STORMING (STRAIGHT) HOME

Storming Home (GB) (Machiavellian)'s march to the front of the turf division was impeded by an inopportune spook at the finish of the GI Arlington Million in his last start, but the five-year-old got back on track yesterday with an impressive come-from-behind score in the GI Clement Hirsch Memorial Turf Championship S. at Santa Anita. Storming Home, winner of last year's G1 Champion S. at Newmarket, opened his U.S. campaign with victories in the May 10 Jim Murray Memorial H. and the June 14 GI Charles Whittingham H., but was disqualified from a first-place finish in the Aug. 16 Million and placed fourth. Under a patient Gary Stevens, the dark bay was content to settle off the pace as **Johar** (Gone West) set easy fractions of :25.46, :50.78 and 1:15.55. Three wide into the lane, Storming Home flew down the stretch, wearing down Johar with a :22 3/5 final quarter. **Cont. p. 2**

GOT KOKO?

Reigning Horse of the Year **Azeri** (Jade Hunter) had come to seem like a lock, but **Got Koko** (Signal Tap) took advantage of a dull performance by the consistent champ and rewrote the script with a game half-length victory in yesterday's GII Lady's Secret Breeders' Cup

H. at Santa Anita. Azeri, looking for her 12th straight victory was bet down to 1-5, while Got Koko, who swept the La Canada Series earlier in the year and finished second behind Azeri last out in the Aug. 10 GII Clement Hirsch H., was let go at 5-1. Allowed to settle at the back of the pack, Got Koko rallied four wide into the lane and finished strongly to best **Elloluv** (Gilded Time). Azeri, who toiled in mid-pack early, never produced a consistent run, finishing third before being promoted to second when Elloluv was disqualified for interference. "When I saw Azeri back there, I thought I had a good chance," winning rider Alex Solis admitted. "I knew my filly has a tremendous late kick. The pace was perfect; it was just right. And then my filly ran her race. TATES CREEK WINS YELLOW RIBBON

Tates Creek (Rahy) had a four-race win streak interrupted with a three-way dead-heat runner-up finish behind Megahertz in the GI John C Mabee H. at Del Mar July 26, but the five-year-old mare started a new streak with a strong performance in yesterday's GI Yellow Ribbon S. at Santa Anita. Sent off the 4-5 favorite, she ran a ground-saving third behind slow early fractions. Forced to steady behind foes on the turn, **Tates Creek** bullied her way through an opening at midstretch and outlasted French Oaks heroine **Musical Chimes** (In Excess {Ire}) for a 3/4-length triumph. "I could have moved up any time I wanted to, but why do it," Stevens commented on his ride aboard Storming Home (GB) in the Clement Hirsch. "I was comfortable and he was comfortable. He broke good, but was very relaxed and I dropped my hands back and he just dropped the bridle and all of a sudden I was last. It didn't matter because he is so talented. He came home in twenty-two and change, and after running a mile there's not many horses that can run a last quarter like that." Asked if he was worried about the slow early fractions, trainer Neil Drysdale said, "You bet I was concerned. He showed me another dimension today. He did it very well." An Off Day for Azeri *(Cont. from p. 1)*

"I'm at a loss for words, I don't what to say," jockey Mike Smith admitted after Azeri's dull performance in yesterday's GI Lady's Secret Breeders' Cup H. Azeri won 11 straight graded races and was 17 months removed from the lone loss of her 15-race career. "She broke really sluggishly, but that's not unusual for her," Smith said. "I thought, 'Well, I'll just tuck in behind them and save ground, and I'll be able to wheel out of there any time I want. That's what I did, and I got her out there in plenty of time to get her running, but I just couldn't get her running. She galloped out good after the race and acted like she was ready now, but it was a little too late."

'Ello Adoration

Elloluv, making her first start since finishing fourth in the May 2 GI Kentucky Oaks, took the lead in upper stretch. The filly drifted in at midstretch, impeding **Adoration** (Honor Grades) and was subsequently disqualified from her runner-up finish and placed fourth. "She just got a little tired and drifted in a little bit," explained Elloluv's jockey Corey Nakatani.

Tate's Creek Wins Yellow Ribbon *(cont. from p. 1)*

"She ran a great race and this is back-to-back Yellow Ribbons for me," jockey Pat Valenzuela said after guiding **Tate's Creek** to victory yesterday. The winner and runner-up **Musical Chimes** are both likely to meet again the Breeders' Cup F/M Turf. "I thought Musical Chimes ran a lovely race," trainer Neil Drysdale said of the French Oaks winner. "Musical Chimes, I think off this race justifies a try at the Breeders' Cup."

Mamool enjoyed the perfect warm-up for his tilt at the G1 Tooheys New Melbourne Cup at Flemington Nov. 4 with a comfortable second Group 1 success in this contest. Unlike last time when he enjoyed a lead en route to victory in the G1 Grosser Bugatti Preis at Baden Baden Sept. 7, the colt was forced to cut out his own running in the early stages. Passed by Well Made as that rival injected pace at half way, he always had his measure and cut him down at the quarter-mile marker to regain the advantage. Driven out to assert from there, he had too many guns for Albanova and George Duffield in the closing stages. Mamool has enjoyed a profitable European campaign in 2003, taking the G2 Yorkshire Cup at York May 15 before finishing fifth in the G1 Ascot Gold Cup at the Royal meeting June 19. Despite stamina being his forte, he proved he had the pace for middle distances when third behind Mubtaker in the G2 Geoffrey Freer S. at Newbury Aug. 16 and scoring at Baden Baden last time out. Halfbridled debuted with a 4 1/2-length win at Del Mar in July and quickly jumped up to stakes company with a dominant five-length victory in the GI Del Mar Debutante at seven furlongs Aug. 30. After making her move from just off the pace in her first start, the dark bay filly was closer to the pace in the Debutante and actually on the early lead here in her first try at a route. She allowed Tarlow to move to the fore down the backstretch, but regained command with ease turning for home and kicked clear down the lane for an authoritative score. "She is truly amazing," jockey Julie Krone said of the winner. "Her stride is incredible and again she galloped out like a monster. She's just so professional and so easy to ride. She's push button and I just get the pleasure of riding her." Winning trainer Richard Mandella, describing the race plan for Halfbridled, said, "We just kept her quiet up to her first race and let her settle back and finish. I told Julie in the second race, I said, 'Never mind what happened first time. She WILL leave there serious today.' And you saw what she did in the Debutante. So today, I told her this was too hard to figure out with all these young fillies, so just play it by ear and she did a beautiful job. I feel pretty confident in [Halfbridled]. I said from the start she's a pretty special filly, so I think I'll stick with that. I hope we can keep everything healthy [until the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies.]"

