### A GOLD MINE

Looking every inch a Horse of the Year candidate, **Mineshaft** (A.P. Indy) made short work of his four rivals in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup at Belmont Park yesterday afternoon.

The eye-catching bay tracked 22-1 shot **Quest** (Seeking the Gold) through moderate fractions, carried jockey Robby Albarado to the lead as they raced into the stretch and, under only mild encouragement, drew off to a 4 1/4-length score. "I just called on him--not much--at the

three-eighths pole to the quarter pole and he responded very well," Albarado said. "I just waved the whip at him once or twice because I wanted to make sure nobody nailed him at the wire. He was just in second gear."

### A BRAVURA PERFORMANCE

**Falbrav (Ire)** (Fairy King) ended the pre-race debate about his suitability for a mile by displaying devastating speed to beat **Russian Rhythm** (Kingmambo) by two lengths in yesterday's G1 NetJets Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot. Racing freely behind early pacesetter **Blatant (GB)** (Machiavellian), the 6-4 favorite settled for Darryll Holland and settled the result in a matter of strides. He grabbed hold of the rabbit passing the quarter-mile marker and quickened clear soon after, then easily held off Russian Rhythm as he powered to the line, just missing the track record. "He's very special," Holland said. "I actually could have made the running, he's that quick. I got a nice lead off the pacemaker and it was just a matter of when to set him alight." But, despite the impressive effort at the mile, Falbrav will be stretching out for his next start. "I'd very much like to go for the GI Breeders' Cup Turf [at Santa Anita Oct. 25]," trainer Luca Cumani said. "We're going from a mile to a mile and a half, which might make it a little bit difficult, but at Santa Anita, with the small, flat fast oval with a downhill run, I think he'll have a chance." ### DIMITROVA BOWLS 'EM OVER

Taking on her elders for the first time, three-year-old **Dimitrova** (Swain {Ire}) swept from the middle of the pack to beat **Walzerkoenigin** (Kingmambo) by a length in the GI Flower Bowl Invitational H. at Belmont Park yesterday. It was the fifth victory of the day for trainer Dermot Weld, who also took four races in Ireland. "We had her ready for this race and she proved to be the top filly that she is," Weld said. "She is a tough, genuine filly and we have a lot to look forward to." The bay will likely head to Santa Anita for her next start. "The obvious direction is sending her to California for the Breeders' Cup [Filly and Mare Turf]," Weld said. **A Grade I Hat Trick...**

A winner in six of his previous eight starts this season, Mineshaft posted a 3 3/4-length score in the GI Pimlico Special, but found Perfect Drift, with an eight-pound advantage, just a little too tough in the June 14 GI Stephen Foster H. and finished second by a head. It didn't take long for the four-year-old to return to his winning ways, however. He bested Volponi by 2 1/4 lengths in the July 5 GI Suburban H. and made it two wins in a row at the highest level in the Sept. 6 GI Woodward S. Looking to complete the hat trick yesterday, the royally bred colt tracked the pace from third while tugging at his rider through the opening half. He drew alongside the leader at the top of the stretch and proved much the best, once again, to the wire. "To me, he's been impressive in every race, even when he got beat," trainer Neil Howard said.

**BC or No BC...**

It has not been decided if Mineshaft will try to put the icing on a sweet 2003 campaign in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic at Santa Anita Oct. 25. "[The Jockey Club Gold Cup] has been our target, and he has had a hard, hard campaign," co-owner Will Farish said. "We'll see about the Breeders' Cup. I don't think this horse has anything more to prove. We've laid our course and invited the other horses in the country to come. In the last few races, they've gone the other direction. We've gone exactly where we've said we were going seven months ago." But, he added, "I'm not ruling anything out. We have to sit down and check it out."

**Moon Ballad Disappoints...**

Adding to his list of disappointing efforts since his awesome win in the Mar. 29 G1 Dubai World Cup, **Moon Ballad (Ire)** (Singspiel {Ire}) pressed the pace early, but faded to finish last for his fourth consecutive off-the-board performance. "He just didn't run his race," Godolphin Racing Manager Simon Crisford said. "We'll let the dust settle before we decide on the future." Added jockey Jerry Bailey, "He was just flat."

