DALAKHANI RETIRED

His Highness the Aga Khan's **Dalakhani (Ire)** (Darshaan {GB}--Daltawa {Ire}, by Miswaki) has been retired to Gilltown Stud in Ireland, it was announced yesterday. Following the sophomore's success in Sunday's G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp, the decision was made to send him to stand at the base of his late sire.

"Dalakhani is a very exciting addition to the Aga Khan's Studs' stallion roster," commented Irish manager Pat Downes yesterday. "It is also very pleasing that we have such a high-class son of Darshaan, who I am confident will provide a fitting replacement for his great sire. Dalakhani was without a doubt an outstanding racehorse with all the attributes we look for in a champion." Dalakhani was the winner of eight of his nine races, collecting a total of €2,180,790 in prizemoney. He was rated France's champion juvenile in the 2002 International Classifications by virtue of his successes in the G3 Prix des Chenes at Longchamp and G1 Criterium International at Saint-Cloud. He returned to take the G2 Prix Greffulhe and G1 Prix Lupin at Longchamp before winning the G1 Prix du Jockey Club (French Derby) at Chantilly. He suffered his only defeat at the hands of Alamshar (Ire) in the G1 Irish Derby at The Curragh before warming up for the Arc by taking the G2 Prix Niel at Longchamp. His 3/4-length defeat of Mubtaker in the autumn showpiece justified his conditioner Alain de Royer Dupré's assertion that he was "the complete racehorse." He added yesterday, "Dalakhani is definitely the greatest middle-distance performer I have ever trained. He has an exceptional temperament, which made him easy to train and incredibly consistent. IS CASUAL LOOK UP TO THE CHALLENGE?

G1 Epsom Oaks winner **Casual Look** (Red Ransom) makes her American debut in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup at Keeneland this afternoon, and a solid effort could earn her a trip to the Breeders' Cup. "If she runs like we hope, then [owner William S. Farish] is keeping an eye on the Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Turf," trainer Neil Howard told *Daily Racing Form*. Casual Look won two of her 10 starts in Europe. She broke her maiden by eight lengths as a juvenile, then ran second in the G1 Fillies Mile and G2 Rockfel S. Sixth in the G1 English 1000 Guineas to start her sophomore season, she won the Oaks in her second outing of the year. Third in the July 13 G1 Irish Oaks, she was off the board in the Aug. 20 G1 Yorkshire Oaks and the Sept. 14 G1 Prix Vermeille to end her overseas stint. While the bay makes her first appearance at Keeneland, **Ocean Drive** (Belong to Me) is a perfect two-for-two on the course. The dark bay took the Green River S. in Lexington last October and added a victory in the Appalachian S. in April. Five-for-seven on the lawn, she came back after a 2 1/2-month break to win the July 2 Gaviola S. at Belmont, but had to settle for second behind **Film Maker** (Dyanformer) in her latest, the July 28 GII Lake George H. Film Maker came back to be a close third to **Sand Springs** (Dynaformer) and **Indy Five Hundred** (A.P. Indy) in the Aug. 17 GII Lake Placid H.; Indy Five Hundred followed up with a win over Dimitrova and **Campsie Fells (UAE)** (Indian Ridge {Ire}) in the Sept. 7 GI Garden City Breeders' Cup H.

CORONADO'S QUEST SOLD TO JAPAN Eight-year-old **Coronado's Quest** (Forty Niner--Laughing Look, by Damascus), who has stood at Claiborne Farm in Paris, Kentucky since retiring to stud at the end of his 1998 campaign, has been sold to the Japan Bloodhorse Breeders' Association for an undisclosed sum. Narvick International acted as agent for the deal. Coronado's Quest won 10 of his 17 starts, including the GI Haskell Invitational H., GI Travers, GI Wood Memorial, GI Remsen S., GI Dwyer S., GI Riva Ridge S., GI Cowdin S. and GI Nashua S., and bankrolled \$2,046,190. With two crops to race, the chestnut has sired 29 winners and four stakes winners, with progeny earnings of more than \$1.8 million. He was represented by his first Grade I winner, Society Selection, in the Oct. 4 GI Frizette S. at Belmont Park. Coronado's Quest will join his sire at Shizunai Stallion Station in Japan. The purchase agreement includes a clause that gives Claiborne the right to buy the stallion back, should the JBBA either retire him or put him up for sale.

