**RECORDS CONTINUE TO FALL AT TATTS**

It was another record-breaking session at the Tattersalls October Yearling Sale (Part One) yesterday where the 40,433gns average was up by 38 percent and the 30,000gns median was 25 percent up on 12 months ago. Tattersalls sold 232 yearlings yesterday for 9,380,500gns, a large increase over last year when just 130 lots sold. There were 15 six-figure lots sold yesterday, compared to just two on the same day in 2002. The top price of 320,000gns was paid by Coolmore agent Demi O'Byrne for a Giant's Causeway colt out of Shalimar (Ire) (Indian Ridge {Ire}). Bred by Lady Bamford, the colt was consigned by Anthony Penfold's Bugley Stud. Sheikh Hamdan Al Maktoum's Racing Manager Angus Gold was underbidder. United States-based Joe Allbritton of Lazy Lane Farms purchased the second-highest priced yearling, a first-crop Diktat (GB) (Warning {GB}) colt consigned for Courtleigh Stud by David and Trish Brown's Furnace Mill Stud. **BREEDERS' CUP BULLETIN**

**Ruler's Court to Skip Breeders' Cup Juvenile**

Darley Stable's **Ruler's Court** (Doneraile Court), dominant 14-length winner of the GII Norfolk S., will bypass the Oct. 25 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile.



Jimmy Bell, spokesman for Darley Stable said, "Sheikh Mohammed has a well-documented desire to win the Kentucky Derby for Godolphin, therefore he has made the decision that it would be in the best interest of the colt to pass on the Juvenile." A debut winner at Hollywood in June, Ruler's Court was third in GIII Hollywood Juvenile Championship and fourth in the GII Best Pal before winning the Norfolk.

**Eurosilver to Rest, Najran Retired**

Buckram Oak Farm's **Eurosilver** (Unbridled's Song), impressive winner of the GII Lane's End Breeders' Futurity Oct. 4, will be put away for the season and readied for a spring campaign while **Najran** (Runaway Groom), also raced by Buckram Oak, has been retired to stud following his victory in the GIII Phoenix Breeders' Cup S. Oct. 3. The status of the stakes winners was determined during a Wednesday evening meeting with Buckram Oak owner Monsour Fustock, racing manager Mohammed Moubarak and trainer Nick Zito. "Eurosilver walked on Sunday and Monday," Zito explained. "We hacked him a little bit on Wednesday and I noticed a bit of a shin. I had Dr. [Mark] Cheney x-ray him and the shin was clean, but the x-ray showed some periostitis, an inflammation of the periosteum, which is a bucked shin." Najran, who gained notoriety when he won the eight-furlong GIII Westchester H. in a world-record equaling 1:32 1/5 this past May, retires with seven wins from 15 career starts and earnings of \$483,448. "We were very pleased with Najran's victory in the Phoenix," Zito continued. "The decision was made to retire him on a happy note. We are entertaining offers from several farms in Kentucky. We will try to find the best possible spot for him."

**Fleetstreet Dancer Joins Classic Field**

**Fleetstreet Dancer** (Smart Strike), claimed for \$40,000 a year ago, will target the Breeders' Cup Classic after running second in Sunday's GII Goodwood Breeders' Cup H. "He's a hard trier and he likes this track," explained trainer Doug O'Neill. "I can't imagine there being more than seven or eight horses in the race, to be honest with you. It's 120 grand to run even if you're nominated. I don't know who's going to be that eager to run a longshot and pay 120 grand, so I guess if we don't get in, it wasn't meant to be. But at this point, we plan to run. I would think the defections have to help our chances."

**Forest Music Possible for Juvenile Fillies**

Owner Michael Gill plans to aim **Forest Music** (Unbridled's Song), impressive winner of a Laurel maiden Wednesday, to the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies. In her first start, the gray filly earned a Beyer Speed Figure of 105. She completed the race in 1:08.53, the fastest debut six furlongs in the 92-year history of Laurel Park and just three-fifths off the track record set by Richter Scale in the 2000 GI De Francis Dash.

**Working Towards the Cup**

**Got Koko** (Signal Tap), who defeated reigning Horse of the Year **Azeri** (Jade Hunter) in the Sept. 28 GII Lady's Secret Breeders' Cup H., worked five furlongs Tuesday at Santa Anita in 1:00.40. "We just wanted to get her loosened up," said trainer Bruce Headley. "Her style is to come from off the pace, but Lady Luck always has something to say about everything. Hopefully, she has the right thing to say."

Breeders' Cup Turf hopeful **Irish Warrior** (Irish River {Fr}) worked four furlongs over Hollywood's main track Thursday in :48. **Megahertz** (GB) (Pivotal {GB}), aiming for the F/M Turf, went six furlongs over Hollywood's main track Thursday in 1:14.40.

**European Notes**

Godolphin's **Moon Ballad** (Ire) (Singspiel {Ire}) will not run in the Classic, but the race could feature Juddmonte Farms' **Weightless** (GB) (In the Wings {GB}), the impressive winner of Saturday's G2 Prix Dollar at Longchamp...The Niarchos Family's G1 Prix Jacques le Marois winner **Six Perfections** (Fr) (Celtic Swing {GB}) was reported on target for the Mile by conditioner Pascal Bary. "The plan is for Six Perfections to go to California, but I want to make sure that my filly is in the best order and I will make a final decision after she has worked at the weekend," he told the *Post*.