Falbrav made his name over middle distances when with Luciano d'Auria in Italy, rounding off a successful four-year-old campaign by winning the G1 Japan Cup. Transferred to Luca Cumani this year, he has added wins in the May 18 G1 Prix d'Ispahan, July 5 G1 Eclipse S. and Aug. 19 G1 International S. He may have been unlucky to finish runner-up behind High Chaparral (Ire) in the G1 Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown last time Sept. 6, but he banished those memories on this occasion. "The horse should have won in Ireland," said conditioner Luca Cumani, enjoying his second renewal after the exploits of Markofdistinction (GB) in 1990. "It was an afterthought to come here, but thank God for the lack of rain. The horse is just amazing and he's probably the best in the world on grass anywhere between a mile and a mile and a quarter." Tillerman, filling third spot for the second consecutive year, may be aimed at the G1 Hong Kong Mile Dec. 14.

Ghostzapper came flying down the stretch to post an impressive victory, becoming a Grade I winner in just his sixth career start. A nine-length winner of his debut last November at Hollywood, the Stronach homebred was put away following a fourth as the 3-10 favorite in a Santa Anita allowance Dec. 26. The bay didn't resurface until June 20, when he swooped late to win over a muddy Belmont strip. He added a determined allowance score at Saratoga July 26, then made his stakes debut in the GI King's Bishop S. Aug. 23. Well back in the early stages, Ghostzapper nearly overcame the speed bias to finish a close third, beaten two necks for the win. Typically unhurried down the backstretch here, he was nearly out of the picture turning for home, but accelerated impressively to seize command inside the eighth pole and open up on the field. "I was really surprised how fast he caught these horses," said trainer Bobby Frankel. "He was 12 [lengths] out of it, and the next thing you know, that's him on the outside." Ghostzapper's time of 1:14.72 was 1/5 of second off the track record, and he just might be joining stablemates **Aldebaran** and **Midas Eyes** in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint. "I'll have to speak to the owners and see what they have to say," Frankel added. "He doesn't like dirt in his face and, at Santa Anita, they don't throw back sand, they throw back clods. Sulamani kicked off the season with a win in the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic Mar. 29, then finished fifth in the G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud June 29. He placed second in the G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth S. at Ascot July 26 and followed that effort up with a second-place finish behind **Storming Home** (GB) while making his U.S. debut in the GI Arlington Million last out Aug. 16. But, in the Million, the bay colt was bothered by the winner nearing the wire and was awarded the victory via disqualification. Sent off as the chalk here, he was taken back early, raced in hand, advanced three wide on the second turn, then stumbled badly after appearing to clip heels approaching the stretch. He recovered quickly, however, caught the leaders leaving the eighth pole and drew clear after one left-handed strike from **Jerry Bailey** to an easy victory. "That was a very athletic and courageous performance," Bailey said. "We had a great trip. [Sabiango {Ger}] wasn't quite clear, and I caught his heel. I've never had a horse, especially one like this that is so lanky, get back into a race after something like that happened." Simon Crisford, racing manager of Godolphin, was pleased with the effort. "He ran fabulous and we are very excited with the win," Crisford said. "We just hope he makes that same move in the Breeders' Cup [Turf, Oct. 25 at Santa Anita]." Dimitrova started her sophomore season a maiden, but has taken only six starts to prove she is one of the best of her generation. The Kentucky-bred bay broke her maiden at Leopardstown in March and made it two in a row in the Listed Leopardstown 1000 Guineas Trial Apr. 13. She was beaten only 3/4 of a length by Yesterday (Ire) in the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas May 25, then shipped to California to post a two-length tally in the July 5 American Oaks at Hollywood Park. The three-year-old went off the 3-5 favorite in her latest, the GI Garden City Breeders' Cup H. Sept. 7, but couldn't hang on and had to settle for second. "I had her better for this race," Dermot Weld said. Allowed to settle in fifth, Dimitrova moved up on the far turn and accelerated down the lane to drive home a determined winner. "A hole opened up, so I went," said jockey Jerry Bailey, who picked up a record 21st Grade I win on the year.