AFFLUENT RETIRED MGISW Affluent (Affirmed--Trinity Place, by Strawberry Road {Aus}), who finished third in the July 13 GI A Gleam H. at Hollywood Park last time out, has been retired. Trainer Ron McAnally told the *Daily Racing Form* that the decision was made to stop on the five-year-old because he was not happy with the way she was training. "At Del Mar, she got a little stiff and wasn't training that good," McAnally said. "We got her [to Santa Anita] and she was different. We breezed her once and she breezed good, but she got a little stiff. I called [owner Jan Whitham] and said, 'I think it's time.' She agreed." A winner in her only start at two, Affluent captured the GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup, GI La Brea S. and GI Hollywood Oaks at three; the GI John C. Mabee H. and GI El Encino S. at four; and the GI Santa Monica H. this year. Overall, she had eight wins, five seconds and four thirds from 23 starts. Her earnings totaled \$1,497,651. It has not yet been decided who she will be bred to.

THAT'S A WRAP AT TATTS An aggregate up 44 percent, an average up 28 percent and a median that rose 17 percent told the story of a remarkable Tattersalls October Yearling Sale, which finished in Newmarket last night. The 2003 sale saw a total of 125 six-figure lots, compared to 67 last year, and the previous record for highest price at the venue was more than doubled when a Dysis (GB) colt was bought by Demi O'Byrne for 1,000,000 guineas Wednesday night. Tattersalls Chairman Edmond Mahony reflected, "Last week's record-breaking Houghton Yearling Sale certainly gave cause for optimism going into part one of the October Yearling Sale, but we could not have predicted the massive rises across the board. Trade this week has been truly phenomenal and the Tattersalls October Yearling Sale record book has been completely rewritten. The sale has been the highest-grossing European yearling sale ever, with the average well over 50,000gns for the first time, a median in previously uncharted territory, the first-ever million guinea October yearling and a staggering 125 lots selling for 100,000gns or more. Last week we would have preferred a slightly larger catalogue, and this week slightly smaller as the sheer numbers have made it a demanding week for buyers, but the week has been a resounding success." He added, "As ever, enormous credit must go to the vendors who have brought the cream of the European yearling crop to Tattersalls in the last two weeks, and buyers from throughout the world have responded in spectacular fashion." Yesterday's lots had received the lowest grading of the week and the market noticeably slowed down accordingly, with a colt by Mujadil (Storm Bird), consigned by Max Ervine, leading the way. He was sold to agent Peter Doyle for 150,000gns. The colt's brother Vermilliann (Ire) represents trainer Richard Hannon in today's G3 Cornwallis S. at Ascot. "This colt is also going to Richard Hannon," said Doyle. "He was a nice type of horse and Richard thinks an awful lot of Vermilliann, although she has a long break to overcome at Ascot." **Tatts Toppers and Stats, p3**

Majestic Missile returns to his favored trip of five furlongs, having finished 2 ½ lengths behind Balmont when sixth in the G2 Gimcrack S. over a furlong further at York last time Aug. 20. That was a creditable performance, as he carried a three-pound penalty for his impressive 1 3/4-length defeat of **Nights Cross** in the G3 Molecomb S. at Goodwood previously July 31. He has extra to carry again here, but **Easycall** (GB) defied a heftier penalty in 1996. Marcus Tregoning saddled **Dominica** (GB) to win this two years ago and relies on **Tahreeb**, who finished third behind **Byron** (GB) and **Grand Reward** in the G2 Mill Reef S. at Newbury last time Sept. 19. Michael Jarvis won this in 1999 with **Kier Park** (Ire) and has strong claims with **Cartography**, based on his third placing in the G3 Sirenia S. at Kempton Sept. 6. He enjoyed a confidence booster when winning a Beverley conditions race last time Sept. 23 and has speed to burn. Fillies have a fine recent record and the unbeaten **Vermilliann** is an interesting contender. Off the track since winning a conditions event at Salisbury May 4, she could be anything.

