**KATIE CARRIES ON**

Mohammed Rashid's **Carry on Katie** (Fasliyev) wired yesterday's G1 Sky Bet Cheveley Park S. at Newmarket, showing determination to defy **Majestic Desert** (GB) (Fraam {GB}) by a short head in a pulsating finish. Taken to post steadily by Frankie Dettori, the 13-8 favorite was eased to the front from the gate and quickened to a decisive advantage inside the final quarter as her rivals lined up behind. It was Kieren Fallon who delivered the challenge on **Majestic Desert**, but **Carry on Katie** pulled out extra to cling to her diminishing lead in the drive to the line. "Today she's proved herself the best two-year-old filly in training," said conditioner Jeremy Nosedá, enjoying his second renewal after the exploits of **Wannabe Grand** (Ire) in 1998. "She's tricky but she's just exuberant and wants to get on with her work. She misses the middle gears--there's a first gear and a fifth but there isn't much in between. It was a game effort and she's done it the hard way." **RECORDS FALL AT HOUGHTON**

The second and final evening session of the Tattersalls Houghton Sale concluded in the same style that Europe's top yearling auction had started: quite spectacularly. Leading last night's session was Lot [115](#), a filly by freshman sire **Giant's Causeway** who was knocked down to Coolmore principal **John Magnier** for a robust 1,250,000gns. The chestnut, out of the unraced **Shirley Heights** (GB) mare **Colorsnap** (GB), was consigned to the sale by **Meon Valley Stud**. Thursday's session saw 57 lots sold at an average of 264,087gns, an increase of 18 percent over 2002's figures, with a median of 160,000gns remaining unchanged from last year. *Houghton coverage cont. p2*

**A GIANT AT THE MEADOWLANDS?**

It would be fitting if New Jersey-bred **Jersey Giant** (Evening Kris) stepped up to win tonight's GII Meadowlands Breeders' Cup S. at the Meadowlands complex, which happens to be the home of football's New York Giants. Second, beaten three-parts of a length, in the GIII **Salvator Mile H.** at **Monmouth Park** July 26, **Jersey Giant** turned in a career-best effort when third, just a length behind the classy **Tenpins**, in the Aug. 23 GIII **Iselin Breeders' Cup H.** at **Monmouth**. The dark bay gelding was most recently the narrow winner of the **Skip Trial S.** at the **Jersey Shore** Sept. 13, but showed no ill effects from an apparent tough effort, as he returned to work six furlongs in a spectacular 1:09 2/5 Sept. 26. **Volponi** (Cryptoclearance) attempts to punch his ticket to **Santa Anita** in the race he used as a springboard to victory in last year's **Classic**. Winless in six starts this campaign, the bay comes into this off a third-place effort in the GII **Belmont Breeders' Cup H.** on the turf Sept. 13. He gets blinkers off tonight. GIII **Lone Star Derby** hero **Dynever** (Dynaformer) was a tough-luck second to **Soto** in the GIII **West Virginia Derby** Aug. 9, but was a disappointing sixth in the slop in the Sept. 1 GIII **Pennsylvania Derby** in his latest effort.

**Small Catalog Yields Big Prices...**

Trade over the two days of the Houghton sale saw 110 yearlings set a new record average and median of 266,727gns and 200,000gns, respectively, up 17 percent and 25 percent over last year's figures. With just 139 offered at the sale, it was the smallest Tattersalls Houghton sale ever. "Small can sometimes be beautiful," said Tattersalls chairman Edmond Mahony. "In an ideal world, we would have preferred to have catalogued closer to 200 yearlings for this week, but the smallest Houghton catalogue ever has broken records for average price and median, and even managed to exceed last year's turnover, which was in excess of 28,000,000gns."

**Big Two Lock Horns Early...**

The first clash on Thursday between the world's two most powerful bloodstock interests happened over Lot 89, a Fasiliyev colt out of the unraced Aunty Eileen (Ire) (Ahoonora {GB}). John Magnier of Coolmore, bidding himself as he usually does at this sale from high in the bidders' area, went to 600,000gns for the well-moving colt, who was consigned by Ashtown House Stud in Ireland. The underbidder was Sheikh Mohammed, the driving force behind Godolphin, and it was this early impetus that drove the evening's proceedings forward.

**Grandera's Brother to Gordon-Watson...**

Lot 102, a full brother to the Godolphin-campaigned Grandera (Ire) (Grand Lodge), went not to Sheikh Mohammed--who was uninvolved in the bidding--but instead to agent Charlie Gordon-Watson, who spent more money on a yearling than he had ever done before: 800,000gns. Gordon-Watson was not content to stop there, going to 1,200,000gns for Lot 114, the only remaining produce of Dubai Millennium left in the sale after one other was withdrawn. Bred by Dr. Tony Ryan, Lot 114 is one of just 56 Dubai Millennium foals. "She had to be bought--she had rarity value with that pedigree and there aren't any more of them," Gordon-Watson said. Magnier was responsible for the remaining seven-figure lot of the night--Lot 132--a Sadler's Wells colt from Timmy Hyde's Camas Park Stud in Ireland. Magnier saw fit to go to 1,200,000gns for the bay, outbidding Hamdan Al Maktoum's racing manager Angus Gold. A full to Lot 132, purchased by Demi O'Byrne for 550,000gns at last year's Houghton sale, recently broke his maiden at Galway as the odds-on choice.

