STROLLING ALONG IN JAMAICA

In what was shaping up as a rematch of the top three finishers of the Aug. 16 GI Secretariat S., yesterday's GII Jamaica H. proved to be a walk in the park for the aptly named **Stroll** (Pulpit). Secretariat winner **Kicken Kris** (Kris S.), second-place finisher **Joe Bear** (Ire) (Peintre Celebre) and third **Lismore Knight** (Woodman)

were well supported as the second through fourth betting choices respectively, but it was GII Hall of Fame H. winner Stroll who stole the show as the 7-5 favorite, stamping himself the top turf colt in the sophomore division. Gradually working his way up through the ranks, Stroll came back from a two-month hiatus to take Monmouth's Lamplighter S. July 5 before

taking the Hall of Fame over Saratoga's yielding turf course Aug. 4. (*Jamaica report cont. p3*)

CANDY RIDE TO SIT OUT THE REST OF 2003?

Sid and Jenny Craig's **Candy Ride** (Arg) (Ride the Rails), an impressive 3 1/4-length winner in the Aug. 24 GI Pacific Classic at Del Mar, may miss the rest of the 2003 season, according to trainer Ron McAnally. McAnally, who is waiting for the Craigs to give the final go-ahead for a possible tilt at the GI Breeders' Cup Classic at Santa Anita Oct. 25, cited his pupil's need for some time off as a major factor in the decision. "He's only run six times, but he's been in training for three years without stop," McAnally told the *Daily Racing Form*. "If he runs in the Breeders' Cup, it might drain him some more. It's a long year next year." Alluding to the horse's relative inexperience, he added, "He's a young horse. He was only three when he beat Medaglia d'Oro in the Pacific Classic." The undefeated colt, who also scored in the GII American H. at Hollywood Park July 4, would have to be supplemented for \$800,000 if the Craigs decide to run him in the \$4-million Classic.

EVENING ATTIRE POSSIBLE FOR GOLD CUP

Evening Attire (Black Tie Affair {Ire}), whose sole Grade I win to date was registered in last year's 10-furlong Jockey Club Gold Cup, worked six furlongs in a handy 1:13 1/5 over Belmont's main track Sunday, but the gelding's trainer Pat Kelly remains on the fence concerning his charge's next start. "The work was nice," said Kelly. "We're just waiting to see who's going to run [in the JC Gold Cup Sept. 27] and how he comes out of this." Kelly, who also mentioned the 1 1/8-mile GII Meadowlands Cup Oct. 3 as a possibility for the five-year-old, appears to be favoring Belmont's \$1-million feature. "[The Gold Cup] is definitely not going to be easy, but I think he's better at a mile and a quarter. He sort of likes Belmont, although he's one-for-eight here." An earner of \$1,704,909, the gray finished fourth in last year's BC Classic at Arlington Park.

Trainer Lee Freedman has a fourth G1 Caulfield Cup well within his sights as Mummify firmed to 9-1 outright favorite for that Oct. 18 event with an off-the-pace success in the Underwood. The winner of the G1 South Australia Derby last season, the gelding prepped for this with an eye-catching third-place effort in the G2 Craiglee S. Sept. 6. Settled in fourth position throughout, Mummify responded when called upon by jockey Dan Nikolic, staged a duel with Ain't Seen Nothin' from the 600-meter mark then withstood a late run from Grey Song, who swept from last to just miss. The disappointment of the race was treble G1 winner Helenus (Aus) (Helissio {Fr}), who finished second last as the 7-2 favorite.

Exceed and Excel did just that yesterday at Caulfield, setting a new course record and giving his trainer a first victory at the highest level. The sophomore was riding a two-race winning streak into this event, having previously taken the G2 Up and Coming S. Aug. 23 and the G3 Roman Consul S. Sept. 6. Sent immediately to the front beneath jockey Corey Brown, the bay colt opened up a three-length bulge with 1 1/2 furlongs to race and was not seriously menaced thereafter. "His work has been getting better and better and he's improved each run and he has shown now he can get the extra trip," winning trainer Tim Martin commented. "His time compares well with the Guineas Prelude. If he recovers well he'll go to the Guineas, and spell after that," said Martin. The A\$1-million G1 Caulfield Guineas is scheduled for Oct. 11.

