HITTING THE HEIGHTS

Aidan O'Brien has yet to add the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe Lucien Barriere to his burgeoning portfolio, but he has the right material to do so in **High Chaparral (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells). Michael Tabor's turf champion of 2002 arrives at Longchamp sharper than he was 12 months ago, when he met with only his second defeat in finishing third behind Marienbard (Ire). But, after failing to pull off the Arc win, he stepped it up to take the G1 Breeders' Cup Turf at Arlington later in the month. Kept off the track by a shoulder injury until late summer, he enjoyed the perfect re-introduction when winning the G2 Royal Whip S. at the Curragh Aug. 10, then had the cream of Europe's turf performers behind when taking the G1 Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown Sept. 6. "Aidan is very happy with the horse," jockey Mick Kinane told the *Irish Independent*. "He's come forward well from Leopardstown and will give a real good account of himself. He was very rusty in last year's Arc, but has had proper preparation this time." **Arc cont. p3**

ZITO UNCORKS BUBBLY

Trainer Nick Zito won his fourth G1 Champagne S. in six years when **Birdstone** (Grindstone) overcame favored **Chapel Royal** (Montbrook) in the stretch at Belmont yesterday afternoon. But unlike Zito's previous Champagne winners The Groom Is Red ('98) and A P Valentine ('00), the Marylou Whitney homebred is not likely to head for the G1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile. "This is probably his last race of the year," said Zito. "He's a late foal [May 16], and the Breeders' Cup Juvenile comes up too soon." Birdstone moved up of his own accord after a :23.90 opening quarter and flanked Chapel Royal on the sweeping Belmont turn. He put a head in front with a furlong to run and edged away from the favorite. "I didn't want to let a horse like Chapel Royal get away and have to come and run him down," explained winning rider Jerry Bailey. "He was there when I asked him to run." **Champagne cont. p2**

CHAMPAGNE WISHES FOR BIRDSTONE A half brother to Kentucky Oaks and Acorn heroine Bird Town (second in the GI Beldame later on the Belmont card), **Birdstone** (Grindstone) had posted one of the most eye-catching maiden victories at Saratoga when he romped by 12 lengths on Whitney Day. He earned a 99 Beyer in that Aug. 2 effort and went postward as the 2-1 second choice to 3-5 **Chapel Royal** (Montbrook) in the GI Hopeful S. Aug. 30. But both colts tasted defeat that day as Silver Wagon swept them aside. Birdstone had been moving well on the turn in the Hopeful before flattening out in the stretch to finish fourth, and trainer Nick Zito's decision to skip the Sept. 14 GI Futurity S. proved to be the right call when Birdstone posted a professional victory in the \$500,000 Champagne. The bay is the fourth Champagne hero for Zito, who won three straight (1998-2000) with The Groom Is Red, Greenwood Lake and A P Valentine. Lane's End Breeders' Futurity-GII cont.

Buckram Oak homebred Eurosilver could be headed for Breeders' Cup gold following a very impressive display in this two-turn contest. The big colt was second best to fellow Buckram Oak runner Silver Wagon in a Saratoga maiden Aug. 8, crossing the wire 7 1/2 lengths behind that colt. But that effort looked a lot better when Silver Wagon triumphed in the GI Hopeful S. Aug. 30, and Eurosilver promptly dispensed of his maiden status the next day at the Spa, winning a 6 1/2-furlong contest by 5 3/4 lengths. With stablemate (and fellow Unbridled grandson) Birdstone holding down the fort in New York, the dark bay went out of town to make his stakes debut and answered the two-turn question very capably. Taken in hand early by Javier Castellano, Eurosilver kicked into gear on the turn, went by favored Value Plus (Unbridled's Song) in midstretch and strode home impressively. "The Breeders' Cup is a very big possibility," said Mohammed Moubarak, Buckram Oak's racing manager. "We'll see how he comes out of the race. He's taken a little while to come to hand. Nick [trainer Zito] has done a super job." Tiger Hunt, dismissed at 12-1 despite boasting a victory in the MGD Cradle S., finished well to claim second. The 2-1 second choice Mass Media (Touch Gold), trying two turns for the first time, was carried wide heading into the clubhouse turn and eventually backed up to finish a distant 10th. "He's had everything his own way in his first two races, and this was a different group of horses today," said trainer Cole Norman. "He had a wide trip that didn't help."

Zito's Big Day...

Victories in the day's biggest events for juveniles pleased the ever ebullient Nick Zito. "Winning two, two-year-old races for two breeders, back-to-back, starting from scratch...I told my wife Kim, 'I think this is our best work,'" said Zito. "These are both homebreds and the breeders [Marylou Whitney and Monsour Fustok of Buckram Oak] deserve a lot." Dalakhani Fits the Bill...

