**ONE HOT PROSPECT**

**One Cool Cat** (Storm Cat) delivered the "unusual" mid-race move that Aidan O'Brien talks about to swoop from last to first and beat **Wathab (Ire)** (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}) by a length as the 4-6 favorite in yesterday's G1 Dunnes Stores National S. at The Curragh. In doing so, the \$3.1-million Keeneland July purchase provided the Ballydoyle conditioner with his fifth renewal of this contest since 1996. Held up in last place by a confident Michael Kinane, the imposing dark bay made smooth progress between horses as chief market rival **Pearl of Love (Ire)** (Peintre Celebre) was committed passing halfway. Temporarily short of room, he was switched inside as Wathab and Declan McDonogh joined Pearl of Love at the head of affairs. But One Cool Cat quickened to pass them both with 150 yards remaining and asserted before idling to a comfortable score. "He's a very serious horse," O'Brien said. "He's very unusual in that in the middle of his work he shows unbelievable pace, but when he gets there he's very lazy. He has unbelievable physical presence, a great mind and seems to have everything. He is very relaxed, but sweated up today because it was a very warm day and he was fresh." **National S. cont. p2**

**THE RIGHT TOUCH**

**Touch of the Blues (Fr)** (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}) was a troubled fifth in last year's GI Atto Mile, but the six-year-old got it right yesterday at Woodbine, pulling away late to earn a half-length victory in the \$1-million race. After last year's Mile, Touch of the Blues narrowly missed in the GI Shadwell Turf Mile and ended his 2002 campaign with a 10th-place finish in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile. He had made only three starts this year, most recently nosing out a course-record setting win in the Aug. 2 Wickerr H. at Del Mar. Racing in midpack early, the Gainsborough Farm homebred charged into contention in deep stretch and overpowered **Soaring Free** (Smart Strike) to win going away. "This horse was unbelievable today," said winning rider Kent Desormeaux. "He was always at the end of my fingertips ready to explode. Going around the racetrack, he was very quiet, very comfortable, in a comfortable stride. When we straightened away and I was able to give him a clear path at the leaders, I didn't get to [Soaring Free] as quick as I thought I would. Fortunately, this guy stuck to his task and just grinded him out, inching and inching and inching to him." Trainer Neil Drysdale said Touch of the Blues will likely start next in the Oct. 4 GI Shadwell Mile S. at Keeneland. **Race Chart p. 2**

**CUVEE STORMS TO FUTURITY WIN**

In his still young racing career, **Cuvee** (Carson City) has made a habit of destroying his competition. The chestnut colt, trained by Steve Asmussen, debuted with a 6 1/4-length victory at Churchill Downs May 2 and returned to take the GIII Kentucky Breeders' Cup. Third in the GIII Bashford Manor, Cuvee responded with a 7 1/2-length win in the GII Saratoga Special. Fourth on his debut over five furlongs Apr. 27 before winning over six furlongs at York June 14, **One Cool Cat** was notching his fourth consecutive success at The Curragh. He has yet to be seriously tested at this track, following a facile score in the G3 Anglesey S. July 13 with a smooth victory in the G1 Phoenix S. last time Aug. 10. "He has a great way of going about him," jockey Michael Kinane said. "When you ask him to quicken he just goes and sweeps them up." As with the stable's 1997 hero King of Kings (Ire), One Cool Cat will now be put away for the G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket in May. **Pearl of Love** will now be aimed at the G1 Racing Post Trophy at Doncaster Oct. 25. In a thrilling renewal of this contest, which boiled down to a straight fight between Godolphin and Ballydoyle, Mezzo Soprano bested Yesterday to provide a shot in the arm for the boys in blue. Capping a fine afternoon for the late stallion Darshaan (GB), who was also responsible for G2 Prix Niel winner Dalakhani (Ire), the regally bred dark bay recorded a lifetime best. Settled in a stalking third by Frankie Dettori off the strong early pace, she quickened to lead with 300 yards remaining as the enterprisingly ridden Casual Look (Red Ransom) began to tire in front. Getting the jump on Yesterday, who was delivered with a strong run by Jamie Spencer, she dug deep to repel that rival's challenge in the drive to the line. Mezzo Soprano began the year with promise when winning the UAE 1000 Guineas at Nad al Sheba Mar. 13, but disappointed when only 14th in G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket May 4. She bounced back to finish runner-up to Ocean Silk (Dynaformer) in the Listed Lupe S. at Goodwood May 21 before finishing third in the G2 Ribblesdale S. at Royal Ascot June 19. She filled the same spot behind Commercante (Fr) (Marchand De Sable) in the G3 Prix de Psyche Aug. 9 before winning the Listed EBF Galtres S. 12 days later. "To win such a prestigious race with a filly from such a beautiful family is fantastic," said racing manager Simon Crisford. "We came here hoping for a place, but she's very tough and stepped up on all her previous efforts." In a sad footnote to the race, the David Smaga-trained State of Art (Fr) (Highest Honor {Fr}) had to be euthanised after suffering a fracture to her right-fore leg during the race. Cuvee, who stormed to an 8 1/4-length victory in the May 26 GIII Kentucky Breeders' Cup at Churchill in his second start, rebounded from a third-place effort in the July 6 GIII Bashford Manor with a 7 1/2-length front-running score in the Aug. 13 GII Saratoga Special. Stretching out to a mile for the first time, the speedy chestnut pressed the early pace of Flushing Meadows (Grand Slam), gained a clear lead nearing the stretch and drew off easily for another open-length victory. "We're very pleased with his race today," admitted winning trainer Steve Asmussen. "He won going a mile and he looked as brilliant today as he did at Saratoga on a different track. That was how he looked in his second lifetime start--just was patient, went around the turn and took over. After his second race, we decided if you have something good enough for the Breeders' Cup, this is it and we spaced his races accordingly from there. We've been very fortunate that we've been able to stay on track." Cuvee is out of Christmas Star, a half sister to millionaire Olympio and GSW Call Now. He is from the family of GSWs Bien Nicole, Early Flyer and Wild Wonder. Second choice Value Plus raced near the back of the pack after hitting the gate at the start, was three wide into the stretch and couldn't challenge the winner. "We gave the winner a five-length head start at the beginning and he got beat seven," trainer Todd Pletcher said of the runner-up. "He ran a big race. He made a big middle move and flattened out a little bit."

