add their names to that roster this afternoon at The Curragh. But he is not the only O'Brien juvenile on display--across the Atlantic, Giant's Causeway's full brother **Tumblebrutus** (Storm Cat) makes his dirt debut in the GI Futurity S. at Belmont Park. (See p10-11 for the preview). One Cool Cat has been impeccable since his debut fourth in a five-furlong maiden at this track Apr. 27. He followed that effort with a smooth score over six furlongs at York June 14 and another faultless performance in winning the G3 Anglesey S. back here July 13. He beat stable companion Old Deuteronomy by a length in the G1 Phoenix S. at this track last time Aug. 10. His conditioner described the \$3.1-million Keeneland July purchase afterwards as "crying out for seven or a mile" with "moves that would knock you dead."

NEARLY PERFECT

Perfect Drift (Dynaformer) remained perfect on the dirt this year, decisively defeating **Congaree** (Arazi) in the GII Kentucky Cup Classic. Winner of the GII Lane's End Spiral S. at three over track and trip, the bay gelding made his first two starts in 2003 on the turf, winning a Keeneland allowance prior to running fourth in

the GI Woodford Reserve Turf Classic May 3. He made a triumphant return to the dirt in the GI Stephen Foster H. June 14, defeating divisional heavy-weight Mineshaft by a head while in receipt of eight pounds, then added an effortless win in the GII Washington Park H. July 19. Trying the big guns in the GI Arlington Mil-

lion, he could do no better than eighth, beaten 3 1/4 lengths. Jockey Pat Day set his sights on 1-2 Congaree from the start as Perfect Drift raced in third, then moved up to challenge the favorite at the top of the stretch. Brian Boru did not disappoint the legion of punters who backed him down to 5-4 as he bested High Accolade in the final furlong. Given a perfectly executed waiting ride by Jamie Spencer, Susan Magnier's dark bay cruised from the rear to join battle with High Accolade with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining before asserting under a strong drive. "This is dedicated to my good friend Kieran Kelly, who was killed [in a jumping accident] a month ago," the emotional rider commented, adding, "I said to Pat [Eddery] after two furlongs 'we're going fairly quick aren't we' and he said 'too fast, son'. So I kept waiting, as I knew he had the kick to get there. He's done it for me--he's very tough and a credit to Aidan O'Brien and his staff."

Brian Boru, named after the famous warrior leader of ancient Irish legend, had already plundered the spoils on Town Moor when winning the G1 Racing Post Trophy last October. He returned to finish third under a penalty behind Alamshar (Ire) in the G2 Derrinstown Stud Derby Trial S at Leopardstown May 11 before disappointing when 16th in the G1 Epsom Derby June 7. He gave notice that he was returning to form when fourth in the G1 Irish Derby at The Curragh June 29 and confirmed that after a break when finishing a neck runner-up to Powerscourt (GB) in the G2 Great Voltigeur S. at York last time Aug. 19. Conditioner Aidan O'Brien, recording his second St Leger success after the exploits of Milan (GB) two years ago, blames himself for the colt's spell in the wilderness. "All the three-year-olds were just probably overdone in the spring, so we gave them a break in the summer and those that were left came on with leaps and bounds," he explained. "We did little things differently and they changed their outer line and physique. We didn't know whether it was for the better or worse, but they didn't run well. When we gave them the break, they came back with the old outer line that they'd always had so we did the wrong thing and we won't do it next year." He added, "Jamie gave him a great ride and put him to sleep, because he said at York he got there [to the lead] and felt he had enough done. He is a lovely horse who has plenty of pace and travels very well. He was a seven-furlong winner at two and always worked with a lot of speed, so we weren't sure whether he'd get a mile and a half. He's a deceiving horse who pulls himself up when he gets there, but he has that cruise to come there on the bit if you can wait on him." The racing public will have plenty of chances to see Brian Boru in action again. "He is in all sorts of big races for the rest of the year, including the Arc, and if things work out that way I shall be happy to run him against High Chaparral at Longchamp," O'Brien said. "We shall just have to see how he comes out of this race and I very much hope that he will stay in training next year."