His Highness the Aga Khan's G1 Prix du Jockey-Club hero **Dalakhani (Ire)** (Darshaan {GB}) fits the profile of a typical Arc winner. Since 1991, Suave Dancer, Peintre Celebre and Montjeu (Ire) all followed success in that Classic with victory here, and the grey deserves to be named in the same breath as those heroes. He enjoyed the traditional mid-summer break after losing his unbeaten tag when runner-up to Alamshar (Ire) in the G1 Irish Derby June 29. Emerging from that rest, he beat **Doyen (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) and **Kris Kin** (Kris S.) in the most informative trial, the G2 Prix Niel over course and distance Sept. 14. His wide draw is a concern, as are the ever-softening ground conditions, but he is in pole position to provide his owner/breeder with his third Arc.

"We have a very bad draw, but for him it's not too bad because of the way he can be ridden," Dalakhani's jockey Christophe Soumillon told *PA Sport*. "If he comes out of the gate last we will wait there, because I know he has a very good finish over the last 400 metres. It is a very good race, an open race."

Ange Gabriel (Fr) (Kaldounevees {Fr}) is not to be underestimated, having won six of his last seven races at Group 1 or Group 2 level. Henri Devin's ultra-consistent grey looked top-class when recording a facile score in the G2 Prix Foy over course and distance last time Sept. 14 and should be in the shake-up. Recent rain will help **Vinnie Roe (Ire)** (Definite Article {GB}) make his mark and he is far from an outsider, having won the last three renewals of the G1 Irish St Leger at The Curragh. He looked better than ever when beating Gamut (Ire) to for the three-peat Sept. 13.

Another powerful performance by Sightseek gave trainer Bobby Frankel his record 23rd Grade I victory of 2003, and the four-year-old booked her ticket to the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff at Santa Anita Oct. 25. But the chestnut suffered three defeats at the Arcadia oval over the winter, and headed East to secure consecutive wins in the GI Humana Distaff H. May 3, the GI Ogden Phipps H. June 21 and the GI Go for Wand H. July 27. Content to let the pace develop up front in this one, the chestnut rolled up on the outside on the turn, collared Bird Town at the top of the stretch and strode home smartly. "I wanted to get away with this race without pushing her too hard," said Frankel. "I thought she ran good, but I know she can run even better than that. [The Distaff] is probably going to be the best race on the [Breeders' Cup] card, if they all show up."

Perfect Soul kicked off 2003 with an allowance victory over this course Apr. 13 and has held solid company since. He won the GII King Edward Breeders' Cup H. at Woodbine June 15, then ran second over that course in the GII Chinese Cultural Centre S. July 20. The bay placed fifth in the GI Arlington Million Aug. 16, beaten only 3/4 of a length, and rallied to finish third last out in the GI Atto Mile Sep. 14. In this one, he was unhurried early, worked his way out behind a wall of horses to be six or seven wide when straightened for home and was hard ridden to be along in time. "I was very confident going into this race," winning rider Edgar Prado said. "He finished very strong in the Atto Mile and I thought he'd have a great chance today. We had a great trip. They were smokin' up front [:23, :46 1/5], so I just waited and the horse responded." GISW Honor in War ran five or six wide much of the way, reached the front approaching the final furlong, but failed to repel the winner's surge and placed second. The 5-2 favorite Trademark came up empty in the drive and finished sixth. Society Selection stumbled at the start of her debut at Saratoga 18, but recovered to post a 3 1/2-length score at 17-1. Better backed facing Grade I company in her second start, the bay filly was last after the opening quarter, but moved up while saving ground on the far turn. She angled outside for the final drive and fought her way past Victory U.S.A. inside the eighth pole to give her sire and her jockey, 30-year-old Trinidad native Ray Ganpath, their first Grade I wins. "Ray has always gotten on this filly, ever since she came from the farm," trainer Allen Jerkens said. "I know who the great riders are, but they can't get on the horses in the mornings and get a good association with them." He added, "If she is sound and eats well, we'll go to the Breeders' Cup. She should be able to manage two turns." Jerkens has been off the board in all five prior Breeders' Cup tries. GI Matron S. winner Marylebone (Unbridled's Song) struggled home last. "It sounds like she might have displaced her palate," trainer Todd Pletcher said.