Marylebone, the least fancied of three Todd Pletcher trainees in this eight-horse field, got up late for a neck tally in her only previous start, a five-furlong maiden race July 31 at Saratoga. Racing in behind rivals early, the gray filly was forced to steady midway around the bend, moved out four wide in the stretch and wore down stablemate Lokoya in a dramatic duel. "She broke beautiful," jockey Edgar Prado said of the winner. "I knew there was a lot of speed in the race. She rated kindly. I really had to motivate her once we were outside. She's still got room for improvement." After watching his fillies battle to the line, Pletcher commented, "Unfortunately, it couldn't have been a dead-heat. I thought both fillies ran exceptionally good races. Lokoya was under pressure the whole way and Marylebone was the beneficiary of a good trip. Both are fillies that I think will continue to improve as they go on. You've got to give a lot of credit to Marylebone to step up off one five-furlong race, it was a pretty big effort." Bachelor Blues graduated from the maiden ranks with a narrow score over the Woodbine course in his turf debut July 26, but came up a head short in a seven-furlong allowance last time Aug. 17. The local runner went right to the lead, opened up three lengths at midstretch and was all out to hold off the late-closing Victory Light. "We wanted to get him to rate today, but he showed he was the speed," said winning jockey Todd Kabel, who replaced the injured Robert Landry on Bachelor Blues. "I just had to get him to relax as much as I could. I had so much horse underneath me turning for home. It was a matter of getting him to finish up strong because he's known to loaf. His head came up on me and he started running sideways with me down the lane. I had concerns, but he got the job done and I'm just very thankful." Winning trainer Josie Carroll added, "We had a lot of concerns if this horse was on the lead, whether we would finish. He does tend to get a little lazy when he gets on the lead. We spent a lot of time trying to teach him to rate the last month. Clearly he has a mind of his own." Held up towards the rear by Christophe Soumillon, Dalakhani was kept wide to avoid trouble on the inner. Not so lucky were Kris Kin and Kieren Fallon, who were held in by Look Honey (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) on the turn into the straight as Dalakhani was readied for his move in behind. Quickening to hit the front with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining, the winner immediately found Doyen and Frankie Dettori alongside, but found an extra gear under hand riding to pull clear in the closing stages. Dalakhani was emerging for the first time since suffering his only career loss when finishing a neck runner-up to subsequent G1 King George winner Alamshar (Ire) in the G1 Irish Derby at The Curragh June 29. "I had no concerns beforehand and he showed he has lost none of his sparkle," trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre commented. "Maybe he was a little fresh without too much work after his break, but the plan was never to have him 100 percent here and hopefully he'll improve to the Arc [at this track Oct. 5]."

The Aga Khan, Dalakhani's proud owner/breeder added, "The first race back in the autumn after a break is always a delicate situation, but was perfectly negotiated by Alain de Royer-Dupre and his team." He added, "I would not be concerned about soft ground in the Arc, but I would be if it was heavy." Diana Cooper, representing Doyen's owner Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid al Maktoum, commented, "Monsieur Fabre has done a marvelous job with him, giving him all the time he needed. It was great to split the two Derby winners today and the boss will decide whether to go for the Arc or not." According to Sir Michael Stoute, Kris Kin "will improve, but has to" as he builds towards the Autumn showpiece. After the five-year-old's history-making third success in the Classic, Weld reported him to be in "great order" yesterday morning. "He is entitled to a crack at the Arc," he commented. "The ground won't be a worry and he'll be there when they are giving out the money. We would have the option of him going into quarantine that night for the G1 Melbourne Cup, but the G1 Canadian International [Oct. 19 at Woodbine] is more likely." Weld also reported G1 2000 Guineas winner **Refuse To Bend (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) on course for a tilt at the G1 Breeders' Cup Mile, saying that "he has to have a fast pace and go left-handed." He also revealed that **Dimitrova** (Swain {Ire}) would contest either the Sept. 27 G1 Flower Bowl S. at Belmont Park or Oct. 11 G1 Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup at Keeneland, while **In Time's Eye (GB)** (Singspiel {Ire}) will run in the G1 Caulfield Cup to guarantee acceptance for the Melbourne Cup.

**September 15, 1973...**Secretariat won the Marlboro Cup Invitational H. in the then-world record time of 1:45 2/5 for 1 1/8-miles. He defeated his stablemate, Riva Ridge, by 3 1/2-lengths. The winner's share of the purse, \$150,000, made Secretariat a millionaire.

**September 16, 1978...**For the first time in history, two Triple Crown winners met in a race, the Marlboro Cup at Belmont Park. **Seattle Slew**, the 1977 Triple Crown winner, defeated **Affirmed**, the 1978 Triple Crown winner, by three lengths.