Content to track MGSW Tenpins in second through pedestrian early splits, Perfect Drift ranged up to that foe a quarter mile out, poked his head in front turning for home and drove clear late, while under a hand ride, to score with ease. "In his last couple of races he's been very matter of fact and professional," commented trainer Murray Johnson. "He's a stick of dynamite. He's a very live horse, but when it comes to conserving his energy, leading up to a race and in his training, he simply doesn't waste any." The winner of the GII Lane's End Spiral S. and the GIII Indiana Derby and third in the GI Kentucky Derby last year, Perfect Drift's crowning achievement was a win in this year's GI Stephen Foster H. at Churchill Downs June 14. Let go at almost 7-1 odds that day, the gelding stunned the racing world when he handed leading Horse of the Year candidate Mineshaft only his second loss this term. An emphatic five-length winner next time out in the 1 3/16-mile GII Washington Park H. at Arlington, the bay recorded his worst finish of 2003 when eighth on the grass in the GI Arlington Million Aug. 16, but rebounded to score in his latest, the nine-furlong GII Kentucky Cup Classic at Turfway Park Sept. 13. Responding to the clamoring masses for a date at Santa Anita Oct. 25 for the Breeders' Cup Classic, Johnson said, "I'll have to talk to the Reeds [owners William and Mary] about going to the Breeders' Cup Classic, but it's doubtful. We've achieved what we set out to do. Now we just have to sit back and see what we want to do next. I'm not sure that we want to send him to the hard tracks in California." This turned into a family affair as Peppercorn bested Peppershot in a triumph for owner/breeder Peter Alexander Battel's Stall Biovita and conditioner Uwe Ostmann. After finishing third in this race two years ago, Peppercorn took the G3 Grosser Preis von Dusseldorf and G3 Grosser Preis der Landeshauptstadt Dusseldorf before being transferred to Francois Doumen. After a relatively unsuccessful French campaign last year, during which he was fifth in this, he was tried over hurdles before being sent to Ostmann. He showed he was returning to his best when winning a handicap at Baden Baden last time Sept. 5. Back in against group company, he delivered a fine turn of acceleration to wear down his front-running sibling and stable companion in the final 100 yards.

BELMONT RUNNERS TAKE STOCK Mineshaft (A.P. Indy) returned from his win in Saturday's GI Jockey Club Gold Cup in good order, according to trainer Neil Howard, but a decision on the colt's participation in the Breeders' Cup Classic is still pending. A major concern for Mineshaft's connections is the ship to Santa Anita. "He's a good shipper and he's done everything well, but it's not like packing up your trunk and shipping from here to The Meadowlands," Howard said. "You're talking about going out there and running against **Medaglia d'Oro** (El Prado {Ire}) and **Ten Most Wanted** (Deputy Commander), horses that are already out there, they're good horses at the top of their game and they have that all-important acclimation problem behind them. You can't give an edge to those kinds of horses." Mineshaft is scheduled to fly to Kentucky Wednesday and there could be a decision on his fate in the Breeders' Cup later this week.

Frankel Weighs In

Meanwhile, Bobby Frankel, who trains Medaglia d'Oro, weighed in on Mineshaft's to-Cup or not-to-Cup decision. "I think he's putting the Horse of the Year in jeopardy," Frankel said. "What has Medaglia d'Oro done wrong? He's allowed to get beat once in a while. What if he goes and wins [the Classic]? That's the championship race. Look at who [Mineshaft] has run against. He hasn't beaten anything. He beat Quest. Medaglia d'Oro beats him 20 lengths when he runs against him, but I don't want to make a big deal about Medaglia. Let him win--then you'll hear me." Frankel added that **Peace Rules** (Jules) may join the Classic contenders, but **Ghostzapper** (Awesome Again), winner of Saturday's GI Vosburgh will skip the Breeders' Cup Sprint. "I know everyone was very impressed, but this is Belmont Park, not Santa Anita," Frankel said of Ghostzapper's Vosburgh victory. "He made his run on the turn and you can't do that at Santa Anita. Most likely, I'll put him away until the Carter next year, bring him back here and have him for the rest of the year." Frankel also said Juddmonte Farms' **Heat Haze** (GB) (Green Desert), third in the GI Flower Bowl Invitational S., will make her next start in the Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Turf.

Tregoning also revealed that Saturday's G2 Royal Lodge S. winner **Snow Ridge (Ire)** (Indian Ridge {Ire}) may run in the G1 Racing Post Trophy at Doncaster Oct. 18, depending on ground conditions. "We'll need about 10 days to see how he is and see how he is moving, but he only lost five pounds yesterday and he looks a picture and is perfectly sound," the trainer said.