Unbeaten as a juvenile, Fruhlingssturm's best effort to date came when an easy winner of Dutch Derby and since that win he has been knocking at the door in stakes company. He was fifth in the G3 Grosser Preis der Wirtschaft at Dortmund June 22 and filled the same berth behind Big Bad Bob (Ire) (Bob Back) in the G3 Furstenberg-Rennen at Baden-Baden Aug. 31. He surpassed all previous form in this contest to secure a career-best success with a decisive victory over Godolphin's favored Naheef. The eventual winner settled in third as Big Bad Bob made the running from Naheef and started his move as the latter was sent on once into the stretch run. Fruhlingssturm challenged Naheef at the eighth pole and ran on strongly in the closing stages to stretch out to a decisive win. Fruhlingssturm's second dam is the multiple stakes placed Blushing Groom mare Fruhlingshochzeit, a half-sister to MGSW Running Stag and Fraulein Tobin, the dam of the G3 Rockfel S. scorer Germane (GB).

The surprise 20-1 winner of a Curragh maiden Aug. 31 on her second lifetime start, Venturi continued her progress along the upward curve to provide trainer David Wachman with a first group race success. Reserved in rear by Richard Hughes as Voile (Ire) (Barathea {Ire}) set the pace, the eventual winner made progress from the quarter-mile and closed on the front rank approaching the final furlong. Looking for his fourth consecutive win here, Stroll was sharp early, but was content to rate in fourth as jockey Jerry Bailey asked his mount to conserve his speed. Poised for take off turning for home, the colt responded when a gap opened up along the rail and drove through to score by two lengths over the game Kicken Kris. "He's learned how to settle," said Bailey. "He still wants to be sharp, but you can talk him out of it." Concerning his rail skimming ride, Bailey added, "You need a horse to get through a hole like that. If you don't, you can look pretty stupid."

PLETCHER TIGHTENS SCREWS ON JUVENILE

TEAM Trainer Todd Pletcher's best juveniles, **Chapel Royal** (Montbrook), **Ashado** (Saint Ballado) and **Limehouse** (Grand Slam), hit Belmont's main track Sunday morning in preparation for their upcoming starts. Chapel Royal, second in the GI Hopeful S. last time Aug. 30, went five furlongs in a sharp 1:00 2/5. The winner of the GII Sanford S. and the GIII Flash S. earlier this year is slated to make his next start in the GI Champagne S. at Belmont Park Oct. 4. "He didn't run a bad race in the Hopeful, he just didn't run as well as we expected him to," explained Pletcher. "He's trained well since then, so we'll just lead him over there and try again." Also on the worktab, GI Spinaway S. heroine Ashado negotiated five panels in 1:02 yesterday. "She's actually training better here than she was at Saratoga," Pletcher said. "She's never really been an impressive horse in the mornings, she kind of does what she has to do. I've liked both her breezes since coming back to Belmont." Owned by Starlight Stables, Paul Saylor and John Martin, she will make her next appearance in the GI Frizette S. on the Champagne undercard. Rounding out the trio, Limehouse, fifth in the Hopeful, completed five furlongs in 1:02. The chestnut, owned by Dogwood Stable, will head to Keeneland for an upcoming start in the GII Lane's End Breeders' Futurity Oct. 4.

Due to its late post time, the result of the GII British Columbia Derby will appear in Tuesday's TDN.

Travelator finished a length second to Grab Bag in a state-bred allowance test Aug. 31 at the Spa, but turned the tables here under jockey Aaron Gryder. The bay, following a third in the restricted Bouwerie S. at Belmont in May, was transferred from trainer Chris Englehart to Stanley Hough and promptly won a NW1X in the slop June 7. She failed as the favorite when second in the Candy Eclair S. at Monmouth July 13 before running into Grab Bag last out, who had returned from a nine-month absence to win her fifth straight. Those two stalked the pacesetting Self Rising through the opening furlongs, and it was Travelator who got the jump as she bid from her outside position. Though Grab Bag kicked into gear late, she couldn't reach the game winner, who had wore down Self Rising. "She's a real honest filly," said Hough. "She tries every time. If everything is right, she'll probably come back in the [Oct. 18] Iroquois S."

Dangle was banned from running for six weeks and Lynam was fined €750 for using the racecourse as a training ground. Murtagh told *PA Sport*: "I certainly am appealing. I didn't sit in the sauna all morning to come here and stop any horse. It's my first offence and the fact that the Arc weekend is affected is not the point. It's not the best ride I gave the horse and I told the stewards that. She ran green, I gave her a smack to teach her a furlong and a half out, we got a run up the inner and she came home strongly but they stopped in front as well." Lynam added: "I haven't been found guilty of stopping one in 20 years' training. I am absolutely fuming. I've invested millions in my place and I just don't do that. Johnny said he gave the horse a bad ride."
