**EMPIRE MAKER OUT OF GOLD CUP**

Juddmonte Farm's **Empire Maker** (Unbridled) has suffered a foot bruise to his left front and will not start in Saturday's GI Jockey Club Gold Cup at Belmont Park. The Bobby Frankel trainee might instead be shipped

back to California to prepare for a possible start in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic at Santa Anita Oct. 25. "His foot busted open," said Frankel. "He'll be alright. It's the weakest part of the foot and if they get a bruise, that's where it comes out. I don't think it will be major." The bruise is the latest installment in a series of minor setbacks suffered by the GI Belmont S. hero, who suffered a similar bruise just prior to the Kentucky Derby and who battled a cough through much of August.

Despite the stumbling block, Frankel remained optimistic about the Breeders' Cup. "One thing about him is that he can miss time and get ready," he said. "He's practiced at it a lot."

**A GRAND FILLY TOPS GOFFS FINALE**

A filly by Grand Lodge out of the Indian Ridge (Ire) mare Zooming (Ire) led the way with a €525,000 final bid at yesterday's final session of the Goffs Orby Sale in Kill, Co. Kildare, Ireland. Consigned by Loughbrown Stud, the February foal was purchased by Bloodstock agent Anthony Stroud on behalf of an "existing client." Stroud indicated that the filly would be sent to trainer Michael Jarvis' yard in Newmarket. Deep on the female side, hip [207](#) is the second foal out of seven-year-old Zooming, who is a half sister to MGSW and MG1SP Zipping (Ire) and French graded stakes winner Zelding (Ire). Her third dam, Mill Princess, has produced 11 winners, including European three-year-old sprint champion Last Tycoon (Ire), who won the GI Breeders' Cup Mile in 1986. **\$100,000 MINE**

Lane's End has announced that William Farish's **Mineshaft** (A.P. Indy--Prospectors Delite, by Mr. Prospector) will enter stud next season at the Versailles, Kentucky farm for a fee of \$100,000 live foal. He will stand alongside his sire, the 1992 Horse of the Year, who will command a fee of \$300,000 in 2004. Mineshaft, who will not be syndicated, is one of three Grade I winners this season for A.P. Indy. The nation's leading older horse is slated to run in Saturday's GI Jockey Club Gold Cup at Belmont prior to concluding his racing career in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic Oct. 25 at Santa Anita. Will his stud fee change if Mineshaft goes on to

win the Gold Cup or the Classic, or if he is named Horse of the Year? "I would be thrilled if we had that to worry about," said Lane's End's Bill Farish. "But we wouldn't have set the fee if we planned on changing it. That will be his fee no matter what happens." The regally bred four-year-old is out of the deceased Prospectors Delite, winner of the GI Acorn S. and the GI Ashland S. A full brother to Grade I-winning millionaire Tomisue's Delight and MSW Rock Slide, Mineshaft is also a half brother to GSW Monashee Mountain (Danzig) and MSW Delta Music (Dixieland Band). He is the final foal to live from Prospectors Delite, who died in 2001. There are no plans to shuttle Mineshaft and he will, in fact, be bred to a limited book of mares. "He will not be bred to a huge number of mares," Farish said. "We don't have a specific number in mind, but it won't be anything like the books we're seeing these days. It will be more in line with what are other stallions do." **Lane's End Fees for 2004, p3**

**National Hunt Trainer Makes Debut at Goffs**

Making a splash during the first two days of the Goffs yearling sale was Co. Durham-based trainer Howard Johnson, who purchased six lots for a total of €2,090,000. Johnson, who spent most of the early part of the decade patronizing the British hunt ranks, broke into the Thoroughbred market earlier this month, with the help of Newcastle-based billionaire Graham Wylie. Dipping his toe with two purchases worth a grand total of €136,000 at Doncaster's St. Leger Yearling Sale earlier this month, Johnson kicked it up a few notches at Goffs final session when he purchased four of the day's top priced nine lots. Among his purchases at this year's venue was hip 240, who brought €470,000, the second-highest price of the session. Consigned by Redpender Stud, the filly by Sinndar (Ire) out of Listed winner and Group placed Asterita (GB) (Rainbow Quest), is a half sister to Listed winner and graded-stakes placed Californian (GB). Ebullient from the fruitful two-day affair, Johnson outlined his game plan, which is to purchase six to eight select flat horses for next year, and according to his patron Wylie, the goal is to "have some fun with them." Let the games begin.

**SHARP CAT, DAM OF POINT GIVEN AT KEENOV**

A number of high-profile mares, including several owned by the Thoroughbred Corp., will go under the hammer at the upcoming Keeneland November sale, as multi-millionaire Sharp Cat (Storm Cat), in foal to Gone West, champion Windsharp (Lear Fan), the dam of GISWs Johar and Dessert, in foal to Gone West, MGISW Habibti (Tabasco Cat), in foal to Point Given, and the dams of Horse of the Year Point Given, Ban-shee Breeze, and Spain will be among the 87 mares offered by Mill Ridge Farm. In addition, a full brother to Point Given and a Point Given filly out of Sharp Cat headline a group of 31 weanlings. "This is truly a first-class group of horses, both in terms of breeding stock and future racing stock," said Bayne Welker, Jr., head of sales development for Mill Ridge. "The private breeders who have asked us to sell this November have spent many years acquiring and cultivating bloodlines, and these horses are the fruits of their labors."