NORTHERN SUNSET DEAD Northern Sunset (Ire) (Northfields--Moss Greine {GB}, by *Ballymoss), the 1995 Broodmare of the Year, suffered a stroke Friday morning and had to be put down. She was 26. Owned by Virginia Kraft Payson, she was purchased for \$105,000 while carrying her first foal, MGSW Salem Drive (Darby Creek Road). The Irish-bred proved to be the foundation mare for Payson Stud in Lexington, producing 1992 European Horse of the Year St. Jovite (Pleasant Colony), winner of the G1 Irish Derby and G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S.; millionaire GSW L'Carriere (Carr de Naskra), who was second in the G1 Breeders' Cup Classic and third in the G1 Dubai World Cup; and MGSW Lac Ouimet (Pleasant Colony). Eleven of her 12 foals to race were winners, and seven were stakes horses. In total, they earned more than \$5.5 million. She was also the great-granddam of 2002 champion three-year-old filly Farda Amiga, winner of the G1 Kentucky Oaks and G1 Alabama S.

CHAMPION OUTSTANDINGLY EUTHANIZED **Outstandingly** (Exclusive Native--La Mesa, by Round Table), the champion two-year-old filly of 1984, was euthanized yesterday at Gainsborough Farm in Kentucky due to the effects of chronic laminitis. Bred and raced by Harbor View Farm, the bay captured the inaugural running of the G1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies and the G1 Hollywood Starlet during her Eclipse Award-winning campaign. She went on to win four more stakes, including the GII Wilshire H., GII Las Palmas H. and GIII A Gleam H., and ran third in the G1 Breeders' Cup Distaff. She retired with 10 wins from 28 starts and earnings of \$1,412,206. She produced 12 foals, including Sensation (GB) (Soviet Star), a Group 2 winner in Britain and Group 3 winner in France; Superiority (Arazi), a stakes winner in the U.A.E.; and GSP Outlasting (Seattle Slew), herself the dam of GSW Fortitude (Cure the Blues). Her last foal is an unnamed filly by Aljabr; she also has an unraced two-year-old filly by Capote, named Life Story.

SUMMER COLONY RETIRED Summer Colony (Summer Squall--Probable Colony, by Pleasant Colony), who became the first horse to finish in front of Azeri when she got the better of the Horse of the Year by a length in the 2002 GII La Canada S., has been retired, the *Daily Racing Form* reports. The five-year-old mare's career was off to an inauspicious start, with three off-the-board finishes at two, but she blossomed when stretched to route races at three, breaking her maiden at Saratoga by an amazing 32 3/4 lengths. She would go on to win six graded stakes, including the G1 Personal Ensign H. and the La Canada at four and the GII Molly Pitcher Breeders' Cup H. this season. In her last outing, she finished fifth in the Oct. 4 G1 Beldame S. She goes to the breeding shed with 10 wins, five seconds and a third from 24 starts and a bankroll of \$1,448,930. "I think she's done enough," trainer Mark Hennig told *DRF*. "We were fortunate she's retired sound. She had a great career." The dark bay will join the Edward Evans broodmare band, which also added Gold Mover and Raging Fever this year. "We're looking forward to an awful nice group of producers," Hennig said. Summer Colony will be bred to Gone West.

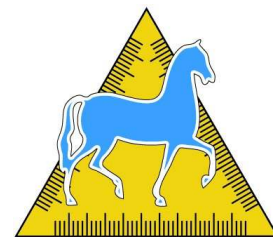

ROMANET RE-ELECTED

Louis Romanet has been re-elected as Chairman of the International Federation of Horseracing Authorities for a new three-year term of office. The General Assembly, which met at the 37th International Conference on Monday, also elected Britain's Christopher Foster as Vice Chairman in charge of regulatory matters, US-based Alan Marzelli as Vice Chairman in charge of commercial matters, and the Asian Racing Federation's Larry Wong as Vice Chairman. The latter appointment underlined the increasing role of Asia on the international racing scene, with the Executive Council expressing its wish to develop co-operation between these three areas to strengthen the role and powers of the International Federation.

INTERNATIONAL ENTRIES FOR HKIR

The latter two runners are slated to kick off their respective 2003-2004 seasons in Saturday's G3-HK Sha Tin Sprint Trophy. Eleven entries were received from the U.S. including top sprinters **Avanzado (Arg)** (Luhuk) and **Bluesthestandard** (American Standard).