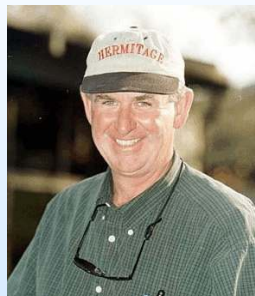

Cheveley Park's Red Bloom, whose dam Red Camellia was fourth in this event in 1996, buried that memory by cracking Snow Ridge's track record (see p6), which lasted just over half an hour. Third in a Newbury maiden on her debut July 18, she beat subsequent dual scorer Silk Fan (Ire) in a similar event at Newmarket last time Aug. 16. Breaking well under Kieren Fallon in this contest, she was reined back to stalk the early leader Punctilious, who raced keenly in the hands of Philip Robinson. Ridden on the turn into the straight, she joined the long-time leader at the quarter-mile marker before asserting passing the eighth pole. Challenged by Sundrop and Frankie Dettori in the closing stages, she responded to driving, despite veering right towards the rail, to hold that rival at bay. "She might want a bit more cut, but she's very tough so it didn't make much difference to her really," commented owner/breeder Patricia Thompson. Unbeaten Cactus Ridge earned his first graded-stakes victory by leading nearly every step of this one-turn mile. After wiring Arlington maidens in a 4 1/2-furlong test June 7, the bay colt travelled to Minnesota and annexed the Canterbury Juvenile S. by 15 lengths July 12. He added a 6 1/2-length win in the James C. Ellis Juvenile S. at Ellis Aug. 17, a seven-furlong event, and was the prohibitive 1-5 chalk while stretching out an extra eighth this time. He bobbled slightly at the start, but that was the only moment of apprehension for his backers. The homebred recovered smartly to lead at every call and opened up late while under a hand ride from Eddie Martin Jr. After a seven-furlong fraction of 1:22 4/5, Cactus Ridge stopped the clock in 1:35 2/5. The winner is the second foal from the Lycius mare Double Park (Fr), who finished third in the 1997 GI Santa Anita Oaks. Glittergem, coming off a successful debut on the Arlington Million undercard, was second best. [Click for the brisnet.com chart.](#)

Everyday Angel, an impressive 12-length maiden winner at Saratoga Aug. 11, showed good early speed to take the field through solid fractions of :23 and :45.97 as Zosima bided her time beneath Day from a close-up third. The favorite still held the call turning for home and began to widen a bit, but Zosima kicked in leaving the eighth pole and wore down Everyday Angel for the win.

As Michael Kinane drove Moscow Ballet past the long-time leader inside the final eighth, it was Snow Ridge who arrived on the scene to cut down that duo in the final 25 yards. "He's very exciting," Tregoning said of the winner. "We were very thrilled with his Kempton performance and Richard Hills [on the runner-up] said he came by him in about three strides, so we were cockily confident today. It just took him a while to get into gear, being green, but won decisively. He's short of experience and quite big and rangy, and sometimes with those horses there's a physical and mental immaturity. He wouldn't want too much this year and wants to grow up and learn a bit, but he's a very exciting prospect. On his dam side he'll get the Derby trip, but he'd also have enough speed for a Guineas." Coral Eurobet make him the 10-1 joint favorite with Yeats (Ire) for next year's Epsom Classic. The bay cruised to a 3 3/4-length score in the Apr. 5 GI Ashland S. at Keeneland, but has not been out since tiring to be fourth in the May 2 GI Kentucky Oaks. The Juddmonte homebred won four in a row from September of 2002 to May of 2003, capping the quartet of victories with a tally in the May 26 GI Gamely Breeders' Cup H. at Hollywood. The five-year-old has been out just once since, finishing in a dead-heat for second behind Megahertz in the July 26 GI John C. Mabee H. at Del Mar. The only question mark is the distance. The chestnut has finished off the board just twice in her life, once when racing on the dirt for the only time in her debut in June of 2001, and once when stretching out beyond nine furlongs for the only time when tiring to be sixth in the 2002 GI Beverly D. S. Trainer Ben Cecil, who won this race with Golden Apples (Ire) last year, saddles another Irish-bred this time. A Group 3 winner in her native country, four-year-old **Red Rioja** made her final European appearance last September, running fifth in a Listed race at Yarmouth, then was off for nearly a year before returning to take a Del Mar allowance Sept. 6. "She fractured her pelvis at the end of last year in Europe," Cecil explained. "I got her here in March. We took a lot of time with her. I ran her at Del Mar at a mile, which I thought was going to be too short for her, but she won quite nicely. A mile and a quarter is more her distance, but it's quite a step up." He added, "She's certainly not of the calibre of Golden Apples yet, but she ran some nice races in Europe last year and she's doing well, so we'll take a shot." **Musical Chimes**, winner of the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches and third in the G1 Prix de Diane this spring, makes her U.S. bow. She tired to be 10th in her latest outing, the Aug. 3 G2 Prix d'Astarte at Deauville.

They thought it was an abscess but when she was still lame yesterday morning there were x-rays taken of her foot and we found a crack in the pedal bone. They usually heel very well but we've been having other niggly problems with her and this has scuppered everything we had intended to do this year. We'll have her six weeks in the box and then review and make a decision in December as to whether we train her for the Guineas or whether she heads off to stud." Attraction was the most notable withdrawal from Thursday's six-furlong contest, for which 11 fillies remained yesterday.