Pleasantly Perfect came home a 3 1/4-length winner in this event last year, but couldn't go on to the Breeders' Cup at Arlington because he bled slightly in the race, and Illinois regulations prohibited him from starting in the GI Classic. The bay had been out just twice since. "I wouldn't have bet in a million years that [the leaders] would walk like that, but [Alex Solis] sensed that and moved him right up into contention," trainer Richard Mandella said. It turned out to be ladies' day at Santa Anita as trainer Kathy Walsh and jockey Julie Krone teamed up to become the first female duo to win a graded stakes together at Oak Tree. I think he deserves a little rest now; he's danced quite a few dances in a row."

Young jockey Corey Brown punched the air jubilantly as Clangalang overwhelmed heavily backed favorite Grand Armee to give him his third Group 1 win on the afternoon. "I'll never forget this day; it's a one in a million to win three Group 1 races in a row," said an exultant Brown, who also scored with Uneathly in the G1 Flight S. and Niello in the G1 Spring Champion S. "I knew I was going in with three great rides. Clangalang was a bit 'iffy' because he had a setback, but I was more than happy to be riding him." Grand Armee surged to the front at the 250-meter mark while Clangalang, beginning from barrier 17, was faced with a wall of horses approaching the turn. Undeterred, Brown wove an ingenious path through the field in a beautifully timed run to enable the rangy gelding to score a determined win. Clangalang overcame an injury cloud to become the first horse (since the AJC Derby was moved to the autumn in 1979) to win the Derby-Epsom double in the same year. Trainer Gerald Ryan has a Cox Plate showdown with Lonhro in mind for Clangalang, and has had the horse inoculated for a possible tilt at the Hong Kong International Vase at Sha Tin in December. Clangalang's spring campaign was in doubt 10 days ago as he suffered suspected suspensory ligament damage to his right foreleg during trackwork. But, he remarked yesterday, "I was quietly confident after he sprinted in his work on Tuesday. Three weeks ago things did not look good, but after scans and X-rays and a lot of ice and an easy time to get the swelling and the bruising out, he's recovered. He's shown he is not just a one-paced plugger who won the AJC Derby on a biased track. He is a genuine Group 1 horse."

She showed she is in peak form when taking the Listed Henry Gee Fillies' S. at Chester Sept. 24.

"But he's done real well for us and, hopefully, next year he can come back just as strong." The Arkansas-bred had won four of his five starts this year prior to the Phoenix. His career record stands at 14-10-3-0 with earnings of \$499,400.

WHITHER AENEAS? Patricia Pavlish's **Aeneas** (Capote) could be headed to the GI Breeders' Cup Classic Oct. 25 at Santa Anita, so long as **Perfect Drift** (Dynaformer) isn't in the starting gate. "If Perfect Drift goes, we'll wait for the GII Clark H. at Churchill Downs, because [Perfect Drift] isn't expected to run in both," said trainer Marty Wolfson. FILLIES TOP ARC SALE [Hip 25](#), a bay filly by Barathea (Ire) out of the Caerleon mare Zelda (Ire) held joint top honors with [hip 36](#), a German-bred mare by Pelder (Ger) out of Septima (Ger) (Touching Wood), at yesterday's Goffs Arc Sale at the Saint-Cloud Sales Complex. Both sophomores secured €320,000 final bids, placing them well ahead of the next highest lot which realized €170,000. Consigned by Robert Collet, multiple-placed **Chabada (Ire)**, a half sister to multiple Group winner and Group 1 placed Zipping (Ire) and G3 Prix Bois victor Zelding (Ire), was purchased by Suprina Bloodstock. Seven lots later Group-placed **Senex (Ger)** took center stage and Mehl Mulhens gave top dollar to purchase the filly from the Hans Blume consignment. For its sixth renewal, the sale experienced an increase in RNAs over last year, with 29 finding a buyer from 54 head through the ring. Among those failing to meet their reserve was Group 3 winner **Whortleberry (Fr)** (Starborough {GB}), who fell short of a €580,000 final bid. Earlier yesterday afternoon, the filly finished a nose back in second in the G2 Prix de Royallieu Hotel du Golf Barriere at Longchamp. Attended by British ambassador the Count of Derby, a committee made up of French Racing authorities met on January 24, 1920 and decided to create a highly prestigious international race, complementary to the Grand Prix de Paris.

In search of a title to pay tribute to the French soldiers that served in the first World War, the committee came down to two possible contenders, the 'Prix de la Victoire' and the eventual choice, the 'Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe.'

Inaugurated at Longchamp, the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe was first contested on Sunday, October 3, 1920.

The winner of the inaugural edition, Comrade, collected FF150,000 for the win.

Traditionally run on the first Sunday in October, with the exception of 1939 and 1940, the Arc will be run for the 82nd time on Sunday October 5, 2003.