Vinnie Roe silenced the doubters in his indomitable style to make history as the only horse to win this event three times. Held up in third by Pat Smullen throughout the early stages, he traveled strongly off the even pace set by Gamut and Kieren Fallon before moving to challenge with ominous ease in the straight. Quickening past that rival with 250 yards remaining, he needed only two strokes with the whip to assert in the closing yards as Gamut clung gamely to the runner's-up spot. "That was the best performance of his career," Smullen said. "He deserves to be in the history books--he's all heart and guts." Those qualities have seen Vinnie Roe beaten only twice since he was stepped up in trip in the late summer of his three-year-old year. A pair of rare failures came when a highly creditable neck runner-up to Royal Rebel (GB) in the G1 Ascot Gold Cup last June and when fourth giving weight all round in the G1 Melbourne Cup last November. Now he may be pitched back at a mile and a half for the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp Oct. 5, the venue of his other Classic success in the 2001 renewal of the G1 Prix Royal-Oak [French St Leger]. "He is a magnificent horse to train," his trainer said. "He is so genuine and brave and he always gives everything, but you definitely haven't seen the best of him today. We will definitely consider the Arc, as he has been working with more speed than ever. There is also a possibility he could go for the Melbourne Cup, as quarantine starts on the night of the Arc." Wild Spirit's unbeaten U.S. streak had come to an end when she lost in the last jump of the GI Personal Ensign H. Aug. 22 to Passing Shot, but the burly filly got back on track with this authoritative effort. Brought north of the equator following several Group 1 wins in her native Chile, Wild Spirit surprised in the GII Shuvee H. May 17 when she won at odds of 10-1, but she's been odds-on in each subsequent outing. Her impressive, six-length victory at 4-5 in the GII Delaware H. July 20 saw her go postward at 1-5 in the Personal Ensign, and she was heavily favored here despite coming off the bench in lieu of coughing stablemate Sightseek. Though the favorite broke from the rail, jockey Jerry Bailey elected to steer her to the outside for clear sailing. Barnmate You showed the way, but Wild Spirit came three wide approaching the stretch, took charge smoothly and went on to post a professional win. "She probably prefers being outside," Bailey explained. "It's a small field in a one-turn race, it's pretty easy to get them out. I rode her like she was 2-5 and she ran that way." As talented as Wild Spirit is, she is not nominated to the Breeders' Cup, a fact not lost on trainer Bobby Frankel. "We'll see what happens," he said. "If she wins for \$750,000 [GI Beldame H. 10-4], why would I need to go to the Breeders' Cup with her and put up all that money? I'll talk to the owners about it." You, meanwhile, could be headed to Keeneland for the GI Overbrook Spinster S. Oct. 5; she finished second in the race last year.

The evergreen Spinning Hill defied a crack field of sprinters at her first appearance this spring to win Australia's first Group 1 event of the new season. Top sprinter Yell (Aus) (Anabaa) gained an early lead before Lovely Jubly (Aus) (Lion Hunter {Aus}) took command; Spinning Hill loomed before jockey Patrick Payne settled her one back and one off the rails. Rounding the turn, Payne sent Spinning Hill out four deep, sprinting past a fast-tiring Yell to fend off a challenge by Tru Glo. The Big Chill powered home from last for third. Spinning Hill, bred and raced by longtime owner Sandy Tait and his sister Jill Nivison, won the Manikato in 2002 and she will now be set for the G2 Schillaci S. at Caulfield Oct. 11. Spinning Hill races in the same colors as 13-time Group 1 winner Tie The Knot (Aus). Her 11 stakes wins include the 2002 G1 Lightning S., but she conceded the 2003 edition to Choisir (Aus) in February, finishing second to the subsequent July Cup placegetter. "She has a fantastic temperament, and I'm very fortunate to have a mare with such freakish ability after having had Tie The Knot," said trainer Guy Walter. Spinning Hill has won on 11 occasions over 1200 meters, with a further three wins over 1100 meters, for A\$2,248,440 in prizemoney.

He tracked favored Pretty Wild from the start and moved up three wide turning for home to take the lead. Tafaseel came with his challenge on the outside, but During had enough left in the tank to get the win. "We had a beautiful trip," said winning rider Jose Santos. "At the half-mile pole, we started picking it up. He fought the whole entire stretch. Tafaseel put in a good run, but my horse wouldn't let him by." During had been ridden in the Swaps by Jerry Bailey, who piloted Pretty Wild in the Jerome. "My agent chose wrong," said Bailey. "That's my only comment."