**Classic Considered for Falbrav**

Teruya Yoshida and Scuderia Rencati's **Falbrav** (Ire) (Fairy King) could be a surprise supplementary entry to the GI Breeders' Cup Classic, it was revealed yesterday. Despite the assertion from conditioner Luca Cumani that the five-year-old "runs in the Turf," he revealed to the *Racing Post* that the dirt contest is under serious consideration. "Running him in [the Classic] would be a punt, but should Falbrav win it, it would prove him more versatile than Giant's Causeway and Sakhee, and give him an incomparable profile as a stallion prospect," the Newmarket-based trainer told the *Post*. "Should he get beaten in the Classic, all people would do is deride me for running him on the dirt, but I can live with that. The Classic is missing some of the top dirt horses, like Mineshaft, Empire Maker and Candy Ride, but Medaglia d'Oro seems virtually unbeatable round Santa Anita. The Turf means taking on Sulamani, which will not be straightforward. However, I believe Falbrav has a faster kick than Sulamani, who is more of a horse who winds up his challenge." But Cumani concluded, "As things stand, it is the idea to run in the Turf." Falbrav looks likely to be pre-entered in both the Classic and Turf at next Tuesday's deadline.

**Tornado to Miss Cup?**

Juddmonte Farms' **Nebraska Tornado** (Storm Cat) may sidestep the Breeders' Cup after it was announced that she will remain in training as a four-year-old. Despite being touted as a live candidate for the Filly & Mare Turf at Santa Anita Oct. 25, the G1 Prix de Diane Hermes (French Oaks) and G1 Prix du Moulin de Longchamp winner looks likely to stay at home. "There are various considerations for our horses at the Breeders' Cup, but the most likely is that Tates Creek and Heat Haze will go for the Filly & Mare Turf, while Oasis Dream is an intended runner in the Mile," Prince Khalid Abdullah's racing manager Teddy Grimthorpe told the *Racing Post*. "Nebraska Tornado has done spectacularly well this year, climaxed by her success in the Moulin, and she will stay in training next year. We will see how she is and monitor how the other horses are progressing and she has got the option of going for the Mile, but it wouldn't be a great surprise if she were to skip the Breeders' Cup. Before further decisions are made, I shall talk to both the Prince and [trainer] Andre Fabre."

**CREME FRAICHE DEAD** Belmont S. winner **Creme Fraiche** (Rich Cream--Likely Exchange, by Terrible Tiger) was euthanized Thursday at owner Betty Moran's Brushwood Stable near Malvern, Pennsylvania after suffering a brief and acute episode of laminitis. The 21-year-old became the fourth of a record five straight Belmont S. winners for Hall of Fame trainer Woody Stephens when he captured the Classic in 1985. He is the only gelding to ever win the Belmont S. As a three-year-old, Creme Fraiche won the GI Super Derby Invitational H., GI American Derby and GI Jerome H. Third in the 1985 GI Jockey Club Gold Cup, he returned to win the race in 1986 and in 1987. He also won the 1987 GI Meadowlands Cup H. Creme Fraiche raced 64 times, finishing on the board in 42 races and winning 17. He retired in 1989 with earnings of \$4,024,727. Creme Fraiche's death leaves Danzig Connection as the lone survivor of Stephens's five Belmont S. winners.

Clock Stopper rallied stoutly on the far turn and pulled away late en route to a richly deserved first stakes victory in the Thursday feature. Sixth to Champali in the Northern Dancer S. going a flat mile at Churchill June 14, the chestnut was caught at the wire by subsequent GI Vosburgh S. winner Ghostzapper in a July 26 allowance test at Saratoga. He recovered from an awkward start in a six-furlong allowance at the Spa Aug. 16 to win by 6 1/4 lengths and was coming into this off an excellent runner-up finish, 3 1/2 lengths clear of Champali in third, in the Gill Kentucky Cup Sprint at Turfway Park Sept. 13. Never far back while chasing the pace four wide, Clock Stopper kicked into high gear on the turn, took command approaching the furlong pole and kicked clear.

### Pari-Mutuel Handle Increases In Third Quarter:

Third quarter figures of 'Thoroughbred Racing Economic Indicators' for North American pari-mutuel wagering on U.S. Thoroughbred racing, U.S. purses and race days in 2003 were released yesterday by the National Thoroughbred Racing Association and Equibase Company LLC. According to the report, total wagering increased to \$4,007,591,917, a 3.38-percent increase over the same quarter last year while third quarter purses dipped 4.15 percent to \$306,800,417. Compared with third-quarter figures in 2002, racing days declined from 1966 last year to 1950 this term. "The increase in pari-mutuel wagering during the last quarter can be attributed in part to the positive impact of the movie 'Seabiscuit,'" said NTRA Commissioner Tim Smith. "In the month after the film's release, wagering increased 5.51 percent over the comparable period in 2002, with no additional racing days. Record-setting meets at tracks like Del Mar and Saratoga also helped fuel the growth we observed in August. Purses, while down against the comparable quarter of 2002, remain fairly constant for the year."

### RTCA Honors Workers With White Horse Heroes Day:

The Race Track Chaplaincy of America, in conjunction with several other racing organizations, will host the inaugural National White Horse Heroes Day on Oct. 23 during the special White Horse Heroes Luncheon which will be held at Santa Anita's Seabiscuit Court. Telecast live on TVG, the award will be presented by WinStar Farm co-owner Kenny Troutt to the one industry worker judged to have performed the most heroic act on behalf of horse or human. Four finalist will all receive paid trips, sponsored by *Daily Racing Form*, to this year's Breeders' Cup at Santa Anita Park and the winner will receive a \$5,000 cash award and a special bronze 'White Horse Trophy.'