**Katie Keeps Perfect...**

Carry on Katie had not seen another rival in her two starts to date, in an Ascot maiden July 25 and in the G2 Lowther S. at York last time Aug. 21. On the latter occasion she took off with Dettori on the way to the start before comfortably beating **Badminton (GB)** (Zieten) by two lengths. "We had her down here 10 days ago to try and get her relaxed and schooled her, and she jogged down to the start nicely," Nosedá explained. "Once in the race she's actually an uncomplicated ride and I said to Frankie not to take her back and just to let her run her race." Dettori added, "She gets a bit warm, but that's in her nature. She got her head down and ran to the line and Kieren was never going to get by me." Connections revealed that she would winter in Dubai before possibly being aimed at the spring Classics next term. Nosedá commented that she has "a big chance" of staying the mile of the G1 1000 Guineas at this track in May, for which bookmakers William Hill make her the 8-1 favorite. "She's relaxing and growing up, but that's a long way away and Mohammed Rashid will make a decision after she has come out of winter quarters," he said.

☆ Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe ☆

**BRIGHT SKY OUT** Alec Wildenstein yesterday withdrew **Bright Sky (Ire)** (Wolfhound) from Sunday's G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp. Despite the defection of the Elie Lellouche-trained four-year-old, who will instead contest the G1 Prix de l'Opera on the undercard, the field stayed at 16 after yesterday's forfeit stage. As expected, Sir Michael Stoute paid the €60,000 supplementary fee for the Saeed Suhail color-bearer **First Charter (GB)** (Polish Precedent), who will serve as a rabbit for G1 Epsom Derby winner **Kris Kin** (Kris S.). Aidan O'Brien also withdrew **Yesterday (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), while **Alamshar (Ire)** (Key of Luck) is likely to be scratched at today's final forfeit. With rain-fall at the track during the week, the penetrometer read 3.6 yesterday, with a drying weather forecast.

Milk It Mick has endured most of the season's cock-fights, but showed he was not done with here, delivering a late kick to record a deserved first stakes score. Alongside a maiden and two conditions scores, the journeyman colt boasts third-place finishes in the Listed Chesham S. at Royal Ascot June 18 and Listed Washington Singer S. at Newbury Aug. 15, and a runner-up placing in the G3 Solario S. at Sandown Aug. 30. He finished fifth in the G2 Champagne S. at Doncaster last time Sept. 12, but bounced back with this career-best effort. Settled in rear by Pat Eddery off the fast fractions cut out by Brunel (Ire) (Marju {Ire}), he was asked to quicken down the outer Bayeux forged up the inside of the tiring leader. Responding gamely to the Eddery drive, Milk it Mick cut down that rival and Bachelor Duke in the final strides to provide conditioner Jamie Osborne with his first group success. "We've been debating long and hard how to ride him, but we took a chance today in dropping him in," Osborne explained. **Shadwell Stud Middle Park S. cont.**

Described by Frankie Dettori earlier this year as the most exciting two-year-old he had ever ridden, **Kheleyf** (Green Desert) enters today's G1 Shadwell Stud Middle Park S. at Newmarket with high expectations. Reports of glowing homework leaked before he debuted in a York maiden May 13 and the brother to the ill-fated Bint Allayl (GB) transferred that to the track, brushing aside subsequent stakes performers in the manner of a high-class colt. Despite being most people's 'banker' at Royal Ascot, he found Russian Valour (Ire) 1 3/4 lengths too strong in the G3 Norfolk S. June 19, where **Nevisian Lad (GB)** (Royal Applause {GB}) and **Old Deuteronomy** (Storm Cat) were back in third and fourth. Given a break afterwards, he returned to take a conditions event at Doncaster in facile fashion last time Sept. 13 and he is primed to provide David Loder with his third renewal since 1996. **Balmont** (Stravinsky) bested **Fokine** (Royal Academy) by a head in a competitive renewal of the G2 Gimcrack S. at York last time Aug. 20. **Grand Reward** (Storm Cat), hampered when fourth in that contest before being promoted to third, was subsequently beaten 3/4 of a length by Byron (GB) in the G2 Mill Reef S. at Newbury Sept. 19. He will be helped by a squadron of stable companions to help draw the sting from the speed horses here, as Aidan O'Brien searches for his third renewal since Minardi opened his account in 2000. **Three Valleys** (Diesis {GB}) demolished the field assembled for the G3 Coventry S. at Royal Ascot June 17 but could finish only third behind One Cool Cat and Old Deuteronomy in the G1 Phoenix S. at The Curragh last time Aug. 10. He returned with mucus in his lungs on that occasion and has another opportunity to impress. **Whipper** beat Much Faster (Ire) in desperate ground in the G1 Prix Morny at Deauville last time Aug. 31 and faces a tougher assignment on this occasion.

James Scaturochio's **Lokoya** put up a determined fight when a nose runner-up to Marylebone in the GI Matron S. at Belmont Sept. 14, pressing sharp early fractions before going all-out to stave off her fast-closing stablemate. The dark bay missed by the narrowest of margins and the final time of the contest, 1:38 flat, was relatively unspectacular, but if nothing the race proved her tenacity. Another young filly with a Grade I stakes placing is Tom Van Meter's **Be Gentle**.