**ROUVRES TO STAND IN IRELAND** French Group 1 winner **Rouvres (Fr)** (Anabaa--Riziere {Fr}, by Groom Dancer), currently campaigning in the U.S., has been sold to Michael and Jane Bowe's Greentree Stud in Co. Tipperary, Ireland, according to *Racing Post*. A stud fee has not yet been announced. The four-year-old will continue to race for breeder Alec Head through the end of 2003. Rouvres went unbeaten at three in France, landing the G1 Prix Jean Prat and the G3 Prix de Guiche, before being sent to Christophe Clement in the U.S. The grandson of Danzig won his first stateside race in February and has gone on to add runner-up finishes in the GII Explosive Bid H., the GII Bernard Baruch H. and the GII Belmont Breeders' Cup H. "Rouvres is the type of horse who will be very sought after," Michael Bowe told *Racing Post*. "The thing about him is he's so consistent. He shows his ability every time he runs. In addition, he's by one of the hottest young stallions around, whose three-parts brother is also one of the hottest young stallions in Ireland." One of the leading sires in France and Australia, Anabaa is also closely related to Key of Luck (Chief's Crown), sire of top three-year-old Alamshar (Ire).

**FUNNY CIDE SAYS NO TO GRASS** Sackatoga Stable's **Funny Cide** (Distorted Humor) took to the sod for the first time yesterday at Belmont under the watchful eye of trainer Barclay Tagg, who seemed less than thrilled with the work. The Kentucky Derby champ breezed five furlongs around the "dogs" in 1:03 over a yielding lawn. "It didn't look like he liked it a whole lot to me," said Tagg. "It didn't look like he was handling it too good, but it might have been too soft. I probably won't run him on the turf; not this year anyway. I was hoping to run him in the [Oct. 4, GII] Kelso [H.], because it's just a mile and I didn't think that would take too much out of him. We've got the [Oct. 4, GIII] Indiana Derby and the [Oct. 3, GII] Meadowlands Cup. I'll see who's going into the Meadowlands Cup."

**AZERI TO TOTE 128 IN LADY'S SECRET** Reigning Horse of the Year **Azeri** (Jade Hunter) will be asked to carry the highest impost of her career, 128 pounds, for Sunday's GII Lady's Secret Breeders' Cup H. at Santa Anita. She'll be spotting her rivals anywhere from 10 to 20 pounds, with MGISW **Elloluv** (Gilded Time) carrying 118 pounds. Mike Smith, Azeri's hall of fame jockey, commented on the assignment Wednesday morning. "When you get up that high, it can definitely be a factor," said Smith. "When you're spotting a horse 10 pounds and more, you're talking about a lot of weight. She's been carrying 127, and her last race was relatively easy [a victory in the Aug. 10 GII Clement L. Hirsch H. at Del Mar]. At any time, I could have blown the race open, so it gives you confidence going in. Hopefully, one more pound won't bother her."

**SCHETTINE CANCELS DISPERSAL** Florida-based breeder William Schettine, who had planned to disperse of his breeding stock during the Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale, announced yesterday that he was withdrawing the 58 broodmares and weanlings that were scheduled to go through the ring Sunday, Nov. 2.

**WANDO'S BC FATE LIES IN INDIANA DERBY** Trainer Mike Keogh will send Canadian Triple Crown winner **Wando** (Langfuhr) to Hoosier Park to contest the Oct. 4 GIII Indiana Derby, a race that will determine if the Gustav Schickedanz homebred will take aim at the GI Breeders' Cup Classic at Santa Anita Oct. 25. "We need to get another race under his belt to go into the Classic," Keogh told *Daily Racing Form*. "And if he's not 1-2-3 there, he shouldn't be going [in the Classic] anyway." Following his Triple Crown-clinching victory in the Breeders' S. at Woodbine Aug. 9, the handsome chestnut finished a non-threatening fourth in the GI Atto Mile Sept. 14.

**SULAMANI IN CLASSIC FORM** Champion **Sulamani (Ire)** (Hernando {Fr}), the Godolphin colorbearer who was awarded victory in last month's GI Arlington Million via disqualification, tuned up for Saturday's GI Turf Classic Invitational at Belmont Park with a six-furlong breeze around the "dogs" over Belmont's inner turf course in 1:16 flat. "He's doing extremely well," said Tom Albertrani, assistant trainer to Saeed bin Suroor. "He wasn't asked for much." Albertrani indicated that GI Jockey Club Gold Cup hopeful **Moon Ballad (Ire)** (Singspiel {Ire}), also representing the Godolphin Stable, might work this morning. "We might give him a little blowout; something to stretch his legs," said Albertrani.

**NEW YORKER SAY FLORIDA SANDY RETIRED**

John Rotella's gritty multi-millionaire **Say Florida Sandy** (Personal Flag--Lolli Lucka Lolli, by Sweet Candy {Ven}), the second richest New York-bred of all time behind Funny Cide, has been retired. Plans are underway to stand the nine-year-old at a New York farm. The dark bay, claimed by Rotella for \$60,000 in 1998, won 33 races in 98 career starts, capturing no fewer than 19 stakes, five graded, including the GII True North H. and two renewals of the GIII Gravesend H. Victor of the Paumonok H. at Aqueduct earlier this year, he was turned out following a seventh-place finish in an allowance test at Saratoga Aug. 19. "He's ready," Rotella told *Daily Racing Form*. "Whenever we sent him to the farm before, he was ready to come back to the track right away. Now, he is happy standing there by himself in the paddock. He's been so good to me. I wanted to retire him 100 percent sound, and he is." Bred by Sanford Bacon, Say Florida Sandy retires with a record of 98-33-17-12, with earnings of \$2,070,407.