Della Francesca finally earned his first stakes win on this side of the pond with an enterprising effort. The well-bred bay, third to Rock of Gibraltar (Ire) in the G1 Irish 2000 Guineas last spring, won the G3 Gallinule S. at The Curragh before heading to the U.S. in the fall of 2002. An impressive allowance win at Gulfstream Jan. 12 tabbed him as one to watch, but failures in the G1 Gulfstream Park Breeders' Cup H. (sixth) and the GII Explosive Bid H. (10th) saw trainer Niall O'Callaghan give the four-year-old time to regroup. He returned from a four-month break to run second in an optional claimer at Churchill July 2 and followed that up with a solid fourth, beaten 1 1/4 lengths, in the GIII Arlington H. July 26, but was let go at 16-1 in this affair. The Pennsylvania-bred saved ground in fifth as Volponi led through soft fractions, but came wide for the drive and finished strongly to deny Rouvres. Bauhauser won a pair of Group 3 events while racing in her native Argentina, including a six-length score going a mile last August. Second in her two subsequent South American starts, the gray mare attracted the attention of U.S. interests and found herself travelling across the equator to continue her career. She made her stateside bow in an optional claimer at Churchill Downs July 2, finishing second, then shipped even further north to post a game victory in a Saratoga allowance test Aug. 7. Looking to add another graded-stakes tally to her resume, Bauhauser pressed a quick pace, took command after a half in :45.02 and dug down deep in the final yards to repulse the late bid of favored Shine Again. "She has been a very nice surprise since the owners bought her," said Scott Blasi, assistant to trainer Steve Asmussen. "She's a very game filly who tries very hard. You know she is going to give you all she has. [Jockey Richie Migliore] has done a very nice job with her in the mornings...she is a bit peculiar with her mouth, and he is very comfortable on her, which makes a big difference in the afternoons." It also makes a difference that Migliore pays close attention to the competition. "I wanted to get the jump on Shine Again," he said. SEPTEMBER SALE CONTINUES A handsome colt by Unbridled's Song was knocked down for a final bid of \$470,000 to top yesterday's fifth session of the Keeneland September Sale in Lexington. Tom McGreevy, bidding on behalf of Rick Porter's Fox Hill Farm, signed the winning ticket on the gray colt, who was consigned to the sale by Taylor Made Sales Agency. Catalogued as hip number 1597, the Apr. 7 foal is the third out of eight-year-old Regal Miss Copelan (Copelan), winner of the Colleen S. and a half sister to GSW Regally Appealing (Valid Appeal). Buzz Chace, representing Barry Schwartz in the sales pavilion, was the immediate underbidder. "We've been trying all week to get a good colt. He was our top pick," McGreevy explained. "We got a lot more aggressive than we normally would, but sometimes when you want the right horse, that's what you have to do. He definitely looks like a two-turn kind of horse and when you pay that kind of money for them, they have to go two turns in order to get a return on your money." California-based trainer Bruce Headley, bidding from the back walking ring, signed the ticket on a \$400,000 colt from the first crop of Overbrook Farm stallion Cat Thief. Consigned by Taylor Made, as agent for White Fox Farm, who bred the colt, hip 1527 is out of the multiple stakes winner and graded-stakes placed Miss L Attack (Skywalker). "I just thought he was an exceptional-looking horse that had a great top line for speed with the body of a distance horse," the conditioner said of the chestnut colt, who bears a striking resemblance to his Breeders' Cup Classic-winning sire. "He is a beautiful mover, has a lot of bone and is the total picture of what a great horse looks like." White Fox Farm went to \$240,000 to acquire the mare carrying a foal by Unbridled at the 2001 Keeneland January Sale. That filly, now named Miss N Control, is unraced to date. The top-selling filly on the session was hip 1319, a bay filly by Unbridled's Song. Consigned by Dromoland Inc., the Mar. 16 foal hails from the female family of GSW Siebe and MSW Dhaka and was purchased by Mohammed Moubarak on behalf of Buckram Oak Farm for \$325,000. The sale continues to thrive with 67 horses bringing in excess of \$100,000 during the session, compared to 32 last year. Bidding resumes this morning at 10 a.m. **September Sale cont. p14.**
